

Notes of Floyd E. Taylor for Mar. 14, 2011, Teleconference Bible Study

### Discerning the Abomination of Desolation and the Time Length of the Affliction of the Desolation

Tonight we are going to consider a very important subject and see what it means, now that we understand the plague that the Lord is sending upon the people. That subject is the Abomination of Desolation that was mentioned by Daniel the prophet.

Let's look again at Matthew 24:22 and Mark 13:20. Consider His warning of there would be no "flesh" left who would be "saved".

- **Matthew 24:15-28** <sup>15</sup>"Therefore when you see the 'abomination of desolation,' spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place" (whoever reads, let him understand), <sup>16</sup>"then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains. <sup>17</sup>Let him who is on the housetop not go down to take anything out of his house. <sup>18</sup>And let him who is in the field not go back to get his clothes. <sup>19</sup>But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days! <sup>20</sup>And pray that your flight may not be in winter or on the Sabbath. <sup>21</sup>For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be. <sup>22</sup>**AND UNLESS THOSE DAYS WERE SHORTENED, NO FLESH WOULD BE SAVED; BUT FOR THE ELECT'S SAKE THOSE DAYS WILL BE SHORTENED.** <sup>23</sup>"Then if anyone says to you, 'Look, here *is* the Christ!' or 'There!' do not believe *it*. <sup>24</sup>For false christs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect. <sup>25</sup>See, I have told you beforehand. <sup>26</sup>"Therefore if they say to you, 'Look, He is in the desert!' do not go out; *or* 'Look, He is in the inner rooms!' do not believe *it*. <sup>27</sup>For as the lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. <sup>28</sup>For wherever the carcass is, there the eagles will be gathered together.
- **Mark 13:14-23** <sup>14</sup>"So when you see the 'abomination of desolation,' spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not" (let the reader understand), "then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains. <sup>15</sup>Let him who is on the housetop not go down into the house, nor enter to take anything out of his house. <sup>16</sup>And let him who is in the field not go back to get his clothes. <sup>17</sup>But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days! <sup>18</sup>And pray that your flight may not be in winter. <sup>19</sup>For *in* those days there will be tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the creation which God created until this time, nor ever shall be. <sup>20</sup>**AND UNLESS THE LORD HAD SHORTENED THOSE DAYS, NO FLESH WOULD BE SAVED; BUT FOR THE ELECT'S SAKE, WHOM HE CHOSE, HE SHORTENED THE DAYS.** <sup>21</sup>"Then if anyone says to you, 'Look, here *is* the Christ!' or, 'Look, He is there!' do not believe *it*. <sup>22</sup>For false christs and false prophets will rise and show signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect. <sup>23</sup>But take heed; see, I have told you all things beforehand.
- **Matthew 24:27** "For as the lightning comes from the East and flashes to the West, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be."

First, the following Prophetic Words were posted on the Internet today.

March 14, 2011: Examine yourself to see if you are in faith. Confront fear and unbelief and overcome, for you are My people of faith. And if not you, who? Rise up and demonstrate My kingdom. ### Audience with the King

Prayer was never meant to be dry, dull or drudgery; on the contrary, it is to be a delightful audience with the KING! We have been granted a wonderful privilege: to approach God! It's almost unbelievable to think that God has invited us to approach Him to behold Him upon His throne. This is an invitation that none can afford to turn down.

The writer of the book of Hebrews states strongly, "Let us then fearlessly and confidently and boldly draw near to the throne of grace (the throne of God's unmerited favor to us sinners), that we may receive mercy [for our failures] and find grace to help in good time for every need [appropriate help and well-timed help, coming just when we need it]" (Hebrews 4:16 AMP).

The Spirit of Truth is, at this time, releasing insights with understanding concerning the power of prayer. We are experiencing the power of the decree; God is turning prayer from a "plea" to a "powerful proclamation"! From, "Oh, God would You?" to "God, You promised!" Remember, you have not because you ask not (see James 4:2). Jesus states: "Ask and you shall receive, seek and you will find"!

Today, take a stand and boldly make your request known to God, having total confidence that He is hearing you and will grant your request.

## Notes for Mar. 14, 2011 Teleconference Bible Study with Floyd E. Taylor

"And this is the confidence (the assurance, the privilege of boldness) which we have in Him: [we are sure] that if we ask anything (make any request) according to His will (in agreement with His own plan), He listens to and hears us. And if (since) we [positively] know that He listens to us in whatever we ask, we also know [with settled and absolute knowledge] that we have [granted us as our present possessions] the requests made of Him" (1 John 5:14-15).

Christ Jesus states: "Truly I tell you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be lifted up and thrown into the sea!' and does not doubt at all in his heart but believes that what he says will take place, it will be done for him. For this reason I am telling you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe (trust and be confident) that it is granted to you, and you will [get it]" (Mark 11:23-24).

I encourage you to cast all your cares upon Christ Jesus, He truly cares for you, and in Him you will find a friend that sticks closer than a brother. In Him, you will find a constant help in the time of need. Just as Queen Esther in the Book of Esther, prepare your heart to come before your King (Christ Jesus), you too will discover a warm welcome. You will find He is willing and waiting to release to you your heart's request (see Esther 5:1-3).

**God has promised that this is a season of His favor.** For He says, "In the time of favor (of an assured welcome) I have listened to and heeded your call, and I have helped you on the day of deliverance (the day of salvation). Behold, now is truly the time for a gracious welcome and acceptance [of you from God]; behold, now is the day of salvation!" (2 Corinthians 6:2 AMP).

God bless you as you prepare to approach your King!

Tonight I would like to remind us of the Promise of God for those who will not obey His Voice (*They will not hear His Words and come to him to seek the Knowledge of Truth that they are able to rightly divide the Word of Truth - that they might rightly discern the Words of God.*), and they will not honor His covenant that is found in Leviticus 26, will suffer the plague of desolation. That is the meaning of the "abomination of desolations". Then we should begin to understand what Daniel is saying in Daniel chapter 9 and Daniel chapter 10. Most people think that the Abomination is the thing that will be set up in the Temple at the time of the Antichrist. That will occur, but that is not the abomination that is being reviewed by Daniel in Daniel 9 and in Daniel 12. That is the second punishment.

The abomination is the Pompous Words spoken by the Beast in the days when the Father has opened His Words and thus they commit abomination of God and they receive the inheritance of the desolation. The desolation is the destruction of the skin and the loss of everything. The Abomination is the refusal to hear His Words and to trample upon His Covenant over the Heavens. That is exactly what the 13 families and the One World Order is doing at this Time, and for that reason they have the Promise of God to have the desolation poured out upon them at the Appointed time. There are two such times revealed in the Bible. The first is at the Tribulation and the culmination of it that comes immediately after the Tribulation (I believe the Tribulation is started now and the finish will be by Rosh Hashanah. That is when the Desolation comes. That is what Daniel talking about in Daniel 9 and Daniel 12. We will walk through this. It is important that you listen to the audio message of this Bible Study tonight so that you get the fullness of this as we walk through these verses. We need to look at Leviticus 26, Daniel 9, Revelation 18, and Daniel 12, but not necessarily will we do so in that order. We also need to remember a statement made in the Parable of the Ten Virgins. We will go over these.

Let us look at the promise of the Appointed Time when He will send the curse of desolation, as it is in Leviticus 26:

↪ **Leviticus 26:1-46** 'You shall not make idols for yourselves; neither a carved image nor a sacred pillar shall you rear up for yourselves; nor shall you set up an engraved stone in your land, to bow down to it; for I am the LORD your God. **<sup>2</sup>YOU SHALL KEEP MY SABBATHS AND REVERENCE MY SANCTUARY: I AM THE LORD.** <sup>3</sup>If you walk in My statutes and keep My commandments, and perform them, <sup>4</sup>then I will give you rain in its season, the land shall yield its produce, and the trees of the field shall yield their fruit. <sup>5</sup>Your threshing shall last till the time of vintage, and the vintage shall last till the time of sowing; **YOU SHALL EAT YOUR BREAD TO THE FULL, AND DWELL IN YOUR LAND SAFELY.** <sup>6</sup>**I WILL GIVE PEACE IN THE LAND, AND YOU SHALL LIE DOWN, AND NONE WILL MAKE YOU AFRAID; I WILL RID THE LAND OF EVIL BEASTS, AND THE SWORD WILL NOT GO THROUGH YOUR LAND.** <sup>7</sup>You will chase your enemies, and they shall fall by the sword before you. <sup>8</sup>Five of you shall chase a hundred, and a hundred of you shall put ten thousand to flight; your enemies shall fall by the sword before you. <sup>9</sup>For I will look on you favorably and make you fruitful, multiply you and confirm My covenant with you. <sup>10</sup>You shall eat the old harvest, and clear out the old because of the new. <sup>11</sup>I will set My tabernacle among you, and My soul shall not abhor you. <sup>12</sup>I will walk among you and be your God, and you shall be My people. <sup>13</sup>I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, that you should not be their slaves; I have broken the bands of your yoke and made you walk upright. **<sup>14</sup>BUT IF YOU DO NOT OBEY ME, AND DO NOT OBSERVE ALL THESE COMMANDMENTS, <sup>15</sup>AND IF YOU DESPISE MY STATUTES, OR IF YOUR SOUL ABHORS MY JUDGMENTS, SO THAT YOU DO NOT PERFORM ALL MY COMMANDMENTS, BUT BREAK MY COVENANT, <sup>16</sup>I ALSO WILL DO THIS TO YOU: I WILL EVEN APPOINT TERROR OVER YOU, WASTING DISEASE AND FEVER WHICH SHALL CONSUME THE EYES AND CAUSE SORROW OF HEART. AND YOU SHALL SOW YOUR SEED IN VAIN, FOR YOUR ENEMIES SHALL EAT IT. <sup>17</sup>I will set My face against you, and you shall be defeated by your enemies. Those who hate you shall reign over you, and YOU SHALL FLEE WHEN NO ONE PURSUES YOU.**

