THE MEANING OF THE WORD GOOD, AS IT IS SPOKEN AND DONE IN HEAVEN

Jesus reveals within the Bible that only God is Good, and that the Works that God does for causing man to believe in His Son, are called His "Good Works". The great King David confirms to us that God is Good and that He does Good. King David says that God looks down from heaven above to see if any of us understand, if anyone of us does Good, but the Lord finds that there is not even one of us who Understands, thus not one of us does Good. However, Jesus testified that He has shown us many Good Works of His Father. Jesus says that the very Works that He did on earth were the Works of His Father. To this the Lord adds that the desire of the righteous is only to do Good, and Jesus says that He is Righteous and that He has done the Works of the Righteous.

The Lord says that the primary thing that He desires from us is that we do Good, and that we increase in the knowledge of the Holy One. The Lord reveals to us that if we diligently seek "Good", then we will find the favor of God. Jesus further adds that those who do the Works of Righteousness shall receive the sure reward. The Bible reveals that all those who receive His Words into their heart receive the wisdom to set their heart upon working diligently to increase in the Knowledge of His Words, for the purpose of obtaining Understanding of the ways of His Great Works, shall obtain the promise of God's favor and blessing. Further to this the Bible reveals that all who obtain Understanding so that they are fully equipped to do the ways of His Words so that He is enabled to do His Good Works, shall Glorify the Son, and Glorify the Father, and they shall receive the sure reward. For the Lord says that a faithful servant is justly due His wages. All who do His "Good" receive His promise of Eternal Life as a sure reward. His Word "Good" is the key that fulfills God's desires and unlocks the favors and the blessings of God.

THE WAY OF THE WORD GOOD

The greatest Word ever given to man within the Bible is the Word "Good". In fact Paul teaches us that the entire purpose of the Scriptures is to fully equip us to do every "Good" Work (*2 Timothy 3:16-17*).

- ☆ **2 Timothy 3:16-17** ¹⁶All scripture (*All of God's Prophetic Word has to agree with Scripture*) is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: ¹⁷**that the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all "Good" Works.**

Interestingly, the Bible reveals that the Word "Good" is the only Word in the entire Bible that not even one man understands (*Psalms 14:2-3, Psalm 53:2-3*).

- ☆ **Psalms 14:2-3, & Psalm 53:2-3** ²The Lord looks down from Heaven upon the children of men, **to see if there are any who understand, WHO SEEK GOD.** ³They have all turned aside, they have together become corrupt; **there is none that does "GOOD", no, not one.**

One would normally think that if the Bible makes such a declaration, then man would surely focus a lot of his resources, both in time and in dollars, into finding the answer to this Word and to discover why would King David say that that not even one man understands it. You would think that every rich man would expend every available possible dollar to uncover the secret of "Good" because the Bible adds a very interesting fact about this Word. The Bible says that if we even begin, in a truly diligent way to seek out the understanding of this Word "Good" that we actually obtain the "favor" of God. That means if we set it upon our heart to begin diligently seeking after the understanding of this Word "Good" as it is known to God, then the favor of God will begin to be poured out upon us.

- ☆ **Proverbs 11:27 He who DILIGENTLY SEEKS "Good" FINDS favor.**

Jesus told us in Acts 13:22 that King David had a heart that was likened to His own and that David would do all His Will? Let us consider this a little more carefully for a moment. King David recorded in Psalms 14:2-3 and 53:2-3, that no one understands and no one does Good. If you really consider this statement carefully it would surely seem like a very prideful statement to proclaim. If you made that statement today, I am sure that everyone would take offense and likely they would consider to throw you out of their house, out of their church, and possibly even out of a country. If you consider another bold statement made by David, one could also receive the idea that David was prideful. That proclamation is found in Psalm 119:97-100. In that passage David says that he has more understanding than not only his teachers, but he also adds that he has more understanding than all the ancients of Israel. Yet, David is the most beloved man of all Israel. The Lord's statement in Acts 13:22 seems to also reveal that David is the most loved man in the eyes of the Lord. If David's statements were prideful then surely the Lord would not say that He loved David's heart. The Lord would have rebuked David's statements. So what truth is hidden here that would enable David to proclaim these seemingly prideful statements, and yet in these statements the Lord is not disagreeing with what David said?

