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THE MEANING OF THE WORD DOOR AS IT IS SPOKEN AND DONE IN HEAVEN:

The Lord Jesus said that He is the Door of the sheep, and that no one comes into the sheepfold except through that Door. Jesus said that when we pray we are to go into our closet and shut the Door, praying to our Father in secret. Jesus told the people of the Church of Philadelphia that He knew their Works, and that He has set before them an open Door, and no one can shut it; for they have a little strength, have kept His Word, and have not denied His name. The Lord told the Church of Laodicea that He stands at the Door and knocks and that if anyone will open the Door that He will come in and dine with them, and they with Him. These passages are all famous and recognizable Scriptures in the Bible referring to the use of a Door. But, there are other passages in the Bible that are critically important to us in reference to the Door and to the doorposts that surround the Door.

In Deuteronomy 6:9 there is a forgotten Law of God that pertains to the Door, and when we come to remembrance of that Law, and gain in understanding of God's promise that is within the Word of God that is the "Door", then the way we live our daily lives will likely be changed forever. That Law reads *"And you shall write them (The Words of God) on the doorposts of your house and on your gates."* The Lord was not speaking of all the words of the Bible. He was speaking of the 153 Words of God. He also did not say that we had to write all of His Words on the Doorposts, but that we are to place at least some of them on the Doorposts of our house. But, why do we need to do this?

Further, you may remember Hannah, the mother of Samuel, going before the doorposts of the synagogue and silently making her pleading to God in regard to her shame at being barren. You may recall that Eli the priest, was sitting there at the doorposts, and he accusingly questioned Hannah in the way she was moving her lips without speaking the words of her prayer while having her face uncovered without a veil. However, after hearing Hannah's explanation Eli told her to go on her way and let the Lord answer her petition. Why was she petitioning to God at the doorposts of the House of God in such a manner?

In Revelation 3:7 the Lord says that He holds the key to the House of David and what He opens to man can close and what He shuts no man can open. Clearly the keys to a house mean that they are keys to a Door of that house. So what does it mean that Jesus is holding the keys to the Door of the House of David?

- ☆ **Isaiah 22:22** The Key of the House of David I will lay on His shoulder; So He shall open, and no one shall shut; and He shall shut and no one shall open.

In John 10 the Lord refers that He is the Good Shepherd and that He is the Door for the sheep to enter into the sheepfold. In the days of Jesus the sheep would follow the shepherd when he calls them, to come into a barn or cave for the night. The shepherd would then lie down across the doorway entrance of the barn or the cave so that nothing could come in to take the sheep, and also that the sheep would not wander out during the night. Why did the Lord describe Himself as the Door for the sheep? While will He keep us sealed up and protected in the Time of the Night?

When the Lord told the Israelites who were captive in Israel to prepare themselves because Death was going to pass through the land of Egypt, part of the instruction was that the blood of a specific sacrifice had to be placed upon the doorpost and the mantle to the doors of their houses, as well as the doors of their barns. All those who obeyed the Lord's command would escape from the hand of Death who was sent by God to come to take the life of all the firstborn in the land of Egypt. What was significant of the doorpost and the mantle of the door?

Jesus said that He is the Door and that no man enters unto the Father except through Him. There are many examples where Jesus forgave the sins of those who did Good for Him, such as when the woman anointed His feet with oil, washed His feet with her tears, and dried His feet with her hair, and the Lord forgave her or her sins ([Luke 7:36-50](#)). Likely we can understand Him forgiving sins, for He is the Son of God, and the Father and He are One. But, why when Jesus suddenly appeared in the Evening in the Upper Room to the disciples, not coming through any Door, did He Greet them and then breath upon them and say to them that they now had the authority to forgive sins and to retain sins ([John 20:21-23](#))? Is there a relationship between the Door, His Words, and the receiving of authority over sin? Why does Jesus teach us to pray by first instructing us to go into our room and closing the Door?

- ☆ **John 20:21-23** ²¹Then Jesus said to them again, **"Peace to you! As the Father sent Me, I also send you."** ²²And when He had said that this, He breathed on them, and said to them, **"Receive the Holy Spirit. ²³If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any they are retained."**
- ☆ **John 3:34** Whoever does accept His testimony attests that God is true; for He whom God has sent speaks the Words of God, for God grants the Spirit only in full measure.

The answer to these questions all references back to the heavenly meaning of the "Door". Jesus placed Himself in the Doorway for He is the One who reveals to us the Words of God, and it is He who pours out the Spirit of Truth to make known all things and gives us understanding of God. In Psalm 119:130 we are told that the entrance of His



Words is what places Jesus, the Light of the world, within us. That verse also tells us that the entrance of His Words gives us the Light within us and that Light gives us Understanding. In Proverbs 9:10 we are told that Understanding is the knowledge of God. Jesus told us that only the Father is Good, and He clarifies that it is the Father who does the Good Works. Thus we can understand that Jesus is the Door who opens for us the knowledge of God, and the knowledge of the Good Works of the Father. Jesus also told us that the Father's Words are the Words that Judge and the Bible reveals that His Words are the laws, and all of God's Laws are also Promises, by which all of the creation was made, by which all of the creation exists, by which all of the creation consists, and by which all of the creation will go forth and fulfill its appointed seasons and ordained acts. Thus it is that all of the promised works of God, such as the promise to raise the worthy to Eternal Life, are found within the Words of God. These promises in God's Words, or as also should be called Laws of God, are ordained within His Words, are the doorposts and mantle of the Door of the Lord. Jesus is the Lawgiver, for it is He who has always spoken forth the Words of God to man. It is Jesus who asks of the Father to send forth the Words of God, for the Father gave the Words of God to the Son, for in the Words of God exists all things, and the Father has given all things to the Son. Thus, even though God is Spirit and His Spirit is His Words, no one can come to the Father except through the Door to His Words, and that is our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. In the Night the Lord will seal us up, to keep us safe and secure as like those in Noah's ark.

THE WAY OF THE WORD DOOR

There is no question that when we communicate with each other, the understanding of the wording of what we say is received along with the method of the delivery, the setting in which we are talking, and is also affected by the history of past communications. In other words what we do, as well as the way in which we say something, are instrumental as to how our communication is received. We see this everyday in sports in the interaction between players and referees, especially in professional basketball games where foul calls are usually greeted with some type of player facial expression, gesture, or even a quite boisterous tirade. Women are generally quite sensitive to the way, the place, and the manner in which a man says the words "I love you". Perhaps those three words most identify with what I am about to explain. Especially when you consider that women, and men, often say these three words with little forethought. Or, there is the especially frustrating experience when the woman, in a moment of heated passion, says the man that she loves him; but then within the next day, or even a few days, she relates that in reality she never could stand him. The point is that we often say things as they seem right to us at the moment, but within our heart we never really believed the words of what we actually said. Also, the setting has much to do with what we say and how it is received. Such is also the case with our prayers to our Lord God in heaven. If we love the Lord, would we not pray in the way He instructed us to pray, seeing the prayer that He instructed us to pray includes the utilization of His Words? Further, if we loved the Father, then why would we enter through the doors of His House on the Sabbath Day and teach our own words when He has opened His Words for us to teach, and He has told us that this is the required teaching for all of His Teachers? It is no wonder why we are in the days of the Seal Judgments and if has come upon us as a snare, just like the Lord told us in Luke 21:34-36 that it would; for Jesus said that if we do not hear the Father's Words, then we do not even know our God. By our actions it cannot be said that we love our Lord. When we enter the door, and walk through doorposts that are by the Law of God required to be ordained to God by having His Words place upon them. If so then we have all failed to see that we have shown the Almighty Father by our actions that we have sinned against His Law. In this Writing we will consider from the Scriptures as to why this is true, and why there is likely not one of us that does not need to turn from our complacent ways, to repent, and to begin diligently seeking the knowledge of our God that we will need to be found worthy of being sealed for the Rapture.

- ☆ **John 14:23-24** ²³Jesus answered and said to him, "IF ANYONE LOVES ME, HE WILL KEEP MY WORD; AND THE FATHER WILL LOVE HIM, AND WE WILL COME TO HIM AND MAKE OUR HOME WITH HIM. ²⁴HE WHO DOES NOT LOVE ME DOES NOT KEEP MY WORDS; and the Word which you hear is not Mine but the Father's who sent Me."
- ☆ **Isaiah 58:13-14** ¹³"If you turn away your foot from the Sabbath, from doing your pleasure on My holy day, and call the Sabbath a delight, the holy Day of the Lord honorable, and shall honor Him, not doing your own ways, nor finding your own pleasure, NOR SPEAKING YOUR OWN WORDS, ¹⁴then you shall delight yourself in the Lord; and I will cause you to ride on the high hills of the earth, and feed you with the heritage of Jacob your father. The mouth of the Lord has spoken."
- ☆ **Luke 21:34-36** "But take heed to yourselves, lest your hearts be weighed down with carousing, drunkenness, and cares of this life, and THAT DAY (*The Day of the Lord that began in June 2003*) come on you unexpectedly. **FOR IT WILL COME AS A SNARE ON ALL THOSE WHO DWELL ON THE FACE OF THE WHOLE EARTH.** Watch therefore, and pray always THAT YOU MAY BE COUNTED WORTHY to escape all these things that will come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man." (*This means that if we do not wake up and see that we do not have the Knowledge of God that we believe that we have, then we have become trapped in a snare, and we will not be found worthy by the Lord at the Midnight Hour, and we will not be kept safe from the troubles that are to come in the remainder of the Day of the Lord. We have to wake-up now, in the Evening Time of the Day of the Lord, to receive the Light and to eat of Great Supper so that our vessel is filled with oil before the Judgment of the Midnight Hour.*)
- ☆ **Matthew 7:24-27** "THEREFORE WHOEVER HEARS THESE WORDS OF MINE, AND DOES THEM, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock: and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall, for it was founded on the rock. **BUT EVERYONE WHO HEARS THESE WORDS OF MINE,**

AND DOES NOT DO THEM, will be like a foolish man who built his house on the sand: and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it fell. And great was its fall."

The Bible tells us that the Father is a reader of our hearts, and He knows what are our true feelings and intentions that are behind our spoken words. With the Father, the way in which we do things is of more importance, or at least it is of as much importance, as to what we say with our mouth. It is very important that we come to understand that although God is in heaven, and His heaven is located possibly billions of light years away from us, He can see instantly see exactly what we do and He hears all of what we say, and He hears our thoughts being formed in our minds prior to the words ever coming out of our mouths. The actions that each of us do are as closely monitored in heaven as if someone was following our every move with cameras from many angles that are always recording. In addition to this the Bible says that angels are always present to perform His Word in its season and within His Will. I do not say this to alarm you, but to attempt to assist in enabling us to understand that what we do is always seen by the Lord, and therefore when do things that are in the way of following the Lord's instructions, that act is given more honor and recognition in heaven than our offerings of many words.

- ☆ **Psalm 44:21** Would not God search this out? For He knows the secrets of the heart.
- ☆ **2 Chronicles 16:9** "For the eyes of the Lord run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to show Himself strong of behalf of those whose heart is loyal to Him."
- ☆ **1 Samuel 16:6-7** ⁶So it was, when they came, that he looked at Eliab and said, "Surely the Lord's anointed is before Him!" ⁷But the Lord said to Samuel, "Do not look at his appearance or at his physical stature, because I have refused him. For the Lord does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart."
- ☆ **Acts 13:22** And when He had removed him (*King Saul*), He raised up for them David as king, to whom also He gave testimony and said, "I have found David the son of Jesse, **a man after My own heart, who will do all My will.**" (*This is the heart that God is seeking after, for it is a heart that hears the Words of Jesus and believes upon Him*).
- ☆ **Proverbs 10:8** The wise in heart will receive commands (*So it is in the way that the Lord describes David's heart in Acts 13:22*).

IT IS A LAW OF GOD TO PLACE HIS WORDS ON OUR DOORPOSTS SO THAT IT IS WELL WITH OUR FAMILY, OUR CHILDREN, FRIENDS, AND NATION

In Deuteronomy 18:18-19 the Father made it a Law that we are to hear His Words, and in Deuteronomy 6:4-9; 11:18-21, the Father made it a Law that we are to teach His Words to everyone in our house, everyone in our business, and all those in the land of our nation, speaking of them throughout our day and night. The Lord also made it a Law that we are to put His Words on our Doorposts and upon our Gates. The Lord also made it a Law that we are to bind them on our wrists, and in other places within the Bible, the Lord also made it a Law that we place His Words on our necks, and on our fingers. There are 153 Words of God and they are acceptable to the Lord to be spelt in any language, or to post them in their physical symbolic form, such as the fish symbol, or the Cube for the Truth symbol, or the Egg symbol, etc. The purpose is so that our mind and also our physical body, are continually caused to be reminded to walk within the Way of His Words.



THE FISH SIGN ON DOORPOSTS
The Desire to Eat of His Food, Being Fed the Spirit of Truth, to Receive of the 2 Ways of God: to Walk Justly and Do Righteously

Deuteronomy 18:18-19 ¹⁸"I will raise up for them a Prophet like you from among their brethren, and will put My Words in His mouth, and He shall speak to them all that I command Him. ¹⁹"And it shall be that whoever will not hear My Words, which He speaks in My name, I will require it of him."

Deuteronomy 6:4-9 ⁴"Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God is one Lord! ⁵You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and all your soul, and with all your might. ⁶And these Words which I command you this day shall be upon your heart; ⁷and you shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. ⁸And you shall bind them as a sign upon your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. ⁹And you shall write them on the door posts of your house and on your gates."

Deuteronomy 11:18-21 ¹⁸"Therefore you shall lay up these Words of Mine in your heart and in your soul, and bind them in your heart and in your soul, and bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. ¹⁹You shall teach them to your children, speaking of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. ²⁰And you shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates. ²¹that your days and the days of your children may be multiplied in the land of which the Lord swore to your fathers to give them, like the days of the heavens above the earth."



TWO BRASS EGGS ON DOORPOSTS
The Desire to Increase in the Knowledge of His Way, to Walk Justly and to Do Good Works, and to Grow Within His Favor



Isaiah 22:22 The Key of the House of David I will lay on His shoulder; So He shall open, and no one shall shut; and He shall shut and no one shall open. (*Jesus was sent to open His Words. Now they are Open, but He will close them again at Midnight*).



Revelation 3:7 "And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write, 'These things says He who is holy, He who is true, "He who has the key of David, He who opens and no one shuts, and shuts and no one opens". (*Eat while we are in Evening, for Night is coming*).

The Lord Jesus taught us that there is as much importance to the way that we pray as to the words that we pray. In Matthew 6:6 the Lord teaches us that we are to pray by going into our room and shutting the door. This is a very important detail. Most of us have heard of the Jewish Prayer Shawl that has the tassels (*tzitzis*) carefully woven into each of its four corners. The Jewish men pray by entering into the prayer shawl by covering their heads with it, and this is considered as going into their prayer room. The reason that this is so, is that the Father made it a law in Deuteronomy 6:4-9 and Deuteronomy 11:18-21, that we are to place His Words on the doorposts of our doorways. These Words should be on every doorpost in every doorway within the house, the business, the government, and most certainly every doorway in a church. When we pass through the doorway we are entering into a room that has the Lord's Law as its anointing frame. When we do this we are doing the way of the promise of the Word of the Lord that is "Door". In Proverbs 8:32-36 the Lord tells us that those who listen to Him are blessed because they watch for knowledge at His gates, and they listening and waiting carefully for His Words at His Doorposts of His Door. This is one of the greatest "key" teachings of His Way that can be found in the entire Bible. Throughout this Writing we will consider this promise of God that is in the Way of His Word Door.

- ☆ **Proverbs 8:32-36** ³²"Now therefore listen to Me, My children, for blessed are those who keep My Ways. ³³Hear instruction and be wise, and do not disdain it. ³⁴Blessed is the man who listens to Me, watching daily at My gates, **waiting at the posts of My doors.** ³⁵**For whoever finds Me finds Life, AND OBTAINS FAVOR FROM THE LORD;** ³⁶but whoever sins against Me wrongs His own soul; all those who hate Me love Death."

In Deuteronomy 6:4-9 and in Deuteronomy 11:18-21, the Father made it a Law that His Words are to be placed on all of our Doorposts and all of our Gates. His Words are Eternal, and His Law to Love Him above all other is also an eternal commandment. Thus, do you not think that that His Words shall be on all the doorposts to the Great Eternal City? Thus it seems disappointing that it is likely only a very few churches in all of America have any symbol of the Word's of God on the doorposts of even their main entrance doorways, let alone all of its doorways? Why would they not observe this Law, when it is considered to be a primary Law of God? Israel recognizes that Deuteronomy 6:4 is a primary Law of God, then why would not verses 5_9 also be a primary law of God, especially when Jesus testified to the high importance of His Words? If one is observant to the Scriptures and the teachings of God, then it is not possible for the full anointing of the Lord to be placed upon a church that is not obeying the Father in this during these days when His Words are opened. This is going to take a change in the mindset of American people, but it is a law that the Lord is going to see that it is enforced, or He will cause the destruction of those churches. The Father said that if we do not hear His Words then He is going to require it of us. How much more do you think that He is going to require it of the churches that will not hear His Words, will not repent, and will not become zealous to obey all of His Laws?

- ☆ **Isaiah 58:13-14** ¹³"If you turn away your foot from the Sabbath, from doing your pleasure on My holy day, and call the Sabbath a delight, the holy Day of the Lord honorable, and shall honor Him, not doing your own ways, nor finding your own pleasure, **NOR SPEAKING YOUR OWN WORDS.** ¹⁴then you shall delight yourself in the Lord; and I will cause you to ride on the high hills of the earth, and feed you with the heritage of Jacob your father. The mouth of the Lord has spoken."
- ☆ **Matthew 7:21-29** ²¹"Not every one who says to Me, "Lord, Lord", shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that does the will of My Father who is in heaven. ²²Many will say to Me in that day, "Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and by Your name cast out demons, and by Your name do many mighty works?" ²³And then I will declare to them, "I never knew you: depart from Me, you that work iniquity." *(This will be the cutting off of the complacent, rebellious, wealthy, blind, naked, and prideful pastors as per Luke 14:24, because they have refused His invitation to come to His Great Supper and partake of His Food of Heaven that gives the true knowledge of Truth).*
- ☆ **Revelation 21:5-8** ⁵Then He who sat on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things new." And He said to me, "**Write, for these Words are true and faithful.**" *(All things are in His Words, and by the time of Revelation 21 He will have fulfilled all things, therefore He will cause His Words to stand forever and ever).* ⁶And He said to me, "It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. I will give of the fountain of the water of life freely to him who thirsts. ⁷He who overcomes shall inherit all things *(They shall inherit His Words, for in His Words are all things, and this enables them to be rulers over Kingdoms, as a Servant of the Lord)*, and I will be his God and he shall be My son. ⁸**But the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death.**" *(Jesus said that he who has put his hand to the plow is not worthy of Him if he turns back; and also if he is a coward and does not take up his cross and follow Him, then He is also not worthy of Him. For the Lord says that we are to not fear others, but we should put our trust in Him. For as He was with the Israelites in power, both in Egypt and coming out of Egypt, so is He with His people during these last days to keep them safe and secure who will hear His voice and obey Him. This is the second death because when the people in God's prisons are brought forth to come before Him at the Great White Throne Judgment they will be resurrected from out of a worm's body and into the body that they would have had if they would have been worthy of Eternal Life. They will be judged and sent to Gehenna where they will again be put into the body of a worm. Gehenna is called as the Second Death also because it is the prison of God that is called as Gehenna, and it will be the same punishment as that found in the prison of God that was called Death).*

If the church tries to say that we are no longer under the Law, then they are truly blind and they are assured of destruction. Jesus said that He did not come to change the Law, but to fulfill it. He was sent into the world to speak and do the Words of God, and He died on the Cross as a sacrifice for our sins so that He could return and open to us

those very Words of God that sweep us clean of our sins. Jesus made it perfectly clear, for in John 8:47, He said that whoever does not hear the Words of God are not of God. James, the leader of the first in Jerusalem, said we are to be doers of His Words, or we are just fooling ourselves about being anointed of the Lord. When His Words are open, as now, then this command should awaken the heart of every minister who truly desires to lead his people in the way desired by the Lord. Can there truly be an anointing upon a church wherein the Law of the love of the Lord's Word is being trampled upon?

- ☆ **James 1:22-24** ²²But be doers of the Word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. ²³For if anyone is a hearer of the Word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror; ²⁴for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was.

Several times Jesus told us that we are to keep His sayings and to do them. There are 153 Words of God, and in each of His Words the Lord that has told us that we are to walk in His two ways, to keep Justice and to do Righteousness. It is impossible to truly walk righteously unless we receive His Words and increase in the Knowledge of God.

- ☆ **Proverbs 2:1-6** ¹My son, if You receive My Words, and treasure My commands within you, ²so that you incline your ear to wisdom (*Discern God's Words*), and apply your heart to understanding (*Seek Understanding Of The Ways The Lord Used The Words As He Was Shown By The Father so that you are able to be a doer of His Words*); ³yes, if you cry out for discernment, and lift up your voice for understanding, (*By asking the Lord to make His Words known to you – Proverbs 1:23*) ⁴IF YOU SEEK HER AS SILVER, AND SEARCH FOR HER AS FOR HIDDEN TREASURES; ⁵THEN you WILL understand the fear of the Lord, and FIND the knowledge of God. ⁶For the Lord gives wisdom; from His mouth come knowledge and understanding.

In like manner to placing His Words to the doorposts of our house, the tzitzis (*tassels*) are attached to the corners of the Jewish Prayer Shawl, and they represent the doorposts of the door. For the knots of the Tzitzis represent all the Laws of God. In the days when the Words of God were opened the Jewish people would have had the 153 Words of God represented by at least two of the Tzitzis, for the requirement in Numbers 15:37-41 requires that they were to remember all of His commandments and that they do them. In the picture you are able to see the Tzitzis hanging from the corner of the Prayer Shawl on the Jewish man at the Western Wall of the old city in Jerusalem. In Numbers 15:39-40 the Lord tells us the reason for the Tzitzis on the prayer shawl, and we can understand by the way of the Tzitzis, that it is the same reason that He commanded us to place His Words upon the Doorposts of our Doorway. The Lord says that you shall look upon the tassels (Tzitzis) and you shall remember all the commandments of the Lord and do them, and that you *may* not follow the harlotry to which your own heart and your own eyes are inclined, and that you may remember and do all My commandments, and be holy (*set apart*) for your God. You can understand this as you read these Laws of God that are given in Deuteronomy 6:4-9 and Deuteronomy 11:18-21.



- ☆ **Numbers 15:37-41** ³⁷Again the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, ³⁸"Speak to the children of Israel: Tell them to make tassels on the corners of their garments throughout their generations, and to put a blue thread in the tassels of the corners. ³⁹And you shall have the tassel, that you may look upon it and remember all the commandments of the LORD and do them, and that you *may* not follow the harlotry to which your own heart and your own eyes are inclined, ⁴⁰and that you may remember and do all My commandments, and be holy for your God. ⁴¹I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: I am the LORD your God."
- ☆ **Deuteronomy 6:4-9** (*The Bible Refers to this passage as both the Law of the Fathers and the Law of the Mothers*) ⁴"Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God is one Lord! ⁵You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and all your soul, and with all your might. ⁶And these Words which I command you this day shall be upon your heart; ⁷and you shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. ⁸And you shall bind them as a sign upon your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. ⁹And you shall write them on the door posts of your house and on your gates." (*Do you have the sign of His Words on the doors of your house, on your car, and on your right wrist? Do you wear them around your neck?*).
- ☆ **Deuteronomy 11:18-21** (*THIS IS THE LAW OF THE PARENTS AND THE LEADERS*) ¹⁸Therefore you shall lay up these Words of Mine in your heart and in your soul, and bind them in your heart and in your soul, and bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. ¹⁹You shall teach them to your children, speaking of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. ²⁰And you shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates (*The Gates are the places of Business and of Government, today that is the doors of our offices, the doors of both business and government*), ²¹that your days and the days of your children may be multiplied in the land of which the Lord swore to your fathers to give them, like the days of the heavens above the earth." (*Are the Words of God posted upon all the doors of your houses, on your business, and on all the doors of our government?*)

Consider what David tells us in Psalm 14:2-3 and that he repeats in Psalm 53:2-3. He says that the eyes of the Lord are always upon us to "see" if anyone "Understands", who seek God, and to see if anyone does "Good". David says

that the truth is that not one of us Understands, and that none of us do Good. Yet it is that the Lord desires us to do Good more than He desires sacrifices for sin.

- ☆ **Psalm 14:2-3, & Psalm 53:2-3** ²The Lord looks down from Heaven upon the children of men, **to see if there are any who understand, WHO SEEK GOD.** ³They have all turned aside, they have together become corrupt; **there is none that does "GOOD", no, not one.**
- ☆ **Hosea 6:6** ⁶For I desire "Good Deeds" and not sacrifice, and the "knowledge of God" more than burnt offerings.
- ☆ **Micah 6:8** ⁸He has shown you, O man, what *is* Good; and **WHAT DOES THE LORD REQUIRE OF YOU BUT TO DO JUSTLY, TO LOVE GOOD DEEDS, AND TO WALK HUMBLY WITH YOUR GOD?**

In many Writings I have reviewed and explained that God is His Words, because the Bible says that God is Spirit, the Spirit is Truth, God is Light, Jesus is Light, Jesus is Life, the Spirit is Life, the Spirit is Truth, God's Word is Truth, and the Spirit is Truth, and God's Words are Spirit and they are Life. Thus, we can see that David is saying that none of us seek to understand the Words of God. In many Writings I have also explained that the Words of God are normal words in all the languages of earth, but in heaven they have an additional meaning. The Words of God as they are in heaven are supernatural and they have promises of God in them that come with the full measure of the power of God's Spirit within them. It is like when Jesus told the prophet Zechariah that His Spirit would complete the Temple of Jerusalem, and that it would not be by His power or by His might. The Lord was saying that it was the promise of His afore spoken prophetic Word of Promise that would cause the Temple to be rebuilt. In other words the Lord was saying that He had to do no knew work to assure that the Temple would be rebuilt, as He has already spoken His Word prophetically that it would be done, and the Spirit of Truth that is in His Word will insure that every promise of God is fulfilled in its season. For His Words are Spirit and they are Life – John 6:63. This means that His Words contain the unbreakable promises of God. Thus, His Words are as Covenant Laws of God, and we can be assured that what promise of God that is in them will be completed within His Will as He has proclaimed from the beginning.

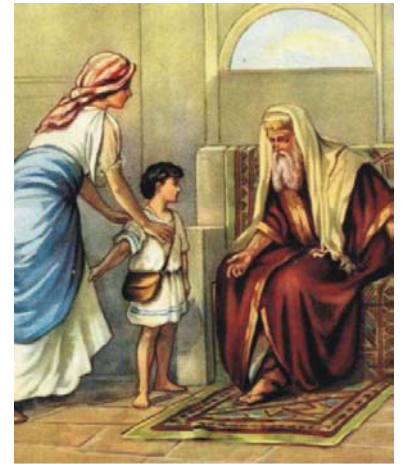
- ☆ **Zechariah 4:6** "So he answered and said to me: This *is* the Word of the Lord to Zerubbabel: 'Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit, Says the Lord of hosts.