<sup>18</sup>And after all this, if you do not obey Me, then I will punish you seven times more for your sins. <sup>19</sup>I will break the pride of your power; I will make your heavens like iron and your earth like bronze. <sup>20</sup>And your strength shall be spent in vain; for your land shall not yield its produce, nor shall the trees of the land yield their fruit. <sup>21</sup>Then, if you walk contrary to Me, and are not willing to obey Me, I will bring on you seven times more plagues, according to your sins. <sup>22</sup>I will also send wild beasts among you, which shall rob you of your children, destroy your livestock, and make you few in number; and your highways shall be desolate. <sup>23</sup>And if by these things you are not reformed by Me, but walk contrary to Me, <sup>24</sup>then I also will walk contrary to you, and I will punish you yet seven times for your sins. <sup>25</sup>AND I WILL BRING A SWORD AGAINST YOU THAT WILL EXECUTE THE VENGEANCE OF THE COVENANT; WHEN YOU ARE GATHERED TOGETHER WITHIN YOUR CITIES I WILL SEND PESTILENCE AMONG YOU; AND YOU SHALL BE DELIVERED INTO THE HAND OF THE ENEMY. <sup>26</sup>WHEN I HAVE CUT OFF YOUR SUPPLY OF BREAD, TEN WOMEN SHALL BAKE YOUR BREAD IN ONE OVEN, AND THEY SHALL BRING BACK YOUR BREAD BY WEIGHT, AND YOU SHALL EAT AND NOT BE SATISFIED. <sup>27</sup>And after all this, if you do not obey Me, but walk contrary to Me, <sup>28</sup>THEN I ALSO WILL WALK CONTRARY TO YOU IN FURY; AND I, EVEN I, WILL CHASTISE YOU SEVEN TIMES FOR YOUR SINS. <sup>29</sup>YOU SHALL EAT THE FLESH OF YOUR SONS, AND YOU SHALL EAT THE FLESH OF YOUR DAUGHTERS. <sup>30</sup>I WILL DESTROY YOUR HIGH PLACES, CUT DOWN YOUR INCENSE ALTARS, AND CAST YOUR CARCASSES ON THE LIFELESS FORMS OF YOUR IDOLS; AND MY SOUL SHALL ABHOR YOU. <sup>31</sup>I will lay your cities waste and bring your sanctuaries to desolation, and I will not smell the fragrance of your sweet aromas. <sup>32</sup>I will bring the land to desolation, and your enemies who dwell in it shall be astonished at it. <sup>33</sup>I will scatter you among the nations and draw out a sword after you; your land shall be desolate and your cities waste. <sup>34</sup>Then the land shall enjoy its Sabbaths as long as it lies desolate and you are in your enemies' land; then the land shall rest and enjoy its Sabbaths. <sup>35</sup>As long as it lies desolate it shall rest—for the time it did not rest on your Sabbaths when you dwelt in it. <sup>36</sup>And as for those of you who are left, I will send faintness into their hearts in the lands of their enemies; the sound of a shaken leaf shall cause them to flee; they shall flee as though fleeing from a sword, and they shall fall when no one pursues. <sup>37</sup>They shall stumble over one another, as it were before a sword, when no one pursues; and you shall have no *power* to stand before your enemies. <sup>38</sup>You shall perish among the nations, and the land of your enemies shall eat you up. <sup>39</sup>And those of you who are left shall waste away in their iniquity in your enemies' lands; also in their fathers' iniquities, which are with them, they shall waste away. <sup>40</sup>But if they confess their iniquity and the iniquity of their fathers, with their unfaithfulness in which they were unfaithful to Me, and that they also have walked contrary to Me, <sup>41</sup>and that I also have walked contrary to them and have brought them into the land of their enemies; if their uncircumcised hearts are humbled, and they accept their guilt— <sup>42</sup>then I will remember My covenant with Jacob, and My covenant with Isaac and My covenant with Abraham I will remember; I will remember the land. <sup>43</sup>The land also shall be left empty by them, and will enjoy its Sabbaths while it lies desolate without them; they will accept their guilt, because they despised My judgments and because their soul abhorred My statutes. <sup>44</sup>Yet for all that, when they are in the land of their enemies, I will not cast them away, nor shall I abhor them, to utterly destroy them and break My covenant with them; for I am the LORD their God. <sup>45</sup>But for their sake I will remember the covenant of their ancestors, whom I brought out of the land of Egypt in the sight of the nations, that I might be their God: I am the LORD.' " <sup>46</sup>These are the statutes and judgments and laws which the LORD made between Himself and the children of Israel on Mount Sinai by the hand of Moses.

In Daniel chapter 9 there is a report of the fasting and prayer that Daniel did to call out to the Lord for understanding as to when His People would return to Him and that they would come to the understanding of His Truth (*That is the understanding of His Words - the time when they would come to the knowledge of Truth as a nation - doing the Ways of God as like a "city" that follows the Lord and honors God's Name.*) Consider the testimony of the people of Israel and why Daniel said they need to repent and what He was asking of the Lord. This is our situation. There is a reason why the Lord warned us of this day to remember the men of Nineveh and the Queen of the South, for they humbled themselves and sought out the knowledge of Truth and saved their peoples. In Daniel 9:2 it is made clear that Daniel knew it was the fulfillment of an Appointed Time.

→ **Daniel 9:1-19** <sup>1</sup>In the first year of Darius the son of Ahasuerus, of the lineage of the Medes, who was made king over the realm of the Chaldeans— <sup>2</sup>in the first year of his reign I, DANIEL, UNDERSTOOD BY THE BOOKS THE NUMBER OF THE YEARS SPECIFIED BY THE WORD OF THE LORD THROUGH JEREMIAH THE PROPHET, (*Take notice that he is revealing that the Appointed Times are set by the Words of God.*), that He would accomplish seventy years in the desolations of Jerusalem. <sup>3</sup>Then I set my face toward the Lord God to make request by prayer and supplications, with fasting, sackcloth, and ashes. <sup>4</sup>And I prayed to the LORD my God, and made confession, and said, "O Lord, great and awesome God, who keeps His covenant and mercy with those who love Him, and with those who keep His commandments, <sup>5</sup>we have sinned and committed iniquity, we have done wickedly and rebelled, even by departing from Your precepts and Your judgments. <sup>6</sup>Neither have we heeded Your servants the prophets, who spoke in Your name to our kings and our princes, to our fathers and all the people of the land. <sup>7</sup>O Lord, righteousness belongs to You, but to us shame of face, as it is this day—to the men of Judah, to the inhabitants of Jerusalem and all Israel, those near and those far off in all the countries to which You have driven them, because of the unfaithfulness which they have committed against You. <sup>8</sup>"O Lord, to us belongs shame of face, to our kings, our princes, and our fathers, because we have sinned against You. <sup>9</sup>To the Lord our God belong mercy and forgiveness, though we have rebelled against Him. <sup>10</sup>We have not obeyed the voice of the LORD our God, to walk in His laws, which He set before us by His servants the prophets. <sup>11</sup>Yes, all Israel has transgressed Your law, and has departed so as not to obey Your voice; therefore the curse and the oath written in the Law of Moses the servant of God have been poured out on us, because we have sinned against Him. <sup>12</sup>And He has confirmed His words, which He spoke against us and against our judges who judged us, by bringing upon us a great disaster; for under the whole heaven such has never been done as what has been done to Jerusalem. <sup>13</sup>"AS IT IS WRITTEN IN THE LAW OF MOSES, ALL THIS DISASTER HAS COME UPON US; YET WE HAVE NOT MADE OUR PRAYER BEFORE THE LORD OUR GOD, THAT WE MIGHT TURN FROM OUR INIQUITIES AND UNDERSTAND YOUR TRUTH. <sup>14</sup>THEREFORE THE LORD HAS KEPT THE DISASTER IN MIND, AND BROUGHT IT UPON US; FOR THE LORD OUR GOD IS RIGHTEOUS IN ALL THE WORKS WHICH HE DOES, THOUGH WE HAVE NOT OBEYED HIS VOICE. <sup>15</sup>And now, O Lord our God, who brought Your people out of the land of Egypt with a mighty hand, and made Yourself a name, as it is this day—we have sinned, we have done wickedly! <sup>16</sup>"O LORD, ACCORDING TO ALL YOUR RIGHTEOUSNESS, I PRAY, LET YOUR ANGER AND YOUR FURY BE TURNED AWAY FROM YOUR CITY JERUSALEM, YOUR HOLY MOUNTAIN; BECAUSE FOR OUR SINS, AND FOR THE INIQUITIES OF OUR FATHERS, JERUSALEM AND YOUR PEOPLE ARE A REPROACH TO ALL THOSE AROUND US. <sup>17</sup>NOW THEREFORE, OUR GOD, HEAR THE PRAYER OF YOUR SERVANT, AND HIS SUPPLICATIONS, AND FOR THE LORD'S SAKE CAUSE YOUR FACE TO SHINE ON YOUR SANCTUARY, WHICH IS DESOLATE. <sup>18</sup>O MY GOD, INCLINE YOUR EAR AND HEAR; OPEN YOUR EYES AND SEE OUR DESOLATIONS, AND THE CITY WHICH IS CALLED BY YOUR NAME; FOR WE DO NOT PRESENT OUR SUPPLICATIONS