- ☆ **Acts 13:22** ²²And when He had removed him (*King Saul*), He raised up for them David as king, to whom also He gave testimony and said, **"I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after My own heart, who will do all My will."**
- ☆ **Psalms 119:97-100** ⁹⁷Oh, how I love your law! (*God's law to hear, to do, and to teach His Words, per Deuteronomy 18:8-9; 6:4-9; and 11:18-21*). It is my meditation all the day. ⁹⁸You, through your commandments, make me wiser than my enemies; for they are ever with me.. ⁹⁹**I have more understanding that all my teachers, for Your testimonies are my meditation.** ¹⁰⁰**I have more understanding than the ancients, because I keep your precepts.**

Let us consider something else as we meditate upon that question. Have you noticed that Jesus said some seemingly similar prideful things while He walked on the earth? Clearly Jesus said many things that offended the Priests, Pharisees, and Scribes, but take notice that in John 4:22, the Lord said something very similar to the Samaritan woman and in His statement He included all the people of Samaria. He told the Samaritan woman that she and her people, "do not know" what they worship. This woman said that they have worshipped on that mountain. So what was wrong with what they worshipped? Did not they worship God. I would gamble that those people in Samaria went to the synagogue far more than we do today, and that they may have even listened more intently than we do today. So what is truly wrong with the picture? You can say that they did not know about Jesus. Yet Jesus reveals that He made this statement a totally different way than focusing it on Him. He is saying that these Samaritans who worshipped God the Father did not know the Father. He then tells the Samaritan woman what the Father is looking for. He did not say that it is what He was looking for. He is saying it is what the Father is looking for – "True Worshipers". She did not know how to respond, for she did not know who this was who was teaching her these things. So she responds very well, as she proclaims what she had been taught, that when the Messiah comes He is going to teach us all things about the Father. Jesus responded to her that He was the Messiah. Thus, in this dialogue between the Samaritan woman and Jesus we have learned that one of the Works of the Messiah was to teach us "ALL THINGS", and that includes that He was sent to teach us "The Father".

☆ **John 4:19-24** ¹⁹The woman said to Him, "Sir, I perceive that You are a prophet. ²⁰**Our fathers worshipped on this mountain,** and you Jews say that in Jerusalem is the place where one ought to worship." ²¹Jesus said to her, "Woman, believe Me, the hour is coming when you will neither on this mountain, nor in Jerusalem, worship the Father. ²²**YOU WORSHIP WHAT YOU DO NOT KNOW, we know what we worship, for salvation is of the Jews.** ²³**But the hour is coming, AND NOW IS, when the TRUE worshippers will worship the Father in Spirit and Truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him.** ²⁴God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship Him in Spirit AND Truth." ²⁵The woman said to Him, "I know that Messiah is coming" (Who is called "Christ"). "When He comes, He will tell us all things." ²⁶Jesus said to her, "I who speak to you am He."

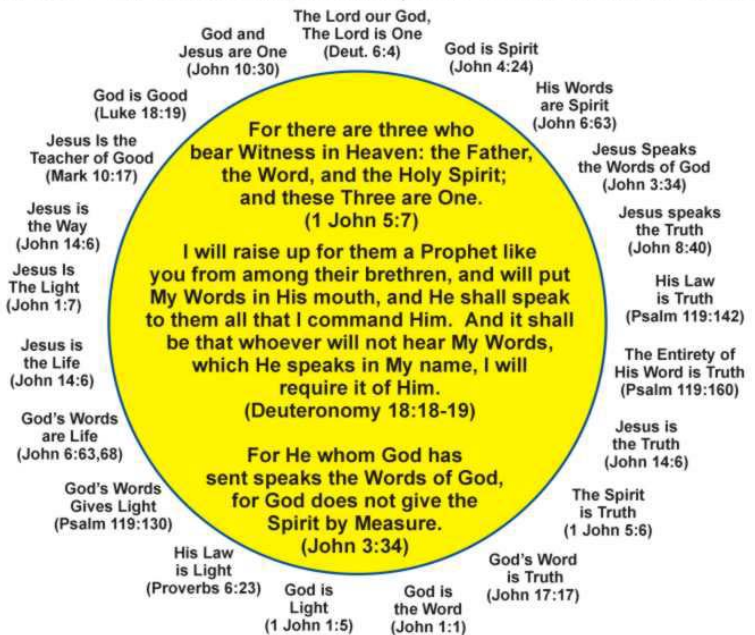
Now, consider for a moment the circle of God. In John 4:24 the Lord tells the Samaritan woman that God is Spirit. In 1 John 5:6 we are told that the Spirit is Truth. Thus, since God is Spirit and the Spirit is Truth, it means that God is also Truth. When we consider that in John 14:6, the Lord Jesus says that He is the Truth. Thus, His statement of John 10:30 that the Father and He are One, means that He is also the Father God. It also means that Jesus is the Spirit of Truth. Now consider carefully again that Jesus is saying in John 4:19-24, that He is going to teach to us "all things of the Father". In John 16:13 the Lord tells us that when the Spirit of Truth has come, that He will reveal "ALL TRUTH" to us. This is a confirmation of the response that the Lord gave to the Samaritan woman in John 4:19-24, for He is saying that the Spirit of Truth is going to teach us about the Father.