In the Bible there is a wonderful story that reveals the importance of the Doorposts and the fact that the deliverance from affliction through being obedient to the way of the promises of God's Word, can be found there. The story will also testify to us that the Way of God's Words is also always to do His Words for the purpose of enabling God to do Good for others. This story also reveals that the door and the doorposts are a key to having mighty prayers answered. The Lord takes simple obedience and turns them into mighty works within the puzzle of fulfilling all of the things ordained for the Kingdom. This is also a story of how a woman obtained the favor of God not by asking for the favor she desired, but by understanding the way of the Lord and seeking to do Good Works for others, while understanding that it is the way of the Lord to grant favor to those whom understand and who diligently seek to do Good. This woman did the way of the Lord 's promises and did first for the Lord without asking for anything for herself, and later, when it was in its season, the Lord blessed her with more than she dreamed for. She had placed her trust in the Lord, knowing that He knew what was best for her, and what she should have in season. And it started with a woman coming humbly, but diligently, to the doorposts, doing the way of the Words of God for to bring the Glory to the Lord.

- ☆ **Proverbs 9:10 Understanding of the Holy One is knowledge.**
- ☆ **Proverbs 12:8 A man will be commended according to His knowledge.**
- ☆ **Proverbs 11:27 He who diligently seeks "Good" finds favor.**
- ☆ **Proverbs 19:8 He who gets Wisdom loves his own soul; he who keeps Understanding will find Good.**
- ☆ **Proverbs 8:32-36** ³²Now therefore listen to Me, My children, for blessed are those who keep My Ways. ³³Hear instruction and be wise, and do not disdain it. ³⁴Blessed is the man who listens to Me, watching daily at My gates, waiting at the posts of My doors. ³⁵**For whoever finds Me finds Life, and obtains favor from the Lord;** ³⁶but whoever sins against Me wrongs His own soul; all those who hate Me love Death."
- ☆ **Proverbs 10:14 Wise people store up knowledge.**

As stated, the Lord desires that we utilize His Words to do Good Deeds for others. However, there are applications where we need to do the way of the Words to resolve issues in our own Life, especially in the area of healing. There is an example within the Bible of a mother who seemingly could be considered to be a "Simple Woman", but through a diligence to increase in knowledge of God, and then do the ways of the Words of the Lord, she was able to overcome the issues that confronted her. Because of her diligence and wisdom, she was able to do the Words of God in the way of the Lord that enabled the Lord to heal her body, such that the Lord changed her from being barren to being able to be a mother of multiple children. At the same time she became very blessed by the Lord. This woman was also given a prophetic Word of the Lord that is affected people from her day all the way to the people of this very day. It is this prophetic word that we should have a keen interest in, for it tells of a basic way of the Lord that should open our eyes to things to happen in these days. What is important to note about this lady is that it becomes apparent in her actions that she knows the Words of God and understands the Ways of the Lord. This woman is Hannah, and her story is recorded in the 1st and 2nd chapters of 1 Samuel. You will know her as the mother of Samuel, the prophet of Israel who put himself in harms way from King Saul to go forth and anoint David, a youthful shepherd boy, to be the

next King of Israel. Take a notice that Hannah and her husband lived in a city that was in the mountains of Ephraim, and that she and her husband were revealed to be Ephraimites. Ephraimites are of course people of the Tribe of Ephraim. Ephraim was the second son of Joseph, and the name "Ephraim" means "double fruitfulness" for Joseph declared "his God had made him fruitful in the land of his affliction". The Ephraimites were an interesting tribe in the history of Israel. Of this tribe came Joshua. Yet during the time of the Judges of Israel they are also often associated with men who were arrogant and prideful, and who sometimes forced their will on the other tribes. They were considered the leaders of the Tribes of the North that would later separate from the Tribes of the South. But, notice that Hannah's husband was of the tribe of Ephraim and that it was the tribe that both Jacob and Moses spoke a strong blessing over. It is considered to be the double blessing. Thus, it is worthy to note that Elkanah was an Ephraimite and that he gave his wife a double blessing everytime they went to the Temple. Let us read the story from 1 Samuel chapters 1 and 2, and we will then look at the way she used the knowledge of the Words of God to enable her healing so that she would glorify God so that within His Good Work He did for her, He could also bless all of Israel through the healing miracle that He gave her – a double blessing.



Hannah Presents Samuel to Eli

- ☆ **1 Samuel 1:1-28** ¹Now there was a certain man of Ramathaim Zophim, of the mountains of Ephraim, and his name was Elkanah the son of Jeroham, the son of Elihu, the son of Tohu, the son of Zuph, an Ephraimite. ²And he had two wives: the name of one was Hannah, and the name of the other Peninnah. Peninnah had children, but Hannah had no children. ³This man went up from his city yearly to worship and sacrifice to the Lord of hosts in Shiloh. Also the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, the priests of the Lord, were there. ⁴And whenever the time came for Elkanah to make an offering, he would give portions to Peninnah his wife and to all her sons and daughters. ⁵But to Hannah he would give a double portion, for he loved Hannah, although the Lord had closed her womb. ⁶And her rival also provoked her severely, to make her miserable, because the Lord had closed her womb. ⁷So it was, year by year, when she went up to the house of the Lord, that she provoked her; therefore she wept and did not eat. ⁸Then Elkanah her husband said to her, "Hannah, why do you weep? Why do you not eat? And why is your heart grieved? Am I not better to you than ten sons?" ⁹So Hannah arose after they had finished eating and drinking in Shiloh. *(Note that the Temple was still in Shiloh, although it did not belong to be in Shiloh, as it should have been in Zion – Jerusalem. David would later establish the Temple in Jerusalem, and He moved the Ark there as well. This is symbolic of the strength and pride of the dominant Ephraimites that they had kept the Temple in Shiloh).* Now Eli the priest was sitting on the seat by the doorpost of the tabernacle of the Lord *(Take notice that Hannah came and made her petition at the "doorpost" of the Temple. It is the place where God has ordered us to place His Words so that we may remember Him to increase in knowledge of Him. It is a place where we are to put the remembrance of His healing Word. It is also on the doorpost so that we remember to use His Words for bringing forth His Good Words for the purpose of blessing of others so that God may be glorified in the face of others for doing His Good Work for us, as it glorifies the power of God to do so as we ask of Him. Hannah was doing the way of the Lord).* ¹⁰And she was in bitterness of soul, and prayed to the Lord and wept in anguish. ¹¹Then she made a vow and said, "O Lord of hosts, if You will indeed look on the affliction of Your maidservant and remember me, and not forget Your maidservant, but will give Your maidservant a male child, then I will give him to the Lord all the days of his life, and no razor shall come upon his head." *(Hannah's petition to the Lord was for a child to be used by God as a Nazarite for the blessing of His people. She never asked for other children. She knew that if she gave this Son to God so that His Good Work blessed His people, then God would meet her other needs as He saw best for her and her husband. So she was not asking for other blessing. It was enough for her that the Lord would give her a son who would glorify the Lord. She did not cry out to the Lord, she spoke her prayer to the Lord calling upon the promises of His Words at the doorpost to His Temple. God reads the heart and could hear her lips without a voice, and she was speaking forth the way of His Words from the resources of her heart wherein she had received the knowledge of His Words. Be clear that Hannah had a medical issue. She was not perfect in her body for her womb was closed. She wanted God's miracle of healing, but she sought it in the way of Wisdom).* ¹²And it happened, as she continued praying before the Lord, that Eli watched her mouth. ¹³Now Hannah spoke in her heart; only her lips moved, but her voice was not heard. Therefore Eli thought she was drunk. ¹⁴So Eli said to her, "How long will you be drunk? Put your wine away from you!" ¹⁵But Hannah answered and said, "No, my lord, I am a woman of sorrowful spirit. I have drunk neither wine nor intoxicating drink, but have poured out my soul before the Lord. ¹⁶Do not consider your maidservant a wicked woman, for out of the abundance of my complaint and grief I have spoken until now." *(Notice that Hannah said that she was not a "sorrowful" spirit. She petitioned the Lord from her grief but it was from the knowledge of God given her by the Spirit of Truth that she spoke to the Lord).* ¹⁷Then Eli answered and said, "Go in peace, and the God of Israel grant your petition which you have asked of Him." ¹⁸And she said, "Let your maidservant find favor in your sight." *(Eli was the anointed priest setting beside the doorpost of the Temple, and thus the authority of God were there to grant the blessing).* So the woman went her way and ate, and her face was no longer sad. *(This is the outward confirmation of the faith of Hannah in the surety of the promise of God that is in the Way of His Words).* ¹⁹Then they rose early in the morning and worshipped before the Lord, and returned and came to their house at Ramah. And Elkanah knew Hannah his wife, and the Lord remembered her. ²⁰So it came to pass in the process of time that Hannah conceived and bore a son, and called his name Samuel, saying, "Because I have asked for him from the Lord." ²¹Now the man Elkanah and all his house went up to offer to the Lord the yearly sacrifice and his vow. *(Notice that each year a wise man makes a vow with the Lord. A vow is what you will do for God with what you are asking Him for that is within His will for you to ask).* ²²But Hannah did not go up, for she said to her

husband, "Not until the child is weaned; then I will take him, that he may appear before the Lord and remain there forever." ²³So Elkanah her husband said to her, "Do what seems best to you; wait until you have weaned him. **Only let the Lord establish His Word.**" (*Take notice that her husband also gives recognition to the promises of the Good Works that are in God's Words.*) Then the woman stayed and nursed her son until she had weaned him. ²⁴Now when she had weaned him, she took him up with her, with three bulls (*Most old Hebrew texts refer to this as one three-year old Bull- the bull is of course the Ox, and it is the symbol of the Priest and teacher of His Words*), one ephah of flour, and a skin of wine, and brought him to the house of the Lord in Shiloh. (*Note that she came with meat to sacrifice, which represents Words of God that sweeps us clean, as the Meat of God is His Word, and that is why they were to sacrifice meat. In addition she brought flour to make bread. Bread is the symbol of the instruction of the Lord to open His Words and make their promises known so that Samuel would gain in Understanding of the Lord. Notice that Samuel would be in the Temple and this bread is the symbol of instruction of God received. Further she brought wine in a skin, and this is that she wanted Samuel to be changed into wine, a child with Knowledge and Wisdom of God. The child was too young to drink wine, so we can see that Hannah did these things with a determined purpose, and that was doing these things by the way of knowledge. Because of Hannah's wisdom, the nation of Israel was blessed and because of her a priest came forth who would hear the Lord and bring them leadership (David) in the Word and the wisdom of God that would benefit us to this very day, for it is through the Writings of David that the key to the power and promises of the Words of God is found – Psalm 119:130.*) And the child was young. ²⁵Then they slaughtered a bull, and brought the child to Eli. ²⁶And she said, "O my lord! As your soul lives, my lord, I am the woman who stood by you here, praying to the Lord. ²⁷For this child I prayed, and the Lord has granted me my petition that I asked of Him. ²⁸Therefore I also have lent him to the Lord; as long as he lives he shall be lent to the Lord." So they worshiped the Lord there. (*Can you actually imagine how hard it is to let your only "son" go from you, to be used by the Lord, and know that he will not be with you? At this time Hannah had no other child, nor even a promise from God to give her another child. It is symbolic of Mary, the mother of Jesus. Likewise, it is symbolic of Mary that Hannah would prophesy in this time, as Mary also prophesied when she came to Elizabeth, as is recorded in Luke chapter 1.*)

- ☆ **1 Samuel 2:1-36** ¹And Hannah prayed and said: (*This is the prophetic Word of prayer spoken by Hannah which its Truth affects us even to this day*) "My heart rejoices in the Lord; my horn is exalted in the Lord. I smile at my enemies, because I rejoice in Your salvation. ²"No one is holy like the Lord, for there is none besides You, nor is there any rock like our God. ³"Talk no more so very proudly; let no arrogance come from your mouth, for the Lord is the God of knowledge; and by His actions are weighed. (*God had seen what she did, and He had performed the promise of His Ways*). ⁴"The bows of the mighty men are broken, and those who stumbled are girded with strength. (*Notice that the bow of the Lord is the symbol of the Glory of God, His total voice control and power over every sub-atomic particle. By His bow He makes the bows of the mighty men of earth to be as nothing, and with His bow He raises up the weak to be healed and strong, as He healed Hannah and raised up in her what would be the strong priest of Israel who would by courage go forth and anoint the King of Israel who would later conquer its enemies, who would bring the Temple of God back to its proper place in Jerusalem, and who would unite the Tribes of Israel together as a strong nation, and through whom would be brought forth the most blessed King of all, our Lord. Please take notice that this prophecy of Hannah was fulfilled by David in 2 Samuel 1:18*) ⁵Those who were full have hired themselves out for bread, and the hungry have ceased to hunger. Even the barren has borne seven, and she who has many children has become feeble. ⁶"The Lord kills and makes alive; He brings down to the grave and brings up. ⁷The Lord makes poor and makes rich; He brings low and lifts up. ⁸He raises the poor from the dust and lifts the beggar from the ash heap, to set them among princes and make them inherit the throne of glory. "For the pillars of the earth are the Lord's, and He has set the world upon them. ⁹He will guard the feet of His saints, but the wicked shall be silent in darkness. (*Elkanah's other wife who had many children and who had treated Hannah wickedly, was caused to be humbled by what the Lord did for Hannah through even this one child. In history it is only Hannah's seed who is remembered*) "For by strength no man shall prevail. ¹⁰The adversaries of the Lord shall be broken in pieces; from heaven He will thunder against them. The Lord will judge the ends of the earth. "He will give strength to His king, and exalt the horn of His anointed." (*The anointed ones of these last days are those who receive His Words, and like Hannah, they do the way of His Words, waiting on the Lord at His Gates (3:00 AM watches) and petitioning the Lord at His doorposts (9:00 PM prayers). The Lord tells us that we are to increase in knowledge of God and store up wisdom for we will need this in the coming Time of the Night when no man can work. In that time the Lord will exalt the horn of His anointed as He protected the Israelites when they safely crossed the Red Sea in the Night under His Light while the waves of the sea stormed around them and the enemies chased after them at their tail.*) ¹¹Then Elkanah went to his house at Ramah. But the child ministered to the Lord before Eli the priest. ¹²Now the sons of Eli were corrupt; they did not know the Lord. ¹³And the priests' custom with the people was that when any man offered a sacrifice, the priest's servant would come with a three-pronged fleshhook in his hand while the meat was boiling. ¹⁴Then he would thrust it into the pan, or kettle, or caldron, or pot; and the priest would take for himself all that the fleshhook brought up. So they did in Shiloh to all the Israelites who came there. ¹⁵Also, before they burned the fat, the priest's servant would come and say to the man who sacrificed, "Give meat for roasting to the priest, for he will not take boiled meat from you, but raw." ¹⁶And if the man said to him, "They should really burn the fat first; then you may take as much as your heart desires," he would then answer him, "No, but you must give it now; and if not, I will take it by force." ¹⁷Therefore the sin of the young men was very great before the Lord, for men abhorred the offering of the Lord. ¹⁸But Samuel ministered before the Lord, even as a child, wearing a linen ephod. ¹⁹Moreover his mother used to make him a little robe, and bring it to him year by year when she came up with her husband to offer the yearly sacrifice. (*Please take notice of this act by Hannah. This is important. The robe is the garment that is the sign of one who desires to receive the knowledge of God. The robe is very important if it is given in the way of the Lord. Hannah came every year with a robe and she was saying to the Lord that she wanted Him to increase Samuel in Knowledge of His Word. She gave Samuel a new robe every year as he grew, so that he would also grow in the knowledge of God.*) ²⁰And Eli would bless Elkanah and his wife, and say, "The Lord give you descendants from this woman for the loan that was given to the Lord." Then they would go to their own home. ²¹And the

Lord visited Hannah, so that she conceived and bore three sons and two daughters. *(Notice that Hannah received the blessing of more children from God. Also she never asked the Lord of this for herself, but Eli did so).* Meanwhile the child Samuel grew before the Lord. ²²Now Eli was very old; and he heard everything his sons did to all Israel, and how they lay with the women who assembled at the door of the tabernacle of meeting. ²³So he said to them, "Why do you do such things? For I hear of your evil dealings from all the people. ²⁴No, my sons! For *it is not a Good report that I hear. You make the Lord's people transgress.* ²⁵If one man sins against another, God will judge him. But if a man sins against the Lord, who will intercede for him?" Nevertheless they did not heed the voice of their father, because the Lord desired to kill them. ²⁶And the child Samuel grew in stature, and in favor both with the Lord and men. ²⁷Then a man of God came to Eli and said to him, "Thus says the Lord: 'Did I not clearly reveal Myself to the house of your father when they were in Egypt in Pharaoh's house? ²⁸Did I not choose him out of all the tribes of Israel *to be My priest, to offer upon My altar, to burn incense, and to wear an ephod before Me?* And did I not give to the house of your father all the offerings of the children of Israel made by fire? ²⁹Why do you kick at My sacrifice and My offering which I have commanded *in My dwelling place, and honor your sons more than Me, to make yourselves fat with the best of all the offerings of Israel My people?*' *(The preachers and priests of this day should take great heed of these acts by the sons of Eli. It is no different today for the prosperity preachers to ask people to come and put money in their pockets or in bowls on His altars. They are worshipping the gift that is on the altar – money – and they are not pursuing the knowledge of God that gives the fullness of the blessings of God according to our needs as is known by God without our asking).* ³⁰Therefore the Lord God of Israel says: 'I said indeed *that your house and the house of your father would walk before Me forever.*' But now the Lord says: 'Far be it from Me; for those who honor Me I will honor, and those who despise Me shall be lightly esteemed. ³¹Behold, the days are coming that I will cut off your arm and the arm of your father's house, so that there will not be an old man in your house. ³²And you will see an enemy *in My dwelling place, despite all the Good which God does for Israel.* And there shall not be an old man in your house forever. ³³But any of your men *whom I do not cut off from My altar shall consume your eyes and grieve your heart. And all the descendants of your house shall die in the flower of their age.* ³⁴Now this *shall be* a sign to you that will come upon your two sons, on Hophni and Phinehas: in one day they shall die, both of them. ³⁵Then I will raise up for Myself a faithful priest *who shall do according to what is in My heart and in My mind. I will build him a sure house, and he shall walk before My anointed forever.* ³⁶And it shall come to pass that everyone who is left in your house will come *and bow down to him for a piece of silver and a morsel of bread, and say, "Please, put me in one of the priestly positions, that I may eat a piece of bread."*' *(Notice that Hannah had been brought forth by God in the proper time and season by God to put Samuel in place because the house of Eli had grown corrupt, and Eli had not done his job to bring up his children in the fear of the Lord by increasing them in knowledge. His children did not know the way of the Lord, and they had no fear of God. But Samuel was properly prepared by his mother in the knowledge of the Way of God, so that Samuel would heed the voice of the Lord when He would call later on).*

As can be seen from the Scriptures, Hannah had knowledge of the Words of God and she did the ways of the Lord. As a result she not only found favor from the Lord, but she greatly blessed Israel. The heart of Hannah would have been satisfied with just blessing Israel with Samuel; and because of that, the Lord blessed Her with far more than she had hoped for. It started with the knowledge of waiting before the posts of His Door.

Another well-known story that involves the answer to prayer when doing the Way of the Lord's "Door", is that of Mary, the mother of Jesus. Mary was a young lady when God called her for service for the benefit of His people. The story of Mary begins with the arrival of the angel Gabriel. Take notice that He comes through the posts of the doorway of the house to give to Mary the news of her selection. An angel can appear in a room instantaneously, but the Bible clearly reveals that the Angel Gabriel intentionally came into the house. That clearly reveals that he did not supernaturally appear, but rather he came in through the doorway. It should be noticed that Gabriel is the Arch Angel in charge of keeping the Words of God. She also never concerned herself with the terrible scrutiny that she would face being pregnant without a husband; for this was a terrible event for a Jewish child in her days. Mary knew that the others of her town could have stoned her to death for such a shame, even if it was only a perceived sin of sexual immorality. But she put her trust in the promise of God's Word that her child would be born, and that He would be great for all the peoples. Mary also realized that there were many ladies in Israel, such as the wives of the Priests who could have born the Son of God. She was just a poor young girl, but God chose her to make her rich, and other women, who were perceived to be rich, were left empty. Take notice that it was after Mary entered through doorway of Elizabeth's house and greeted Elizabeth that Elizabeth answered her greeting with the help of a supernatural intervention. Remember that the Angel Gabriel had given Mary a promise, and that was that Elizabeth, a woman in years, had conceived and would have a son. That was news not known, and the Lord had provided Mary the comfort support she needed of an older woman who could understand such a supernatural birth. Consider that Mary had to have been a troubled girl inside. Yes, she was excited, but the fear of being pregnant and of not knowing a man was surely going to test her. That was the wording of the question that she had asked of the Angel Gabriel. She had just become engaged and now she was pregnant in a supernatural way that hardly anyone would understand. Surely she must have also had deep concerns that Elizabeth would believe her story. After entering the house through the doorway and having Elizabeth receive her greeting in such a wondrous way, Mary, like Hannah, gives us a prophetic Word, and that prophetic Word is very much attuned to these Last Days we are now living in. Mary's prophetic Word relates to the Lord's warning of Revelation 3:16-22 wherein the Lord says that the rich are going to be made empty. The Lord is talking about those who believe that they are rich in knowledge, and yet they have missed the boat of knowledge. Mary had a child that was the Son of God, and she

knew that no one in all of Israel was expecting the child to come forth in this manner, even though His Words had disclosed it in Scriptures. It is the same today. Please meditate upon what Mary has prophesied.

☆ **Luke 1:39-55** ²⁶Now in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, ²⁷to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin's name was Mary. ²⁸**And having come in**, the angel said to her, "Rejoice, highly favored one, the Lord is with you (*Meaning the Word of God is with you*); blessed are you among women!" ²⁹But when she saw him, she was troubled at his saying, and considered what manner of greeting this was. ³⁰Then the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. ³¹And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name Jesus. ³²He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. ³³And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end." ³⁴Then Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I do not know a man?" ³⁵And the angel answered and said to her, "*The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God.* ³⁶Now indeed, Elizabeth your relative has also conceived a son in her old age; and this is now the sixth month for her who was called barren. ³⁷For with God nothing will be impossible." ³⁸Then Mary said, "Behold the maidservant of the Lord! Let it be to me according to your word." And the angel departed from her. ³⁹Now Mary arose in those days and went into the hill country with haste, to a city of Judah, ⁴⁰and **entered the house** of Zacharias and greeted Elizabeth. (*Take notice that Mary came through the Doorway, between the Doorposts of a house that was of a Rabbi, and then it was she Greeted Elizabeth, and the warm greeting that the troubled soul of Mary desired and badly needed, her request was answered by the Lord, for the Lord supernaturally caused the baby inside of Elizabeth to leap at the presence of the Son of God that was in Mary's belly, but do not miss the way of the Lord being answered for Mary, even if it was accidental on her part, as she was without knowledge of the Words of God at this time, as the Words were also not revealed to her until after the Lord returned from the Resurrection.*) ⁴¹And it happened, when Elizabeth heard the greeting of Mary that the babe leaped in her womb; and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit. ⁴²Then she spoke out with a loud voice and said, "Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb! ⁴³But why is this granted to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me? ⁴⁴For indeed, as soon as the voice of your greeting sounded in my ears, the babe leaped in my womb for joy. ⁴⁵Blessed is she who believed, for there will be a fulfillment of those things which were told her from the Lord." ⁴⁶And Mary said: "My soul magnifies the Lord, ⁴⁷and my spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior. ⁴⁸For He has regarded the lowly state of His maidservant; for behold, henceforth all generations will call me blessed. ⁴⁹For He who is mighty has done great things for me, and Holy is His name. ⁵⁰And His mercy is on those who fear Him from generation to generation. ⁵¹He has shown strength with His arm; He has scattered the proud in the imagination of their hearts. ⁵²He has put down the mighty from their thrones, and exalted the lowly. ⁵³**He has filled the hungry with Good things, and the rich He has sent away empty.** (*This is a prophetic praise song of Mary. Notice that she is saying that the Father is sending the rich away empty. The priests of that day, as they are in this day, have grown rich and they were seeking ways to increase the income that they were receiving, such as the merchants being allowed in the Temple Court. These priests did not receive of the Knowledge of God that would enable His Good Works to be done for them for the benefit of their congregations and to the Glory of the Lord. Instead they believed that they were rich in knowledge with a direct access to God; but they went away empty, even to be without the knowledge of His Word that makes them clean and gives them the unbreakable promise to be raised up into Eternal Life. Such is it going to be in this day. If the rich, and the preachers who are rich, do not turn, repent, and become zealous for increasing in the Knowledge of God that they might be able to teach His people His Words as He has commanded for them to do in these days, then they will be left empty at the Midnight Hour.*) ⁵⁴He has helped His servant Israel, in remembrance of His mercy, ⁵⁵as He spoke to our fathers, to Abraham and to his seed forever."

Hannah went forth in the way of Wisdom and God answered her request and did Good things for Israel. Hannah had great wisdom and sacrificed her own selfish desires to first bless God and she trusted in the Lord that He would bless her and her husband without doubting, so she never asked. For she had the promise of His double blessing of Jacob, and she did indeed receive the double blessing. Mary did not have the knowledge of God that Hannah had; but she had courage and faith. Mary heard the Word of God and immediately believed in His Word and went forth obediently with a joyous heart to perform what He had called her to do, even though it meant great risk and unknown things to her. Mary had great courage. What will you do with God's Words now that He has opened them? The future is not certain to you within the limitations of earthly wisdom, but the future is certain in God's Word that is established in heaven. Do you have the faith and the courage to follow His calling? Faith is grown by the increase in knowledge. If you do receive His Words and seek Knowledge of God from the Lord, then you will receive the understanding of what to do, just as Hannah did, and God gave to her more than she asked.

I encourage you to get the complete Writing on His Words, "*The Gift of God*", and study His Words carefully while seeking the Lord for revelation. You will find knowledge, if you place the Writings in front of the Lord and remind Him to keep His Word of Proverbs 1:23. For therein the Lord promised that if you will seek Him diligently that He will perform His Word by the way according to knowledge. Jesus warned us in Malachi 4:6 that if we fail to hear His Words and receive them gladly, then He shall come and strike the earth with a curse. Thus His invitation to partake of His food during this time of His Great Supper of abundance of the food of heaven is not something to take lightly. The Lord said that all those who reject of His invitation shall not partake of His food (*Luke 14:15-24*), and He told us that if we do not partake of His flesh then we shall also not find Eternal Life (*John 6:43-69*).