**BEFORE YOU BECAUSE OF OUR RIGHTEOUS DEEDS, BUT BECAUSE OF YOUR GREAT MERCIES. <sup>19</sup>O LORD, HEAR! O LORD, FORGIVE! O LORD, LISTEN AND ACT! DO NOT DELAY FOR YOUR OWN SAKE, MY GOD, FOR YOUR CITY AND YOUR PEOPLE ARE CALLED BY YOUR NAME."**

The Lord's answer given in the Seventy-Weeks Prophecy that has two explanations of the Timing of when the Lord will cause His City to turn to Righteousness by the Lord causing them to hear Him and to return to Him. The first timing relates of the Time from Daniel until now (*See the maroon and gold colored Timing chart*). The second timing relates to the time from the beginning of the Time that the Lord establishes His Kingdom on the earth

→ **Daniel 9:20-27** <sup>20</sup>Now while I was speaking, praying, and confessing my sin and the sin of my people Israel, and presenting my supplication before the LORD my God for the holy mountain of my God, <sup>21</sup>yes, while I was speaking in prayer, the man Gabriel, whom I had seen in the vision at the beginning, being caused to fly swiftly, reached me about the time of the evening offering. <sup>22</sup>And he informed me, and talked with me, and said, "O Daniel, I have now come forth to give you skill to understand. <sup>23</sup>At the beginning of your supplications the command went out, and I have come to tell you, for you are greatly beloved; therefore consider the matter, and understand the vision: <sup>24</sup>Seventy weeks are determined for your people and for your holy city, **TO FINISH THE TRANSGRESSION, TO MAKE AN**



**END OF SINS, TO MAKE RECONCILIATION FOR INIQUITY, TO BRING IN EVERLASTING RIGHTEOUSNESS, TO SEAL UP VISION AND PROPHECY, AND TO ANOINT THE MOST HOLY.** <sup>25</sup>Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the command to restore and build Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince, there *shall be* seven weeks and sixty-two weeks; the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublesome times. <sup>26</sup>And after the sixty-two weeks Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself; and the people of the prince who is to come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary. (*This destruction occurred in 70 AD*). **THE END OF IT SHALL BE WITH A FLOOD, AND TILL THE END OF THE WAR DESOLATIONS ARE DETERMINED.** (*This confirms that the end of the desolations will be at the End of the Ezekiel 38 War. The Lord calls it "THE WAR" and it is the War that ends with "THE*

**FLOOD" - this is the Flood that is described in Ezekiel 38:22.)** **27** THEN HE SHALL CONFIRM A COVENANT WITH MANY FOR ONE WEEK; BUT IN THE MIDDLE OF THE WEEK HE SHALL BRING AN END TO SACRIFICE AND OFFERING. **AND ON THE WING OF ABOMINATIONS SHALL BE ONE WHO MAKES DESOLATE, EVEN UNTIL THE CONSUMMATION, WHICH IS DETERMINED, IS Poured OUT ON THE DESOLATE** (This reveals that the Desolation is the result of the abomination. It is an Appointed Time that comes from the Lord as a result of the abomination of the people. The desolation causes the peoples to be consumed. That is the plague that I have told you about.)

In Daniel 12:1-13 we are confirmed the timing of these things. Consider verse 13 clarifies that this will occur before the Time of the Rapture. Thus we have the clear picture when compared with Daniel 9:26-27.

→ **Daniel 12:1-13** <sup>1</sup>"At that time Michael shall stand up, the great prince who stands watch over the sons of your people; and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation, even to that time. And at that time your people shall be delivered, everyone who is found written in the book. <sup>2</sup>And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, some to shame and everlasting contempt. <sup>3</sup>Those who are wise shall shine like the brightness of the firmament, and those who turn many to righteousness like the stars forever and ever. <sup>4</sup>"But you, Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book until the time of the end; many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall increase." <sup>5</sup>Then I, Daniel, looked; and there stood two others, one on this riverbank and the other on that riverbank. <sup>6</sup>And one said to the man clothed in linen, who was above the waters of the river, "How long shall the fulfillment of these wonders be?" <sup>7</sup>Then I heard the man clothed in linen, who was above the waters of the river, when he held up his right hand and his left hand to heaven, and swore by Him who lives forever, that it shall be for a time, times, and half a time; and when the power of the holy people has been completely shattered, all these things shall be finished. <sup>8</sup>Although I heard, I did not understand. Then I said, "My Lord, what shall be the end of these things?" <sup>9</sup>And he said, "Go your way, Daniel, for the words are closed up and sealed till the time of the end. <sup>10</sup>Many shall be purified, made white, and refined, but the wicked shall do wickedly; and none of the wicked shall understand, but the wise shall understand. <sup>11</sup>"And from the time that the daily sacrifice is taken away, and the abomination of desolation is set up, there shall be one thousand two hundred and ninety days. <sup>12</sup>Blessed is he who waits, and comes to the one thousand three hundred and thirty-five days. <sup>13</sup>"But you, go your way till the end; for you shall rest, and will arise to your inheritance at the end of the days."

Parable of the Ten Virgins reveals in verse 9 that there is a time gap from the beginning of the Tribulation to the completion of the receipt of the fullness of the desolation. But, the unwise know - they have the beginnings of the plague - and they know it is about to come upon them for the 1290 days of the plague, as it is made known in Daniel 12:11. The healing of the plague is not for 1,335 days because it incorporates the 45 days of mourning. The plague will be over before the Rapture event occurs, as is also revealed in the event scheduling of Daniel 12:11-13. I will make a chart of this timing and include it in tomorrow night's Bible Study.

→ **Matthew 25:1-13** <sup>1</sup>Then shall the Kingdom of Heaven be likened unto ten virgins, which took their lamps, and went forth to meet the bridegroom. <sup>2</sup>Now five of them were wise, and five were foolish. <sup>3</sup>Those who were foolish took their lamps, and received no oil in them: <sup>4</sup>But the wise received oil in their vessels of their lamps. **5** WHILE THE BRIDEGROOM DELAYED, THEY ALL NODDED AND SLEPT. (Take notice that they all sleep through the invitations to come to the Great Evening Supper to eat of the bread of His Instruction? At best they will have a chance to come at the last second before Midnight.) **6** AND AT MIDNIGHT A CRY OCCURRED, "BEHOLD, THE BRIDEGROOM COMES! GO FORTH TO A MEETING OF HIM". <sup>7</sup> THEN ALL THOSE VIRGINS AROSE, AND

**TRIMMED THEIR LAMPS.** <sup>8</sup>**AND THE FOOLISH SAID UNTO THE WISE, "GIVE US OF YOUR OIL; FOR OUR LAMPS HAVE GONE OUT."** <sup>9</sup>But the wise answered, saying, "Lest there be not enough for us and for you: but rather you go to them that sell, and buy for yourselves." <sup>10</sup>And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came; and they that were ready went in with him to the marriage: and the door was shut. <sup>11</sup>Afterward came also the other virgins, saying, "Lord, Lord, open to us." <sup>12</sup>But He answered and said, "Verily I say unto you, I know you not." <sup>13</sup>Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of man comes.

- **Matthew 7:21-23** <sup>21</sup>"Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. <sup>22</sup>Many will say to Me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?' <sup>23</sup>**AND THEN I WILL DECLARE TO THEM, 'I NEVER KNEW YOU; DEPART FROM ME, YOU WHO PRACTICE LAWLESSNESS!'"**

In Job 24:1 we are told that we are to know the Times of God IF WE KNOW HIM. That is the problem we have, for our eyes are closed to what He is telling us in His Words. This is why we were not aware we were to be looking to become a tooth on His Threshing Sledge, and that we should have been looking for the knowledge of the Sun rising at the same time as the Night.

- **Job 24:1** "Since times are not hidden from the Almighty, why do those who know Him see not His days?" (*Job is saying if we know the Father, then we will understand His Times.*)
- **Proverbs 9:10** Understanding of the Holy is knowledge. (*God is Holy, Psalm 99:9.*)
- **Psalm 119:130** **The Entrance of Your Words GIVES LIGHT; it gives Understanding to the Simple.**
- **Revelation 6:3-4** <sup>3</sup>When He opened the second seal, I heard the second living creature saying, "Come and see." <sup>4</sup>Another horse, fiery red, went out. And **IT WAS GRANTED TO THE ONE WHO SAT ON IT TO TAKE PEACE FROM THE EARTH, AND THAT PEOPLE SHOULD KILL ONE ANOTHER; AND THERE WAS GIVEN TO HIM A GREAT SWORD.**
- **Joel 2:32** <sup>32</sup>**AND IT SHALL COME TO PASS THAT WHOEVER CALLS ON THE NAME OF THE LORD SHALL BE SAVED.** For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, as the Lord has said, among the remnant WHOM THE LORD CALLS. (*It is our assigned work in this Day to be an army of people who do the Ways of His Words for others so that we enable the Lord - the Words - to call many to Him. Those who turn others to the Truth shall cover a multitude of Sins - James 5:19-20.*)
- **John 5:24** "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My Word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and **SHALL NOT COME INTO JUDGMENT**, but has passed from death into everlasting life."
- **Zephaniah 3:20** At that time I will bring you back, even at the Time I gather you (*Matthew 25:31-34, Ezekiel 36:22-36*); for I will give you fame and praise among all the peoples of the earth, when I return your captives before your eyes," says the Lord. (*After the Compelling Event Gog will be afraid to hold a Jewish person captive, or anyone who speaks in the Lord's Pure Language, for they will come to fear God, and they will let His Elect free for they will know He will greatly punish those who oppose His Name they speak.*)
- **John 8:12** Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the Light of the world. **HE WHO FOLLOWS ME SHALL not walk in darkness, but HAVE THE LIGHT OF LIFE.**"
- **John 8:28** **I DO NOTHING ON MY OWN BUT SPEAK JUST WHAT THE FATHER HAS TAUGHT ME.**

## URGENT RED ALERT!!!! THE BRIDEGROOM COMES!!!! HIS REWARD COMES WITH HIM!!!!!! God's Plague for the Complacent and the Disobedient Is Coming!