☆ **John 16:13-15** ¹³However, **WHEN He, the Spirit of Truth, HAS COME, He will guide you into all Truth;** for He will not speak on His own, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. ¹⁴He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you. ¹⁵All things that the Father has are Mine. Therefore I said that He will take of Mine and declare it to you."

☆ **John 14:6-7** ⁶Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. ⁷If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; and from now on you know Him and have seen Him."

Now, consider adding another variable into your thought process to meditate upon: Why does Jesus tell His disciples that they have not known Him in John 14:7? Jesus had just spent 3.5 years walking, fellowshiping, preaching, teaching, and traveling all over Israel with His disciples. What was He truly saying when He proclaims that they have not known Him? It would seem that if you were with Jesus that long of a time, that surely they would have known Him. Had not Peter say that He was the Christ, the Son of the Living God? Jesus had told this truth even to the Samaritan woman. So what is it that we are missing in understanding "the Christ"? Does it not seem that we are missing some knowledge about something? Why does it seem by these examples that we could possibly go through a lifetime walking right beside Jesus, and then He would say to us "You do not know Me"? How can that be? Some of these men had been disciples of John the Baptist. How is it possible that they did know Him? You

might say well John the disciples surely knew Him, but if we think about it, John is the one recording this and in John 21:24 he testifies that all these things that he recorded were true.

When you ask yourself that question, you might think about what the Lord is saying about the many preachers, prophets and evangelists of these last days who are going to be shocked at the time of the Rapture and they find that they are to be left behind and cast out into the Outer Darkness to be continuously tortured, torn, and eaten by the Beasts reserved for them in the prisons of God in the Outer Darkness. Jesus says that many are going to come to Him in that day and they are going to claim that they healed many in His name, cast out demons in His name, they prophesied in His name, and that they even did many miracles for people in His name. Clearly these are people who go to church and are loyal worshippers. Clearly there are many intercessors and wonderful people in this crowd. This crowd is obviously faithful in going to church, tithing, and in worshiping Him. Yet, we see in Matthew 7:21-23, that many Jesus is going to say that He did not even know them and that they practiced lawlessness. They cast out demons and enabled miracles in the name of Jesus, how is it possible that He did not even know them? If you prophesy are you not hearing from the Spirit of God? If you are enabling miracles are you not communicating with God? If you are casting out demons in Jesus name are you not honoring God? What can possibly be missing in this picture? Jesus is saying to these people that they do not know Him. That is the something that He said to His own disciples in John 14:7. That is really the same thing that He said to the Samaritan woman in John 4:22. What is missing from this picture that would tell us why they do not know Him?

- ☆ **Matthew 7:21-23** ²¹"Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. ²²Many will say to Me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?' ²³And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!'.

Let us go back to John 14:6-7 and look at the continuation of this statement of Jesus one more time. In John 14:7 Jesus is saying that if the disciples would have known Him, then they would have also known the Father, and further, He adds that because they have seen Him they have seen the Father. I have heard countless preachers teach that Jesus is saying that when you look upon Him you are looking upon God because Jesus and God are One. However, is that all that Jesus is saying here? If He were limiting His instruction to that then He would have said it that way. There is more to this statement than what we are seeing. Remember that Jesus told us in John 6:44-46 that those who come to Him are drawn to Him by the Father.

- ☆ **John 14:6-7** ⁶Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. ⁷**If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; and from now on you know Him and HAVE SEEN HIM.**"
- ☆ **John 6:44-46** ⁴⁴"No one can come to Me unless the Father who Me draws him; and I will raise him up at the last day. ⁴⁵"It is written in the prophets, 'And they shall all be taught by God.' Therefore everyone who has heard and learned from the Father comes to Me. ⁴⁶Not that any man has seen the Father except "he" who is from God; he has seen the Father." *(Most Bibles write this "he" as "He", but it should be "he". Because in verse 44 the Lord reveals that God drew those to Him who come to Him. These are those that from the desire to be of God, they are coming to Him to gain instruction and knowledge of His Words that are God. For His Words is God, and God is Spirit, and the Spirit is Truth, and the entirety of His Words are Truth. Thus, those that are coming to Him for knowledge were drawn to Him from God who has revealed to them that it is Jesus who pours out the Spirit of Truth and makes His Words – that are God – known to them, as He promises in Proverbs 1:23)*