☆ **Malachi 4:4-6.** ⁴**Remember the Law of Moses** (*Deuteronomy 18:18-19; 6:4-9; and 11:18-21*), **My servant, which I commanded him in Horeb for all Israel, with the statutes and judgments.** ⁵**Behold, I will send you Elijah the**

prophet before the coming of the great and terrible day of the Lord. ⁶ He will turn the hearts of the fathers to their children and the hearts of the children to their fathers, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse (*This is as the Lord promised in Deuteronomy 18:18-19, that if we fail to hear His Words and receive them, then He will require it of us*).

There is another type of Door that reveals the promise of the Lord. The veil to the Temple was a door that separated the Holy of Holies from man. The High Priest of Israel went into the Holy of Holies once a year to offer the sacrifice for the sin of the people, and to receive the communication from the Lord. As was reviewed in the Writing of the Word of God that is "Flesh", at the death of Jesus the inner veil of the Temple was torn in two from the top to the bottom. This represented that the Lord Jesus had fulfilled all things and now the Words of God were opened to all the Jews who would hear the Words of Jesus, and then later they would be opened for all the Gentiles.

☆ **2 Corinthians 3:16-17** ¹⁶ Nevertheless when one turns to the Lord (*To actually hear His Words and to seek to understand His Good Works*), the veil is taken away. ¹⁷ Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is Liberty. (*Jesus said in John 15:3 that it is His Word sweeps us clean, and that is the meaning that it wipes away the sin, and gives us Eternal Life. For it is the receiving of the Spirit that profits a man, for it is the Spirit that raises us up to Eternal Life, and the Spirit is His Words, and His Words come with Eternal Life as a Promise of God. That is why the Lord says in John 6:63 that His Words are Spirit and they are Life*).

Note: The Lord reveals to us through His disciples and apostles that we have a veil over our eyes until we see that when Jesus died, that the veil of the Temple was torn in two from the top to the bottom so that we are able to come in and seek God to hear His Words. It seems that we think it was torn so that we can go into Him and ask for financial blessings of the things of this world, and we make a promise to give Him back a share of it. That is so foolish and limiting, when you consider that all things belong to God and that He has told us that it is His desire and requirement for us to seek knowledge of Him so that we are able to enable Him to do Good Works for others as we ask of Him, and then He will bless us with His favor, and He has far more knowledge and resources of how to bless us than we can even imagine. This is why the poor who have nothing are more apt to receive great blessings on this earth and in heaven, for they will come to God without the ability to give a financial seed, but they come with a pure heart that is truly seeking to gain knowledge of God's promises so that they can truly be able to enable the Father to do His Good Works for others. They are happy with whatever the Lord's favor is poured out upon them, and they place no preconceived prosperity limitations on the pouring out of God's favor

THE TORN VEIL GAVE WITNESS CHRIST DIED TO OPEN THE WORDS OF GOD

Jesus died in His earthly flesh upon the Cross so that He could fulfill all things that were written, and that He would be Worthy to return and give us the flesh of Heaven - the Words of His Father in which all things consist within His Promises that are in His Words, and that the Holy Spirit fulfills. By the tearing of the Temple Veil the Father shows to us that all things are fulfilled, and now all who diligently seek Him shall find Him. If we would have obeyed the Father to listen carefully to what Jesus said, and if we would have looked carefully upon the Works Jesus did, we would have found Him. **John 18:36-38** Jesus answered, "My Kingdom is not of this world." Pilate therefore said to Him, "Are you a King then?" Jesus answered, "You say rightly that I am a King. For this cause I was born, and for this cause I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the Truth. Everyone who is of the Truth hears my voice." Pilate said to Him, "What is Truth?" **John 8:31-32** Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My Word, you are My disciples indeed. And you shall know the Truth, and the Truth shall make you free." **2 Corinthians 3:16-17** Nevertheless when one turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away. The Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is Liberty. **1 John 5:6** And it is the Spirit who bears Witness, because the Spirit is Truth.

John 6:53-58 Then Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you. Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day. For My flesh is meat indeed, and My blood is drink indeed. He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him. As the living Father sent Me, and I live because of the Father, so he who feeds on Me will live because of Me. This is the bread which came down from heaven—not as your fathers ate the manna, and are dead. He who eats this bread will live forever." **John 6:62-63** What then if you should see the Son of Man ascend where He was before? It is the Spirit that gives Life, the flesh profits nothing. The Words that I speak to you are Spirit (*They are the Holy Spirit*), and they are Life."

John 3:34 "For He whom God has sent speaks the Words of God, for God does not give the Spirit by measure."

Luke 24:44-45 Then He said to them, "These are the Words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things must be fulfilled which were written in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms concerning Me." And He opened their understanding, that they might comprehend the Scriptures.

John 8:47 "He who is of God hears God's Words; therefore you do not hear, because you are not of God."

John 15:3 "You are already clean because of the Word which I have spoken to you."

John 20:21 Then Jesus said to them again, "Peace to you! As the Father sent Me, I also send you."

Mark 15:33-39 "Now when the sixth hour had come, there was darkness over the whole land until the ninth hour. And at the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?" which is translated, "My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?" "Some of those who stood by, when they heard that, said, "Look, He is calling for Elijah!" "Then someone ran and filled a sponge full of sour wine, put it on a reed, and offered it to Him to drink, saying, "Let Him alone; let us see if Elijah will come to take Him down." "And Jesus cried out with a loud voice, and breathed His last. Then the veil of the Temple was torn in two from top to bottom. So when the centurion, who stood opposite Him, saw that He cried out like this and breathed His last, he said, "Truly this Man was the Son of God!" **Matthew 27:51** And behold, the veil of the Temple was torn in two from top to bottom and the earth quaked and the rocks were split,

In Hebrews 10:20 the apostle Paul reveals that through His death upon the Cross, the Lord gained for us a new way of Life, and that is through offering to us of His flesh (*Our partaking of His flesh is the symbolic Opening of His Words, because by His Death He fulfilled all things and gained the authority to return and open for us the Words of God that are the Father, and the Lord says that the Father is greater than He, and because He went to the Father He obtained the Father for us within His Words*) that is the veil, or door that we come into the presence of the Father. Everyone remembers that the veil of the Temple was torn at the moment of His death on the Cross. It was the sign from the Father that Jesus had fulfilled all things and that now the Words of God would be opened to man. Remember that the priests pass through the veil that covered the door to the Holy of Holies and the veil would close behind them, and then the Father would reveal His instructions to the High Priest within the smoke rising from the incense. The High Priest would only go into the Holy Holies once a year, and to receive God's Word was a most sacred event. The Priests did not go into the Holy of Holies to ask of God, but to receive the Word from God. Thus the tearing of the veil of the Temple truly reveals that we are now able to go the Father to receive His Words; but we have not understood that there were Words of God to receive instruction of. The tearing of the Temple meant that the Lord had not approved the teachings of the Jewish Priests to their people, for they had not sought His Words, and therefore when they came into the Holy of Holies He had not been able to reveal to them all the things that He truly desired to reveal to them. Jesus said so much when He wept over the city and said that how often He had wanted to take them under His arms but they would not allow Him to do so. The veil represents the unsealing of the Words of God to the Jews, and now to us Gentiles. The veil is the opening of the Door to the Words of God, and since the Words of God are the Father, then it is that Jesus is that veil, for our Lord taught us that no man comes to the Father except through Jesus, so therefore Jesus is the veil that was torn for us. It is recorded in Luke 24:44-45 that He returned after the Resurrection and opened the Words of God to His Jewish followers.

☆ **Luke 24:44-45** ⁴⁴Then He said to them, "**These are the Words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things must be fulfilled which were written in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms concerning Me.**" ⁴⁵And He opened their understanding, that they might comprehend the Scriptures.

Please now consider the Door as the Lord refers to it within His instruction to us of how to pray. There are two major accounts of the Lord teaching the way to pray. The first is in Matthew 6:5-15 and this is during the Sermon on the Mount when He was teaching the multitudes. The second is found in Luke 11:1-4, and on this occasion He was teaching His disciples of how to pray. What is significant about this is that He gives the disciples – the preachers, if you will – and the multitudes of people the same instruction without differentiation. You may say that in Luke 11:1-4 that there is no mention of the instruction of the Lord to go into a room and shut the door, as there is such an instruction given in Matthew 6:5-15. But, in reality there is that instruction given, for in Luke 11:1 the disciples were waiting for the Lord to finish His prayers before they asked Him. Jesus wore a Jewish Prayer Shawl, and as mentioned previously, that is the tool that was given them by the Lord in Numbers 15:37-41 for their usage during the day when they were traveling, or when they were out in the field. The disciples would not interrupt the Lord for He was closed up with the prayer shawl pullet over top of Him while He prayed in secret to the Father behind the "Door" of the Prayer Shawl, with the Commands of the Lord upon the Tzitzis (*Tassels*) of the His Prayer Shawl, the same as His Words were to be on the Door Posts. So the prayer instructions are the same in Matthew 6:5-15 and Luke 11:1-4. If you will consider the Lord's command to give the people of Israel the Prayer Shawl, you will come to an interesting revelation. The Lord considered the Way of the Law of the Word "Door", and the placing of His Commands and Promises upon the Doorposts, as it is given to us in Deuteronomy 6:4-9 and Deuteronomy 11:18-21, so important, that He created a tool for the Israelites to utilize as they traveled, and they went about their work, and as they went into any building where the Words of God were not placed upon the Doorposts. The Law of the Father that is in the Promise of God that He has placed within the Word "Door" is so important that the Father wants us to always have it to be near. For the Word "Door" is the answer to bring you back to the basic principles of deliverance from the way of sin. Jesus told Cain that if you do not always diligently seek to do His Way of Good, then sin lies at the Door waiting to snare you (*Genesis 4:1-15*). We will consider this situation with Cain after we have more closely reviewed the Lord's Prayer. The Lord did not need to review the instruction of telling the Disciples to enter into their Room of the Prayer Shawl because He was doing it before them as a Witness and Testimony of this Way that He prays, and they were asking Him to teach them to pray in like manner to Him.

Our Lord was the wisest man to ever walk the earth, and it was He who gave us the instruction of how to pray, but nearly no one actually listens to Him, and we do not see the supernatural power of the Promise of God in the Word of God that is "Door" by which the Lord prefaces His instruction of doing this prayer that is called the Lord's Prayer. This prayer is given as an instruction from the Lord for the way by which we are to pray. Consider that Jesus, the teacher of the Words and the way to do the Words, is the One who gave us the Lord's Prayer. We therefore should be careful to understand that the Lord does not tell us just what to say when we pray, but what we are to do, and also we need to discern why we are to do it the Way that He has instructed. Therefore we can know that the Lord's use of a room and a Door with the posts of a Door is as important as the actual Words that we speak, for the Words coincide with the Way of God in that Word of God by which we are utilizing to come before Him to ask of Him what we desire. Remember that God is always looking down from heaven to see if we understand and if we are seeking to do the Way of His Good. When we are asking in our prayer for things to be done for others, as we should be asking for that is the

desire of God for us to do, and it is His Will for us to do; then we will always come into a room. In the Lord's Prayer we are asking for God's Will to be done for all people. Consider that Hannah went to the Doorposts because she was making a pleading of a Supernatural Act of God based upon a Promise she was giving to the Lord. In the Lord's Prayer we are not making a Covenant with God, so it is not the Way to go and make your plea to the Doorpost. In the Lord's Prayer we are seeking instruction and we are following Instruction for others and ourselves. This is differentiated for example from Martin Luther. The Spirit of the Lord gave him divine guidance and he penned the 95 Theses and placed them on the Door of the Church at Wittenberg, Germany. Even though it is not possible that Martin Luther understood the promises of God in the Word "Door", the Spirit of God seems to have led him to post the 95 Thesis on the Door. This act enabled the Father to cause the Reformation to break out as a result of those Writings.

We should also remember that there are Angels specifically assigned to watch over the Words of God, and that includes actions of doing the ways of the promises that are in the Words of God. The Lord opened His Words and the Understanding of the Scriptures to the disciple John, as is testified to by the apostle Luke as is recorded in Luke 24:44-45. In Revelation 22:6-11 we are given evidence that the angels are always present when we go into our prayer room and shut the door. For they are always present to watch over the doing of the Words of God. Also notice that the Angel tells John that those who keep His Words are "fellow servants" with the angels. Notice in verse 9, the Angel also reveals that the brethren who kept the Words of God that tell of prophecy that are revealed within the Bible are to be called as Prophets, for the Lord and the Angels call them "Holy Prophets", meaning that the Father has set them apart by the knowledge of the Word of Truth at the request of the Lord; and the Father has granted this gift of discernment to them at the request of the Lord, as is recorded in John 17:17-22. We should have confidence that when we do the Way of the Words of God that we are both seen in heaven by the Father, and that we are also seen by the Angels whose charge it is to watch over His Words. Thus, when we pray in the manner of the instruction that is given to us by the Lord in the Lord's Prayer, then we are bringing ourselves into compliance with the desire of the Father and within the assistance of His most powerful Holy Angels whose task it is to protect the Words of the Promises of God that are the same Word as the Words of the Prophecy of the Bible.

- ☆ **Revelation 22:6-10** ⁶Then he said to me, "These words *are* faithful and true." And the Lord God of the holy prophets (*Prophets who are Set Apart to receive His Words, for in John 17:17 the Lord asked the Father to set them apart by His Truth, and His Truth is the Words of God*) sent His angel to show His servants the things which must shortly take place. ⁷"Behold, I am coming quickly! Blessed *is* he who keeps the Words of the Prophecy of this Book." ⁸Now I, John, saw and heard these things. And when I heard and saw, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel who showed me these things. ⁹Then he said to me, "See *that you do not do that*. **For I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren the prophets, and of those who keep the words of this book. Worship God.**" ¹⁰And he said to me, "Do not seal the words of the prophecy of this book, for the time is at hand. ¹¹He who is unjust, let him be unjust still; he who is filthy, let him be filthy still; he who is righteous, let him be righteous still; he who is holy, let him be holy still."
- ☆ **John 17:9-26** ⁹"I pray for them. I do not pray for the world but for those whom You have given Me, for they are Yours. ¹⁰And all Mine are Yours, and Yours are Mine, and I am glorified in them. ¹¹Now I am no longer in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to You. Holy Father, keep through Your name those whom You have given Me, that they may be one as We are. ¹²While I was with them in the world, I kept them in Your name. Those whom You gave Me I have kept; and none of them is lost except the son of perdition, that the Scripture might be fulfilled. ¹³But now I come to You, and these things I speak in the world, that they may have My joy fulfilled in themselves. ¹⁴**I have given them Your Word (He showed them the Way and He told them that after He had died and the Spirit of Truth had come, that He would bring all things back to their remembrance again, because they could not comprehend His Words while He was with them. Remember that Jesus spoke and taught the Words in parables while He was on earth, because when He opened them to them, as is recorded in Luke 214:44-45, He told them that these are the Words that He had spoken while He had been with them);** and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. ¹⁵I do not pray that You should take them out of the world, but that You should keep them from the evil one. ¹⁶They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. ¹⁷**Sanctify them by Your truth. Your Word is truth.** ¹⁸**As You sent Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world (The Father sent Jesus into the Word speaking the Words of God – Deuteronomy 18:18-19 and John 3:34).** ¹⁹**And for their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also may be sanctified by the truth. (Take notice that Jesus said that He was set apart by the Truth, and that the truth is the Words of god, so He is holy being set apart by the sacred Words of God, and we are also to be set apart as holy by His Words, thus it will be when we are sealed at the Midnight Hour).** ²⁰"I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their Word (*They will speak the Words of God*); ²¹that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me. ²²And the Glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one: ²³I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me. ²⁴"Father, I desire that they also whom You gave Me may be with Me where I am, that they may behold My glory which You have given Me; for You loved Me before the foundation of the world. ²⁵O righteous Father! The world has not known You, but I have known You; and these have known that You sent Me. ²⁶And I have declared to them Your name, and will declare *it*, that the love with which You loved Me may be in them, and I in them."

It is likely that we have all prayed the Lord's Prayer hundreds and even thousands of times; yet we need to consider carefully the Lord's instruction of how we are to offer this prayer to the Lord. The Lord instructs us to go into our room and shut the Door. If we have paid attention to the Lord, then we should understand that His Words were to be

written upon the Doorpost of our Door, and as we pass through it and shut the Door, we are doing the Way of the Word "Door", and we are enabling the Father to do a Good Work for us and for those for whom we pray. The reason is that by doing the Way of His Word we have enabled the Promise of the Father to be enabled that is within His Word "Door". We will review the Promise of the Word "Door" later, but for now please consider that the Lord has commanded us to put His Words as a remembrance upon our Doorposts. The God of All Things is a just and righteous God, and remembrance always goes two ways with the Father. When we seek to do His Ways of Righteousness, He will always honor our remembrance and He will also always do the Promise that He has given us. Therefore, as an example, there is no better prayer or repentance that is possible for us to offer to the Father than that which is given to us by His Son. If we do what we are instructed, and we say the Lord's prayer and its simple line regarding repentance, then we can know for certain that our sins are forgiven us. This is especially true in these days when there no longer remains a sacrificial covering for willful sins. Thus, doing the Way of entering our prayer room, closing the Door, and saying the Lord's prayer with a sincere and wise heart, then we are actually giving the greatest of praise that we could offer our Lord, and we are doing the fulfillment of Hosea 6:6 and Micah 6:8.

- ☆ **Matthew 6:5-15** ⁵"And when you pray, you shall not be like the hypocrites. For they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the corners of the streets, that they may be seen by men. Assuredly, I say to you, they have their reward. ⁶But you, when you pray, go into your room, **AND WHEN YOU HAVE SHUT YOUR DOOR**, pray to your Father who *is* in the secret *place*; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly. (*Remember that in Psalm 14:2-3 and 53:2-3, we are told that God is always looking to down to see if anyone Understands, to see if anyone does Good, but David says that not one does because they have not understood His Words*). ⁷And when you pray, do not use vain repetitions as the heathen do. (*The Father is more satisfied by your doing the way of His Words than by your many great words and pleadings for forgiveness – Hosea 6:6, Micah 6:8*). For they think that they will be heard for their many words. ⁸"Therefore do not be like them. For your Father knows the things you have need of before you ask Him. ⁹In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. ¹⁰Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. ¹¹Give us this day our daily bread. ¹²**And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.** ¹³And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen. ¹⁴For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. ¹⁵But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses."
- ☆ **Luke 11:1-4** ¹Now it came to pass, as He was praying in a certain place, when He ceased, *that* one of His disciples said to Him, "Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples." ²So He said to them, "When you pray, say: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as *it is* in heaven. ³Give us day by day our daily bread. ⁴And forgive us our sins, for we also forgive everyone who is indebted to us. And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one."

If we are desiring forgiveness from the Lord, there is no reason for us to offer long cries of repentance. For by doing the way of the Words of the Lord in following the easy instruction, the light yoke, that the Lord has given us, we have actually done for the Lord what He desires more from us than sacrifices of repentance. It is not wrong to weep in repentance, but consider Mary when she came and she washed His feet with her tears and dried them with her hair, and poured perfume on His feet. The Lord made it clear that what she was doing was following the Way of doing Good for others, and that was more desired by God than any pleas and words of repentance that she could have spoken. The words of verse 12 of the Lord's Prayer contains the only Words needed to be said to be forgiven for any sin we may have committed. God desires for us to seek to do Good Deeds more than sacrifices of words. the entire basis of God's plan for us is indeed a very light yoke. He requires only that we diligently seek to increase in knowledge so that we are able to do Good Works for others. If we try to do this, it is enough. The Lord never rejected Cain's efforts to do Good. In God's eyes they both merited the gift of Eternal Life. It was the complacency and lazy factor that hit Cain, and caused his jealousy. We are all one family and one team. As long as we are all trying to increase in knowledge of God and to do good them there is not one of us better than the other. The Father may give us greater rewards, but that is His choice as a Father for what He has planned for that person to do for Him. But, we are all going to receive a mansion in heaven in streets of Gold, and we will all eat at the same table. I often pray just to overcome and get there. I would clean waste in heaven rather than spend at least the next 1,000 years being chained inside of the body of a slithering man-sized worm, and being chased by great beasts that desire to eat my worm body as their food. I would give all I have to get to heaven, or to get my children to heaven. I write these Writings at the consternation of others and at risk of significant repercussion because I desire to do Good for others and at least try to get them to look into His Words in the Bible and to plead for them to ask the Lord for understanding with an open heart to hear Him. That is all that our God desires any of us to do. His prayers are not complicated. His Way is easy, and His task is light. But it does take diligence of heart, and it requires that we trust in Him in the Promises that He has placed within each of His Words.

- ☆ **Hosea 6:6** ⁶For I desire "Good Deeds" and not sacrifice, and the "knowledge of God" more than burnt offerings.
- ☆ **Micah 6:8** ⁸He has shown you, O man, what *is* Good; and **WHAT DOES THE LORD REQUIRE OF YOU BUT TO DO JUSTLY, TO LOVE GOOD DEEDS, AND TO WALK HUMBLY WITH YOUR GOD?**
- ☆ **Psalm 14:2-3, & Psalm 53:2-3** ²The Lord looks down from Heaven upon the children of men, **to see if there are any who understand, WHO SEEK GOD.** ³They have all turned aside, they have together become corrupt; **there is none that does "GOOD", no, not one.**

If we taught sinners the way to say this simple prayer, we would do more for the Kingdom of God than in all the years since the apostles. Remember that Jesus was wiser than Solomon, and He was sent by God to speak His Words and to do those things that God directed Him. Jesus said that He saw these things done in heaven before He told them to us. Should we then not do His prayer in the way that He has instructed us to do it? We have not believed His Words, and it is natural that we also have not believed His instructions on how we are to pray, possibly because it may have likely seemed to be just to simple for us to believe in it. In truth, there is no church service that should not begin with the closing of the doors and the praying of the Lord's Prayer. Consider wisely this: Is the wisdom of our pastors greater than that of the Lord's? It is better to enter into a service seeking to follow the teaching of His way to ask for the knowledge of His Kingdom – His Words – to come down upon us, so that we can understand how to do Good and His Will for us to do Good. That is what any church gathering is supposed to be utilized for. Remember that the Lord has said that the Preachers are to teach His Words on the Sabbath Day, but they will not even hear Him. Why would you not read Psalm 119:130 and come up with any other explanation than that is the key to understanding the way to gain in the knowledge of God? Then why would preachers not teach His Words on His Sabbath Day if that is the Day proclaimed by the Lord that He would give Rest to those who believe on Him? If we do not believe in His instruction, then how are we going to receive Rest on His Sabbath Day? Rest is peace, it is financial favor, it is wisdom, it is answers to needs, and it is answers to healing. Clearly, from Psalm 119:130 we can see that we are not going to receive that Rest unless His Words are being taught on His Sabbath Day for they are the Key to unlock the Understanding of Rest.

- ☆ **Psalm 119:130** The Entrance of Your Words Gives Light; It gives Understanding to the Simple.
- ☆ **Proverbs 1:23** Turn at My reproof; Surely I will pour out My Spirit on you; I will make My Words known to you.
- ☆ **Proverbs 19:8** He who gets Wisdom loves his own soul; he who keeps Understanding will find Good.
- ☆ **Proverbs 11:27** He who diligently seeks "Good" finds favor.

In the instruction of the Lord in regard to the Lord's Prayer He warns us against "vain babblings". The Lord gives us the recipe in the Lord's Prayer for the all the things that are important for us to obtain and to prayer for that would solve our issues. If His Kingdom comes, meaning that if His Words come, and they are done on earth by His people as they are done in heaven by the angels and those who are in Paradise (*As Paul reveals in 2 Corinthians 12:1-4*), then it would be staggering as to the supernatural miracles that would occur in this nation. The Lord is setting there saying that for so long He has wanted to take us in and to shelter us in His Words, but we have refused to hear Him. It is amazing that even though the people of Israel rejected His Words and they rejected increasing in knowledge, that the Lord so Mercifully gave them instructions of how to pray in a way that would have them doing the way of His Words even without their knowledge. The people had no idea that they were enabling the Promises of God that are in His Words when they enter into the Prayer Room and close the Door. The Lord gave us an instruction a Way of doing His Good that is hard for us to mess up even without knowledge. I am sure that many miracles that have occurred through the years have occurred because we have followed in the Way of His Word that He provided us in a parable within His instruction, even though we did it not according to knowledge of His Words. Praise God for the Mercy of our Lord, that He helps the simple and the foolish, even though they do not have wisdom and understanding.

Let us consider another interesting utilization of God's Word Door. In Genesis 4:1-15, we see the communication between Cain and the Lord in regard to the doing of Good Works. In verse 7 the Lord utilizes the word "Door" when discussing His Law relating to His promise that is within His Word "Good" with Cain. The Lord is saying to Cain that all of those who diligently seek to do the way of His Good will find favor with Him, just as it is confirmed to us in Proverbs 11:27. (*I have explained His Word "Good" in the Writing, "The Word of God: Good"*). The Lord is explaining to us within Genesis 4:7 that if we do not make the effort to receive His Words and to diligently seek to increase in the knowledge of God so that we are able to do enable the Good Works of the Lord to be done for us, then we are in fact giving authority for sin to get into our lives. If you will carefully meditate upon this teaching of the Lord, you will find great wisdom. I believe that a 24 hour sermon could easily be preached upon this single verse of this revelation from God as recorded in Genesis 4:1-15.