The Bridegroom is coming! But, do you know what happens if you have not put on a garment and come out of your dressing room? The answer is you are going to receive of a plague that will shock you so mightily that you will suddenly fear God. The Lord makes clear in the Bible the sign of His Appearing for the Harvest Judgment. It is that all those who do not have His Seal of His Words inside of them – meaning that they have not rightly divided the Word of Truth and therefore do not have the knowledge of His Truth in them – shall receive of the Father's Plague that has been reserved for this Night of the Day of the Lord as the punishment upon the complacent (the lukewarm who are unwise) and for the wicked. It is a plague from the Father that no man on earth will be able to cure. It is a plague of the Right Finger of God, for it will strike the heads of all the unwise and the wicked. But, it will first begin at the house of the Lord and upon the leaders of Government who have made rules over His church, such as the removal of prayers from school and the requirement to recognize homosexuality despite the Law of God. It is a plague of severe leprosy such as has never seen before. No man who receives of it will be able to work, for there eyes will be closed and darkened, their tongues will decay, and their skin will rot off! The Father warned the people that He will cut them off and they will wither. Like He did to the people at the Tower of Babel, He will reform them as a Potter. He will give them a body of dishonor.

He has warned us to hear His Voice and come out, or else!

**John 15:6** "If anyone does not abide in Me, **he is cast out as a branch and is withered**; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned." (*A terrible plague now comes!*)

**Psalms 2:9** "You shall break them with a rod of iron; You shall dash them to pieces like a potter's vessel." (*The world leaders have refused to believe He is in charge of all Creation, and they doubted His Power.*)

**Revelation 2:27** "He shall rule them with a rod of iron; they shall be dashed to pieces like the potter's vessels' — as I also have received from My Father;" (*He will crush satan's One World Order by His Plague!*)

**John 9:39** "And Jesus said, "For judgment I have come into this world, that those who do not see may see, and that those who see may be made blind." (*The eye is the lamp of the body, and it will go out!*)

**Zechariah 14:12** And this shall be the plague with which the LORD will strike all the people who fought against Jerusalem: **Their flesh shall dissolve (This word means "decay", or "be destroyed") while they stand on their feet, their eyes shall dissolve in their sockets, and their tongues shall dissolve in their mouths.**



## Man has Lived by the Flesh and Not By His, Now He Will Forget Man's Flesh!

The Lord's flesh of the body is the symbol of the Way of the Words of God that He spoke and that He kept. The blood of Christ is the Work of God that was given to Him to complete. He gave His blood on the Cross as the required purchase price to open to us the knowledge of Truth – the knowledge of God's Words. Jesus warned us in John 6:53-58 that if we do not eat of His flesh and do not drink of His blood, then we will not gain Eternal Life but shall be cut off by the Father. The Father told us in Deut. 18:18-19 that if we will not hear the Words that Jesus the Christ was sent into the world to speak, that He would hold us into account. Our body is to be His house. We are to build it upon the Rock of His Words. If we do not, then He will break us down so He can rebuild us, or He will cast us out from Him.

**Isaiah 64:8** But now, O LORD, You are our Father; We are the clay, and You our potter; And all we are the work of Your hand." (*If we repent zealously He will remold us perfect!*)



**Romans 9:21** "Does not the potter have power over the clay, from the same lump to make one vessel for honor and another for dishonor?"

**Gal. 6:8** "For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life."

**Is. 52:10** The LORD has made bare His holy arm in the eyes of all the nations; and all the ends of the earth shall see the salvation of our God.

**Revelation 2:27** "He shall rule them with a rod of iron; they shall be dashed to pieces like the potter's vessels' — as I also have received from My Father;"

**Isaiah 29:16** "Surely you have things turned around! Shall the potter be esteemed as the clay; For shall the thing made say of him who made it, "He did not make me"? Or shall the thing formed say of him who formed it, "He has no understanding"?"

**Exodus 4:11** "So the LORD said to him, "Who has made man's mouth? Or who makes the mute, the deaf, the seeing, or the blind? Have not I, the LORD?""

**Psalms 127:1** "Unless the Lord builds the house, they labor in vain who build it; unless the Lord guards the city, the watchman stays awake in vain."

**Isaiah 41:25** "I have raised up one from the North (*This means the world – Job 26:7*), And he shall come; from the rising of the sun he shall call on My Name; And he shall come against princes as though mortar, as the potter treads clay."



- **John 8:31-47** <sup>31</sup>Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, **"IF YOU ABIDE IN MY WORD, YOU ARE MY DISCIPLES INDEED.** <sup>32</sup>**AND YOU SHALL KNOW THE TRUTH, AND THE TRUTH SHALL MAKE YOU FREE."** <sup>33</sup>They answered Him, "We are Abraham's descendants, and have never been in bondage to anyone. How *can* You say, 'You will be made free?'" <sup>34</sup>Jesus answered them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin. <sup>35</sup>And a slave does not abide in the house forever, *but a son abides forever.* <sup>36</sup>Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed. <sup>37</sup>**"I KNOW THAT YOU ARE ABRAHAM'S DESCENDANTS, BUT YOU SEEK TO KILL ME, BECAUSE MY WORD HAS NO PLACE IN YOU.** <sup>38</sup>**I SPEAK WHAT I HAVE SEEN WITH MY FATHER, AND YOU DO WHAT YOU HAVE SEEN WITH YOUR FATHER."** <sup>39</sup>They answered and said to Him, "Abraham is our father." Jesus said to them, "If you were Abraham's children, you would do the works of Abraham. <sup>40</sup>But now you seek to kill Me, **A MAN WHO HAS TOLD YOU THE TRUTH WHICH I HEARD FROM GOD."** <sup>41</sup>You do the deeds of your father." Then they said to Him, "We were not born of fornication; we have one Father--God." <sup>42</sup>Jesus said to them, "If God were your Father, you would love Me, for I proceeded forth and came from God; nor have I come of Myself, but He sent Me. <sup>43</sup>**WHY DO YOU NOT UNDERSTAND MY SPEECH?** (*Pure Language of His Pure and Holy words that He set apart with His Promises of Good Works from before the Creation.*) **BECAUSE YOU ARE NOT ABLE TO LISTEN TO MY WORD.** <sup>44</sup>You are of *your* father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the Truth, because there is no Truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own *resources*, for he is a liar and the father of it. <sup>45</sup>But **because I tell the Truth, you do not believe Me.** <sup>46</sup>Which of you convicts Me of sin? **AND IF I TELL THE TRUTH, WHY DO YOU NOT BELIEVE ME?** <sup>47</sup>**HE WHO IS OF GOD HEARS GOD'S WORDS; THEREFORE YOU DO NOT HEAR, BECAUSE YOU ARE NOT OF GOD."**
- **John 8:51** **Most assuredly, I say to you, if anyone keeps My Word he shall never see Death.** (*Death is the name of one of the prisons of God. There is the 2<sup>nd</sup> Death, which has the same tortures and beasts of punishment as the prison that is called the 1<sup>st</sup> Death. The first Death is alongside the Pit in the Outer Darkness, but it is above the physical location of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Death. Whoever goes into the second Death shall never return. In this Writing we will review the Creation and look at where Death is located. The King of Beasts is located there).*

## DESOLATION

- **Leviticus 26:31** I will lay your cities waste and bring your sanctuaries to **desolation**, and I will not smell the fragrance of your sweet aromas.
- **Leviticus 26:32** I will bring the land to **desolation**, and your enemies who dwell in it shall be astonished at it.
- **Jos 8:28** So Joshua burned AI and made it a heap forever, a **desolation** to this day.
- **2 Kings 22:19** "because your heart was tender, and you humbled yourself before the LORD when you heard what I spoke against this place and against its inhabitants, that they would become a **desolation** and a curse, and you tore your clothes and wept before Me, I also have heard you," says the LORD.
- **2Ch 29:8** "Therefore the wrath of the LORD fell upon Judah and Jerusalem, and He has given them up to trouble, to **desolation**, and to jeering, as you see with your eyes.
- **2Ch 30:7** "And do not be like your fathers and your brethren, who trespassed against the LORD God of their fathers, so that He gave them up to **desolation**, as you see.
- **Psalms 73:19** Oh, how they are brought to **desolation**, as in a moment! They are utterly consumed with terrors.
- **Isaiah 10:3** What will you do in the day of punishment, And in the **desolation** which will come from afar? To whom will you flee for help? And where will you leave your glory?
- **Isaiah 17:9** In that day his strong cities will be as a forsaken bough And an uppermost branch, Which they left because of the children of Israel; And there will be **desolation**.
- **Isaiah 24:12** In the city **desolation** is left, And the gate is stricken with destruction.
- **Isaiah 47:11** Therefore evil shall come upon you; You shall not know from where it arises. And trouble shall fall upon you; You will not be able to put it off. And **desolation** shall come upon you suddenly, Which you shall not know.
- **Isaiah 51:19** These two things have come to you; Who will be sorry for you?-- **Desolation** and destruction, famine and sword-- By whom will I comfort you?
- **Isaiah 64:10** Your holy cities are a wilderness, Zion is a wilderness, Jerusalem a **desolation**.
- **Jeremiah 22:5**"But if you will not hear these words, I swear by Myself," says the LORD, "that this house shall become a **desolation**." " "
- **Jeremiah 25:11** 'And this whole land shall be a **desolation** and an astonishment, and these nations shall serve the king of Babylon seventy years.
- **Jeremiah 25:12** 'Then it will come to pass, when seventy years are completed, that I will punish the king of Babylon and that nation, the land of the Chaldeans, for their iniquity,' says the LORD; 'and I will make it a perpetual **desolation**.
- **Jeremiah 25:18** Jerusalem and the cities of Judah, its kings and its princes, to make them a **desolation**, an astonishment, a hissing, and a curse, as it is this day;
- **Jeremiah 34:22** 'Behold, I will command,' says the LORD, 'and cause them to return to this city. They will fight against it and take it and burn it with fire; and I will make the cities of Judah a **desolation** without inhabitant.' "

