

October 11, 2011, A Little Nibble About the Power of a Kiss

FYI - We need to become zealous to learn of the knowledge of the Words of God's Wisdom. This knowledge of the reasons for the Ways of God's Words of Wisdom that are sealed with His greater promises, has been kept from us because we have violated the right to receive of the instruction of Sanctification when they changed the calendars in ~350 AD under Constantine's rule (Ex. 31:13).

Thus, here is just a little information of the power of the "Kiss" from the Bible.

The kiss is something to be taken very seriously, for it can have a result on the way of your future, and the Way of your ending. The kiss is a way of doing the Word of God "Love". The Kiss enables this Word of God called Love, and thus it ("Love") is one of the most powerful Words of God, for it carries the Father's Greatest Promises of His Eternal Way, and thus it is one of the Most Powerful of His Words that we could choose to enable. Thus, the "Kiss" needs to be taken seriously, and not just from passion. It is a tool that can be used to communicate to the Lord the desires of your heart (John 15:7).

We are told in the Bible to greet one another with a "Holy Kiss". This is because the Kiss is likened to enabling the Seal of the Word of Truth. (Eph. 1:13-14, Psalm 33:4, Psalm 119:9, 130, 142, 160). The Kiss is, of course, the doing of the Way of Testifying to the Way of Love.

The Holy Kiss would be to kiss the right cheek of an adult you greet, for the right is the Way of Righteousness. You should refrain from kissing the left cheek for it is the Way of Justice. That is unless you desire that person speak correction of justice upon you, and that they do so in the Way of God and not man. The kiss seals the word of Righteousness, for the jaw "bone" is the vehicle of speaking words and it is vibrated as a testimony of the words we speak. The bone is a memory device of the words that we speak, and that wisdom is beyond the understanding of man's science, but it is revealed in Scriptures. It is of the Words of the Wisdom of God. It is why the Lord will have the people's bones to wither in the coming plague of the Night, for they failed to heed His instruction and did not do the Ways of His Words that He has spoken and that His Scriptures testify to. People often forget that Satan not only struck Job with boils of the skin, but also with the withering of the bones (Job 2:5). But, the Lord restored him after the testing.



You may recall that Absalom kissed the people of Israel of those he met, and stole the hearts of the nation. He was also the most handsome of David's sons. It was a deceitful intent kiss of intent to take the kingdom from David; and that way of kiss had its eventual Judgment work, for it actually sealed the way of his fate - for he was killed by an intentional action of a deceitful act (carried out by Joab) that was against the instructional Word of David for how to treat Absalom if he was captured. Soon, all people will learn how very little of God's exceedingly great promises and wisdom that has truly been known during our generations.

In some cases, such as in speaking a blessing, it is to kiss the forehead. Jesus kissed the foreheads of the youth after He blessed them. It is the Seal of the Word of His Mouth that enables the Father's Words to cause them to receive the Way of that blessing (See Eph. 1:13-14). For the Word of Truth is that Hope of Resurrection. Because Jesus was sealed with the Words of God in Him, it meant that His kiss of these children would mean that later, as they got older, they would be caused by the Father to receive the knowledge of Truth and not depart from it (Per the Way of John 15:7 enabled by the desire of Jesus' heart.).

One might choose to kiss the right hand of a woman, for she is the assigned by God to be the keeper of the garments, and belts, and food, for the Way of Knowledge of her household (Prov. 31). When you come into her house, you are to receive of the ways of her preparation.

Of course there is the great lesson of the Kisses of the harlot who continuously kissed the feet of Jesus. She was likely the one who was later blessed to be chosen by the Father to be given the understanding by the Holy Spirit to come forth and anoint the feet of Jesus with oil so that He would be prepared in the Ways of the Law of God for the great work of the Cross that He was about to accomplish. Her repeated kisses of His feet at the early stages of His ministry wherein she washed His feet with her tears and dried them with her hair, enabled the Holy Spirit were to enable the Father to call her to the very important work that she later was able to perform for His burial (It seems that surely, because of the Words of John 3:32, that she did not know He was going to die, nor did she comprehend His Words; but by the Ways of God's Words she was enabled to be led by the Spirit to do this Good Work due to her previous kisses of His feet.).



The greeting of a holy kiss is that sign of desiring the instruction of the word to come between the two, to be of the Word of Truth. It is the way of Heb. 10:24 where you seek to stir up love and Good Works. You are enabling His Words to be stirred up - this is of the ways of doing the way of His Word of Love.