- ☆ **Proverbs 11:27** He who diligently seeks "Good" finds favor.
- ☆ **Proverbs 12:8** A man will be commended according to His knowledge.
- ☆ **Proverbs 9:10** Understanding of the Holy One is knowledge.
- ☆ **Proverbs 19:8** He who gets Wisdom loves his own soul; he who keeps Understanding will find Good.
- ☆ **Genesis 4:1-15** ¹Now Adam knew Eve his wife, and she conceived and bore Cain, and said, "I have acquired a man from the Lord." ²Then she bore again, this time his brother Abel. Now Abel was a keeper of sheep, but Cain was a tiller of the ground. ³And in the process of time it came to pass that Cain brought an offering of the fruit of the ground to the Lord. ⁴Abel also brought of the firstborn of his flock and of their fat. And the Lord respected Abel and his offering, ⁵but He did not respect Cain and his offering. And Cain was very angry, and his countenance fell. ⁶So the Lord said to Cain, "Why are you angry? And why has your countenance fallen?" ⁷**If you do Good, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do Good, sin lies at the door.** (*Take notice that the Hebrew word of "yatab" is used here, and many Bible's translate this word as "well", but it also means "to do Good". In this case it should be translated as "to do Good" and not "to do well". The reason is that Adam and Eve had taught Cain the knowledge of Good and Evil. Remember that Adam and Eve had*

received the knowledge of Good and Evil, and that means that they had learned the ways of God's Words and how to seek knowledge from the Lord of how to do the way of His Words so as to be able to enable the Promises of the Father to do Good Works for them as they desire. Both Cain and Able were taught the ways of enabling God's Good Works. Clearly, Able had been more diligent in seeking instruction of knowledge from the Lord, for Able was trying to do what was a greater pleasing for the Lord. Able was doing for others and not focused on doing for himself. Take notice that it is God who is telling us that Cain knew the way of doing Good Works. That tells you that God's Law of teaching His Words to our children began with Adam and Eve. This is the Law of Deuteronomy 6:4-9, 11:18-21. In this Scripture we are also shown that the children did different works because it is the way of the Lord that all of us strive to enable His Good Works to be done for others. The children of Adam and Eve thus picked different works. The Lord is saying that both men are striving to enable Him to do Good Works for them, and that both of their efforts are acceptable to Him. It also shows that the more diligent we are to seek the knowledge of the ways of God's Words unlocks greater favor from God. It also shows that you can lose all that you do achieve if you become jealous of another's Works. God rewards us with His favor based upon our diligence to increase in the knowledge of Him. In today's world we see a few of those chasing after the prosperity message who are prospering, but they are ignoring God's numerous prophetic warnings that this is not what He desires, and that He is going to cause it to come crashing down, and He is going to cast those people out into the troubles of the wilderness just like he did Cain, but because they lack any effort to increase in the knowledge of His Good, they will not have a seal upon them as God put on Cain. If Cain lived in these days he would still be counted among the raptured even though he may not prosper in the time of the Night; however he would be kept safe and secure during the time of the Night because of the Seal of God. The Lord is showing us that our hearts matter most. Our works are important as they are rewarded, but it is not our works in Life that give us Eternal Life. It is our desire to increase in the Knowledge of God and that our heart is set upon seeking to do Good). And its (sins) desire is for you, but you should rule over it." ⁸ Now Cain talked with Abel his brother; and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother and killed him. ⁹ Then the Lord said to Cain, "Where is Abel your brother?" He said, "I do not know. Am I my brother's keeper?" ¹⁰ And He said, "What have you done? The voice of your brother's blood cries out to Me from the ground. ¹¹ So now you are cursed from the earth, which has opened its mouth to receive your brother's blood from your hand. ¹² When you till the ground, it shall no longer yield its strength to you. A fugitive and a vagabond you shall be on the earth." ¹³ And Cain said to the Lord, "My punishment is greater than I can bear! ¹⁴ Surely You have driven me out this day from the face of the ground; I shall be hidden from Your face; I shall be a fugitive and a vagabond on the earth, and it will happen that anyone who finds me will kill me." (This verse indicates that Cain was afraid of those from his family. If there were other people upon the earth, and they met him without a mark upon him, they were not likely to kill Cain. His family would. It takes those of His family who know the Words of God and the way of the Lord to see a mark and to know that He is not to be touched. The Father surely placed a symbol of one of His Words upon Cain that those children of Adam and Eve would know that God's hand is upon Cain. Since all of Adam and Eve's children would have known Good and Evil, the mark God placed upon Cain had to be of the Words of His Good Works. This verse also shows that Cain had repented, because it shows knowledge that Cain was dependent upon God for keeping him safe. For only children of Adam and Eve and their descendants would want Cain dead. This gives us our best understanding that there were not other people on the earth in the days of Adam and Eve, and that all people came forth from them. I believe that the Lord placed a cube upon Cain, or possibly a Rainbow. Most likely it was a cube to show that Cain was a thing of God's and that he was set apart as holy, even though under punishment while he lived. I believe that Cain was forgiven at this very moment because he sought Good in the way of healing from God, and he was also basically saying that he would not fight against others, even if they tried to kill him. Remember that Cain and Able knew God's way of Evil, and they would have known that it the will of the Lord that evil men are to be stamped. We in our day are going to see this come to its fruition, for at the return of the Lord in 2028, the Lord will stamp out all evil men from the earth. So Cain knew that the first person that saw him would kill him. Cain had not yet experienced how complacent men become. He was of the first generation, of Adam and Eve and already he had been complacent towards God's laws, even though he had been taught the ways of Good and of Evil). ¹⁵ And the Lord said to him, "Therefore, whoever kills Cain, vengeance shall be taken on him sevenfold." And the Lord set a mark on Cain, lest anyone finding him should kill him.

The posts of the Door, or also called as doorposts, surround the Door. On those doorposts is to be represented the Words of God. The doorposts are never moving, like promises that are forever. The Door is the active part that you are continually going in through and going out of. Jesus said that He is the Door, and that is because only the Lord is able to pour out His Spirit upon us that makes His Words known to us – Proverbs 1:23, John 16:13. Sin cannot enter into a house through the Door unless you carry it in. This is why the anointing of all your Doorposts and Doors in your house is a very "Good" work to do. In doing so you are giving glory and honor to the Way of the promises of God that are in His Word "Door". In Genesis 4:7 the Lord is saying that sin waits outside the Door to see if you are diligently focused on the Words of God and in increasing in the knowledge of God. As long as you are so diligently focused, sin has no authority to enter. Cain took his eyes off the focus of seeking the Lord for knowledge of how to better able to enable the Good Works of the Father to be done, and he focused them on the obtainment of greater status. That is the way of the world. When he took His eyes off of the seeking the Lord for instruction, and set them upon the reward given to his brother, then he fell away from seeking God. Like his mother, Cain was looking for the short cut to knowledge and the favor of God. Knowledge of Good, and the resultant favor of God that is eternal favor, comes from diligently seeking after the Lord to pour out His Spirit upon us so that His Words are made known to us – Proverbs 1:23. There is no shortcut. There is not a magical one-page or 40-page short form method. To be a leader in the way of His Words requires commitment to seeking Him continuously in the day. If you read carefully Deuteronomy 6:4-9 and Deuteronomy 11:18-21 you will see that the Lord says that the seeking of His knowledge that enables His Good to be done, and favor to be gained, has to be done continuously throughout the day. Eternal Life is received

differently than Good Works. Eternal Life is freely given with the hearing of the Words of God and the change of the heart to begin to seek Good. With good Works there are rewards and favor from God. But, the Bible reveals that there are no true shortcuts to increasing in the knowledge of His Words other than the commitment level of the heart that is applied. I believe that it is genuinely possible for one to learn faster than another, but if we study any case I believe that it will come around to the commitment level of the heart towards hearing God's Word. The Lord's instruction of Deuteronomy 6:6-9, 11:18-21 requires that it is doing with a diligent effort. Please take notice that the Lord's command is that we are to do this diligently and continuously. It is a 24-hours a day instruction. It is obvious from the lives of Adam and Cain as to which one was doing this diligently, and which one rather wanted to be complacent in seeking knowledge.

- ☆ **Deuteronomy 6:4-9** ⁶ **And these Words which I command you this day shall be upon your heart; ⁷ and you shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. ⁸ And you shall bind them as a sign upon your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. ⁹ AND YOU SHALL WRITE THEM ON THE DOORPOSTS OF YOUR HOUSE and on your gates."**
- ☆ **Deuteronomy 11:18-21** ¹⁸ **Therefore you shall lay up these Words of Mine in your heart and in your soul, and bind them in your heart and in your soul, and bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. ¹⁹ You shall teach them to your children, speaking of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. ²⁰ AND YOU SHALL WRITE THEM ON THE DOORPOSTS OF YOUR HOUSE and on your gates.**

We are now in the days of the Seal Judgments. We are in the days when knowledge of His Words is available in abundance. We are in the days when the Lord is looking down from heaven ready to pour out His Spirit abundantly on those who seek knowledge. The Lord has invited you to His Great Supper in this the Time of the Evening of the Day the Lord, and He has placed a Silver Cup in front of you that will supernaturally turn into a Golden Gold if you drink from it diligently. But will you? Our eyes are not focused on God or in hearing His Words. We are not focused on believing Him so that we can learn Good. We are not even capable of understanding the way of Good as sufficiently as Cain understood. So if Cain fell to the sin that was at his door and He knew the way to find Good, what will happen to all of those who have not even heard His Words and have no knowledge of Good? The Lord has said in Proverbs 1:23-33 that in their days of trouble that come at the Midnight Hour, and because they rejected to receive nay of His knowledge when it was offered, that He will not show them the Mercy that He showed Cain, and He will not place His Seal upon them to keep them safe and secure in the coming Time of the Night. In the Time of the Night, unless you are sealed by God, those days will see all those of the world, except the very few protected by the world system, faced with bankruptcy, loss of home, loss of freedom, and the death of more than one-fourth of all those on earth, and that number is after the Lord destroys the armies that come against Israel just prior to the Midnight Hour.

- ☆ **Hosea 4:6** **"MY PEOPLE ARE DESTROYED FOR LACK OF KNOWLEDGE. Because you have rejected knowledge, I also will reject you from being a priest before Me, because you have forgotten the law of your God I also will forget your children."**
- ☆ **Proverbs 1:20-33** ²⁰ **Wisdom (*The Words of God that are our Helper, and that Jesus is calling out to us*) calls aloud outside (*of the city of the world*); she raises Her voice in the open squares. ²¹ She cries out in the chief concourses (*The Chief Doorways, Entranceways*), at the openings of the gates in the city She speaks Her Words (*The Words of God, that are also called the "Truth"*). ²² How long you simple (*naïve*) ones, will you love simplicity (*naïvety*)? For scorers delight in scorning, and fools hate knowledge. ²³ Turn at My reproof: Surely I will pour out My Spirit on you. I will make My Words known to you (*This has always been available to us, yet we failed to seek His Words and the understanding of the way of His "Good" Works*). ²⁴ Because I have called and you refused. I have stretched out My hand and no one regarded (*This is a warning that we should not reject His Knowledge of Truth – His Words - when they are opened to us. He made it a Law in Deuteronomy 18:18-19 and we should listen because we are going to be judged by our obedience in Hearing Him*). ²⁵ **Because you disdained all My counsel, and would have none of My reproof,** ²⁶ **I also will laugh at your calamity; I will mock when your terror comes. ²⁷ When your terror comes like a storm, and your destruction comes like a whirlwind. When distress and anguish come upon you. ²⁸ Then they will call upon Me, BUT I WILL NOT ANSWER; they will seek Me diligently, but they will not find Me. ²⁹ Because they hated knowledge,** and did not choose the fear of the Lord, ³⁰ **they would have none of My counsel, and would have none of My reproof. ³¹ THEREFORE they shall eat the fruit of their own way, and be filled to the full with their own fancies. ³² For the turning away of the simple will slay them, and the complacency of fools will destroy them. (*Those who reject His Knowledge in these days when the Lord has opened the Words of His promises to them, as per Hosea 4:6, will be destroyed, and God will allow them to suffer the troubles of the 3rd, 4th and 5th Seal Judgments in the Time of the Night, while He keeps all those who received His Words safe and secure; as He will not allow His oil and wine to be troubled*). ³³ **BUT WHOEVER LISTENS TO ME WILL DWELL SAFELY, AND WILL BE SECURE (AT EASE) WITHOUT FEAR OF EVIL (*Please understand that this is great news revealed to you from God. For God is offering to you that if you turn, repent, and change, and if you pray to Him to change the nation, then during these coming times of trouble of the 3rd through the 5th Seal Judgments, that you will be kept safe and secure and you will be raptured with the Saints in the time of the 6th Seal Judgment*).******

If we are going to enter into the Door of Jesus that gives us Understanding and makes known His Words to us, then we have to love Jesus. For the Lord says that only if we Love Him will He and the Father come in and make their home within us. The Father is His Words, for the Lord Jesus revealed in John 6:63 that His Words are Spirit and they

are Life. Thus, we must come to understand and to love His Words, and that Jesus is the key to the Father's House. Jesus makes it clear in John 14:23-24, that even though you may think you love the Lord, you do not love Him if you do not hear His Words (*Such as did Saul before he was made wise and became Paul*). The Lord says clearly in John 14:23-24 that you are not able to love God if you do not hear His Words, receive them, and keep them (*This means that you become doers of His Words as is instructed by James 1:22*). If you do not hear His Words then you have not obtained Understanding and the knowledge of God. Many of His present day Preachers, Ministers, Priests, Bishops, Evangelists, Prophets, Theologians, Bible Scholars, Bible Teachers, and Rabbis, are quick to condemn the Priests, Pharisees, and Scribes of Israel of in the days of Jesus, and do not understand that they have been found to be just like them. That is why Jesus prophesied that the Day of the Lord that has now come upon the world, would come as a snare to ALL THE PEOPLE ON THE FACE OF THE WHOLE EARTH, and that certainly includes all His Preachers, Ministers, Priests, Bishops, Evangelists, Prophets, Theologians, Bible Scholars, Bible Teachers, and Rabbis.

☆ **John 14:23-24**^{23a} Jesus answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My Word; and the Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him. ²⁴**HE WHO DOES NOT LOVE ME DOES NOT KEEP MY WORDS; and the Word which you hear is not Mine but the Father's who sent Me."**

JESUS CHRIST HOLDS THE KEY TO THE HOUSE OF DAVID

In Deuteronomy 18:18-19 our Father who are in heaven promised that He would send Jesus into the world to speak His Words and to do those things that the Father would tell Him to do: The Father also promised that He would give to our Lord Jesus Christ, the keys to the house of David. The keys of a house open the Doors to the house. Thus the Messiah shall be known by being the One to have the keys to the Doors of the house of David. But what are the keys to the Doors of the House of David, and what is the House of David? Since all of Creation is made by the spoken Word of God, then the keys to the Doors to the House of David are the Words of God that the Father sent His Son into the world to open. The Lord has now opened His Words to all the Gentiles. These Words are the keys to the House of David. The Lord closed the Words in Daniel 12:4, and no one could open them. In Daniel 12:4 the Lord says that the Words will be opened at the Time of the End. He opened them to the Jews after His return following His Resurrection (Luke 24:44-45); now He has opened them to the Gentiles. Those who receive His Words are grafted into the House of David. His Words are alive, and the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit now make their home inside those who receive His Words, thus, Jesus has returned in Flesh.

Deuteronomy 18:18-19 "I will raise up for them a Prophet (Jesus) like you (Moses, the Law Giver) from among their brethren, and will put My Words in His mouth, and He shall speak to them all that I command Him. 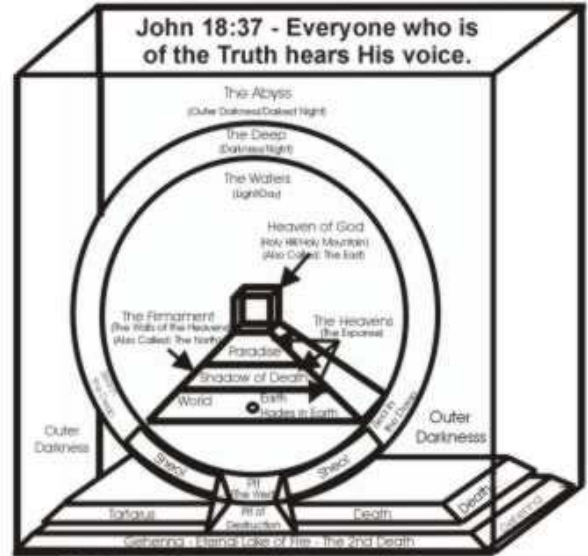

The Bible Reveals that all God Works are Truth & are in Truth
Daniel 4:37 for all His works are Truth, and His Ways are Justice.
Psalms 33:4 For the Word of the Lord is right, and all His works are in Truth.

In the book of Revelation the Lord uses the Word "Door" in two of the seven letters to the churches. To the Church of Philadelphia in Revelation 3:7-13, the Lord proclaims that He has placed an open door in front of them. He has opened the door to let anyone in who will come and feed on His Words. The open door reveals that on the doorposts, in accordance to the Law of God revealed in Deuteronomy 6:4-9 and Deuteronomy 11:18-21, the Lord would have placed the Words of God so that all of the people know the way of the Promises of God, and in the letter to the Church of Philadelphia the Lord reveals that to all those who come in His door they have the promise that they will be kept safe and secure in the time of the troubles to come.

In Revelation 3:14-22, in His letter to the Church of Laodicea, the Lord proclaims that He is standing outside the Door and knocking, and that He is speaking His Words and no one is hearing His voice, and no one is interesting in eating the food that He has prepared for them to dine with Him. How sad a picture is revealed in Revelation 3:14-22, as the Lord, our Door to the supernatural Words of God, is standing outside the Door of each of the people of that Church, speaking forth the salvation Words of His Father, and wanting to come in, yet they have removed from Him the access of the handle to their door? His Words are not written on their doorposts, or a handle would have been found because those who have received His Words already have heard His voice speaking His Words as they are heard in heaven, and their Door has been opened so that they could receive His heavenly Words inside their heart.



☆ **Revelation 3:14-22** ¹⁴"And to the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write, 'These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God: ¹⁵"I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot. I could wish you were cold or hot. ¹⁶So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spew you out of My mouth. ¹⁷**Because you say, 'I am rich, have become wealthy, and have need of nothing' -- and do not know that you are wretched, miserable,**

poor, blind, and naked – ¹⁸I counsel you (*warn you*) to buy from Me gold refined in the fire, that you may be rich; and white garments, that you may be clothed, that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed; and anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see. ¹⁹As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. Therefore be zealous and repent. ²⁰Behold, I stand at the DOOR and knock. If anyone hears My voice AND OPENS THE DOOR, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me. (*The Lord is saying that He is there, and notice that the Door is closed. The promises of the Words of God are always available at the posts of our Door if we will seek them. The Door is the Lord Jesus, and He is the one who gives us instruction and opens the teaching to us of His Words. The reason the Door is closed is that the people inside have not received His Words, and therefore they have not bothered to open the Door to the Lord to seek the Knowledge of the Truth that is also known as the Knowledge of His Words. The Lord is saying that these people have been given their invitation to His Great Supper where the Food of Heaven is being poured out in abundance; but they have not answered the Lord, and they do not know that the Midnight Hour is coming at which time they will be left unsealed, and therefore they will be cast out into the Outer Darkness upon their earthly death. It is important to notice that this church is not going to receive the Knowledge of the Words later. The Lord says that if they reject Him, that at the Midnight Hour they are going to be cast out forever. This means that these people are the wealthy who have had the best of everything, and they have believed that they are spirit-filled, but the Lord says that they are actually rebellious against Him*). ²¹To him who overcomes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne. ²²He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.”

The Laodiceans' Church has a door that is closed to their salvation because they thought they were wise and that they were rich in the knowledge of God and wealthy being Spirit-filled. Yet they do not even know that there is no handle upon the outside of their door. It is a church that does not have His Words written upon their doorposts. Thus, it is a church that is disobedient to God, and they do not know the Way to the only Door that will get them into heaven.

Let us consider each of these seven churches in order by considering the Words of God and how His Words apply to each of these churches. After we review these churches then we will summarize this information of these churches in a chart. This should enable us to understand what the Lord is saying in regard to these churches and give us greater insight as to what it means to us who live in these years of the Day of the Lord.

First we must consider that there are a few things that are common to each of the Lord's letters to these churches. The first of which is that the Lord is addressing these letters to the angel of each of these churches, and not to the people of these churches. This reveals that the Lord has assigned an angel to each of the churches, and that He is giving to each angel an instruction of how the angel is to handle the people of these churches. These angels are part of those who watch over the Words of God because in each of the letters the Lord is referring within the instructions that He has given to each church a reference to the Words of God. Thus, the letter to the churches remains continuous with the purpose that the Father has given us the Bible, so that we are fully equipped to do every Good Work. It should not be a surprise then that in the Lord's instructions the Lord is referencing the obedience of the churches to hearing His Words and in increasing in the Knowledge of God. Clearly it is revealed that the meanings given to these churches are accounted to the churches of these last days, for the Lord utilizes the mysteries of the Words of God to unveil the ways of these churches. This means that we must take the Lord's instructions to these churches very seriously, as a matter that must be written upon our heart. For the Lord is giving to us a prophecy and a way of Mercy for all of these churches. The letters to the seven churches reveal to us the way of these churches within this very day, and it tells us what the people who follow after the ways of these seven churches are going to go through if they do not turn and overcome so that they are found worthy at the Time of the Midnight Hour.

If we do not hear His Words, and if we have not discerned that we have entered into the Seal Judgments of the Day of the Lord, then we are already lost and we condemn ourselves. I have given you thousands of pages of Writings that reveal His Words. I cannot open His Words to you, only the Lord can do that; but I would hope that you would at least recognize that there are Words of God and that you would at least believe the Lord enough to understand that if the Bible says that if you turn at His reproof that He will pour out His Spirit upon you and make His Words known to you (*Proverbs 1:23*), and more importantly, the Lord has warned you that if you do not hear His Words when the Father has set the time – the season - that they are opened to you, then you are not of God if you do not hear them. Since we are in the Day of Judgment that fact should at least highly concern you.

Another factor that lets us to understand that the Lord is addressing these letters to the all of the churches of this the Day of the Lord is His use of the phrase “He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches”. I have revealed in several Writings that the Holy Spirit is indeed the Words of God. Thus, the Lord is saying to us in the phrase that the people should hear what the “Words of God” says to the churches. The meaning of “Church” is the “Called out ones”, as it comes from the Greek word “Ekklesia”. The word “Angel” also means “Messenger”. But, since the Lord is addressing these angels in regard to His Word, they are of the Holy Angels in charge of keeping His Words. Since the Words of God were opened to the entire world in June 2003, we are now able to understand these letters, and we are able to have that ear to hear these letters as they are spoken in the language of heaven. Let us now begin the review of these seven churches.

Church #1: The Church of Ephesus that is commonly referred to in most Bibles as “The Loveless Church”

- ☆ **Revelation 2:1-7** ¹“To the angel of the church of Ephesus write, ‘These things says He who holds the seven stars in His right hand, who walks in the midst of the seven golden lampstands: (*This is the Spirit of Truth that He pours out on the Seven Churches*). ²“I know your works, your labor, your patience, and that you cannot bear those who are evil. And you

have tested those who say they are apostles and are not, and have found them liars; ³and you have persevered and have patience, and have labored for My name's sake and have not become weary. ⁴Nevertheless I have *this* against you, that you have left your first love. ⁵Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent and do the first works, or else I will come to you quickly and remove your lampstand from its place--unless you repent. ⁶But this you have, that you hate the deeds of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate. ⁷"He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes I will give to eat from the tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God."

In this Church the Lord is addressing the church that seems the best performing of the seven churches. For at the end of the letter the Lord says that they only truly have one flaw, and that is that they have forgotten their first love and that is the Lord. That statement by the Lord gives us the understanding of whom this church truly is. This is the church of the best of the true worshippers of God that are in the world today. They are the dedicated churches that have built a solid church based upon the best of God's foundations, as they have known them to be. This is the church that sends out evangelists and who are active in missions work.

This is the also church of people who are true followers of Christ. Such as that great and humble man who has operated a wonderful food program for the needy, and who has done so without fanfare. He flies coach class so that the funds raised are truly used for the Lord's work of doing Good Deeds for others, and not for his own luxury in travel. He is a tireless worker who has kept alive many of God's people as a result of his faithfulness. It is people like my foster father who once he was saved he grew in the Lord. Being a very silent man he did not push his faith on others, and he did not raise his voice in anger. A diligent man, who daily arrived 30 minutes early for his shift work as a welder at Goodyear Tire Company, so that he could take 15 minutes to sit on a chair by his locker and have a silent 15 minute devotional reading of the scriptures followed by a short silent prayer. It was his silent and personal testimony given before men for his Lord. He was a faithful churchgoer attempting to be there for every service when the doors were opened, and he was diligent in his support of the church with his tithes and offerings. It is likened to the great church in New York started by a faithful man who was willing to take on the streets of Harlem to preach the Word of God, and who has been faithful to create a credible drug treatment program for the afflicted in the city that is of the face of the world and that therefore as did Lot, its people place themselves in the forefront to receive of the afflictions of the sins of world. Yet is this sinkhole of sin this man and those who faithfully follow him have raised a beacon of Light unto that city and even out into distant lands. This first church of Revelation is also the church of the faithful intercessors that sacrifice for God's purposes and they seek to do all that they can to help others and to intercede against afflictions of others. This is the church of the faithful worshippers who go every week to church and they believe that they are raising their family in every way right and good deed that they can do for the promotion of the Lord. They are the church of the diligent Sunday school teachers and the faithful prayer warriors. They are the church of those who regularly visit the hospitals so that they can pray with the afflicted. They are those who go into the prisons and pray with those who have been punished and who are in the most part neglected. Most of all, this is the church of those who love the children and seek to feed house and comfort them. It the church of those who try to house the poor, the church of those who fight to stop abortions, and of those who fight for the right to protect marriages as they are intended by God. It is the church that desires that Truth be upheld in all walks of life and in the Government.

The Lord reveals that this church has lost its first love. In this church the people are faithful to love each other as the Lord has commanded them to do. The first love that is above all other loves is that we are commanded to first love the Father. The Lord is not saying that these people do not love the Father, as we know the way of loving Him here on earth. For that is the second love of God. The Lord is saying that we have lost the first love, and that is the Love of God as it is known in heaven and that is commanded of us to love Him. In our Lord's Prayer we ask the Father to come in His Kingdom "as it is in heaven". Jesus says that you cannot love God the Father if you do not receive and keep His Words. The Lord also says that we are not of God if we do not hear His Words. That is the way of the first love that this church has lost. You can see this if you carefully consider the following verses:

- ☆ **Matthew 22:36-40** ³⁶"Teacher, which is the great commandment in the law?" ³⁷ **Jesus said to him, "you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and all your mind.** ³⁸**This is the first and great commandment.** ³⁹And the second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. ⁴⁰On these two commandments hang all of the Law and the Prophets."
- ☆ **John 14:23-24** ²³"**Jesus answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My Word; and the Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him.** ²⁴**HE WHO DOES NOT LOVE ME DOES NOT KEEP MY WORDS;** and the Word which you hear is not Mine but the Father's who sent Me."
- ☆ **John 8:47** ⁴⁷"**He who is of God hears God's Words; therefore you do not hear, because you are not of God.**"
- ☆ **John 5:24-25** "Most assuredly, I say to you, **he who hears My Word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into everlasting life.** Most assuredly, I say to you, the hour is coming, and now is, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God; **AND** those who hear will live."
- ☆ **John 12:48** "**He who rejects Me, and does not receive My Words has that which judges him – the Word that I have spoken will judge him in the last day.**"
- ☆ **John 6:63** "**The Words that I speak to you are Spirit, AND THEY ARE LIFE.**"

- ☆ **John 15:3** "You are already clean because of the Word which I have spoken to you."
- ☆ **James 1:22-24** ²²But be doers of the Word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. ²³For if anyone is a hearer of the Word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror; ²⁴for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was.