- **Jeremiah 44:2** "Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: 'You have seen all the calamity that I have brought on Jerusalem and on all the cities of Judah; and behold, this day they are a **desolation**, and no one dwells in them,
- **Jeremiah 44:22** "So the LORD could no longer bear it, because of the evil of your doings and because of the abominations which you committed. Therefore your land is a **desolation**, an astonishment, a curse, and without an inhabitant, as it is this day.
- **Jeremiah 49:13** "For I have sworn by Myself," says the LORD, "that Bozrah (*This name means "in tribulation", or "distress"*) shall become a **desolation**, a reproach, a waste, and a curse. And all its cities shall be perpetual wastes."
- **Jeremiah 49:33** "Hazor shall be a dwelling for jackals, a **desolation** forever; No one shall reside there, Nor son of man dwell in it."
- **Jeremiah 50:23** How the hammer of the whole earth has been cut apart and broken! How Babylon has become a **desolation** among the nations! I have laid a snare for you;
- **Jeremiah 51:29** **And the land will tremble and sorrow; For every purpose of the LORD shall be performed against Babylon, To make the land of Babylon a desolation without inhabitant.**
- **Jeremiah 51:43** Her cities are a **desolation**, A dry land and a wilderness, A land where no one dwells, Through which no son of man passes.

## DESOLATE

- **Gen 47:19** "Why should we die before your eyes, both we and our land? Buy us and our land for bread, and we and our land will be servants of Pharaoh; give us seed, that we may live and not die, that the land may not be **desolate**."
- **Exodus 23:29** "I will not drive them out from before you in one year, lest the land become **desolate** and the beasts of the field become too numerous for you.
- **Leviticus 26:22** I will also send wild beasts among you, which shall rob you of your children, destroy your livestock, and make you few in number; and your highways shall be **desolate**.
- **Leviticus 26:33** I will scatter you among the nations and draw out a sword after you; your land shall be **desolate** and your cities waste.
- **Leviticus 26:34** Then the land shall enjoy its sabbaths as long as it lies **desolate** and you are in your enemies' land; then the land shall rest and enjoy its sabbaths.
- **Leviticus 26:35** As long as it lies **desolate** it shall rest-- for the time it did not rest on your sabbaths when you dwelt in it.
- **Leviticus 26:43** The land also shall be left empty by them, and will enjoy its sabbaths while it lies **desolate** without them; they will accept their guilt, because they despised My judgments and because their soul abhorred My statutes.
- **Num 23:3** Then Balaam said to Balak, "Stand by your burnt offering, and I will go; perhaps the LORD will come to meet me, and whatever He shows me I will tell you." So he went to a **desolate** height.
- **2Sa 13:20** And Absalom her brother said to her, "Has Amnon your brother been with you? But now hold your peace, my sister. He is your brother; do not take this thing to heart." So Tamar remained **desolate** in her brother Absalom's house.
- **2Ch 36:21** to fulfill the word of the LORD by the mouth of Jeremiah, until the land had enjoyed her Sabbaths. As long as she lay **desolate** she kept Sabbath, to fulfill seventy years.
- **Job 15:28** He dwells in **desolate** cities, In houses which no one inhabits, Which are destined to become ruins.
- **Job 16:7** But now He has worn me out; You have made **desolate** all my company.
- **Job 30:3** They are gaunt from want and famine, Fleeing late to the wilderness, **desolate** and waste,

- **Job 38:27** To satisfy the **desolate** waste, And cause to spring forth the growth of tender grass?
- **Psalms 25:16** Turn Yourself to me, and have mercy on me, for I am **desolate** and afflicted.
- **Psalms 69:25** Let their dwelling place be **desolate**; Let no one live in their tents.
- **Psalms 107:4** They wandered in the wilderness in a **desolate** way; They found no city to dwell in.
- **Psalms 109:10** Let his children continually be vagabonds, and beg; Let them seek their bread also from their **desolate** places.
- **Isaiah 1:7** Your country is **desolate**, Your cities are burned with fire; Strangers devour your land in your presence; And it is **desolate**, as overthrown by strangers.
- **Isaiah 3:26** Her gates shall lament and mourn, And she being **desolate** shall sit on the ground.
- **Isaiah 5:9** In my hearing the LORD of hosts said, "Truly, many houses shall be **desolate**, Great and beautiful ones, without inhabitant.
- **Isaiah 6:11** Then I said, "Lord, how long?" And He answered: "Until the cities are laid waste and without inhabitant, the houses are without a man, the land is utterly **desolate**,
- **Isaiah 7:19** They will come, and all of them will rest in the **desolate** valleys and in the clefts of the rocks, and on all thorns and in all pastures.
- **Isaiah 13:9** BEHOLD, THE DAY OF THE LORD COMES, CRUEL, WITH BOTH WRATH AND FIERCE ANGER, TO LAY THE LAND DESOLATE; AND HE WILL DESTROY ITS SINNERS FROM IT.
- **Isaiah 15:6** For the waters of Nimrim (*This name means "bitterness" or "rebellion"*) will be desolate, for the green grass has withered away; the grass fails, there is nothing green.
- **Isaiah 24:6** THEREFORE THE CURSE HAS DEVOURD THE EARTH, AND THOSE WHO DWELL IN IT ARE DESOLATE. THEREFORE THE INHABITANTS OF THE EARTH ARE BURNED, AND FEW MEN ARE LEFT.
- **Isaiah 27:10** YET THE FORTIFIED CITY WILL BE DESOLATE, THE HABITATION FORSAKEN AND LEFT LIKE A WILDERNESS; THERE THE CALF WILL FEED, AND THERE IT WILL LIE DOWN AND CONSUME ITS BRANCHES.
- **Isaiah 41:18** I will open rivers in **desolate** heights, and fountains in the midst of the valleys; I will make the wilderness a pool of water, and the dry land springs of water.
- **Isaiah 49:8** Thus says the LORD: "In an acceptable time I have heard You, and in the day of salvation I have helped You; I will preserve You and give You as a covenant to the people, to restore the earth, to cause them to inherit the desolate heritages;
- **Isaiah 49:9** That You may say to the prisoners, 'Go forth,' To those who are in darkness, 'Show yourselves.' "They shall feed along the roads, And their pastures shall be on all **desolate** heights.
- **Isaiah 49:19** "For your waste and **desolate** places, And the land of your destruction, Will even now be too small for the inhabitants; And those who swallowed you up will be far away.
- **Isaiah 49:21** Then you will say in your heart, 'Who has begotten these for me, Since I have lost my children and am **desolate**, A captive, and wandering to and fro? And who has brought these up? There I was, left alone; But these, where were they? ' "
- **Isaiah 54:1** "Sing, O barren, You who have not borne! Break forth into singing, and cry aloud, You who have not labored with child! For more are the children of the **desolate** Than the children of the married woman," says the LORD.

- **Isaiah 54:3** For you shall expand to the right and to the left, And your descendants will inherit the nations, And make the **desolate** cities inhabited.
- **Isaiah 59:10** We grope for the wall like the blind, And we grope as if we had no eyes; We stumble at noonday as at twilight; We are as dead men in **desolate** places.
- **Isaiah 62:4** You shall no longer be termed Forsaken, Nor shall your land any more be termed **Desolate**; But you shall be called Hephzibah, and your land Beulah; For the LORD delights in you, And your land shall be married.
- **Jeremiah 2:12** Be astonished, O heavens, at this, And be horribly afraid; Be very **desolate**," says the LORD.
- **Jeremiah 3:2** "Lift up your eyes to the **desolate** heights and see: Where have you not lain with men? By the road you have sat for them Like an Arabian in the wilderness; And you have polluted the land With your harlotries and your wickedness.
- **Jeremiah 3:21** A voice was heard on the **desolate** heights, Weeping and supplications of the children of Israel. For they have perverted their way; They have forgotten the LORD their God.
- **Jeremiah 4:7** The lion has come up from his thicket, And the destroyer of nations is on his way. He has gone forth from his place To make your land **desolate**. Your cities will be laid waste, Without inhabitant.
- **Jeremiah 4:11** At that time it will be said To this people and to Jerusalem, "A dry wind of the **desolate** heights blows in the wilderness Toward the daughter of My people-- Not to fan or to cleanse--
- **Jeremiah 4:27** For thus says the LORD: "The whole land shall be **desolate**; Yet I will not make a full end.
- **Jeremiah 6:8** Be instructed, O Jerusalem, Lest My soul depart from you; Lest I make you **desolate**, A land not inhabited."
- **Jeremiah 7:29** 'Cut off your hair and cast it away, and take up a lamentation on the **desolate** heights; for the LORD has rejected and forsaken the generation of His wrath.'
- **Jeremiah 7:34** "Then I will cause to cease from the cities of Judah and from the streets of Jerusalem the voice of mirth and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride. For the land shall be **desolate**.
- **Jeremiah 9:11** "I will make Jerusalem a heap of ruins, a den of jackals. I will make the cities of Judah **desolate**, without an inhabitant."
- **Jeremiah 10:22** Behold, the noise of the report has come, And a great commotion out of the north country, To make the cities of Judah **desolate**, a den of jackals.
- **Jeremiah 10:25** Pour out Your fury on the *Gentiles*, who do not know You, And on the families who do not call on Your name; For they have eaten up Jacob, Devoured him and consumed him, And made his dwelling place **desolate**.
- **Jeremiah 12:10** "Many rulers have destroyed My vineyard, They have trodden My portion underfoot; They have made My pleasant portion a **desolate** wilderness.
- **Jeremiah 12:11** They have made it **desolate**; **Desolate**, it mourns to Me; The whole land is made **desolate**, Because no one takes it to heart.
- **Jeremiah 12:12** The plunderers have come On all the **desolate** heights in the wilderness, For the sword of the LORD shall devour From one end of the land to the other end of the land; No flesh shall have peace.
- **Jeremiah 14:6** And the wild donkeys stood in the **desolate** heights; They sniffed at the wind like jackals; Their eyes failed because there was no grass."

