

September 3, 2016, The Jubilee, and a Clarification of the Teachings of the Apostles and the Disciples.

FYI – I have included below a commentary of the introduction of Paul’s letter to the Corinthians to highlight a major flaw in our translations and interpretations of the New Testament writings of the Apostles and Disciples. Even our understanding of what is a Saint is flawed. I believe that this commentary, if received will completely change our understanding of the teachings of Paul and the disciples. It should reveal to us the richness of the New Testament, and all of the Bible that we are missing.

And also woven into this Commentary is a critical truth that we must awaken ourselves to. For this is the Jubilee Year of the Lord, and the Prophetic Words and Visions are mightily pointing to this is the Year of the Great Tribulation that is ended with the Separation Judgment of the Lord. This is not the time of the Rapture. In fact, the elect will not be a part of the Rapture if they do not discern the Work that the Father has given for us to do.

But, what is important to understand is that on Rosh HaShanah the Father who has been sitting in the Throne of Judgment for these past 14 years, will render the Judgment Decrees for each of us for the coming year. Since this is the Jubilee Year, it means that the Judgment Decree that He will render will be the Judgment Decree for us that will be manifested at the Separation Judgment that will occur in this Year.

Because God cannot change His Ways (*Malachi 3:6*), it would mean that due to the testimony of His Warning to Nineveh, we have 40 days, including Rosh HaShanah, to plead before Him (*See Joel 2:12-20*), for Him to change His Judgment Decree against each of us. That is likely the very reason that the Lord warns us that the men of Nineveh would be standing before the Father and testifying against us, or for us, at this very time. And it would seem that this is also the time that the Lord spoke of when He says that the Queen of the South (*the double blessed*), will be standing in testimony either against us or for us.

I have explained in many emails and writings why it seems that today is the correct Rosh HaShanah (*Sundown Sept. 2, 2016, until sundown Sept. 3, 2016*). It is possible that Rosh HaShanah is at Sundown on October 1, 2016, until sundown October 2, 2016. However, it seems that the actual day is today. Even the book of Enoch foretold that in this Day of our Judgment the calendar would be confused.

In any case, can we risk not reacting like the men of Nineveh and not obeying the Father’s instruction given to us in Joel 2:12-20 on the only Way that He will hear us and intervene for us (*Which means that He would change our Judgment Decree*)? If we think that we are spirit filled, or that we are saved from being cast out from Him because of the blood, then we need to carefully discern the warning of the Lord in John 12:48, Matthew 7:21-23, John 5:24-25, and Revelation 3:14-22.

Also, do you know why it is important to ask to have the Lord’s Face to Shine upon all those whom we bless? I will have that Bible Study out hopefully today. It is a very important teaching on what the Priestly Blessing means.

Food for the wise in Christ who desire to “see” the Lord.....