Let me explain this in a way that my friend, Mr. John Westfall, has explained it. There are many who recognize that the supernatural miracles of God basically ended with the passing away of the disciples and the people of that first church of Jerusalem and the other places where they taught. Within just a few years the cares of the world destroyed all of the knowledge of how they were able to access the Lord and receive such a great anointing from the Lord. Since that time that anointing has not been seen upon the earth. It is about to fall on us again, for its season is about to come, as it had came to the Disciples. The disciples did not receive that anointing by accident. They received it from the Lord because they loved the Lord according to the way instructed of them by the Lord. With the passing away of the Disciples and Apostles, this strong church of His believers lost that knowledge of how to enable God's Good Works. Within a very short time that knowledge was reduced to myths and even to be categorized as false teachings. The Lord never hid this knowledge from us. It was always open to us if we, as a man or woman, would have actually tried to seek out this knowledge. Because those who were taught by the disciples failed to be diligent to teach His Words to their children, this knowledge of how to do His Words and to enable the Good Works of the Father, this wisdom and understanding was lost. For the Gentiles the Spirit of Truth

was not sent forth to stir up the hearts of people until the Day of the Lord began to draw near and the Lord released the knowledge of Truth to be received, as it is so stated in Hebrews 10:25-31. It is not the fault of this first church that they did not seek this knowledge. The Words were closed up and sealed, although the Bible is clear that if anyone had been diligent to seek them out, the Lord would have opened them to them. We failed to do this. This is how the faithful and diligent churchgoers lost this first love, but now that the Words of God are freely opened, we have no excuse not to regain this first love. Until 2003 we were covered for this sin of complacency of not seeking the Words of God; but now that the Words of God are opened we are without excuse for not seeking God, for God is His Words. If you consider the chart with the circle of Bible verses, I believe that you can easily see that God is Spirit, and His Spirit is Truth, and His Truth is His Words, and His Words are God.

The reason that the Lord says that this church of Ephesus had lost its first love is found in the book of Ephesians. The answer is found in Ephesians 1:13-14. That verse says that this churches first love was the Word of Truth, the Words of God. Paul says that he rejoiced that their salvation was based upon the promise of God to raise them up by the Holy Spirit because of their faith in His Word of Truth, and it is God's Words that are the Truth.

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- ☆ **Ephesians 1:13-14** ¹³In Him you also trusted, after you heard the Word of Truth, the Good News of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of PROMISE, ¹⁴who is the GUARANTEE of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, to the praise of His Glory.



- ☆ **Mark 10:26-27** ²⁶And they were greatly astonished, saying among themselves, "Who then can be saved?" ²⁷But Jesus looked at them and said, "**With men it is impossible, but not with God (*His Words*); for with God all things are possible."**

There is a dispute as to whether this letter of Paul's was actually addressed to the "Ephesians". Some original transcripts did not have to text to the church is Ephesus included in Ephesians 1:1. It may be that this is actually the open letter sent to all churches that is referred to in Colossians 4:16 as being the epistle to the Laodiceans. That was an open letter sent to the people of all the churches. This book of Ephesians may well have been addressed to all churches, and its content would more indicate it was sent to all the churches. But, the intrigue is that in this letter to the Ephesians Paul seems to be addressing us of this day for it is addressed to the brethren in Ephesians 1:24 and his wording in Ephesians chapter 3 indicates that it is for a people who will someday come to understand and to appreciate the mysteries of the Kingdom of God that Paul and the disciples had known. Since we are the ones to whom the Words of God have been opened, and since it was Paul who prophesied in Acts 28:28 that the mysteries of the Kingdom had been taken from the Jews and sent to the Gentiles, and since that could not be fulfilled until this day, it seems clear that Paul was especially writing to the people of this last day whom he would certainly include the people who are of the way of this first church of Ephesus that the Lord is referring to. Paul entreats the people of this first church to turn to His Words, and for them to receive the Knowledge of Truth so that they are set apart for the Lord by increasing in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ and of the Good Works obtained through being obedient to do the ways of the promises of the Father.

- ☆ **Ephesians 3:1-7** ¹For this reason I, Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus for you Gentiles-- ²if indeed you have heard of the dispensation of the Grace of God which was given to me for you, ³how that by revelation He made known to me the mystery (as I have briefly written already, ⁴by which, when you read, you may understand my knowledge in the mystery of Christ), ⁵which in other ages was not made known to the sons of men, as it has now been revealed by the Spirit to His holy apostles and prophets (*Remember that the holy apostles and prophets are those set apart by His Truth that is the knowledge of the Words of God, according to John 17:17, and fulfilled in Luke 24:44-45 and 2 Corinthians 12:1-4.*); ⁶that the Gentiles should be fellow heirs, of the same body, and partakers of His promise in Christ through the Good News, ⁷of which I became a minister according to the gift of the grace of God given to me by the effective working of His power.

Take notice that the Lord makes a very important clarification in Revelation 2:2, and the Lord says that this church of Ephesus will accept His truth and will hear what He has said. That clarification by the Lord is that only those who are filled with the knowledge of the Words of God are true apostles and true prophets of God, all others have no right by definition of scripture to call themselves as Prophets and Apostles. The Lord says that those who say they are apostles and do not know His Words are impostors, and in Revelation 2:2 the Lord calls them liars. Take notice that it is the knowledge of Truth, the knowledge of the Words of God that separates true apostles and true disciples from the imposters. Those who speak prophesies from the Lord are clearly not Apostles of God. The Lord reserves the title of Apostle for those who have obtained the mysteries of the Kingdom by the receiving of the knowledge of His Words. He has called all of us to be apostles for Christ, and we will become this when we receive His Words and to increase in the Knowledge of God.

- ☆ **Revelation 2:2** ²"I know your works, your labor, your patience, and that you cannot bear those who are evil. **And you have tested those who say they are apostles and are not, and have found them liars;**
- ☆ **Revelation 2:17-19** ¹⁷Sanctify them by Your truth. Your Word is truth. ¹⁸**As You sent Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world** (*The Father sent Jesus into the Word speaking the Words of God – Deuteronomy 18:18-19 and John 3:34*). ¹⁹**And for their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also may be sanctified by the truth**
- ☆ **John 8:31-32** ³¹Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My Word (*For a preacher to abide in His Word, then He has to receive it, increase in knowledge of it, and then He must obey the Lord and teach his Words and not his own words*), you are My disciples indeed. ³²And you shall know the Truth, and the Truth shall make you free." (*His Words are Truth, and in John 15:3 the Lord says that it is His Word – His Spirit - that sweeps you clean*).
- ☆ **1 Peter 5:1-5** ¹The elders who are among you I exhort, I who am a fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, and also a partaker of the glory that will be revealed: ²Shepherd the flock of God which is among you, serving as overseers, not by compulsion but willingly, not for dishonest gain but eagerly (*This says that the Prosperity Ministry is not of the way of the Lord, as they receive their gain by dishonestly representing the Words of God to cause others to give of their resources to them for their private and dishonest gain. They must turn and repent and seek to learn and to follow the way of the Lord, and they will be considered cleansed of their deceit*); ³nor as being lords over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock (*Teacher s and keepers of His Holy Words*); ⁴and when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the crown of glory that does not fade away (*The Crown of Glory is given to those who have increased in the knowledge of God and who are able to be doers of His Words to enable the Father to do His Good Works for others. These people are not seeking gain for themselves, but for others so that the Good Works of the Father is enabled for their neighbor and for the Glory of the Lord. To these people the Lord is providing a special crown, and every crown is a great value in heaven*).

This first letter is clearly addressed to the best of today's Spirit-filled churches that are doing great works around the world. This letter is addressed to those churches that are doing active evangelical and missions' work. The Lord is saying that this church is the closest to the being like the first church in Jerusalem. They have the heart of that early church, and the only thing that these people are missing is to hear His Words and to receive them, and they will receive Eternal Life. It is important that we understand that it is His Words that gives us Eternal Life. The people who

are of this first church of Ephesus should be careful to consider the Lord's warning of Revelation 2:5. The Lord says that even though they are the greatest and most faithful among the people of all the churches of these last days, they must repent. I have repeatedly warned people that we are guilty of the sin of complacency and of trampling upon the very first Law of God. If we do not hear His Words when they are opened to us, then Jesus says clearly and distinctly that we are not of God no matter what we think in our hearts. Jesus is saying the same thing in this letter to the angel of the church of Ephesus. Here in Revelation 2:5 the Lord is calling this best of the people of His churches in this last day to repentance.

- ☆ **Revelation 2:1-5** ¹"To the angel of the church of Ephesus write, 'These things says He who holds the seven stars in His right hand, who walks in the midst of the seven golden lampstands: ²"I know your works, your labor, your patience, and that you cannot bear those who are evil. And you have tested those who say they are apostles and are not, and have found them liars; ³and you have persevered and have patience, and have labored for My name's sake and have not become weary. ⁴Nevertheless I have *this* against you, that you have left your first love. ⁵**Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent and do the first works, or else I will come to you quickly and remove your lampstand from its place-- UNLESS YOU REPENT.**

Remember that when Jesus came the first time that He called everyone who was in Israel to repentance and to receive the Words of God. Only John the Baptist was above this, but even John would have had to receive the Words at the Resurrection of Christ. Jesus said of John that he was the greatest of those among men but the least in the Kingdom of God because John was perfect on earth, yet he had not yet received the knowledge of Truth for he also had not taken time from his service to come and chase after the Lord to receive the knowledge of His Words, even though John the Baptist had prophesied about the Words of God that Jesus would speak. The great news about this first church is that it sounds like many of them are going to turn, repent, go to and fro wherever necessary so that they can increase in the knowledge of God, and be made wise to do Good Works, as it is foretold in Daniel 12:9-10. They are the faithful ones and they love God more than man and more than the world. They are able to discern false teachers and our Lord says that they also hate the way of the Nicolaitans, as He hates them. The Lord also says that these people will hear Him and that they will come out from following the way of the City of Babylon that is the way of deceit and evil. When the truth of the

deceit by the leaders of the nations is made known the Lord says that these people will identify it and that they will not accept those leaders who have lied to them and deceived the nations.

- ☆ **Daniel 12:9-10** ⁹And He said, "Go your way, Daniel, for the Words are closed up and sealed till the Time of the End. ¹⁰**Many shall be purified, made white, and refined,** but the wicked shall do wickedly; and none of the wicked shall understand, but the wise SHALL understand.

WHAT JESUS SAID ABOUT ETERNAL LIFE

1. Those who believe on Him have Eternal Life.
 2. Those who do not hear His Words do not have Eternal Life, for they are not of God; and, further, they will receive punishment for their rejection of His Words.
- ☆ **John 6:47** ⁴⁷Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me has everlasting life.
 - ☆ **John 3:36** ³⁶He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him".
 - ☆ **John 3:16** ¹⁶"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever BELIEVES in Him should not perish but have everlasting Life."
 - ☆ **John 6:54-57** ⁵⁴**Whoever eats My Flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day.** ⁵⁵For My Flesh is food indeed, and My blood is drink indeed. ⁵⁶He who eats My Flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him. ⁵⁷As the living Father sent Me, and I live because of the Father, so he who feeds on Me will live because of Me.
 - ☆ **John 10:25-29** ²⁵Jesus answered them, "I told you, and you do not believe. The works that I do in My Father's name, they bear witness of Me. ²⁶But you do not believe, because you are not of My sheep, as I said to you. ²⁷**My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. ²⁸And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. ²⁹My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand. ³⁰I and My Father are one."**
 - ☆ **John 8:47** **"He who is of God hears God's Words; therefore you do not hear, because you are not of God."** (*If you do not hear His Words, there is no Life*).
 - ☆ **Deuteronomy 18:18-19** ¹⁸"I will raise up for them a Prophet (*Jesus*) like you (*Moses, the Law Giver*) from among their brethren, and will put My Words in His mouth, and He shall speak to them all that I command Him. ¹⁹And it shall be that whoever will not hear My Words, which He speaks in My name, I WILL REQUIRE IT OF HIM."

Note: It is impossible to believe on Jesus if you do not believe the Words of God that He was sent into the World by the Father to speak and to do. He was sent so that we might receive His Words that unlock the mysteries of the Kingdom and fully equip us to do every Good Work and in so doing bring Glory to the Father. Further, the Father says in Deuteronomy 18:18-19 that if we do not hear His Words that Jesus will speak and believe in His Works that Jesus will do, then He will require it of us. Jesus says that if we do not eat His flesh, then we shall not have everlasting Life. The Lord is speaking of the Words that He has received from heaven, for His Words are food because all things exist and consist from His spoken Words. In His Words is God and in His Words is Life. This is confirmed in Proverbs 8:35 for the Lord says that whoever finds wisdom (*Understanding*) finds Life.

The name Ephesus is reported to mean “to be relaxed” or “to become complacent”. Some say that it also can mean “desirable”. Both of those meanings do fit the description of this church. The people of this Church of Ephesus are tireless workers for God who have preserved. This is the best of God’s people upon the earth. But, please pay attention to what the Lord is saying to this people. These people, as wonderful as they are, and as great of workers for God as they are, need to hear the Words of God, repent for their complacency towards receiving His Holy Words and not seeking for knowledge of His Works. The Lord says that they must turn and diligently seek in the Knowledge of God so that they are able to do the first works. Everyone who reads Genesis 1 will see that the Works of God that were done for the blessing of mankind, not the punishment of mankind, are called as the “Good Works” of God. Those are the foundation of the Good Works of God that Jesus spoke forth and the Father, the Spirit of God that is the Words of God, hovered above the Waters and He established the Creation exactly as Jesus spoke it forth. In Hosea 6:8 the Lord says that we are required to increase in knowledge of God so that we are able to enable the Father to do the Good Works for others as we ask Him to do. That is the First Works that the nearly perfect Church of Ephesus has forgotten the way to do, for they are the true ancestor of the first church of Jerusalem, and that only thing that they lack is that desire for God’s Words. They should seek these Words with the love of the Fear of God that should penetrate their minds as they gain His favor by their seeking to enable Him to do His Good Deeds through them so that He is Glorified before mankind. Consider, what will that great and humble man do during the Time of the Night when the famine comes upon the world? If he has God’s Words then he will enable God to do this Good Work through him so that the Lord is Greatly magnified even far more than He is today through the work of this man. What will the missions’ people do when there is global economic collapse during the Time of the Night? Only if they have the Words of God in them will they be able to continue to enable God’s work to be done, and with His Words they will do it far more gloriously for the growth of the knowledge of the Lord. The Lord says that all of these wonderful and glorious people of this first Church of Ephesus must repent, and become diligent to seek the knowledge of God that will enable them to do His Good Works in the coming Time of the Night. They will then return to becoming that thriving church as they were in His first church of Jerusalem.

- ☆ **Revelation 2:1-7** ¹"To the angel of the church of Ephesus write, 'These things says He who holds the seven stars in His right hand, who walks in the midst of the seven golden lampstands: *(This is the Spirit of Truth that He pours out on the Seven Churches)*. ²"I know your works, your labor, your patience, and that you cannot bear those who are evil. And you have tested those who say they are apostles and are not, and have found them liars; ³and you have persevered and have patience, and have labored for My name's sake and have not become weary. ⁴Nevertheless I have *this* against you, that you have left your first love. ⁵Remember therefore from where you have fallen; **REPENT AND DO THE FIRST WORKS, OR ELSE** I will come to you quickly and remove your lampstand from its place--unless you repent.
- ☆ **Hosea 6:6** ⁶For I desire “Good Deeds” and not sacrifice, and the “knowledge of God” more than burnt offerings.
- ☆ **Micah 6:8** ⁸He has shown you, O man, what *is* Good; and **WHAT DOES THE LORD REQUIRE OF YOU BUT TO DO JUSTLY, TO LOVE GOOD DEEDS, AND TO WALK HUMBLY WITH YOUR GOD?**
- ☆ **Psalms 14:2-3, & Psalm 53:2-3** ²The Lord looks down from Heaven upon the children of men, **to see if there are any who understand, WHO SEEK GOD.** ³They have all turned aside, they have together become corrupt; **there is none that does “GOOD”, no, not one.**
- ☆ **Proverbs 11:27** He who diligently seeks “Good” finds favor.
- ☆ **Proverbs 12:8** A man will be commended according to His knowledge.
- ☆ **Proverbs 9:10** Understanding of the Holy One is knowledge.
- ☆ **Proverbs 19:8** He who gets Wisdom loves his own soul; he who keeps Understanding will find Good.

Let us cover one last subject in regard to this first church. That is the subject of the Nicolaitans. In the seven letters to seven churches, the Lord references the Nicolaitans twice. The Lord says in Revelation 2:6 that He hates the deeds of the Nicolaitans, and in Revelation 2:15 that He hates the doctrine of the Nicolaitans. The deeds of the Nicolaitans can also be interpreted as its works, or as its practices.

- ☆ **Revelation 2:6** ⁶But this you have, that you hate the deeds of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate.”
- ☆ **Revelation 2:15-16** ¹⁵Thus you also have those who hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate. ¹⁶Repent, or else I will come to you quickly and will fight against them with the sword of My mouth.”

The title “Nicolaitans”, as like the title “Laodiceans”, is not broken down by meaning from the original Greek, but is transferred intact to its English title. The foundation of the word “Nicolaitans” comes from the words “Nicos” and “Laity”. The word Nicos means a man, or person, who has a conquest over, or a victory over, or dominion over, something. In the case of the word Nicolaitans, it is over the “laity”. The Laity is the people or the congregation. In a nutshell the meaning of Nicolaitans is a system wherein a person or a hierarchy has established a conquest of God’s bride, the church, and has utilized a position within His church as a vehicle to take dominion or possession of His bride. We see an example of this in the Lord’s parable of the Great Supper that is found in Luke 14:15-24. In these last days that we are now in that is the Evening Time of the Day of the Lord, the Lord has sent out His Servant the Spirit of Truth, to invite all of His invited guests, the people of His Churches, to come in and dine with on the food of heaven with Him. Naturally the first invitation to any church goes out to the head of the church. In Luke 14:20 we see

the response of one of the churches as being that they have taken a bride and they have no desire to come to this Great Supper as they are busy with their wife. Was the bride was stolen from the Lord?

☆ **Luke 14:15-24** ¹⁵Now when one of those who sat at the table with Him heard these things, he said to Him, "Blessed is he who shall eat bread (*Partake of Instruction from the Lord*) in the kingdom of God!" (*The Kingdom of God is His Words that are within us*). ¹⁶Then He said to him, "A certain man gave a great supper and invited many, ¹⁷and sent his servant at supper time to say to those who were invited, 'Come, for all things are now ready.' ¹⁸But they all with one accord began to make excuses. The first said to him, 'I have bought a piece of ground, and I must go and see it. I ask you to have me excused.' ¹⁹And another said, 'I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I am going to test them. I ask you to have me excused.' ²⁰Still another said, 'I have married a wife, and therefore I cannot come.' ²¹So that servant came and reported these things to his master. Then the master of the house, being angry, said to his servant, 'Go out quickly into the streets and lanes of the city, and bring in here the poor and the maimed and the lame and the blind.' ²²And the servant said, 'Master, it is done as you commanded, and still there is room.' ²³Then the master said to the servant, 'Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel them to come in, that my house may be filled. ²⁴For I say to you that none of those men who were invited shall taste my supper.'" *19*



The Nicolaitans are those churches that will not teach the Words of God, they have taken the Bible and added their own false teachings that contradict the Laws of God that are revealed in the Writings of the Prophets. For example there are churches that have various forms of the Nicolaitan practices and doctrine as follows:

1. The Lord tells us in Matthew 23:8-11 that there is no one who dare to have his position in the church to be called as a father. There is no head Bishop or Pope in God's church. There is not one in the church of God that has a direct line to God that is greater than another. At the death of Christ the veil of the Temple was torn in two from top to bottom, and the Father abolished the position of the High Priest and his attending hierarchy. The Lord opened the way to the Door of heaven to receive His Words directly from Him. The Lord has told us that all people now have direct access to call out to the Lord to receive knowledge of God so that they are able to do the Words of God to enable the Good Works of the Father to be done for others and to unlock God's favor for themselves.

☆ **Matthew 23:8-11** ⁸"But you do not be called 'Rabbi'; for One is your 'Teacher', the Christ, and you are all brethren. ⁹Do not call anyone on earth your father; for One is your Father, He who is in heaven. ¹⁰And do not be called teachers; for One is your Teacher, the Christ. ¹¹But he who is greatest among you shall be your servant. ¹²And whoever exalts himself will be abased, and he who humbles himself will be exalted."

☆ **Proverbs 1:23** Turn at My reproof; Surely I will pour out My Spirit on you; I will make My Words known to you.

2. The Lord tells us that there is no other way to the Father than through Jesus, yet some churches teach the false Nicolaitan doctrine that we can pray and even offer offerings to the Saints or to angels to intercede for us to have our prayers answered. That is a false doctrine that the Lord is going to destroy in these next 10 years. In Revelation 22:9 the Holy Angel chastised the Disciple and Apostle John for worshipping him. He said we are to only pray and worship the Lord who is also our Father and who is the Holy Spirit. Jesus said in John 14:6 that there is no other way to the Father except through Him, and He is faithful to hear all those who call to Him. The Lord's mother Mary is at rest in Paradise. She is also under the same command that the Lord allowed Abraham to give to the rich man who died and went to Hades. The Command of the Lord is that the Writings of Moses and the Prophets are enough for us, and in no way can Abraham, Elijah, Mary, John, Peter, David, or any other Saint make intercession for you to the Father.

☆ **John 14:1-18** ¹"Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. ²In My Father's house are many mansions; if *it were* not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. ³And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, *there* you may be also. ⁴And where I go you know, and the way you know." (*If we receive His Words and write them in our hearts, then we have received the unbreakable promise of God to raise us up to eternal Life, and the Lord says that the Scriptures cannot be broken*) ⁵Thomas said to Him, "Lord, we do not know where You are going, and how can we know the way?" ⁶**Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.**" ⁷"If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; and from now on you know Him and have seen Him." ⁸Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient for us." ⁹Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father?' ¹⁰Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own *authority*; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works. ¹¹Believe Me that I *am* in the Father and the Father in Me, or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves. ¹²**Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father.** ¹³**And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.** ¹⁴**If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.** ¹⁵If you love Me, keep My

commandments. ¹⁶And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever-- ¹⁷even the Spirit of Truth, whom **the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you AND WILL BE IN you.** ¹⁸I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you."

3. A third doctrine of the Nicolaitans that God hates is the doctrine that someone from earth can purchase a better condition for someone who has already died. There is no purgatory in the Bible. There is one place where in the worthy are taken, and the Bible reveals that God has established five prisons for the wicked. Of those one is the Eternal Prison that is called Gehenna, also called as the Lake of Fire or the 2nd Death. Those cast in there shall never return. The Antichrist and the false prophet will be cast into there at the Lord's coming in the physical flesh at the time of the 7th Bowl Judgment. Another is called Tartarus, and that is reserved for the Fallen Angels, inclusive of Satan when he is cast down in the year 2028, and is to remain there for ~950 years. There are three prisons where the people of the past 6000 years are immediately cast into upon their death on earth. There is no one who can enter these prisons. The Bible says that even the mighty angels do not go out into the area known as the Darkness where the prisons of Sheol and Death are located. If the mighty angels are afraid and will not go there, then for certain there is no one a person of earth could ask a dead Saint to intervene to bring some one back from one of God's prisons. Further it is a law that if while they lived upon the earth they did not believe in the Lord, then there is no manner to avoid the wrath of God that abides on them. The Word of God is Law and the Holy Angels are tasked to keep every promise of God that is in His Words. The only purpose that can be recognized from the false doctrine of what is called "Purgatory" can only be to deceitfully contrive to receive financial gain from selling this false concept. Again, this is likened to the teaching of the Lord in Luke 14:19 that the church leaders have purchased five yoke of oxen and they desire to test them. The doctrines are the yokes, and Purgatory is one of these false doctrines. The only doctrine acceptable to God is that we hear His Words and come to Jesus to seek to increase in the knowledge of God so that we are able to enable Him to do His Good Works for others.

✧ **John 3:36** "He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him".

4. A fourth doctrine of the Nicolaitans is like the third doctrine. It is the selling of a concept of Communion that there is a substitute sacrifice of Jesus that gives us an anointing. This can be seen in the false communion practice that is offering a sacrament substitute for Jesus. The Communion is the doing the Way of His Words so that we are able to enable His Spirit to be poured out upon us to receive from Him knowledge so that we grow and that we become able to enable the Father to do a Good Work for others as we ask of Him. His body is the food of heaven that was broken for us so that all Scriptures were fulfilled and that He was authorized to open His Words to us and to give us Understanding. Other teachings are not according to His teaching of His Words from John chapter 6.
5. A fifth doctrine of the Nicolaitans is the doctrine of false prosperity by the perceived authority of a special anointing. There are many forms and practices to this doctrine. For example there are churches operating places where illegal money is laundered through churches. There are churches operating casinos. All these things are supposedly covered because there is a special anointing on that church. It is reported that at least a few of these churches even have shipping containers of various currencies and stores of precious metals and artwork, all stored for the "wealth" of the work of God's Kingdom. The Lord put the money to work in the people of the church and did not hoard it into bank accounts and private storage containers while millions of people are starving and homeless. Further the Lord did not gain resources through illegal and false ways. Today there is also TV broadcasters, and TV evangelists, who have gathered funds into huge private offshore bank accounts. One of the ways of the prosperity teachings of today that is likened to this doctrine of the Nicolaitans is the "purchase of the false anointing". There are religious leaders of churches who have even gathered other gullible church leaders into conventions and have taught them an abominable doctrine that says that if you give a "seed of cash" offering into the pocket of one that has a greater anointing than you, then a part of that anointing will rub off on you and you will be able to have others receive the anointing from you in like manner. That is a Financial Pyramid scheme of hierarchy anointing that is not of God according to the Lord's teaching of Matthew 23:8-11. Those who follow after this Nicolaitan doctrine will share in her sins and will be destroyed by the Lord. The Lord says in Revelation 2:17 that if they do not repent from these teachings that He is going to return and destroy them with His mouth.

Before we go on to the review of the other seven churches, it is worth taking a minute and reviewing the following Scriptures of the Apostles that teach us of the ways of the people and the religious leaders of these last days. If we follow them carefully, the key to not being accounted among these whom the Lord says will fail and fall, is to diligently seek His Words and to increase in the Knowledge of God, just as He told us in Hosea 6:6 and Micah 6:8 that it is His desire for us.