- **Jeremiah 18:16** To make their land **desolate** and a perpetual hissing; Everyone who passes by it will be astonished And shake his head.
- **Jeremiah 19:8**"I will make this city **desolate** and a hissing; everyone who passes by it will be astonished and hiss because of all its plagues.
- **Jeremiah 25:38** He has left His lair like the lion; For their land is **desolate** Because of the fierceness of the Oppressor, And because of His fierce anger."
- **Jeremiah 26:9**"Why have you prophesied in the name of the LORD, saying, 'This house shall be like Shiloh, and this city shall be **desolate**, without an inhabitant'?" And all the people were gathered against Jeremiah in the house of the LORD.
- **Jeremiah 32:43** 'And fields will be bought in this land of which you say, "It is **desolate**, without man or beast; it has been given into the hand of the Chaldeans."
- **Jeremiah 33:10** "Thus says the LORD: 'Again there shall be heard in this place--of which you say, "It is **desolate**, without man and without beast"--in the cities of Judah, in the streets of Jerusalem that are **desolate**, without man and without inhabitant and without beast,
- **Jeremiah 33:12** "Thus says the LORD of hosts: 'In this place which is **desolate**, without man and without beast, and in all its cities, there shall again be a dwelling place of shepherds causing their flocks to lie down.
- **Jeremiah 44:6** 'So My fury and My anger were poured out and kindled in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem; and they are wasted and **desolate**, as it is this day.'
- **Jeremiah 46:19** O you daughter dwelling in Egypt, Prepare yourself to go into captivity! For Noph shall be waste and **desolate**, without inhabitant.
- **Jeremiah 48:9**"Give wings to Moab, That she may flee and get away; For her cities shall be **desolate**, Without any to dwell in them.
- **Jeremiah 48:34** "From the cry of Heshbon to Elealeh and to Jahaz They have uttered their voice, From Zoar to Horonaim, Like a three-year-old heifer; For the waters of Nimrim also shall be **desolate**.
- **Jeremiah 49:2** Therefore behold, the days are coming," says the LORD, "That I will cause to be heard an alarm of war In Rabbah of the Ammonites; It shall be a **desolate** mound, And her villages shall be burned with fire. Then Israel shall take possession of his inheritance," says the LORD.
- **Jeremiah 49:20** Therefore hear the counsel of the LORD that He has taken against Edom, And His purposes that He has proposed against the inhabitants of Teman: Surely the least of the flock shall draw them out; Surely He shall make their dwelling places **desolate** with them.

- **Jeremiah 51:26** They shall not take from you a stone for a corner Nor a stone for a foundation, But you shall be **desolate** forever," says the LORD.
- **Jeremiah 51:41** "Oh, how Sheshach is taken! Oh, how the praise of the whole earth is seized! How Babylon has become **desolate** among the nations!
- **Jeremiah 51:62** "then you shall say, 'O LORD, You have spoken against this place to cut it off, so that none shall remain in it, neither man nor beast, but it shall be **desolate** forever.'
- **Lamentations 1:4** The roads to Zion mourn Because no one comes to the set feasts. All her gates are **desolate**; Her priests sigh, Her virgins are afflicted, And she is in bitterness.
- **Lamentations 1:13** "From above He has sent fire into my bones, And it overpowered them; He has spread a net for my feet And turned me back; He has made me **desolate** And faint all the day.
- **Lamentations 1:16** "For these things I weep; My eye, my eye overflows with water; Because the comforter, who should restore my life, Is far from me. My children are **desolate** Because the enemy prevailed."
- **Lamentations 3:11** He has turned aside my ways and torn me in pieces; He has made me **desolate**.
- **Lamentations 4:5** Those who ate delicacies Are **desolate** in the streets; Those who were brought up in scarlet Embrace ash heaps.
- **Lamentations 5:18** Because of Mount Zion which is **desolate**, With foxes walking about on it.
- **Ezekiel 6:4** "Then your altars shall be **desolate**, your incense altars shall be broken, and I will cast down your slain men before your idols.
- **Ezekiel 6:6** "In all your dwelling places the cities shall be laid waste, and the high places shall be **desolate**, so that your altars may be laid waste and made **desolate**, your idols may be broken and made to cease, your incense altars may be cut down, and your works may be abolished.
- **Ezekiel 6:14** 'So I will stretch out My hand against them and make the land **desolate**, yes, more **desolate** than the wilderness toward Diblah, in all their dwelling places. Then they shall know that I am the LORD.' " " "
- **Ezekiel 12:20** "Then the cities that are inhabited shall be laid waste, and the land shall become **desolate**; and you shall know that I am the LORD." " " "
- **Ezekiel 14:15** "If I cause wild beasts to pass through the land, and they empty it, and make it so **desolate** that no man may pass through because of the beasts,
- **Ezekiel 14:16** "even though these three men were in it, as I live," says the Lord GOD, "they would deliver neither sons nor daughters; only they would be delivered, and the land would be **desolate**.
- **Ezekiel 15:8** 'Thus I will make the land **desolate**, because they have persisted in unfaithfulness,' says the Lord GOD."
- **Ezekiel 19:7** He knew their **desolate** places, And laid waste their cities; The land with its fullness was desolated By the noise of his roaring.
- **Ezekiel 20:26** "and I pronounced them unclean because of their ritual gifts, in that they caused all their firstborn to pass through the fire, that I might make them **desolate** and that they might know that I am the LORD." ' "

- **Ezekiel 25:3** "Say to the Ammonites, 'Hear the word of the Lord GOD! Thus says the Lord GOD: "Because you said, 'Aha!' against My sanctuary when it was profaned, and against the land of Israel when it was **desolate**, and against the house of Judah when they went into captivity,
- **Ezekiel 25:13** 'therefore thus says the Lord GOD: "I will also stretch out My hand against Edom, cut off man and beast from it, and make it **desolate** from Teman; DeDaniel shall fall by the sword.
- **Ezekiel 26:19** "For thus says the Lord GOD: 'When I make you a **desolate** city, like cities that are not inhabited, when I bring the deep upon you, and great waters cover you,
- **Ezekiel 26:20** 'then I will bring you down with those who descend into the Pit, to the people of old, and I will make you dwell in the lowest part of the earth, in places **desolate** from antiquity, with those who go down to the Pit, so that you may never be inhabited; and I shall establish glory in the land of the living.
- **Ezekiel 29:9** "And the land of Egypt shall become **desolate** and waste; then they will know that I am the LORD, because he said, 'The River is mine, and I have made it.'
- **Ezekiel 29:10** "Indeed, therefore, I am against you and against your rivers, and I will make the land of Egypt utterly waste and **desolate**, from Migdol to Syene, as far as the border of Ethiopia.
- **Ezekiel 29:12** "I will make the land of Egypt **desolate** in the midst of the countries that are **desolate**; and among the cities that are laid waste, her cities shall be **desolate** forty years; and I will scatter the Egyptians among the nations and disperse them throughout the countries."
- **Ezekiel 30:7** "They shall be **desolate** in the midst of the **desolate** countries, And her cities shall be in the midst of the cities that are laid waste.
- **Ezekiel 30:14** I will make Pathros **desolate**, Set fire to Zoan, And execute judgments in No.
- **Ezekiel 32:15** 'When I make the land of Egypt **desolate**, And the country is destitute of all that once filled it, When I strike all who dwell in it, Then they shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 33:28** "For I will make the land most **desolate**, her arrogant strength shall cease, and the mountains of Israel shall be so **desolate** that no one will pass through.
- **Ezekiel 33:29** "Then they shall know that I am the LORD, when I have made the land most **desolate** because of all their abominations which they have committed." '
- **Ezekiel 35:3** "and say to it, 'Thus says the Lord GOD: "Behold, O Mount Seir, I am against you; I will stretch out My hand against you, And make you most **desolate**;
- **Ezekiel 35:4** I shall lay your cities waste, And you shall be **desolate**. Then you shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 35:7** "Thus I will make Mount Seir most **desolate**, and cut off from it the one who leaves and the one who returns.
- **Ezekiel 35:9** "I will make you perpetually **desolate**, and your cities shall be uninhabited; then you shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 35:12** "Then you shall know that I am the LORD. I have heard all your blasphemies which you have spoken against the mountains of Israel, saying, 'They are **desolate**; they are given to us to consume.'
- **Ezekiel 35:14** 'Thus says the Lord GOD: "The whole earth will rejoice when I make you **desolate**.