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1 Corinthians 1

1 Corinthians 1:1-3 ¹Paul, called to be an apostle of Jesus Christ through the will of God, and Sosthenes our brother, ²to the called out assembly of God (*Wrongly translated as the “church of God”. Church is a created word used in the New Testament that inaccurately describes the intent of the meaning being revealed by the disciples and the apostles of our Lord.*) which is at Corinth, to those who are sanctified in Christ Jesus (*This statement sets the entire tone of this letter to the Corinthians. This statement means that Paul has addressed this letter to those who are sanctified. This means that they have set themselves apart from the world by having heard and received the knowledge of Truth as instructed by Jesus Christ (John 17:17). It means they have been taught and have received the knowledge of the Holy Words of God that are living and filled with the Spirit of God (John 6:63, John 3:34, John 15:7). Paul is bearing witness that they have been set apart from those of the world, and sanctified per the Way of the instruction of the Lord revealed in John 17:17 and Joel 2:12-2. Thus, the people whom Paul is writing to had been taught by Paul the knowledge of the Words of God and the Promises of God's Special Good Works that are unlocked by the doing of these Holy Words (Ephesians 2:10, John 15:7). These people know the difference between the words of earthly languages and the Set Apart Sacred Words of God that are spoken and made known by the One Good Sheppard, our Lord Jesus Christ (Ecclesiastes 12:11, Deuteronomy 18:18-19, John 3:26-36, John 8:43-47, John 18:37, Luke 24:44-45). And in Paul's letter he reveals that these people have been taught that the Power of God is found in the Holy Words of Jesus the Christ, for He is the King of all those who hear His Voice and believe the Promises of the Father given in His Words (Ecclesiastes 8:4, Deuteronomy 18:18-19, John 5:24-25, John 15:7, 1 John 5:24-25, Romans 10:17). Paul was famously taught that he had overlooked these Words of God opened by the Lord. It occurred when the Lord appeared to him as a bright Light and caused him to open his heart to the knowledge of Truth by blinding him for three days. The entrance of His Words is what gives Light and gives Understanding (Psalm 119:130). The Lord told to Paul that he is persecuting the Lord Jesus the Christ by stumbling against the goads. Paul was a scholar of the Scriptures, and he was able to then understand that he had missed the discernment of God's Words by ignoring the revelation of Solomon given in Ecclesiastes 12:11. There we are taught that the precious Words of God are like goads given to us by the One Good Shepherd. Jesus famously said that He is the One Shepherd. Paul, in this letter to the Corinthians, reveals repeatedly that the people need to heed the Words of the Christ, for in these Words are found the Power of the Christ.), called to be saints (*It is revealed by John in Revelation 19:1-10 that the people become saints of the Lord when they receive the authority to put the fine linen on their garment by doing the Ways of the Words of God that enable the Righteous Acts of God to be done for the Glory of the Father (See John 15:7). When we discern that we are called to be saints, and we set ourselves apart from the world to seek Him for understanding on how to do all things by the Ways of His world (See Proverbs 1:23), then we are of the elect who obeyed the instruction of the Lord to come out of the world and return to Him to be as our only King and our only High Priest. For as it so states in Proverbs 1:23, it is He who causes our hearts to know His Words. And by this we receive Faith (Romans 10:17). Paul reveals repeatedly within this book to the Corinthians that all though He teaches the Christ manifested, it is only the Spirit of the Lord that causes the Words to be burned into our heart so that we have real Faith that is based on a foundation of wisdom and understanding of the Good News.), with all who in every place call on the name of Jesus Christ our Lord (*In the bible the Name means the work for the Kingdom of God that one is given to do. The “Name” of Jesus Christ that summarizes all His Works (Thus, the Name that summarizes the meanings given in all of His other Names mentioned in the Bible that describe His Works.) is “the Word”, as is testified to by***

*John in Revelation 19:11-13. We should understand this because the Father testifies in Deuteronomy 18:18-19 that He gave this Work for the Kingdom of God to the Lord Jesus that He is to bear witness to the Words that the Father God gave to Him; and also that the Lord Jesus should bear witness to the Good Works that God has prepared for those who are sanctified and that the Father has shown Him. It is recorded in John 18:37 that Jesus the Christ testified of this Truth in His trial before Pilate. We should desire to know this Truth very well because the Lord testifies in John 12:48 that in this Day of the Lord, at the time of the Separation Judgment, the Judgment Decree issued by the Father for each one of us that is given by the Father is going to be based upon these Words of God that Jesus bore witness to. And we should be careful to note that this is a Jubilee Year that begins on Rosh HaShanah the Father issues His Judgment Decree for us for the year to come based upon the works of His Words that we have done. That should shake us – totally tremble us - to the bones, for this is the Jubilee Year that will include the Separation Judgment of all those on the earth. And since the Father is God and can never changes His Ways (*Malachi 3:6*), then the people of the called out assembly only have 40 days to plead before Him to change their Judgment Decree. This is because He Mercifully gave the people of Nineveh 40 days until their Judgment would be finalized (*Book of Jonah*). However, the people of Nineveh were given that merciful 40 days because they had not heard the Words of God preached to them. But, at the 3 day preaching of Jonah as he walked through their city, the Spirits of the Lord, of Wisdom, and of Understanding, were released by that Good Work given to these people by the instruction of the Lord to Jonah. And this was allowed by the Father because these enemies of Israel had not had the knowledge of Truth preached to them by the people of Israel with hearts of passion for their souls (*Even Jonah had a heart of bitterness towards the people of Nineveh. The Lord had appointed Jonah from before, and He called him to speak His Words to the people of Nineveh. And Jonah only obeyed the Will of God and went to Nineveh and spoke the Words that God made known to him, only because the Lord had shown Jonah the result of disobedience. He had Jonah swallowed by the great fish and cast out into the prisons of God. That is the Way God has prepared for those who have bitter hearts toward their enemies who have not been taught the knowledge of Truth, and who do not go forth and speak His Words with passion to these known to be judged by God in this Day of His Judgment. The Laws of God bear witness that the Separation Judgment will suddenly come on all those on the earth during this Jubilee Year, for it is that God cannot change His Ways. The Prophetic Words and Visions are pouring out from Heaven bearing witness to this Truth.*) Please note that I believe the calendar's likely are in error as is foretold in the book of Enoch. And thus, I believe that today is likely real Rosh Hashanah of the critical year of our judgment. That would mean from the evening of September 2 until sundown on September 3. That would mean we have 40 days. If there is not a revival, then it seems assured that the called out assembly will be cast out from God in the Judgment. And if Rosh Hashanah is on the evening of October 1 and until sundown on October 2, there still remains little time for a Revival when the people are taught the knowledge of Truth from pulpits. This has been rejected by all "churches" from April 2003 until now. Professing to be wise the shepherds have believed the lie of the complacent teachings and they have denied the Power of God that is found in the Words of King Jesus that God has appointed.), both theirs and ours: ³Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.*