✧ **2 Timothy 3:1-9** ¹But know this that in the last days perilous times will come: ²For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, ³unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, ⁴traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than

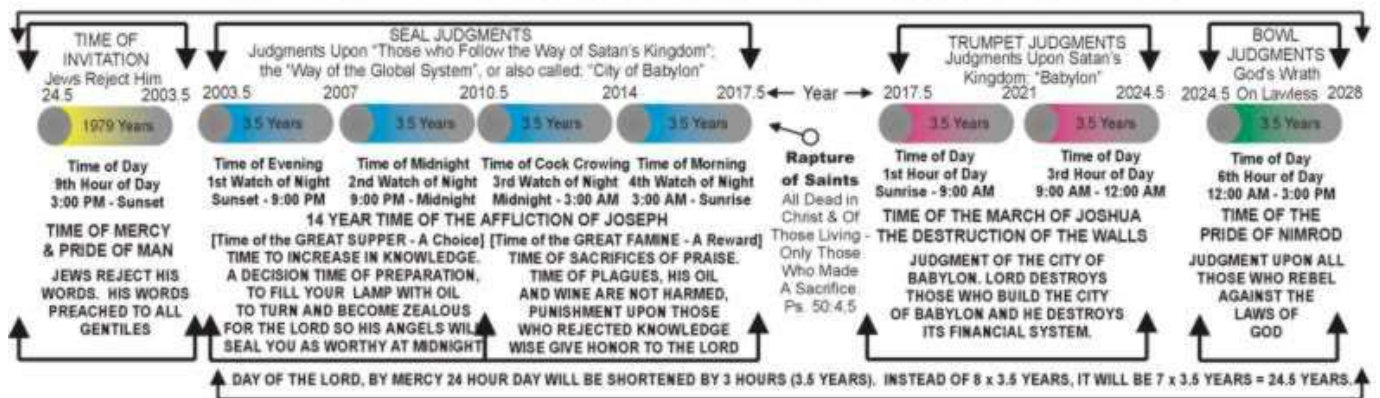
lovers of God, ⁵having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away! ⁶For of this sort are those who creep into households and make captives of gullible women loaded down with sins, led away by various lusts, ⁷always learning and never able to come to the knowledge of the Truth. ⁸Now as Jannes and Jambres resisted Moses, (*The priests of the Pharaoh of Egypt*) resisted Moses (*Sent by God to reveal God's message and things to come*) **so does these also resist the Truth: men of corrupt minds, DISAPPROVED CONCERNING THE FAITH: ⁹but they will progress no further, for their folly will be manifest (*Made evident*) to all, as theirs also was.**

- ☆ **2 Timothy 4:3-4** "For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers; and they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables."
- ☆ **2 Peter 2:1-3** "But there were also false prophets among the people, even as there will be false teachers among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Lord who bought them, and bring on themselves swift destruction. And many will follow their destructive ways, because of whom the way of truth will be blasphemed. By covetousness they will exploit you with deceptive words; for a long time their judgment has not been idle, and their destruction does not slumber."

Let us also remember that the Lord loves the Elders, and through Paul He has revealed that the Elders who are found worthy will be given a double honor here on earth in heaven. That reward will come at the Midnight Hour when the Lord removes the Spirit from the unworthy and adds it to that of those found worthy. The Lord is saying that those Elders who not only pursue after the knowledge of the Word, but also pursue after the discernment of doctrine, will be especially honored by the Lord and by the people. This is because by the time of the 6th Seal Judgment all the knowledge of the Glory of the Lord will be made known and by that time all of the false doctrines will have been exposed and disposed of, just as like the Lord destroyed the false doctrines of Egypt prior to taking His people out of Egypt and to the Promised to Land.

- ☆ **1 Timothy 5:17** Let the Elders who rule well be counted worthy of double honor, especially those who labor in the Word and Doctrine.
- ☆ **1 Peter 5:1-5** ¹The elders who are among you I exhort, I who am a fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, and also a partaker of the glory that will be revealed: ²Shepherd the flock of God which is among you, serving as overseers, not by compulsion but willingly, not for dishonest gain but eagerly; ³nor as being lords over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock (*Teacher s and keepers of His Holy Words as examples before the flock*); ⁴and when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the crown of glory that does not fade away (*The Crown of Glory is given to those who have increased in the knowledge of God and who are able to be doers of His Words to enable the Father to do His Good Works for others. These people are not seeking gain for themselves, but for others so that the Good Works of the Father is enabled for their neighbor and for the Glory of the Lord. To these people the Lord is providing a special crown, and every crown is a great value in heaven*).

TIME LINE OF THE END TIMES - THE DAY OF THE LORD

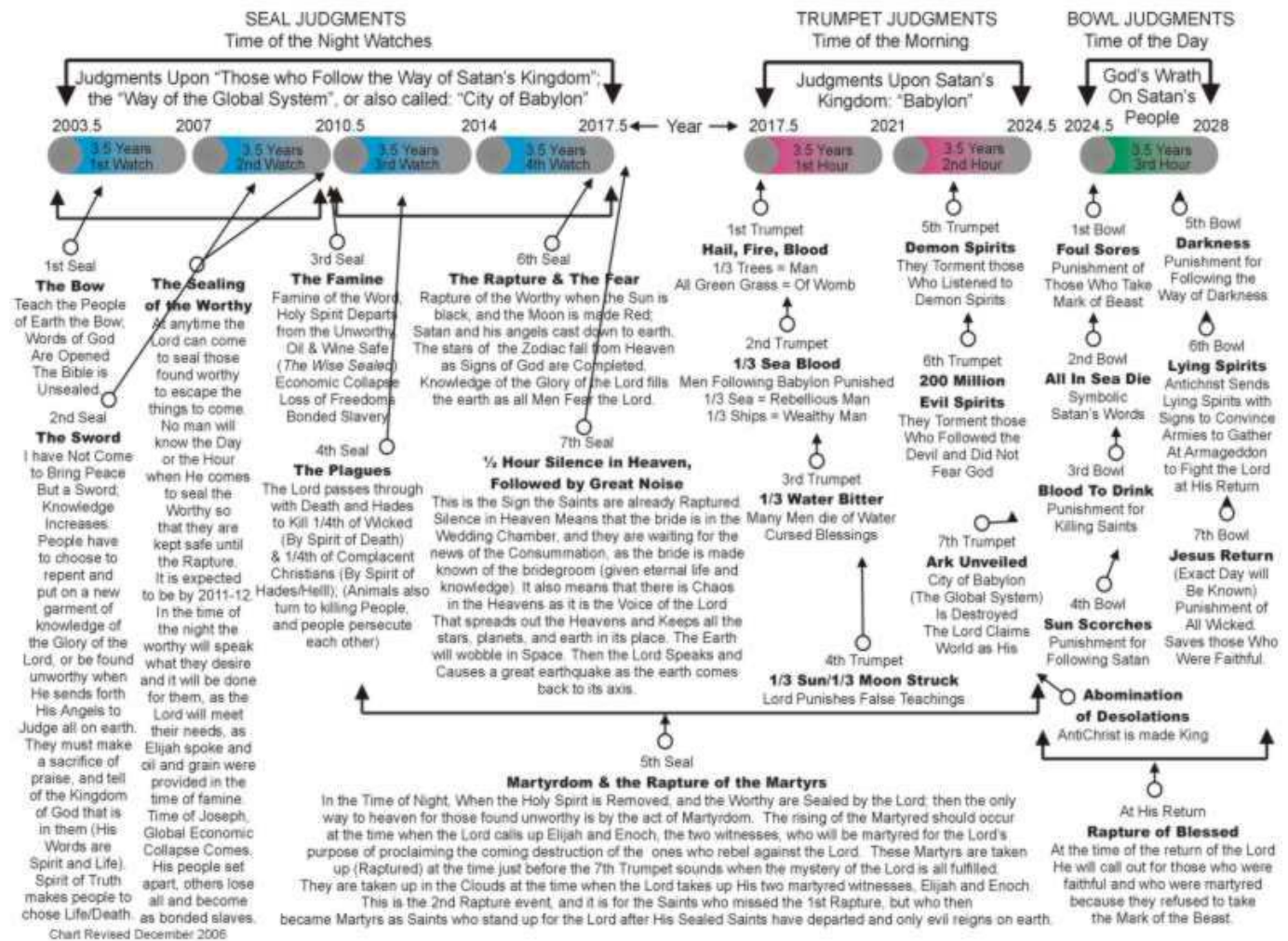


Church #2: The Church of Smyrna that is commonly referred to in most Bibles as "The Persecuted Church"

- ☆ **Revelation 2:8-11** ⁸And to the angel of the church in Smyrna write, 'These things says the First and the Last, who was dead, and came to life: ⁹"I know your works, tribulation, and poverty (but you are rich); and I know the blasphemy of those who say they are Jews and are not, but are a synagogue of Satan. ¹⁰Do not fear any of those things which you are about to suffer. Indeed, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be tested, and you will have tribulation ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life. ¹¹"He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. He who overcomes shall not be hurt by the second death."

The name of Smyrna means "Myrrh", or an "Offering of Sacrifice". This is the people that are likened to the unwise virgins. It is a people who would not hear receive His knowledge when it was opened to them. It is a people who are not going to receive the Words of God in these days of the Seal Judgments. This is the people whose hope for Eternal Life is only by the way of becoming Martyrs for His name. The Lord reveals to us that they are those who have no richness in the knowledge of God. They are likely the ones who did not attend church but they believed in the Lord. This passage of Scripture reveals that these people are of those who did nice things for others. The Lord says that they are going to be forced to go through tribulation, but

they are in no ways evil in their ways. Because they profess to be Christians they are going to be persecuted. From the time of the First Trumpet Judgment to the last Bowl Judgment there is a time span of ten years (*10.5 years is counted as 10 years*), and the ten days are equal to ten years. From the time of the Fourth Seal Judgment the Global Economic Collapse is going to come upon the earth, and there will be troubles. Under cover of the Patriot Act and other laws, the world system has been using a company in America to cast every person on earth into a label. In the time of the economic collapse of the fourth Seal Judgment, Satan is going to be allowed by God to place all those "Christians" found unworthy at the Midnight Hour, into prisons. But it is in the time of the Tribulations, the Times of the Trumpet Judgments and Bowl Judgments that the Lord will pour out upon the earth, that there will be tribulations. This is the ten days referred to in this letter to this church. The Lord is saying that this is the true left behind people. You can see from the text of Revelation 2:8-11 that the only way to Eternal Life that is given to these people is the option of becoming a Martyr for Him. The Lord says that if they will be true to Him and hold fast their belief in Him and accept the suffrage of earthly death, then they will be given Eternal Life, as will all of the Martyrs for the Lord Jesus Christ. This means that they have a chance to not go to one of God's Prisons upon their death, but rather into Paradise until they are raised to Life. They are not of the Raptured, but they are of the Glory of the Martyrs. Many will be raised at the same moment when the Lord calls up Elijah and Enoch at the time of the 7th Seal Judgment when they shall be Martyred for His name sake. There will be martyrs throughout the time of the Seal Judgments; but the people of this second church are singled out as being those who are those who are left behind to go through the Time of the Tribulations – the Times of the Trumpet Judgments and Bowl Judgments.



There is an interesting note that the Lord throws into this letter. He tells these people that they will not be hurt by the 2nd Death. The 2nd Death is the punishment that awaits after the Great White Throne Judgment. In Revelation 6:9-11 we see that the Martyrs are treated differently than the Worthy. The Lord gives the fifth Seal Judgment as a gift of hope to those who are left behind. They are going to go through the ten years of the Tribulations, but they are going to be Raptured together. When they die they will go to Paradise and they will be left there until the Resurrection of the Martyred. That will either be at the time of the resurrection of Elijah and Enoch, or after the Return of Christ in physical form at the end of the Bowl Judgments. The Bible indicates that there is a different Resurrection for those who die as Martyrs for not accepting the Mark of the Beast during the time of the Bowl Judgments. They are different from these Martyrs who are killed for their believe in the Word of God.

☆ **Revelation 6:9-11** ⁹When He opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain for the word of God and for the testimony which they held. ¹⁰And they cried with a loud voice, saying, "How long, O Lord, holy and true, until You judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?" ¹¹Then a white robe was given to each of them; and it was said to them that they should rest a little while longer, until both *the number* of their fellow servants and their brethren, who would be killed as they were, was completed.

Church #3: The Church of Pergamos that is commonly referred to in most Bibles as “The Compromising Church”

- ☆ **Revelation 2:12-17** ¹²“And to the angel of the church in Pergamos write, ‘These things says He who has the sharp two-edged sword: ¹³“I know your works, and where you dwell, where Satan’s throne is. And you hold fast to My name, and did not deny My faith even in the days in which Antipas was My faithful martyr, who was killed among you, where Satan dwells. ¹⁴But I have a few things against you, because you have there those who hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balak to put a stumbling block before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed to idols, and to commit sexual immorality. ¹⁵Thus you also have those who hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate. ¹⁶Repent, or else I will come to you quickly and will fight against them with the sword of My mouth. ¹⁷“He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes I will give some of the hidden manna to eat. And I will give him a white stone, and on the stone a new name written which no one knows except him who receives it.”

The meaning of Pergamos is “much married” or “adulterous”. Thus, this is likened to the tribe of Dan, and they are a people who follow after the god of Dan that the Lord tells us in Amos 8:14 that He is going to destroy and cause them to never rise again. In the Writing, “*America in the Time of the Affliction of Joseph*”, I have revealed in detail the way of the people who follow after the god of Dan. These are the compromising people who, like Lot, choose to participate in the city of the world. They follow after leaders who deceive them and they also allow the merger of all of the religions of the world to be accepted in their nation, and yet they expect the Lord to bless them and to keep them safe and secure when the famine and global economic collapse comes upon the earth in the Time of the Night. In this passage the Lord is warning these people that He will not wait until the Midnight Hour to begin to bringing affliction upon these people. America is filled with churches that are like these who follow the god of Dan. The Spirit of the people who follow after the god of Dan is to ignore the correction of national leaders even when they see clearly that they are walking in the way of deceit, and when those leaders tell them to shut up and go



along for it is better for the career of the ministers if he preaches a message that is blind to the truth of what is happening, because it is more financial rewarding to the career of the preacher if he preaches to the thousands rather than to just the few. The people of the god of Dan allowed the rulers of the nation to dictate what they will worship in their churches. Europe, especially churches in England and Germany, are beginning to see the Lord allowing the E. U. Courts to bring forth laws to take away their religious freedoms and that will cause them to accept a new Constitution that restricts their religious rights and their legal recourse against corruption within the national leadership. The Lord has said that He will restore them with the Word of His Mouth if they repent, and come out, or He will come and curse them by the Word of His Mouth. They will share in the city’s sins and plagues. The Spirit of Truth has come to these people and they must choose to come out from following after the worship of the world, or the Lord is going to allow them to fall victim to the world. The Lord is calling His people to come out from following the way of Satan that is of the false ways of the prophets of Balaam and the doctrines and deeds of the Nicolaitans.

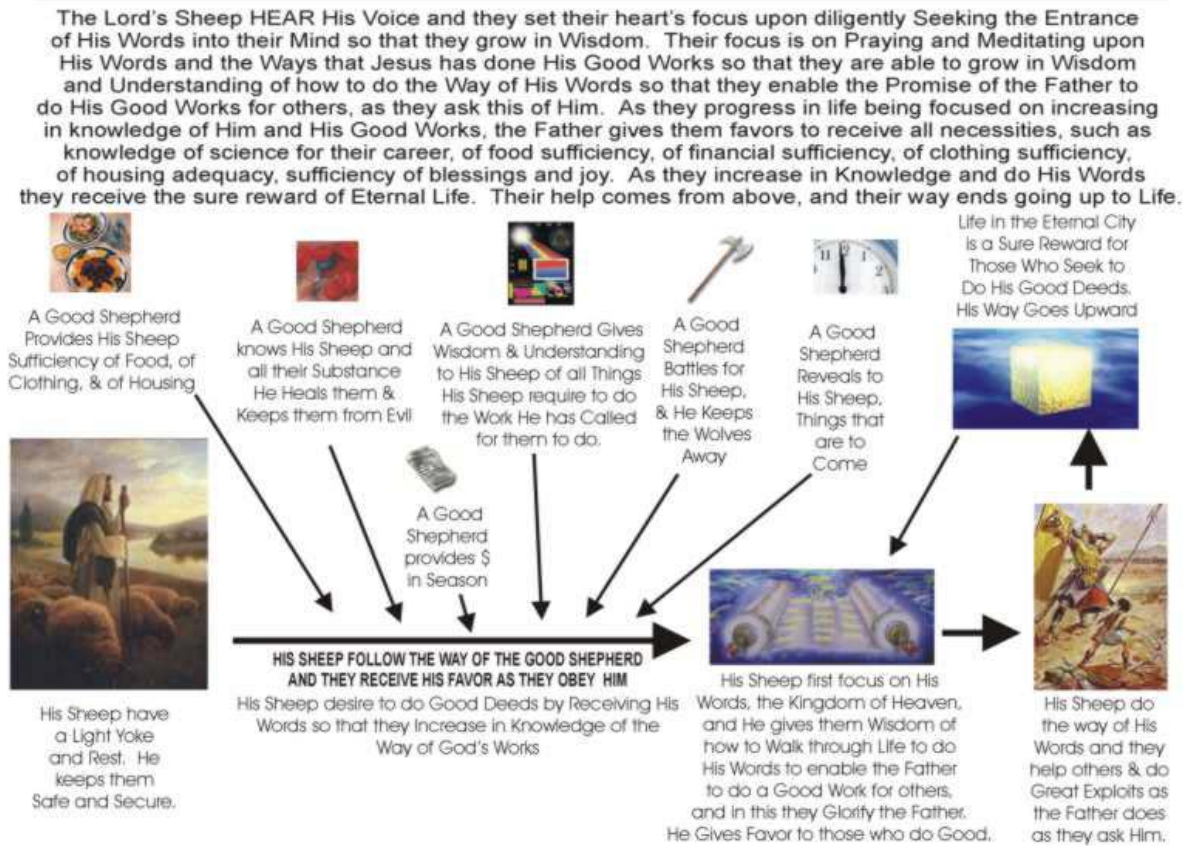
- ☆ **Amos 8:11-14** “Behold the days are coming,” declares the Lord God, “that I will send a famine into the land; not a famine for bread, nor a thirst for water, but rather a famine for hearing the words of God. And they shall wander from sea to sea, and from the North even to the East; they shall seek the word of God, and they shall NOT find it. In that day the fair virgins (*The ones who did not have their lamps prepared with oil*) and strong young men shall faint from thirst (*They will faint from seeking the Spirit of the Lord, who is the Spirit of the Words*). **Those who swear by the sin of Samaria (Ashima, a Syrian Goddess, who loved the mixture of the ways of the world), who say, “As your God lives, O Dan!” (Those who mix the worship of the world’s idols and God’s Bible); and, “As the way of Beersheba lives!” (Those who confuse the way of the covenant of prosperity the Lord made with Abraham, and with Isaac, at Beersheba). They shall fall and never rise again.” (Those who follow after these false teachings will be caused to fall and be put to shame).**

As you can see from Amos 8:11-14, the god of Dan includes the prosperity teachings. That is the way of Balaam. The prophets of Balaam were ministers who were all about speaking whatever message, or sermon, that would give him the greatest financial reward. They spoke whatever prophecies would give them the greatest financial rewards. The prophets of Balaam spoke to the leaders and the elite whatever message give them financial gain. The prophets of Balaam did not have a god to answer them, they created their doctrine message from a supposed god, to fit whatever occasion seemed right and that would give them position and financial reward. The present day prosperity preachers and the “you can be all you can be if you just speak it” preachers all come in this category of church. The Lord is warning them that He is calling them out from this way of false teaching that promises financial gain without scriptural accuracy as to the Knowledge of Truth. The people who walk in the way of using religion for financial gain are of the god of Dan. If a prophet begins to speak God’s Words for directing financial investments, and as means to obtain financial returns then He is teaching falsely for that is not the way of God for His people that is given in Hosea 6:6 and Micah 6:8. The Lord has told this people if they do not turn and repent that He is going to expose their false

teachings and that He will come early and strike them with a curse, for they have become as prostitutes of His Prophetic Word.

We must remember that Jesus warned that He did not come to bring Peace, but to bring a Sword that will separate even families (Matthew 10:34-40). (In Revelation 6:3-4 the Lord reveals to us the Sword of Truth that comes in the 2nd Seal Judgment, is sent to take Peace from the earth, and

that because of it people are killed. The Sword of Truth separates the Unworthy from the Worthy, and that the Unworthy are left to go through the troubles and upon their earthly dying, their soul shall be sent to one of God's prisons, called Death, Sheol, or Hades. Further, the Unworthy will face the troubles of the 4th Seal Judgment when Death and Hades pass through and kill one-fourth of those on earth). We have seen from the Lord's teaching in John 6:43-69 that it is a requirement of the Lord that we eat His Flesh to receive Eternal Life, will separate the brethren. Jesus said that His flesh was that bread that came down from heaven. That manna is the Words of God that Jesus came down to open for us and to pour out His Spirit upon us and give us Understanding. Jesus is the Door to knowledge of God's Words and He is the Door to opening Understanding that is the knowledge of the promises of the Father. Notice that the Lord did not say that He would give them their fill of manna, but that He would only give them some. Also the Lord says that He will give them a new name, as like He gave a new name to Abram, Sarai, and Jacob. Abram was brought out from he was originally ordained and placed by God for his season on earth. God called him out of Ur and named him Abraham, and his wife Sarai was renamed Sarah. For God changed them from their life's blessing they had from the time of creation. Jacob was born second, and his name was "a deceiver". Jacob desired the inheritance of the tribe of Israel and saw that Esau did not honor the covenant inheritance and the receiving of the knowledge of God's Words. Jacob purchased it, and then overcame his tests from God. He was rewarded with a new name, Israel, as the Lord raised his assigned blessing. The Pergamus people are called out from the world and from being deceivers from the beginning. Thus, when they overcome they will receive a new white stone with a name, a new blessing, known only by the one who receives it. These people were after the luxuries of the world and they ignored the Words of God until it is late, and their teachings have caused many to stumble in the way. Thus, the Lord is not going to raise them up as high and lofty as they were previously. They will pay a price, but they will be kept safe and secure in the Time of the Night and they will find Life and some of the favor of God.

☆ **Matthew 10:34-40** ³⁴Do not think that I came to bring peace on earth. I did not come to bring peace but a sword. ³⁵For I have come to set a man against his father, a daughter against her mother, and a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law. ³⁶And a man's foes will be those of his own household. ³⁷He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me. ³⁸And he who does not take up his cross and follow after Me is not worthy of Me. ³⁹He who finds his life will lose it, and he who loses his life for My sake will find it. ⁴⁰He who receives you receives Me, and he who receives Me receives Him who sent Me." (The Lord says that we cannot love Him if we do not receive His Words – John 14:23-24).

Church #4: The Church of Thyatira that is commonly referred to in most Bibles as "The Corrupt Church"

☆ **Revelation 2:18-29** ¹⁸"And to the angel of the church in Thyatira write, 'These things says the Son of God, who has eyes like a flame of fire, and His feet like fine brass: ¹⁹"I know your works, love, service, faith, and your patience; and as for your works, the last are more than the first. ²⁰Nevertheless I have a few things against you, because you allow that woman Jezebel (*Could be translated as "your wife Jezebel"*), who calls herself a prophetess, to teach and seduce My servants to commit sexual immorality and eat things sacrificed to idols. ²¹And I gave her time to repent of her sexual immorality, and she did not repent. ²²Indeed I will cast her into a sickbed, and those who commit adultery with her into great tribulation, unless they repent of their deeds. ²³I will kill her children with death, and all the churches shall know that I am He who searches the minds and hearts. And I will give to each one of you according to your works. ²⁴"Now to you I say, and to the rest in Thyatira, as many as do not have this doctrine, who have not known the depths of Satan, as they say, I will put on you no other burden. ²⁵But hold fast what you have till I come. ²⁶And he who overcomes, and keeps My works until the end, to him I will give power over the nations-- ²⁷*'He shall rule them with a rod of iron; they shall be dashed to pieces like the potter's vessels'*-- as I also have received from My Father; ²⁸and I will give him the morning star. ²⁹"He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches."

The meaning of Thyatira is a "sacrifice of Labor". This is the people of these last day charismatic and evangelical churches. They have a desire to go out and evangelize the world. They are talking of great teachings and they expound many pearls of God's wisdom, but they have not purchased the pearl of Great Price. The Lord shows us this by His reference to His eyes of fire. The Word of God "Fire" refers to the gain of Knowledge of Him that sweeps us clean. Those who rejected His knowledge on earth will forever live in a place that has fire for eternity, for they will forever remember that they missed the opportunity to live and would not hear the Lord speak His Words from His mouth. Instead the mouth beasts will forever torment them, and they will have forever the knowledge that they are writhing within the body of a worm, yet they could have lived in a mansion in that Eternal City of God. They chose to follow after the ways of the world and would not follow after His Words.

The person Jezebel is notorious with the Worship of Baal. The true lasting remembrance of Jezebel is for her wickedness and deceit. She was of the Phoenicians and they were the masters of Trade. Ahab's palace was filled with the luxury and the waste of abundance, such as the ivory that was purchased from foreign merchants. Jezebel's legacy was one of wealth that she took away from the people of Israel. Her great grand daughter was the founder of the city of Carthage. From her family lines in Carthage came the mercenary war ways of Hannibal that were engaged with ruthlessness and boldness. It was the remains of the spirit of Jezebel. She let nothing stand in the way of obtaining the luxuries and gains that she desired to obtain. Whether it was at the cost of the lives of her people, or at the cost of the lives of others. To her, everyone was as a mercenary to hire or they were as an unwanted obstacle, thus to becoming a victim to be brushed aside as needed by any means possible.

There come to mind many teachings that have ministers speaking words of the wisdom of this world but in their messages there is no meat of His Words, and there is not a teaching of the fear of God. These ministers are causing their people to stumble with the nuggets of wise knowledge that has nothing related to the wisdom of God's timing of the days we are now living in. These are teachers that have the people just to shut and get out there and get a job, get out there and pay your taxes, and get out there and vote for people to put in office. They ignore the truth of the system and the illegality of the Court systems. They ignore the establishment of false laws, or that the currency of the nation has nothing behind it, or that the tax system is illegal. They shut up and go along like those who allowed Jezebel to prosper. They know that the way of Jezebel is for a foreign party to come in to a nation and control and dictate policies to the nation's leaders. Jezebel made the priests of God to go into hiding and she would only allow those to preach who were compliant with the deceit of the national government. Jezebel sold the nation's treasures for foreign luxuries and corrupted all of the laws of the land. If one would look carefully at America we will see that even though the office of the President is operating the nation under a cloaked state of marshal law, there are ministers who have praised him and told their people to go along with him. They even go to Washington and have breakfasts and prayer meetings with him, while the ignore the obvious truth that he is directly to be held accountable for the policies of military leaders removing Jesus from all their chapels, and for the government justice offices restricting the worship of Jesus in the Federal prisons. They ignore the fact that under the War Powers Act that all of the Federal Judges operate only under the autonomy of the Presidents office, and that there truly are no runaway judges in America, as they all have to have the allowance of the President's office to establish these unjust rulings. These are all facts that are supported by many documents filed against Federal and Government officials. These are truths that have been spoken openly on public radio, especially on the Power Hour. The Scriptures revealed that Jezebel had killed all those who would stop her from her ways. She killed many priests of the Lord who spoke out against her false teachings. Jezebel had Naboth defamed by lies, and then murdered so that she could obtain his land by deceit. It has been reported in the last two weeks by the Power Hour that the U.S. government has placed over 300,000 Americans in Federal Prisons by exaggerated and false accusations so as to discredit them and to cause them difficulty in getting finance and other benefits. The Lord says that for those who will not walk justly, and who chase after the ways of the world to seek status positions among the kings of the world and the great business leaders, of whom He says in Revelation 18:3-4, 23 that they are all walking in fornication with the rulers of the City of Babylon, that if they do not repent and come out from following after them and seek

after the way of Truth, that He will cause their sins and their plagues to come upon them. They will see imprisonment, they will see economic collapse, and they will see much death, for those are their plagues.

☆ **Psalm 2:9** You shall break them with a rod of iron; You shall dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel.