- **Ezekiel 35:15** "As you rejoiced because the inheritance of the house of Israel was **desolate**, so I will do to you; you shall be **desolate**, O Mount Seir, as well as all of Edom--all of it! Then they shall know that I am the LORD." '

- **Ezekiel 36:35** "So they will say, 'This land that was **desolate** has become like the garden of Eden; and the wasted, **desolate**, and ruined cities are now fortified and inhabited.'
- **Ezekiel 36:36** "Then the nations which are left all around you shall know that I, the LORD, have rebuilt the ruined places and planted what was **desolate**. I, the LORD, have spoken it, and I will do it."
- **Ezekiel 38:8** "After many days you will be visited. In the latter years you will come into the land of those brought back from the sword and gathered from many people on the mountains of Israel, which had long been **desolate**; they were brought out of the nations, and now all of them dwell safely.
- **Daniel 9:17** "Now therefore, our God, hear the prayer of Your servant, and his supplications, and for the Lord's sake cause Your face to shine on Your sanctuary, which is **desolate**.
- **Daniel 9:27** Then he shall confirm a covenant with many for one week; But in the middle of the week He shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes **desolate**, Even until the consummation, which is determined, Is poured out on the **desolate**."
- **Hosea 5:9** Ephraim shall be **desolate** in the day of rebuke; Among the tribes of Israel I make known what is sure.
- **Joe 2:3** A fire devours before them, And behind them a flame burns; The land is like the Garden of Eden before them, And behind them a **desolate** wilderness; Surely nothing shall escape them.
- **Joe 2:20** "But I will remove far from you the northern army, And will drive him away into a barren and **desolate** land, With his face toward the eastern sea And his back toward the western sea; His stench will come up, And his foul odor will rise, Because he has done monstrous things."
- **Joe 3:19** "Egypt shall be a desolation, And Edom a **desolate** wilderness, Because of violence against the people of Judah, For they have shed innocent blood in their land.
- **Amo 7:9** The high places of Isaac shall be **desolate**, And the sanctuaries of Israel shall be laid waste. I will rise with the sword against the house of Jeroboam."
- **Micah 1:7** All her carved images shall be beaten to pieces, And all her pay as a harlot shall be burned with the fire; All her idols I will lay **desolate**, For she gathered it from the pay of a harlot, And they shall return to the pay of a harlot."
- **Micah 6:13** "Therefore I will also make you sick by striking you, By making you **desolate** because of your sins.
- **Micah 7:13** Yet the land shall be **desolate** Because of those who dwell in it, And for the fruit of their deeds.

- **Nah 2:10** She is empty, **desolate**, and waste! The heart melts, and the knees shake; Much pain is in every side, And all their faces are drained of color.
- **Zephaniah 2:4** For Gaza shall be forsaken, And Ashkelon **desolate**; They shall drive out Ashdod at noonday, And Ekron shall be uprooted.
- **Zephaniah 3:6** "I have cut off nations, Their fortresses are devastated; I have made their streets **desolate**, With none passing by. Their cities are destroyed; There is no one, no inhabitant.
- **Zechariah 7:14** "But I scattered them with a whirlwind among all the nations which they had not known. Thus the land became **desolate** after them, so that no one passed through or returned; for they made the pleasant land **desolate**."
- **Malachi 1:4** Even though Edom has said, "We have been impoverished, But we will return and build the **desolate** places," Thus says the LORD of hosts: "They may build, but I will throw down; They shall be called the Territory of Wickedness, And the people against whom the LORD will have indignation forever.
- **Matthew 23:38** "See! Your house is left to you **desolate**;
- **Luke 13:35** "See! Your house is left to you **desolate**; and assuredly, I say to you, you shall not see Me until the time comes when you say, 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD!' "
- **Acts 1:20** "For it is written in the Book of Psalms: 'Let his dwelling place be **desolate**, And let no one live in it'; and, 'Let another take his office.'
- **Galatians 4:27** For it is written: "Rejoice, O barren, You who do not bear! Break forth and shout, You who are not in labor! For the **desolate** has many more children Than she who has a husband."
- **Revelation 17:16** "And the ten horns which you saw on the beast, these will hate the harlot, make her **desolate** and naked, eat her flesh and burn her with fire.
- **Revelation 18:19** "They threw dust on their heads and cried out, weeping and wailing, and saying, 'Alas, alas, that great city, in which all who had shiPsalm on the sea became rich by her wealth! For in one hour she is made **desolate**.'

### ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION

- **Daniel 11:31** "And forces shall be mustered by him, and they shall defile the sanctuary fortress; then they shall take away the daily sacrifices, and place there the **abomination of desolation**."
- **Daniel 12:11** "And from the time that the daily sacrifice is taken away, and the **abomination of desolation** is set up, there shall be one thousand two hundred and ninety days.
- **Matthew 24:15** "Therefore when you see the '**abomination of desolation**,' spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place" (whoever reads, let him understand),
- **Mark 13:14** "So when you see the '**abomination of desolation**,' spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not" (let the reader understand), "then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains.

### ABOMINATION

- **Genesis 43:32** So they set him a place by himself, and them by themselves, and the Egyptians who ate with him by themselves; because the Egyptians could not eat food with the Hebrews, for that is an **abomination** to the Egyptians.
- **Genesis 46:34** "that you shall say, 'Your servants' occupation has been with livestock from our youth even till now, both we and also our fathers,' that you may dwell in the land of Goshen; for every shepherd is an **abomination** to the Egyptians."

- **Exodus 8:26** And Moses said, "It is not right to do so, for we would be sacrificing the **abomination** of the Egyptians to the LORD our God. If we sacrifice the **abomination** of the Egyptians before their eyes, then will they not stone us?"
- **Leviticus 7:18** 'And if any of the flesh of the sacrifice of his peace offering is eaten at all on the third day, it shall not be accepted, nor shall it be imputed to him; it shall be an **abomination** to him who offers it, and the person who eats of it shall bear guilt.
- **Leviticus 11:10** 'But all in the seas or in the rivers that do not have fins and scales, all that move in the water or any living thing which is in the water, they are an **abomination** to you.
- **Leviticus 11:11** 'They shall be an **abomination** to you; you shall not eat their flesh, but you shall regard their carcasses as an **abomination**.
- **Leviticus 11:12** 'Whatever in the water does not have fins or scales--that shall be an **abomination** to you.
- **Leviticus 11:13** 'And these you shall regard as an **abomination** among the birds; they shall not be eaten, they are an **abomination**: the eagle, the vulture, the buzzard,
- **Leviticus 11:20** 'All flying insects that creep on all fours shall be an **abomination** to you.
- **Leviticus 11:23** 'But all other flying insects which have four feet shall be an **abomination** to you.
- **Leviticus 11:41** 'And every creeping thing that creeps on the earth shall be an **abomination**. It shall not be eaten.
- **Leviticus 11:42** 'Whatever crawls on its belly, whatever goes on all fours, or whatever has many feet among all creeping things that creep on the earth--these you shall not eat, for they are an **abomination**.
- **Leviticus 18:22** 'You shall not lie with a male as with a woman. It is an **abomination**.
- **Leviticus 19:7** 'And if it is eaten at all on the third day, it is an **abomination**. It shall not be accepted.
- **Leviticus 20:13** 'If a man lies with a male as he lies with a woman, both of them have committed an **abomination**. They shall surely be put to death. Their blood shall be upon them.
- **Deuteronomy 7:25** "You shall burn the carved images of their gods with fire; you shall not covet the silver or gold that is on them, nor take it for yourselves, lest you be snared by it; for it is an **abomination** to the LORD your God.
- **Deuteronomy 7:26** "Nor shall you bring an **abomination** into your house, lest you be doomed to destruction like it. You shall utterly detest it and utterly abhor it, for it is an accursed thing.
- **Deuteronomy 12:31** "You shall not worship the LORD your God in that way; for every **abomination** to the LORD which He hates they have done to their gods; for they burn even their sons and daughters in the fire to their gods.
- **Deuteronomy 13:14** "then you shall inquire, search out, and ask diligently. And if it is indeed true and certain that such an **abomination** was committed among you,
- **Deuteronomy 17:1** "You shall not sacrifice to the LORD your God a bull or sheep which has any blemish or defect, for that is an **abomination** to the LORD your God.
- **Deuteronomy 17:4** "and it is told you, and you hear of it, then you shall inquire diligently. And if it is indeed true and certain that such an **abomination** has been committed in Israel,
- **Deuteronomy 18:12** "For all who do these things are an **abomination** to the LORD, and because of these abominations the LORD your God drives them out from before you.