1 Corinthians 1:4-9 ⁴I thank my God always concerning you for the grace of God which was given to you by Christ Jesus, ⁵that you were enriched in everything by Him in all utterance and all knowledge, ⁶even as the testimony of Christ (*John 18:37, Deuteronomy 18:18-19, John 3:34*) was confirmed in you, ⁷so that you come short in no gift, eagerly waiting for the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ, ⁸who will also confirm you to the end, that you may be blameless in the day of our

Lord Jesus Christ. ⁹God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

1 Corinthians 1:10-13 ¹⁰Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment. ¹¹For it has been declared to me concerning you, my brethren, by those of Chloe's household, that there are contentions among you. ¹²Now I say this, that each of you says, "I am of Paul," or "I am of Apollos," or "I am of Cephas," or "I am of Christ." ¹³Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul?

1 Corinthians 1:14-17 ¹⁴I thank God that I baptized none of you except Crispus and Gaius, ¹⁵lest anyone should say that I had baptized in my own name. ¹⁶Yes, I also baptized the household of Stephanas. Besides, I do not know whether I baptized any other. ¹⁷For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the Good News (*Incorrectly translated as "gospel", a false word used by translators that removes the greatness of the meaning being revealed by the disciples and also the apostles such as Paul.*), not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of no effect.

1 Corinthians 1:18-19 ¹⁸For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. ¹⁹For it is written: "I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and bring to nothing the understanding of the prudent." (*Quote taken from Isaiah 29:14*)

1 Corinthians 1:20-25 ²⁰Where *is* the wise? Where *is* the scribe? Where *is* the disputer of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of this world? ²¹For since, in the wisdom of God, the world through wisdom did not know God, it pleased God through the foolishness of the message preached to save those who believe. ²²For Jews request a sign, and Greeks seek after wisdom; ²³but we preach Christ crucified, to the Jews a stumbling block and to the Greeks (Gentiles) foolishness, ²⁴but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God. ²⁵Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men.

1 Corinthians 1:26-31 ²⁶For you see your calling, brethren, that not many wise according to the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called. ²⁷But God has chosen the foolish things of the world to put to shame the wise, and God has chosen the weak things of the world to put to shame the things which are mighty; ²⁸and the base things of the world and the things which are despised God has chosen, and the things which are not, to bring to nothing the things that are, ²⁹that no flesh should glory in His presence. ³⁰But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God—and righteousness and sanctification and redemption— ³¹that, as it is written, "He who glories, let him glory in the LORD." (*Quote taken from Jeremiah 9:24*)