We see a Jezebel spirit in many wealthy ministries that have grown by promotion of any gimmick and that support nearly any marketable avenue, all in the name of growing a global ministry. Instead of teaching His Words, they promote fiction books, fictional movies, and market all kinds of books on end time world events, without knowledge of His Words. They do not understand the Scriptures by the Words of God, but they trust in their wisdom over God's. Such ministries are little more than self-promotions designed to establish a profitable career and the obtainment of great luxuries of this world. The purpose and will of God for the Scriptural season that has been entered is of no true importance in comparison to the growth of the goal of their ministry. Jezebel had no fear of God, and her only goal was to use God's people to grow her own wealth and personal legacy. Jezebel came into a foreign nation, Israel, and grew her wealth and fame from the deceit of the people for the betterment of her career and legacy. The works of her ancestry are evidence of the tradition and wealth that she left behind for her seed to follow after her ruthless ways.

☆ **Matthew 23:15** ^{15m}Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you travel land and sea to win one proselyte, and when he is won, you make him twice as much a son of hell as yourselves.

The church of Thyatira includes those who eat things sacrificed to idols. This is prosperity teaching. The food that they eat is the words of prosperity ministers and their idol is the world's money and the world's luxuries. They ignore the Father's command that they are to teach God's Words on His Sabbath, or the Father has promised that He will hold them into account. Some prosperity ministers have boldly proclaimed that they have fired their church board because they would not agree with them that they should drive a Rolls Royce, or that they should purchase luxury jets. They desire to have great wealth of the world and they flaunt it. It has been reported that some pastors will fire associate pastors if they will not sacrifice and buy larger vehicles because it is a bad representation of their blessings from God. Still others have said that they will not establish a church board that will disagree with them or hold them into account. There are prosperity preachers living in small American towns and have more than one Rolls Royce sitting in their driveways. Others preach that God's way is that you focus on what you want and keep this in your mind and you pronounce this with your lips that this is what you want, and God will give it to you. When you name and claim things of the world you are speaking to demons if you are not obeying the Lord's command to increase in knowledge of Him so that you are able to enable the Father to do Good Works for others. The prosperity teaching is that you just ask God for what you desire. God's message is that you seek to do Good Deeds for others and trust Him without asking and without limitations for Him to give you all that you need and what is good for you.

☆ **James 4:4** Adulterers and adulteresses! (*Those who do not hear God's Words and do not seek Him for knowledge are chasing the wisdom of man, and that is as adultery before God, for God makes wisdom to be as a female helpmate that stands always beside us. And pursuing the wisdom that is of the men's words is a bride who is committing adultery before God with a false Bridegroom – the false and foolish teachers*). Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.

The people of the church of Thyatira hate those who bring them the Word because they will not endure reproof, as they believe that their abundance of worldly possessions stand as a testimony of their great knowledge of God and of His Spirit upon them. They do not test the spirit of error and the Spirit of Truth with all the Scriptures, therefore they follow the spirit of error and rob those people whom they have taken away from following after God. They have forgotten what God requires of them, and therefore they hate the messengers of His Word.

☆ **John 17:14** "I have given them Your Word, and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, just as I am not of the world."

Another spirit of Jezebel is churches' that operate Book Stores on His Holy Sabbath Day. That is the spirit of the world entering into His house. Outside of the Bibles, it would seem that nearly every book, tape, CD, and video that is sold in those stores have nothing to do with enabling the people to increase in the knowledge of God's Words so that they can enable the Father to do His Good Works for others. There are six days a week for which to purchase those tapes, books and CD's. Even the proceeds are going into churches not walking in obedience to God's laws to teach His Words on His Sabbath Day.

The spirit of Jezebel is a merchandising spirit and the greatest money boom in America and the world on the Sabbath day is sports. Everyone wants to have fun of the world's pleasures on His Sabbath Day. They shall not find His Peace, and they will be sent into the chains of being confined into a worm's body upon their earthly death. There they will become the sport game hunted by the Beasts in God's prisons. The Sabbath Day is for gaining in strength and there has to be a Blue Law put back into place as it was in the first church of Jerusalem. You can have all the fun and pleasure that you desire on His Sabbath, but you had better give consideration to the fact that in just over 3 years the Midnight Hour is coming. At that time the Holy Spirit will be removed from all who have sought their own pleasures on His Sabbath Day. They will not find these pleasures in the Time of the Night because the Lord is going to allow the world system to bring forth the famine and the Global Economic Collapse that they have been conniving to bring upon the world so that they can cause every country to eliminate their Constitutions and accept a One World Order Constitution in exchange for a credit line. Also they will cause people to be imprisoned so that the people will accept

whatever work and job that they assign to them based upon the characterization that they have been compiling of all the people in the world through a secret American company that is located in Boca Raton, Florida. This is prophesied in the Bible that this will occur and it has been proclaimed over the Power Hour radio show for months, but no one is listening because they love their life style and they do not want anything to interrupt their way of pleasure and lifestyle of luxury. The Lord Jesus wept over Jerusalem and He foretold the people to whom He had brought the Words of God to teach and to open, that within a short time there would not be one stone left not unturned in the Temple. They would not heed Him and within 40 years His prophecy was fulfilled. The Lord has told us in Zephaniah chapters 1 and 2 as to what is going to happen in this Day of the Lord, but we also refuse to hear Him. He has also warned us in the book of Amos that in these last days we should not forget the Affliction of Joseph; but we ignore the Lord, and we listen to the prophets of Baal that proclaim to keep on with your seed money gifts for there will be continued blessing and continued prosperity. That is not what the Bible foretells. The Bible reveals, and even the Prophecies that the Lord is giving through prophets and leading preachers even concur, if they will test them with the Scriptures, that we have three years left before the Midnight Hour. However, the Lord has said that soon He is going to start to cause the rumblings to grow and there will be people cut off and brought to shame if they do not repent. The Lord wants to save His people in America and He wants to set apart America, just as He desired to do so for Jerusalem, but as they said in Jerusalem, we are wise and in need of no reproof. (Note: I would ask that people consider reading "America in the Time of the Affliction of Joseph" and "He Makes Wise the Simple". These Writings are free downloads. They should help you to understand these last days from the Scriptures. They may be difficult reads but it is God's requirement of you that you increase in knowledge of God and what is His Will for us, as He has revealed in the Scriptures).

The people of this church are those who walk along in the way of this deception and deceit of the world, and they do not cry out for justice. They are growing mega-churches and leaving them to their offspring whom they have failed because they did not obey God and teach them the Words of God. Thus their offspring only perpetuate the nakedness of the leaders before them to the detriment of the congregations. They relish in their position of importance with the government leaders who are walking in deceit. They ignore the death of the millions of unborn babies and the removal of His Bible from the educational systems. These are the ways of those who allow Jezebel to prosper within their midst. The Lord is calling these people to come to the knowledge of Truth. The Lord says that in these last days that He is not going to allow anything that is secret to not be revealed. If His people turn to Him He will expose the Truth. But, notice that the Lord is saying to these people that if they will turn to Him that He will allow them to rise up and take control of their land. He is saying that He will strike the rulers who follow the way of Jezebel and crush them like potters vessels so that the nation is set apart and placed as a refuge for the Lord's people and nothing in the world can come against it. The Lord says that if His people will rise up that He will give them as to their works. The Lord has promised to bless those with talents so that in the Time of the Night they will be able to prosper as a nation so that His people are kept safe and secure. The Lord desires to establish America as like a land of Goshen for those who are to be gathered and kept safe and secure in the coming Time of the Night. If we do not hear Him then we will see the punishment of curse of God.

- ☆ **Luke 8:17-18** ¹⁷For nothing is secret that will not be revealed, nor *anything* hidden that will not be known and come to Light (*The entrance of His Words gives Light*). ¹⁸Therefore take heed how you hear. For whoever has, to him more will be given; and whoever does not have, even what he seems to have will be taken from him."
- ☆ **2 Corinthians 5:1-21** ¹For we know that if our earthly house, *this* tent, is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens. ²For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed with our habitation which is from heaven, ³if indeed, having been clothed, we shall not be found naked. ⁴For we who are in *this* tent groan, being burdened, not because we want to be unclothed, but further clothed, that mortality may be swallowed up by life. ⁵Now He who has prepared us for this very thing *is* God, who also has given us the Spirit as a guarantee. ⁶So we are always confident, knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from the Lord. ⁷For we walk by faith, not by sight. ⁸We are confident, yes, well pleased rather to be absent from the body and to be present with the Lord. ⁹Therefore we make it our aim, whether present or absent, to be well pleasing to Him. ¹⁰**For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things *done* in the body, according to what he has done, whether Good or bad.** ¹¹Knowing, therefore, the terror of the Lord, we persuade men; but we are well known to God, and I also trust are well known in your consciences. ¹²For we do not commend ourselves again to you, but give you opportunity to boast on our behalf, that you may have *an answer* for those who boast in appearance and not in heart. ¹³For if we are beside ourselves, *it is* for God; or if we are of sound mind, *it is* for you. ¹⁴**For the love of Christ compels us, because we judge thus: that if One died for all, then all died; ¹⁵and He died for all, that those who live should live no longer for themselves, but for Him who died for them and rose again.** ¹⁶Therefore, from now on, we regard no one according to the flesh. Even though we have known Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know *Him thus* no longer. ¹⁷Therefore, if anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. ¹⁸Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation, ¹⁹that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the Word of reconciliation. ²⁰Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore *you* on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God. ²¹For He made Him who knew no sin *to be* sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him. (*The Righteous always seek to enable the Father to do His Good Works*).

The people who follow the god of Dan are a very dangerous group because they offer teachings that have the sacred powers of God's Holy Words in them, and they market these items for financial gain like the Jews in the court of the Temple in the days of Jesus. For example there are those who are selling handkerchiefs claiming that they have the special anointing like Paul, and that they have prayed over these handkerchiefs, and for a certain amount of money you can receive the handkerchiefs that they are calling on God to give these people a healing. But these men who are selling such handkerchiefs are doing this without knowledge for financial gain and not for enabling the Father to do His Good Works for others. Paul would not have sent such a thing and ask for a cost from some one, for it would have taken away the anointing from the cloth. These men who are doing this are not doing so according to the ways of God's Words, which is the knowledge of the Mysteries, of which Paul and the other apostles had Understanding. This merchandising of God's Holy and Sacred things is not of God, when it is not done with Knowledge of God's Words and of His Promises. This is as the spirit of Jezebel. They use God's people for private financial gain and to support a career as a preacher that is not founded upon the Knowledge of Truth received from the Lord. There are other examples of selling Prayer Shawls and Holy Water, and the list goes on. There is a reason to sell items, but it has to be per the way that the Lord has ordained for these things. God's Words are Holy and it is not a wise thing to trample upon the Holy Things of God without Knowledge. The lesson of this is Uzzah who reached out to touch the Ark and God killed him. David immediately halted everything and determined to increase himself in the Knowledge of God before he touched such an article, and to do so only through those who were truly anointed by God to do so.

Church #5: The Church of Sardis that is commonly referred to in most Bibles as "The Dead Church"

- ☆ **Revelation 3:1-6** ¹"And to the angel of the church in Sardis write, 'These things says He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars: "I know your works, that you have a name that you are alive, but you are dead. ²Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die, for I have not found your works perfect before My God. ³Remember therefore how you have received and heard; hold fast and repent. Therefore if you will not watch, I will come upon you as a thief, and you will not know what hour I will come upon you. ⁴You have a few names even in Sardis who have not defiled their garments; and they shall walk with Me in white, for they are worthy. ⁵He who overcomes shall be clothed in white garments, and I will not blot out his name from the Book of Life; but I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels. ⁶He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches."

The meaning of Sardis is Remnant. This Church of Sardis is a strong Church. Like the first Church of Ephesus this Church loves God and they aspire to be a Spirit-filled Bible believing Church. They do not know that they are dead. They try to be strict followers of the Word. They could be like the Messianic Jewish churches that have a strong Bible teaching. The Lord says must repent, for they have ignored the Law of God that they must hear His Words to receive Eternal Life. The Sardis church is more likened to the Quiet Church. They are alive in God and they have praise and worship that gives off the appearance of being alive, but like the woman at Jacob's well in Samaria, they do not know what they worship. Thus, they have forgotten to Watch. Therefore they did not see that Jesus was coming back first in the flesh as His Word. He is now having the Spirit of Truth stir inside of them a desire to understand His Truth.

- ☆ **Luke 21:34-36** "But take heed to yourselves, lest your hearts be weighed down with carousing, drunkenness, and cares of this life, and THAT DAY (*The Day of the Lord that began in June 2003*) come on you unexpectedly. **FOR IT WILL COME AS A SNARE ON ALL THOSE WHO DWELL ON THE FACE OF THE WHOLE EARTH. Watch therefore, and pray always THAT YOU MAY BE COUNTED WORTHY to escape all these things that will come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man.**"
- ☆ **John 16:13-15** ¹³"However, **WHEN He, the Spirit of Truth, HAS COME, HE WILL GUIDE YOU INTO ALL TRUTH;** for He will not speak on His own, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. ¹⁴He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you. ¹⁵All things that the Father has are Mine. Therefore I said that He will take of Mine and declare it to you."

The Church of Sardis is close to God. They are almost ready lacking only to understand that there is a heavenly language. They may be intercessors and prayer warriors. They do good things for others, but they do not have that one thing that is going to get them into heaven – His Words. The Lord indicates that these people are not like the first church of Ephesus in one way. This people of the Sardis are Church are far less zealous. They do not zealously inspire to increase in the knowledge of God that will lead them into the ability to make them able to enable the Father to do His Good Works for others as they ask of Him. The Lord is saying that this church will be the ones whom it will be sufficient for them if they obtain the knowledge of His Words so that they are able to gain Eternal Life. These are those who are likely the ones who are going to turn to Him for His knowledge at the last minute before the Midnight Hour. Likely they are the ones who will see what the Lord does in Israel just before the Midnight Hour and it will awaken them. However, this is not a group who are working zealously to please God by increasing in knowledge to enable His to do His Good Works, and thus they do not attempt to do those things that will store up treasures for themselves in heaven. They do not rejoice at His Words as though they have found great treasure. However, if they do turn, repent, and obtain Eternal Life will be a very great thing, and all the angels will rejoice over them.

- ☆ **Matthew 12:37** "For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned."
- ☆ **Psalms 119:162** I rejoice at Your Word as one who finds great treasure.
- ☆ **Proverbs 4:20-22** ²⁰My son, give attention to My Words; incline your ear to My Sayings. ²¹Do not let them depart from your eyes; keep them in the midst of your heart; ²²for they are Life to those who find them; and health to all their flesh.

Church #6: The Church of Philadelphia that is commonly referred to in most Bibles as "The Faithful Church"

- ☆ **Revelation 3:7-13** ⁷"And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write, 'These things says He who is holy, He who is true, "He who has the key of David, He who opens and no one shuts, and shuts and no one opens": ⁸"I know your works. See, I have set before you an open door, and no one can shut it; for you have a little strength, have kept My Word, and have not denied My name. ⁹Indeed I will make *those* of the synagogue of Satan, who say they are Jews and are not, but lie--indeed I will make them come and worship before your feet, and to know that I have loved you. ¹⁰Because you have kept My command to persevere, I also will keep you from the hour of trial which shall come upon the whole world, to test those who dwell on the earth. ¹¹Behold, I am coming quickly! Hold fast what you have, that no one may take your crown. ¹²He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he shall go out no more. I will write on him the name of My God and the name of the city of My God, the New Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God. And I will write on him My new name. ¹³"He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches."

The meaning of the name Philadelphia is "Brotherly" or "Love of the Brethren". The Church of Philadelphia are those who are now receiving God's Words and they are diligently seeking to increase in the Knowledge of God's promises so that they are able to enable His Good Works during the coming Time of the Night. These are the True Worshipers of the Father. All those who receive His Words are Sons of God, and they are the true grafted in Jews of God's family. For they have received Eternal Life by readily receiving His Words when they first heard of them. These are the people called by Jesus, as like He called the twelve disciples, for He opened the Door. The clarity of the status of this church is that the people of this church have found that the Lord has the Keys – His Words - that unlock the House of David. The key to the House of David is the Words of God. David says so in Psalm 119:130. David also gives this knowledge to His Son Solomon. We can understand this Key from Isaiah 22:22. In that Scripture it is revealed that the Key to the House of David was given to the Messiah that the Father would send forth. Jesus came speaking the Words of God, and in Psalm 119:130 we are told that it is the entrance of His Words that gives us Light and that gives Understanding. Thus the Keys are His Words, and they unlock the Mysteries of the Knowledge of the Kingdom of God that enables the praise of Good Works and gains God's favor. That Knowledge is revealed only through Jesus and only to those who seek to pursue after the knowledge of His Words, for they are the Key that unlocks the Good Works of God and that enables the person who seeks them to find the favor of God. That is the Pearl of Great Price. The people of this Philadelphia Church are truly "The Highly Blessed of God", or "The Elect".

- ☆ **Isaiah 22:22** The Key of the House of David I will lay on His shoulder; So He shall open, and no one shall shut; and He shall shut and no one shall open.
- ☆ **Psalm 119:130** The Entrance of Your Words Gives Light; It gives Understanding to the Simple.
- ☆ **Proverbs 1:23** Turn at My reproof; Surely I will pour out My Spirit on you; I will make My Words known to you.
- ☆ **Proverbs 19:8** He who gets Wisdom loves his own soul; he who keeps Understanding will find Good.
- ☆ **Proverbs 11:27** He who diligently seeks "Good" finds favor.

The Lord has given high recognition and honor to those who will be among the servants, or brethren, of this Church. If they will persevere through until the Rapture, and hang onto what they have obtained, He will bless them and keep them safe and secure. Because they have received His Words they have already received the promise of being given the Crown of Life, and they will receive the Crown of Glory at His coming. The Lord has also promised them to be established as Pillars in the Temple of God in heaven. What a glorious reward this is! These are the people who will lead His people in the Time of the Night and be able to enable His Good Works for the Father to provide for those who have been sealed by God. As a Pillar in the New Jerusalem they will reveal the knowledge of God to His people. For in His Eternal Kingdom to give Praise means to do the Words of God and Give Glory to the Father, for God's Words are forever. In the Eternal Kingdom, from knowledge of His Words, His saints will enable marvelous works by God.

- ☆ **John 4:23-24.** But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in Spirit and Truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. **God is Spirit,** and those who worship Him must worship in Spirit and Truth. (True Worshipers will worship Him in His Words – Spirit, and in the way of His Good Works – Truth).

Please consider what the Lord is promising the people of this Church. He is going to write on them the name of His God, His name, and His City. That means that they are going to receive in heaven all the wisdom of the Words of God, all Understanding of Jesus, and the Way of Righteousness. Consider carefully: If you turn at your first calling, you will receive Knowledge of all wisdom, of all understanding, and the Knowledge of the Way of Righteousness. The Lord is going to make them a keeper of His Words in the Temple of His God in that city of His God, the New Jerusalem – that is as a High Priest. They will have the pleasure of always being with God and they will not be sent out any more. The Lord says this because as He was sent out, is how He is now sending these people out into the World. These people are those who have received His Words by at least this early time of these days of the last watch of the Evening of the Day of the Lord. This is truly a greatly blessed group, and at the Midnight Hour they will have the oil that is taken from others added onto their vessel. The Lord says that these people have already received the Crown of Life, for the Lord promises that whoever has received and has kept His Words has Eternal Life.

- ☆ **Psalm 119:162** I rejoice at Your Word as one who finds great treasure.
- ☆ **John 5:24-25** "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My Word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into everlasting life. Most assuredly, I say to you, the hour is coming, and now is, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God; **AND** those who hear will live."

- ☆ **Revelation 3:12** "He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he shall go out no more. I will write on him the name of My God and the name of the city of My God, the New Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God. And I will write on him My new name." (*The Lord is giving these people the name of God, His new name, and the name of His City. That is the knowledge of the wisdom of God, wisdom of understanding, and the knowledge of the Will – the city. He makes them High Priests over all His peoples – 1/3 of people who have ever lived*).
- ☆ **Psalm 119:97-105** ⁹⁷Oh, how I love your law! (*The law of the fathers to know His Words Deut. 11:18-21. David says in Psalm 119:142 that His Law is Truth, and Jesus told us that His Words are Truth*) **It is my meditation all the day.** ⁹⁸You, through your commandments, make me wiser than my enemies, for they are ever with me. ⁹⁹I have more understanding (*Knowledge of God*) than all my teachers, for Your testimonies are my meditation. ¹⁰⁰I understand more than the ancients (*Knowledge of God's Good Works*), because I keep your precepts (*ways*). ¹⁰¹I have restrained my feet from every evil way, **that I may keep Your Word.** ¹⁰²I have not departed from Your judgments, for you Yourself have taught me (*We are judged by His Words*). ¹⁰³**HOW SWEET ARE YOUR WORDS TO MY TASTE, SWEETER THAN HONEY TO MY MOUTH!** ¹⁰⁴**THROUGH YOUR PRECEPTS I GET UNDERSTANDING.** (*Precepts are the Promises of God and the way that the Lord Jesus uses the way of His Words to enable the Good Works of the Promises of the Father that are in His Words to be done*). ¹⁰⁵Therefore I hate very false way. **Your Word is a light to my feet and light to my path.**
- ☆ **Psalm 119:145-148** I cry out **with my whole heart**; Hear me, O Lord! I will keep Your statutes. I cry out to You; Save me, and I will keep Your testimonies. I rise before the dawning of the morning. And cry for help; I **hope in Your Word. My eyes are awake in the (Night) Watches that I may meditate on Your Word.**

Church #7: The Church of Laodicea that is commonly referred to in most Bibles as "The Lukewarm Church"

- ☆ **Revelation 3:14-22** (What is commonly called as: **The Lukewarm Church**) ¹⁴"And to the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write, 'These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God: ¹⁵'I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot. I could wish you were cold or hot. ¹⁶So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spew you out of My mouth. ¹⁷**Because you say, 'I am rich, have become wealthy, and have need of nothing' -- and do not know that you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked –** ¹⁸**I counsel you (warn you) to buy from Me gold refined in the fire, that you may be rich; and white garments, that you may be clothed, that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed; and anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see.** ¹⁹**As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. Therefore be zealous and repent.** ²⁰Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice AND opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me. ²¹To him who overcomes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne. ²²He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches."

The meaning of the name Laodicea is "Justice to the People" or "Judgment". I have already reviewed this Church earlier in this Writing. I have also reviewed this church more extensively in the Writings "*He Makes Wise the Simple*" and "*America in the Time of the Affliction of Joseph*". I hope that you will review those Writings. The Laodiceans are a people who believe that they are very rich in Knowledge and filled with the Spirit of God and lacking in nothing. You will notice that the Lord says that there is a Door provided for them, but it remains closed because they refuse to open it due to their pride and conceit. They are a people filled with the belief that they know everything. They are the people of the wealthy churches and extensive ministries. They are the people with the great wealth lacking nothing. They have private jets and drive big fancy cars, living in million dollar homes and having multi-million dollar ranch retreats and resort homes. They have TV ministries, they have schools and they have Bibles with their blueprint on them. They have foreign missions and they have outreach programs. They hold big conferences and have ministers and pastors coming to learn from them. They have satellite TV broadcasts and they active Internet Ministries. They have foreign conferences and they sponsor foreign schools and homeless children projects. On the surface they are of the giant white churches. They have everything and they are lacking in nothing. Yet this is the only church that God says is a wretched church whose people are blind, and naked of knowledge. The Lord is saying that all of their money is going to be as sand in their fingers for He is about to put the souls of these people into the chains of worm bodies in His prisons in the Outer Darkness and they will never see heaven or Eternal Life.

What is important about this Church of the Laodiceans is that the Lord says that this is the "almost" church. They are the Proud and Rebellious people. They are as much like the Jewish Priests, Pharisees and Scribes of Jesus Day as you can get. The Lord has placed a Door in their midst and they will not even try to open it despite His calling them by the works of the Spirit of Truth. The Lord is saying that not only is He standing outside the Door knocking on their hearts letting them know that there is many things amiss in the nation and in the church, He is also calling out to them with His voice, giving them prophecy on prophecy, and Word of Knowledge on Word of Knowledge, and vision upon vision. Yet they refuse to hear His calling, and they ignore the evidence of the Scriptures, and they desire instead to listen to themselves and to their close buddies who are just like themselves. These men are hearing the Word of God, but they are too proud to hear the message and test it with the Scriptures. For example I have heard TV Evangelists proclaim that the Words of God are now opened and yet they twist the Lord's message to just be another sign that everything is fulfilled and that the Lord could return at any moment. Prior to the Lord opening His Words these same men were proclaiming that everything was fulfilled. They do not receive the Lord's reproof, and thus they are blind to see that the opening of the Words of God was the opening of the Seal Judgments. They do not see that the Words of God are the key that unlocks understanding and opens the knowledge of the things to come. Interestingly I have heard them receive the Prophecy that the Sword of Truth has now come, and yet they refuse to see that this is the opening of the 2nd Seal Judgment. They remain waiting for the antichrist to appear on a white

horse. Jesus has come as the Spirit of God in His Words, and they do not receive Him. This is as like the Jewish priests in Jesus day would not receive Him as the Messiah because they ignored the warning of the Father that is recorded in Deuteronomy 18:18-19 that the Lord would come forth speaking the Words of God. The Bible records that the Pharisees and Scribes would come up to Him and ask what are these Words that you are teaching, but like the preachers of today they would not check them with the Bible to see what this meant. Thus they did not recognize Jesus as the Messiah. Now these Laodiceans will not recognize the Lord calling out His Words. They ignore the many prophecies that they are hearing that the Lord wants them to increase in knowledge. They trust in their own knowledge and they will not search the Scriptures nor will they receive the messenger the Lord has sent with His Words. They are repulsed that a discredited regular man would be given the Words of God. Thus they do not seek the Knowledge of Truth and they will not hear the message of the Knowledge of Truth. Therefore the Door that the Lord has set in the midst of their church goes untouched and unopened despite the knocking by the Lord and the calling out of His prophetic voice speaking the Good News of His Words being received. They have not accepted His calling for them to come to His Great Supper and to eat of the true Food of the Father that is sent down from Heaven.

This is the church of those who say that they are on fire for God and they are going all over the world trying to convert people, holding grand services and even pastor training conferences, yet they have no knowledge of God, and they have no clue as to the Knowledge of Truth. They are the wealthy churches of global evangelism wherein the pastors are flying jet airplanes and driving expensive cars, and having grand revivals. But there is not meat of heaven in these men and women, for they do not know the season. Even though the Lord is standing just outside, they do not see the way of His Words. They do not see the promises of God on the doorposts and they do not know to open His Door. They are filled with their own wisdom and they believe that they can cause the Global White Harvest Revival without Him. They have not heard His call to His Great Supper. The Lord is saying that if they do not turn, and repent, then He is going to cast them out of His Mouth, meaning that He is going to take His Spirit – His Words – away from them and they will be cast into the Outer Darkness.