- **Deuteronomy 22:5** "A woman shall not wear anything that pertains to a man, nor shall a man put on a woman's garment, for all who do so are an **abomination** to the LORD your God.
- **Deuteronomy 23:18** "You shall not bring the wages of a harlot or the price of a dog to the house of the LORD your God for any vowed offering, for both of these are an **abomination** to the LORD your God.
- **Deuteronomy 24:4** "then her former husband who divorced her must not take her back to be his wife after she has been defiled; for that is an **abomination** before the LORD, and you shall not bring sin on the land which the LORD your God is giving you as an inheritance.
- **Deuteronomy 25:16** "For all who do such things, all who behave unrighteously, are an **abomination** to the LORD your God.
- **Deuteronomy 27:15** 'Cursed is the one who makes a carved or molded image, an **abomination** to the LORD, the work of the hands of the craftsman, and sets it up in secret.' "And all the people shall answer and say, 'Amen!'
- **1 Samuel 13:4** Now all Israel heard it said that Saul had attacked a garrison of the Philistines, and that Israel had also become an **abomination** to the Philistines. And the people were called together to Saul at Gilgal.
- **1 Kings 11:5** For Solomon went after Ashtoreth the goddess of the Sidonians, and after Milcom the **abomination** of the Ammonites.
- **1 Kings 11:7** Then Solomon built a high place for Chemosh the **abomination** of Moab, on the hill that is east of Jerusalem, and for Molech the **abomination** of the people of Ammon.
- **2 Kings 23:13** Then the king defiled the high places that were east of Jerusalem, which were on the south of the Mount of Corruption, which Solomon king of Israel had built for Ashtoreth the **abomination** of the Sidonians, for Chemosh the **abomination** of the Moabites, and for Milcom the **abomination** of the people of Ammon.
- **Psalms 88:8** You have put away my acquaintances far from me; You have made me an **abomination** to them; I am shut up, and I cannot get out;

- **Proverbs 13:19** A desire accomplished is sweet to the soul, But it is an **abomination** to fools to depart from evil.
- **Proverbs 15:8** The sacrifice of the wicked is an **abomination** to the LORD, But the prayer of the upright is His delight.
- **Proverbs 15:9** The way of the wicked is an **abomination** to the LORD, But He loves him who follows righteousness.
- **Proverbs 15:26** The thoughts of the wicked are an **abomination** to the LORD, But the words of the pure are pleasant.
- **Proverbs 16:5** Everyone proud in heart is an **abomination** to the LORD; Though they join forces, none will go unpunished.
- **Proverbs 16:12** It is an **abomination** for kings to commit wickedness, For a throne is established by righteousness.
- **Proverbs 17:15** He who justifies the wicked, and he who condemns the just, Both of them alike are an **abomination** to the LORD.
- **Proverbs 20:10** Diverse weights and diverse measures, They are both alike, an **abomination** to the LORD.
- **Proverbs 20:23** Diverse weights are an **abomination** to the LORD, And dishonest scales are not good.
- **Proverbs 21:27** The sacrifice of the wicked is an **abomination**; How much more when he brings it with wicked intent!

- **Proverbs 24:9** The devising of foolishness is sin, And the scoffer is an **abomination** to men.
- **Proverbs 28:9** One who turns away his ear from hearing the law, Even his prayer is an **abomination**.
- **Proverbs 29:27** An unjust man is an **abomination** to the righteous, And he who is upright in the way is an **abomination** to the wicked.
- **Isaiah 1:13** Bring no more futile sacrifices; Incense is an **abomination** to Me. The New Moons, the Sabbaths, and the calling of assemblies-- I cannot endure iniquity and the sacred meeting.
- **Isaiah 41:24** Indeed you are nothing, And your work is nothing; He who chooses you is an **abomination**.
- **Isaiah 44:19** And no one considers in his heart, Nor is there knowledge nor understanding to say, "I have burned half of it in the fire, Yes, I have also baked bread on its coals; I have roasted meat and eaten it; And shall I make the rest of it an **abomination**? Shall I fall down before a block of wood?"
- **Isaiah 66:17** "Those who sanctify themselves and purify themselves, To go to the gardens After an idol in the midst, Eating swine's flesh and the **abomination** and the mouse, Shall be consumed together," says the LORD.
- **Jeremiah 2:7** I brought you into a bountiful country, To eat its fruit and its goodness. But when you entered, you defiled My land And made My heritage an **abomination**.

- **Jeremiah 8:12** Were they ashamed when they had committed **abomination**? No! They were not at all ashamed, Nor did they know how to blush. Therefore they shall fall among those who fall; In the time of their punishment They shall be cast down," says the LORD.
- **Jeremiah 32:35** 'And they built the high places of Baal which are in the Valley of the Son of Hinnom, to cause their sons and their daughters to pass through the fire to Molech, which I did not command them, nor did it come into My mind that they should do this **abomination**, to cause Judah to sin.'
- **Ezekiel 16:50** "And they were haughty and committed **abomination** before Me; therefore I took them away as I saw fit.
- **Ezekiel 18:12** If he has oppressed the poor and needy, Robbed by violence, Not restored the pledge, Lifted his eyes to the idols, Or committed **abomination**;
- **Ezekiel 22:11** "One commits **abomination** with his neighbor's wife; another lewdly defiles his daughter-in-law; and another in you violates his sister, his father's daughter.
- **Daniel 11:31** "And forces shall be mustered by him, and they shall defile the sanctuary fortress; then they shall take away the daily sacrifices, and place there the **abomination** of desolation.
- **Daniel 12:11** "And from the time that the daily sacrifice is taken away, and the **abomination** of desolation is set up, there shall be one thousand two hundred and ninety days.
- **Hosea 9:10** "I found Israel Like grapes in the wilderness; I saw your fathers As the firstfruits on the fig tree in its first season. But they went to Baal Peor, And separated themselves to that shame; They became an **abomination** like the thing they loved.
- **Micah 6:10** Are there yet the treasures of wickedness In the house of the wicked, And the short measure that is an **abomination**?
- **Malachi 2:11** Judah has dealt treacherously, And an **abomination** has been committed in Israel and in Jerusalem, For Judah has profaned The LORD's holy institution which He loves: He has married the daughter of a foreign god.

- **Matthew 24:15** "Therefore when you see the '**abomination** of desolation,' spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place" (whoever reads, let him understand),
- **Mark 13:14** "So when you see the '**abomination** of desolation,' spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not" (let the reader understand), "then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains.
- **Luke 16:15** And He said to them, "You are those who justify yourselves before men, but God knows your hearts. For what is highly esteemed among men is an **abomination** in the sight of God.
- **Revelation 21:27** But there shall by no means enter it anything that defiles, or causes an **abomination** or a lie, but only those who are written in the Lamb's Book of Life.

The Lord warns this church that is the 7<sup>th</sup> church (This means the church that has had the fullness of His Works of His Seen Spirits and therefore is appointed as being the Church of the fullness of His Appointed Time Harvest Judgment). You can see that this is the Church to be in place when He comes to rule over the Heavens and let them to eat of His food of Heaven and that they are to do the Righteous Acts that feeds Him with honor and Glory and makes the knowledge of His Glory to cover the earth as the waters covers the Sea - IS. 11:9, Hab. 2:14, Num. 14:21.).

Let us now look at the Lord's Way. In several books I have described John chapter 21 and how it shows His Way. But, also David gives us Psalm 107 that is an instruction in the Ways of the Lord. It is a great parable, just as the apostle John gives us a phenomenal parable of divine instruction in John chapter 21, in which He writes that this is the Way that the Lord manifested His Way - meaning that in this Way of His works in chapter 21 He revealed to them His Ways. Take notice that in verse 11 of Psalm 107 King David reveals that the ones who are punished by God are those who would not do two things: (1) receive the knowledge of the Words of God; and (2) would not obey the instructions of God, such as the ways of the Laws of Moses and the Ten Commandments. The second part is the counsel of God, while the first part is the Law of God (His Words are the summation - the entirety - of His Law - per Psalm 119:142 and Deuteronomy 18:18-19).

→ **James 1:17** Every Good Gift and every perfect Gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of Lights (*David makes clear in Psalm 119:130 that it is the entrance of His Words that gives Light, and the Father created these set apart Words from before the foundations of the World.*), with whom there is no variance, neither shadow of turning (*This has the meaning that His Words never change and their Promises never depart from His Words. Therefore our key is to understand the Way of His Words and what is His Perfect Will, for that clearly releases His Good Works that are given to us as Promises within His Words.*)

(NaturalNews) For several decades, colony collapse disorder (CCD) -- a mysterious condition where entire bee colonies die for seemingly no obvious reason -- has been inflicting bee populations across both Europe and the US. But scientists from the United Nations (UN) say the phenomenon is now a global crisis, afflicting bees across China, Japan, and Africa, as well as in other places.

The report, issued by the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), explains what many NaturalNews readers already know -- mainly that without *bees*, there will be no more *food*. Bees are one of nature's primary pollinators, and over 70 percent of the world's *food supply* relies on them to grow.

**"Human beings have fabricated the illusion that in the 21st century they have the technological prowess to be independent of nature," said Achim Steiner, UN Under-Secretary-General and UNEP Executive Director. "Bees underline the reality that we are more, not less, dependent on nature's services in a world of close to seven billion people."**

One such mode of "technological prowess" is the flagrant and irresponsible use of genetically-modified organisms (*GMO*). *GMO* technology is heavily reliant on the use of toxic *pesticides* and herbicides, which several recent studies have pinned to the widespread bee deaths ([http://www.naturalnews.com/025287\\_b...](http://www.naturalnews.com/025287_b...)).

In January, a leaked document revealed that the US Environmental Protection Agency (*EPA*) actually knowingly approved a bee-killing pesticides known as clothianidin. This Bayer CropScience chemical has been identified as a primary instigator of CCD, and yet it has remained freely available on the market since 1993 when the EPA first approved it.

**Pesticides use is obviously not reserved just for *GMOs*, either. The entire industrial agriculture system that dominates the majority of the US food supply is heavily reliant on toxic pesticides of all varieties, which reports say now pollute over 90 percent of the nation's rivers** ([http://www.naturalnews.com/027971\\_p...](http://www.naturalnews.com/027971_p...)).