**Romans 16:16** Greet one another with a holy kiss. The churches of Christ greet you.

**1 Corinthians 16:20** All the brethren greet you. Greet one another with a holy kiss

**2 Corinthians 13:12** Greet one another with a holy kiss

**1 Thessalonians 5:26** Greet all the brethren with a holy kiss

**1 Peter 5:14** Greet one another with a kiss of love. Peace to you all who are in Christ Jesus. Amen.

Judas kissed Jesus and thus sealed the Way of his death, for he was hung by himself on a tree, and then his body was also dropped to the ground where his blood spilt out, duplicated the way of Christ's death, but Judas was a testimony to the Seal of the Kiss. Judas' repentant testimony to the priests and even the return of the money was denied by the priests. I believe it is said that the money - the 30 pieces of silver - was used to buy the very field Judas died in. The number 30 is the number for the preparation of ministry. Consider that Judas's kiss sealed that Jesus would be found guilty by the priests and crucified on a tree, and the blood of Jesus was spilt onto the ground and went down on the Mercy seat. Jesus paid the price for our salvation. He was without sin. He started His ministry at the age of 30.

***Matthew 27:3-8** Then Judas, which had betrayed him, when he saw that he was condemned, repented himself, and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders, Saying, I have sinned in that I have betrayed the innocent blood. And they said, What is that to us? see thou to that. And he cast down the pieces of silver in the temple, and departed, and went and hanged himself. And the chief priests took the silver pieces, and said, It is not lawful for to put them into the treasury, because it is the price of blood. And they took counsel, and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in. Wherefore that field was called, The field of blood, unto this day.*

***Acts 1:18-19** Now this man purchased a field with the reward of iniquity; and falling headlong, he burst asunder in the midst, and all his bowels gushed out. And it was known unto all the dwellers at Jerusalem; insomuch as that field is called in their proper tongue, Aceldama, that is to say, The field of blood.*

The kiss is the sign of the Seal of our Words of Truth, spoken or done. It is a serious tool, and yet we treat it as a common thing.

Consider that if we kiss while in deceit, the price we pay will be extreme. Joab took the hair of the beard of Amasa (*Likely with the left hand*) and then kissed him while at the same time he struck him with a sword that he held in the other hand (*likely the right hand*) and killed him, spilling his blood and bowels on the ground. Amasa was the one David had chosen to replace Joab because Joab had earlier killed Absalom against his instruction. (*Joab was the son of a sister of David, and thus it made it difficult for David to have the Will of God to slay Joab, even though he had sinned.*) The have hair on the chin is a Way to seek of God for wisdom to guide ones mouth by His instruction. To grab that hair and do deceit by it, is not a good thing to do.

**2 Samuel 20:9** Then Joab (*This name means "paternity, or voluntary", and he had followed David voluntarily, and made commander of his army as such*) said to Amasa (*Name means "sparing the people"*), "[Are] you in health, my brother?" And Joab took Amasa by the beard with his right hand to kiss him.

The end result of Joab is clear testimony of the way of that kiss. Joab did other evils besides killing Absalom, for he participated in the killing of Uriah. Thus, he died of the innocent blood killed by the ways of his words in his life, but as shown below, the Father saw to it that he died in the way of that kiss of Amasa when he held

the hair of the beard and killed with the sword. Joab died at the altar of the Tabernacle of the house of the Lord and he died holding onto the horns of the altar.

There are more good examples of the kiss, but I think that you can get the idea. A kiss is not something that you mess around with.

There are so much more about "kiss", and I will try to make more of this known.

**Genesis 27:26** Then his father Isaac said to him, "Come near now and **kiss** me, my son."

**Songs 8:1** Oh, that you were like my brother, Who nursed at my mother's breasts! [If] I should find you outside, I would **kiss** you; I would not be despised.

**Hosea 13:2** Now they sin more and more, And have made for themselves molded images, Idols of their silver, according to their skill; All of it [is] the work of craftsmen. They say of them, "Let the men who sacrifice **kiss** the calves!"

**Matthew 26:48** Now His betrayer had given them a sign, saying, "Whomever I **kiss**, He is the One; seize Him."

**Mark 14:44** Now His betrayer had given them a signal, saying, "Whomever I **kiss**, He is the One; seize Him and lead [Him] away safely."

**Luke 7:45** "You gave Me no **kiss**, but this woman has not ceased to **kiss** My feet since the time I came in.

**Luke 22:47** And while He was still speaking, behold, a multitude; and he who was called Judas, one of the twelve, went before them and drew near to Jesus to **kiss** Him.

**Luke 22:48** But Jesus said to him, "Judas, are you betraying the Son of Man with a **kiss**?"

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