This is the Church of the TV Evangelists. They are the people of the grandiose evangelism techniques and they are so busy enjoying their short to run stardom that they do not hear the voice of God calling out His Words and inviting them to His Great Supper. They do not try to open His Door and seek His knowledge because they believe that they are rich in the Spirit and filled with the Knowledge of God. They believe that they are masters of the knowledge of the book of Revelation, and they are so ready for heaven that they are telling their people to sit still and wait for there is nothing more that they have to do to get ready for the Rapture that they believe could happen at any time. They have not even tried to open the Door to seek His instruction and His knowledge because they believe that they are filled with the Holy Spirit, but the Lord says that they are blind and do not even know God.

This reminds me of the churches to whom I personally sent many copy of Writings on the Words of God. The Writings that went to some of these churches, and at least one church threw them into the trashcan. Thus by a lack of knowledge they blasphemed against the Holy Spirit. Of this group Paul said in 2 Timothy 3:1-9, that they will have a wonderful form of godliness, but there will not be found a shred of Knowledge of His Truth in them. They worship by their own wisdom and count the true wisdom of God as foolishness. They do not know the God of whom they worship. As Jesus said to the Samaritan woman in John 4:10, they do not know the Gift of God. If you send them a teaching that says that they must repent, they cry out that all such teachings that reproof them are written with a Spirit of Fear; yet they refuse to test their own teachings by the entire Bible.

☆ **2 Timothy 3:1-9** ¹But know this that in the last days perilous times will come: ²For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, ³unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, ⁴traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, ⁵having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away! ⁶For of this sort are those who creep into households and make captives of gullible women loaded down with sins, led away by various lusts, ⁷always learning and never able to come to the knowledge of the Truth. ⁸**Now as Jannes and Jambres resisted Moses, (The priests of the Pharaoh of Egypt) resisted Moses (Sent by God to reveal God's message and things to come) so does these also resist the Truth: men of corrupt minds, DISAPPROVED CONCERNING THE FAITH: ⁹but they will progress no further, for their folly will be manifest (Made evident) to all, as theirs also was.**

☆ **Hebrews 10:25-31** ²⁵...and so much more **AS YOU SEE THE DAY (Day of the Lord – that is the beginning of the Time of the End) APPROACHING.** ²⁶For IF we sin willfully **AFTER We HAVE RECEIVED the KNOWLEDGE OF THE TRUTH**, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins. ²⁷but a certain fearful expectation of judgment, and fiery indignation, which will devour the adversaries. ²⁸Anyone who has rejected Moses' law dies without mercy on the testimony of two or three witnesses. ²⁹Of how much worse punishment do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of Grace? ³⁰For we know Him who said "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says the Lord. And again, "The Lord will judge His people." ³¹It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the Living God.

☆ **John 8:47** "He who is of God hears God's Words; therefore you do not hear, because you are not of God."

☆ **John 4:3-10** ³He left Judea and departed again to Galilee. ⁴But He needed to go through Samaria. ⁵So He came to a city of Samaria which is called Sychar, near the plot of ground that Jacob gave to His son Joseph. ⁶Now Jacob's well was there (*A well dug by your own hand is doing the way of the Lord because you are seeking from the earth the waters of the extra blessings for the future that God has stored there from the Creation, as long as it remains in the will of God's plan of*

the ages. Jacob dug this well for the future blessings of His people). Jesus therefore, being wearied from His journey, sat thus by the well. It was about the sixth hour. ⁷A woman of Samaria came to draw water. Jesus said to her, "Give Me a drink." ⁸For His disciples had gone away into the city to buy food. ⁹Then the woman of Samaria said to Him, "How is it that You, being a Jew, ask a drink from me, a Samaritan woman?" For Jews have no dealings with Samaritans. ¹⁰Jesus answered and said to her, "**If you only knew the Gift of God, (His Words and the promises of the Works that are in them) AND** who it is who says to you, 'Give Me a drink', you would have asked Him, and He would have given you living water."

It is important to take notice in the Lord's letter to the Church of Laodicea that after the Midnight Hour falls on them the Lord is not going to give these people a second chance to repent. The reason is given in the fact that they have chosen their way, and they were given much wealth. They have had many resources available to them to search out His Truth and to hear His Words and discern the Light. But they remained filled with their own light, and it is growing dim for lack of real oil from heaven. This is revealed in Proverbs 1:20-33. The Lord is going to bring them to an end because He cannot give them more time past the Midnight Hour and be just to others. They are of those who have rejected his Knowledge and they have trampled upon the Spirit of Truth and therefore they have come to a moment where they will merit God's Wrath to be poured out upon them for all those whom they have caused to stumble in the Way. They have rejected to open the Door, and thus they have stood like Jannes and Jambres and they have resisted the Truth. Because of this they will be cast out for the Lord says that they are wretched and disapproved regarding the faith. As like those who follow Jezebel, so is it with the pride of those who will not receive reproof because they believe they are rich in the Spirit of God, and yet they do not know His Words are the Father and they are Spirit. They hate those who bring them the Word because they will not endure reproof, as they believe that their abundance of worldly possessions stand as a testimony of their great knowledge of God and of His hand upon them. They have forgotten what God requires of them, and therefore they hate the messengers of His Word.

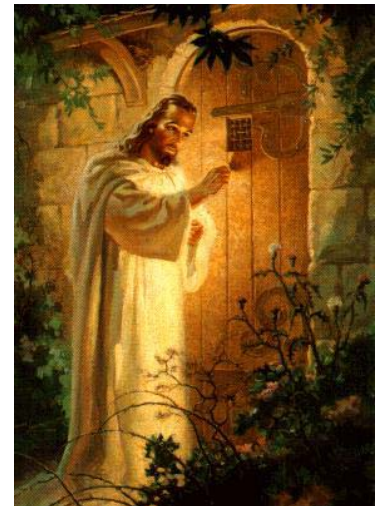
☆ **John 17:14** "I have given them Your Word, and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, just as I am not of the world."

☆ **James 4:4** Adulterers and adulteresses! (*Those who do not hear God's Words and do not seek Him for knowledge are chasing the wisdom of man, and that is as adultery before God, for God makes wisdom to be as a female helpmate that stands always beside us. And pursuing the wisdom that is of the men's words is a bride who is committing adultery before God with a false Bridegroom – the false and foolish teachers*). Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.

The people of the Church of Laodicea need to wake-up. They do not even believe their own name, for the Lord says that this is the church that is in the Judgment of God. Their actions of rejecting His knowledge will destroy them and they will be left outside and called as workers of lawlessness, for they have lead millions of people astray and caused countless of His little ones to stumble in the Way. They have been called to repentance before their shame is revealed, but they are resisting the need to repent. They are the blessed churches of this day having great wealth, but they are also of the church where the Spirit of Truth has come to judge them because they have been given so much. The Lord has placed in front of them Himself as the Door to the food of heaven. He is also calling out to them to hear His Words and has told them to rightly divide the Word of Truth, but they will not hear Him and the Door to knowledge remains untouched. They refuse to take the handle and to seek God to pour out His Spirit upon them so that He will make His Words known to them as He has promised to do in Proverbs 1:23. The Lord has opened His Words to all the people on the earth as Judgment, and this Church is the primary church of that Judgment. They are the first of the churches that will be judged, and they are in the most danger before God for He has allowed them to obtain much resources on this earth.

☆ **John 8:47** "He who is of God hears God's Words; therefore you do not hear, because you are not of God."

☆ **John 9:39-41** ³⁹And Jesus said, "For judgment I have come into this world, that those who do not see may see, and that those who see may be made blind." ⁴⁰Then some Pharisees who were with Him heard these words, and said to Him, "Are we blind also?" ⁴¹Jesus said to them, "If you were blind you would have no sin; but now you say, 'We see.' **Therefore your sin remains.**" (*How many believers today repeat this statement that Jesus is addressing? They say that "they see" and that they are rich in knowledge of Him. They believe that they are Spirit-filled and yet their heart is not open to receiving His Words. It does not mean that Jesus does not love them, but it does mean that their clock is running out. They are the lukewarm believers who are actually neither hot nor cold. They have a little of knowledge; but, at the midnight hour, what little knowledge of His Words that is His Holy Spirit, that they do have, will be taken from them and it will be added onto those who listened to His voice when He spoke His Words. At the Midnight Hour there will be many preachers, teachers, prophets, evangelists, healers, and even dedicated intercessors, who will awaken to the sudden reality that God no longer hears their prayers and no longer speaks to them. For they will be numbered among the unworthy because they rejected the knowledge of His Words when He opened It to them. They were not watching and they were caught unaware, and they fell by the way of the snare of these last days as Jesus forewarned them in Luke 21:34-36. They will be those who do not understand why the Lord says to them to depart from Me for I never knew you and they are workers of*

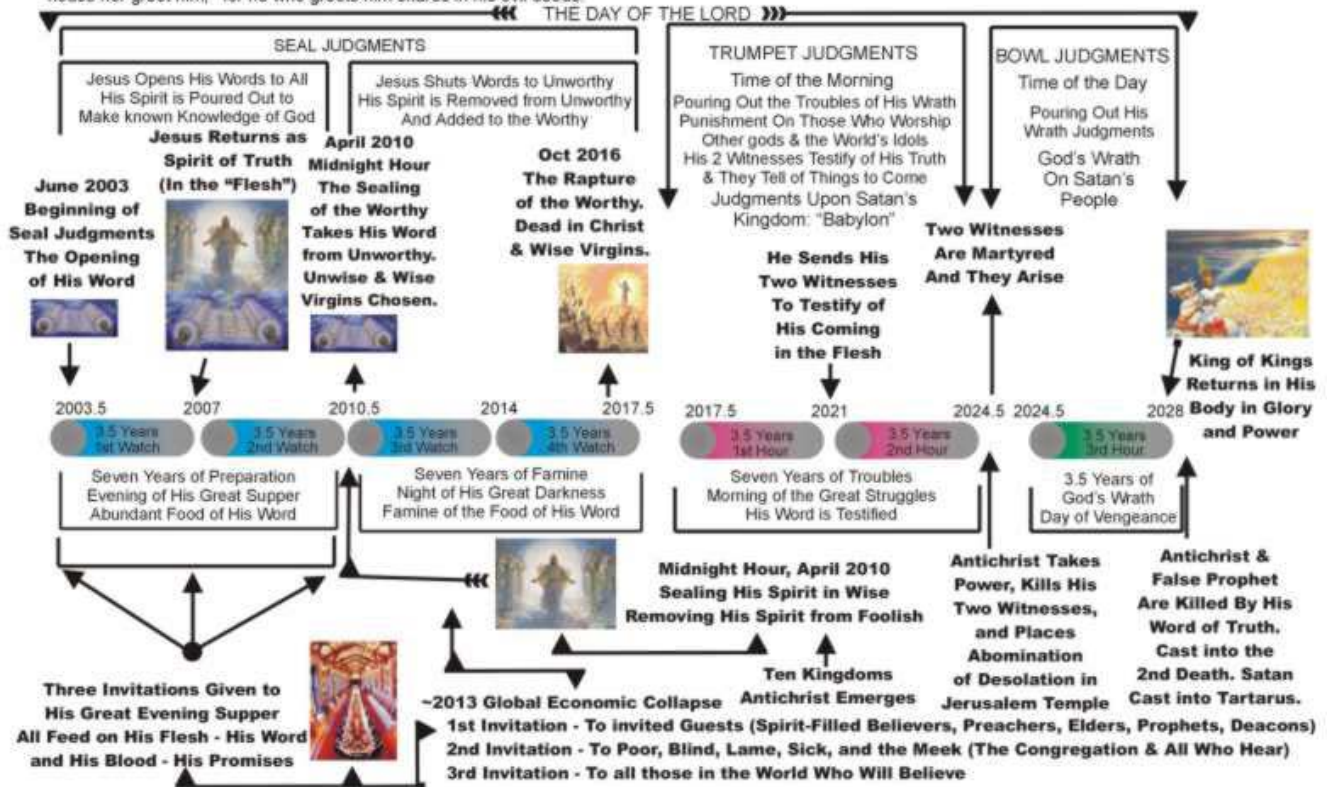


lawlessness. For it is a law of God that we teach His Words – Deuteronomy 6:4-9; Deuteronomy 11:18-21, and they ignored His law. I know of many who have heard His Words yet they do not teach them to their children or to those who are their friends. Their pride in their own knowledge will not allow them to receive the knowledge of His Words; nor do they desire to receive His messenger to whom He revealed His Words).

They are faced with the Door of Truth that stands before them as a Judgment. The Lord says that if they do not turn, repent and become zealous then they are never going to be allowed to taste of His Food. They will have rejected His invitation and they will be cast out into the Outer Darkness upon their earthly death. There are many big churches in places like Fort Lauderdale, Houston, Dallas, San Antonio, Los Angeles, San Diego, Seattle, Columbus, Chicago and so many other cities where the Lord is offering them the opportunity to hear His Words. It is truly sad, for the situation of these churches is similar to the Jewish synagogues in the days of Jesus. They are absolutely convinced that they are doing the work the Lord has called them to do in these days. They do not see that this is their last chance to repent of their pride before He reveals the true shame of their nakedness. If they do not turn then they are going to be asking God why they were cast out, and He will say depart from Me you workers of Lawlessness, I never knew you. The reason is that God is His Words and they never sought His Words for they loved their own words, thus they are naked, blind and wretched before Him.

JESUS IS COMING TWO TIMES IN THE FLESH

2 John 1-11 The Elder, to the elect lady and her children, whom I love in Truth, and not only I, but also all those who have known the Truth: because of the Truth which abides in us and will be with us forever: Grace, Mercy, and Peace will be with you from God the Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in Truth and Love. I rejoiced greatly that I have found some of your children walking in Truth, as we received commandment from the Father. And now I plead with you, lady, not as though I wrote a new commandment to you, but that which we have had from the beginning: that we love one another. This is love that we walk according to His commandments. This is the commandment, that as you have heard from the beginning, you should walk in it. For MANY deceivers have gone out into the world who do not confess Jesus Christ is coming in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an Antichrist. Look to yourselves, that we do not lose those things we worked for, but that we may receive a full reward. Whoever transgresses and does not abide in the doctrine of Christ does not have God. He who abides in the doctrine of Christ has both the Father and the Son. If anyone comes to you and does not bring this doctrine, do not receive him onto your house nor greet him; for he who greets him shares in his evil deeds.



☆ Proverbs 1:20-33 ²⁰Wisdom (*The Words of God that are our Helper, and that Jesus is calling out to us*) calls aloud outside (*of the city of the world*); she raises Her voice in the open squares. ²¹She cries out in the chief concourses, at the openings of the gates in the city She speaks Her Words (*The Words of God, that are also called the "Truth"*). ²²How long you simple (*naïve*) ones, will you love simplicity (*naivety*)? For scorners delight in scorning, and fools hate knowledge. ²³Turn at My reproof: Surely I will pour out My Spirit on you. I will make My Words known to you (*This has always been available to us, yet we failed to seek His Words and the understanding of the way of His "Good" Works*). ²⁴Because I have called and you refused. I have stretched out My hand and no one regarded (*This is a warning that we should not reject His Knowledge of Truth – His Words - when they are opened to us. He made it a Law in Deuteronomy 18:18-19 and we should listen because we are going to be judged by our obedience in Hearing Him*). ²⁵Because you disdained all My counsel, and would have none of My reproof, ²⁶also will laugh at your calamity; I will mock when your terror comes. ²⁷When your terror comes like a storm, and your destruction comes like a whirlwind. When distress and anguish come upon you. ²⁸Then they will call upon Me, BUT I WILL NOT ANSWER; they will seek Me diligently, but they will not find Me. ²⁹Because they hated knowledge,

and did not choose the fear of the Lord, ³⁰they would have none of My counsel, and would have none of My reproof. ³¹THEREFORE they shall eat the fruit of their own way, and be filled to the full with their own fancies. ³²For the turning away of the simple will slay them, and the complacency of fools will destroy them. (*Those who reject His Knowledge in these days when the Lord has opened the Words of His promises to them, as per Hosea 4:6, will be destroyed, and God will allow them to suffer the troubles of the 3rd, 4th and 5th Seal Judgments in the Time of the Night, while He keeps all those who received His Words safe and secure; as He will not allow His oil and wine to be troubled*). ³³BUT WHOEVER LISTENS TO ME WILL DWELL SAFELY, AND WILL BE SECURE (AT EASE) WITHOUT FEAR OF EVIL (*Please understand that this is great news revealed to you from God. For God is offering to you that if you turn, repent, and change, and if you pray to Him to change the nation, then during these coming times of trouble of the 3rd through the 5th Seal Judgments, that you will be kept safe and secure and you will be raptured with the Saints in the time of the 6th Seal Judgment*).

- ✧ **Luke 11:9** "And I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and it will be opened to you."
- ✧ **Matthew 7:7-8** ⁷"Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. ⁸For everyone who asks receives, and **he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.**"
- ✧ **Luke 11:9,10** ⁹"And I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. ¹⁰For everyone who asks receives, and **he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.**"
- ✧ **Luke 12:29-34** ²⁹"And do not seek what you should eat or what you should drink, nor have an anxious mind. ³⁰For all these things the nations of the world seek after, and your Father knows that you need these things. ³¹**But seek the Kingdom of God** (*The Kingdom of God is the Words of God that are inside you. You have heard and read them, but you do not know them. The Lord is saying to harvest these Words that have already been sown*), and all these things shall be added to you. ³²**Do not fear, little flock, for it is your Father's Good pleasure to give you the kingdom.** ³³Sell what you have and give alms; provide yourselves money bags which do not grow old, a treasure in the heavens that does not fail, where no thief approaches nor moth destroys. ³⁴**For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.**
- ✧ **Proverbs 4:1-7** "Hear, my children, the instruction of a father, and give attention to know understanding; for I give you Good doctrine: Do not forsake my law (*Solomon recognizes it as a law for him, the law of the fathers – per Deuteronomy 11:18-21*). When I was my father's son, tender and the only one in the sight of my mother, He also taught me, and said to me; "Keep my commands, and live. Get Wisdom! Get Understanding! Do not forget, nor turn away from the Words of my mouth (*Like Jesus, David spoke the Words of God, for he had a heart after God's own heart, and Jesus had god's Words written upon His heart – Acts 13:13:22*). Do not forsake her, and she will preserve you; love her, and she will keep you. Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom. And in all your getting, get understanding."
- ✧ **Romans 11:1-36** ¹I say then, has God cast away His people? Certainly not! For I also am an Israelite, of the seed of Abraham, of the tribe of Benjamin. ²God has not cast away His people whom He foreknew. Or do you not know what the Scripture says of Elijah, how he pleads with God against Israel, saying, ³"*Lord, they have killed Your prophets and torn down Your altars, and I alone am left, and they seek my life*"? ⁴But what does the divine response say to him? "*I have reserved for Myself seven thousand men who have not bowed the knee to Baal.*" ⁵Even so then, at this present time there is a remnant according to the election of grace. ⁶And if by grace, then *it is* no longer of works; otherwise grace is no longer grace. But if *it is* of works, it is no longer grace; otherwise work is no longer work. ⁷**What then? Israel has not obtained what it seeks; but the elect have obtained it, and the rest were blinded.** ⁸**Just as it is written: "God has given them a spirit of stupor, eyes that they should not see and ears that they should not hear, to this very day."** ⁹And David says: "*Let their table become a snare and a trap, a stumbling block and a recompense to them.*" ¹⁰**Let their eyes be darkened, so that they do not see, and bow down their back always.**" ¹¹I say then, have they stumbled that they should fall? Certainly not! **But through their fall, to provoke them to jealousy, salvation has come to the Gentiles.** ¹²Now if their fall *is* riches for the world, and their failure riches for the Gentiles, how much more their fullness! ¹³For I speak to you Gentiles; inasmuch as I am an apostle to the Gentiles, I magnify my ministry, ¹⁴if by any means I may provoke to jealousy those who are my flesh and save some of them. ¹⁵For if their being cast away *is* the reconciling of the world, what will their acceptance *be* but life from the dead? ¹⁶For if the firstfruit *is* holy, the lump *is* also *holy*; and if the root *is* holy, so *are* the branches. ¹⁷And if some of the branches were broken off, and you, being a wild olive tree, were grafted in among them, and with them became a partaker of the root and fatness of the olive tree, ¹⁸do not boast against the branches. But if you do boast, *remember that* you do not support the root, but the root supports you. ¹⁹You will say then, "Branches were broken off that I might be grafted in." ²⁰Well said. **Because of unbelief they were broken off, and you stand by faith. Do not be haughty, but fear.** ²¹**For if God did not spare the natural branches, He may not spare you either.** ²²Therefore consider the goodness and severity of God: on those who fell, severity; but toward you, goodness, if you continue in *His* goodness. Otherwise you also will be cut off. ²³And they also, if they do not continue in unbelief, will be grafted in, for God is able to graft them in again. ²⁴For if you were cut out of the olive tree which is wild by nature, and were grafted contrary to nature into a cultivated olive tree, how much more will these, who *are* natural branches, be grafted into their own olive tree? ²⁵For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own opinion, that blindness in part has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in. ²⁶**And so all Israel will be saved, as it is written: "The Deliverer will come out of Zion, and He will turn away ungodliness from Jacob; ²⁷For this is My covenant with them, when I take away their sins."** ²⁸Concerning the gospel *they are* enemies for your sake, but concerning the election *they are* beloved for the sake of the fathers. ²⁹For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable. ³⁰For as you were once disobedient to God, yet have now obtained mercy through their disobedience, ³¹**even so these also have now been disobedient, that through the mercy shown you they also may obtain mercy.** ³²For God has committed them all to disobedience, that He might have mercy on all. ³³Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable *are* His judgments and His ways past finding out! ³⁴"*For who has known the mind of the Lord? Or who has become His counselor?*" ³⁵"*Or who has first given to Him and it shall be repaid to him?*" ³⁶**For of Him and through Him and to Him are all things, to whom be glory forever. Amen.**

The Laodiceans are faced with great peril. They are the ones with much, but if you carefully study the Lord's prophetic warning, they are the people, along with the Nicolaitans, who will receive the first of God's punishments. They will fall very hard because among them are many of the national leaders of His Church, especially in America. The Lord says that they are in Judgment at this very day. As they reject the receiving of the Knowledge of Truth they are receiving their judgment. The Lord says in Luke 14:25 that if they reject His invitation, then they shall never taste of His food. Since the Lord tells us in John 6 that if we do not eat of His flesh, then we will not see Eternal Life, it means that these people are given a chance to receive His Words, but if they reject to receive His invitation to begin diligently to seek after the knowledge of Truth, then they are already being cut off from Him forever. If they open the Door the Lord says that He will dine with them and they with Him. This means that if they do open the Door the Lord is going to turn around their ministries and cause them to be on fire for God. He is saying that many great works will be done in their churches as He says that He will also be fed from them. The Sword of Truth that they have heard of is about to divide their churches, and take His peace from the unworthy.

THE PROMISE OF GOD IN THE WORD DOOR

After the Death of Christ the Father gave us a great gift. He tore the veil of the Temple and He sent His Son back to the Earth to open His Words that Jesus had spoken to the Disciples while He was with them, and then with the use of those Words He opened for them Understanding of the Scriptures. The Lord replaced the curtain of the Holy of Holies in the Temple with the Door of the new Church. Those early churches would have been obedient to God and posted the Words or the symbols of His Words on the posts of their church doors. As like the Jewish Priests, who over time and generations had lost the knowledge of the way of His Words and those lost the power of the promises of God that are in the Words of God found by walking through His Door to hear His Words, so has the preachers and evangelists lost the knowledge of His Word of the posts of the Door. They have lost the meaning of the Door of the Lord that is the entrance to the instruction of His promises that are in God's Words. The church is a mighty weapon of the Lord. When we enter into the church and shut the door and hear His Words being spoken, then the way of the Words of God has been fulfilled for the promise of the Lord that He will pour out His Spirit upon the minds of the people inside who have come to seek knowledge from Him. He has promised that if His ministers speak His Words and not their own words that He will pour out His Spirit upon us and make His Words known to us. That promise is enabled by the entrance of the Door of His church and the closing of that Door with His people inside. For the Door is the symbol of His Instruction, and the posts of the Door is the holder of His Words that contain all of His promises.

The Lord has not just given the promise of His word "Door" to the churches. He has given it to us for use in every house, in every vehicle, in every business office, and in every Government office. That promise is that if you will open the Door and enter and close the Door behind you, that you have fulfilled the saying of the Word Door as it is seen in heaven, and you have turned at His reproof, and therefore He has promised that He will pour to His Spirit upon you and make His Words known to you. The Key of the House of David are the Words of God that give us entrance to the Holy Spirit of God (*The Light*) and the Spirit unlocks His Words to give us Understanding of the Knowledge of the Holy One, the Father who does the Good Works for us as we ask. When we have increased in knowledge and have received His Will to be understood when to be doers of His Words to enable those Good Works of the Father, then we give Glory to the Father. By entering His Door and diligently seeking to receive knowledge of His Words, we also begin to receive His favor. The promises of God are in His Words that are in the posts of the Door. But, it is Jesus Christ who is the Door that enters us into instruction. Only through seeking Jesus Christ for understanding we will be able to come to the knowledge of the Father who is the promises of the Holy Spirit that are in His Words. The Spirit of Truth is the Holy Spirit – His Words – and His Words are God, and Jesus and the Father are One. His Words are supernatural, as we unlock His Words as they are spoken in heaven we find Good, and only the Father is Good; and we find Eternal Life, for the Crown of Life is a free Gift of God in each of God's 153 Words.

☆ **Romans 6:23** For the wages of sin is Death, but the Gift of God is eternal Life in Christ Jesus our Lord. (*The Gift of God is that Jesus returned to open His Words and to give us understanding of Himself, for in His Words all things exist and consist, and all power resides in His Words*).

Note: It would be wise for all people to obtain a Jewish Prayer Shawl and to use it diligently and reverently. For it has embedded within its design the posts of the Door and the Door with His Holy Words symbolized. This will enable their prayers to be heard in heaven when they do not have a room to enter, or there is no room where the Holy Words of God are not symbolized on the posts of the Door. It may be interesting to note that the Scripture tells us in Numbers 15:37-41 that the Prayer Shawl is to have a blue thread woven through it and the Tzitzis. The gematria of Hebrew words for "a thread of Blue" is equal to the sum of 1370. The 1370 is equal to 2 X 5 X 137. (The number 137 is related to the secret of the balance of all particles that exist). That is the same gematria as the Hebrew words for "Mighty King". The word "Mighty" in the Bible is symbolized by the Lord of those who have the knowledge to understand that God has assigned a frequency to each and every particle, as well as a group frequency to each group of particles. It is the key that unlocks creation, and only those who have power over the elements are called Mighty. There is God alone who is a Mighty King. The only other who tried was Nimrod who tried to become a Mighty Hunter before the Lord, and God had to come down and destroy Him. The other man who will try to be a Mighty Hunter before the Lord is the antichrist who will emerge and begin to come forth just after the Seal Judgments. The Bible records that He will try to change the seasons and the times by using frequency to control the things in the heavens; but the Bible records that the Lord God will come down and destroy him before he destroys the entire world in his effort.