I realize that this seems confusing to grasp, but please persist to see this through, because I believe that the Lord is trying to give you a deeper understanding of God than you have had. If we go back to Deuteronomy 18:18-19 and consider the purpose of the Father sending Jesus in to the world, we find that Jesus was sent to the earth to do two things: (1) To speak the Words of God; and (2) to do all that He is commanded by the Father to do. We know that John the Baptist testified to the fact that Jesus came into the world to speak the Words of God as they are known in heaven, and that the language of heaven is different than the language of earth. Now easily we can understand that Jesus came to speak the Words of God and to teach people, but what did He do to speak God's Words? In Isaiah 50:4 the Lord prophetically reveals that the Father would awaken Him early every morning and He would reveal to Him HOW TO SPEAK a Word of God at the right time and place so that He could help someone who is weary. Jesus was revealing to us that He came speaking the Words of God, but that He also came doing the Words of God at the right time and place as the Father instructed Him to do. This helps us to understand the instruction of James, the step-brother of Jesus, and the leader of the church in Jerusalem, who says in James 1:22 that we are to be doers of the Word and not hearers only.

- ☆ **Deuteronomy 18:18-19** ¹⁸"I will raise up for them a Prophet (*Jesus*) like you from among their brethren, and **will put My Words in His mouth, and He shall speak to them all that I command Him.** ¹⁹**And it shall be that whoever will not hear My Words, which He speaks in My name, I WILL REQUIRE IT OF HIM.**"
- ☆ **Isaiah 50:4** ⁴"The Lord God (*The Father God in Heaven*) has given Me (*Jesus*) the tongue of the learned, that I should know HOW TO SPEAK a Word IN SEASON to him who is weary. He (*The Father*) awakens Me (*Jesus*) morning by morning. He awakens My ear to learn as the learned.
- ☆ **John 3:34** ³⁴"For He whom God has sent speaks the Words of God, for God does not give the Spirit by measure."

- ☆ **James 1:22-24** ²²But be doers of the Word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. ²³For if anyone is a hearer of the Word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror; ²⁴for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was.

This brings us back to David's proclamation of Psalm 14:2-3 and Psalm 53:2-3. In those verses there is one point that is made abundantly clear, David reveals that "Good" is something that is being physically done. It is an action word, and David is revealing that we do not understand and we are not doing that action of "Good". It also brings us back to the explanation of the apostle Paul that tells us that the entire Bible is provided for the purpose of fully equipping us to do every "Good Work". The Lord is revealing through David that we have missed it. The purpose of the Bible is to reveal His Words and give us understanding so that we can DO His Words and enable a Good Work to be done for someone who is weary at the very right time that has been designated by the Lord. This is the essential meaning of the Father telling us when to speak His Word "in Season" to do a "Good Work" as He desires.

- ☆ **Psalm 14:2-3, & Psalm 53:2-3** ²The Lord looks down from Heaven upon the children of men, **to see if there are any who understand, WHO SEEK GOD.** ³They have all turned aside, they have together become corrupt; **there is none that does "GOOD", no, not one.**
- ☆ **2 Timothy 3:16-17** ¹⁶All scripture (*All of God's Prophetic Word has to agree with Scripture*) is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: ¹⁷**that the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all "Good" works.**
- ☆ **John 10:32** ³²Jesus answered them, "Many Good Works I have shown you from My Father.
- ☆ **Matthew 5:48** "Therefore you shall be perfect (*Completed – meaning to be fully equipped*), just as your Father in heaven is perfect." (*This verse means that we are to fulfill the purpose of the Bible that is given in 2 Timothy 3:16-17, that we are to increase in knowledge and understanding so that we become fully equipped for every Good Work that the Father gives to us the opportunity to perform.*)

Could it be that the obtainment of the knowledge of Good is very high on the list of God's priorities for us? In the Bible the Lord proclaims that it is that important to Him. For in the Bible the Lord reveals that the desire of God for us, His desired requirement for us, is only three things: (1) That we work justly, (2) That we do Good Deeds, and (3) That we increase in Knowledge of God.

- ☆ **Micah 6:8** ⁸He has shown you, O man, what is Good; and what does the Lord REQUIRE of you but to do justly, to love Good Deeds, and to walk humbly with your God?
- ☆ **Hosea 6:6** ⁶For I desire "Good Deeds" and not sacrifice, and the "knowledge of God" more than burnt offerings.

Micah 6:8 reveals that we are in fact required to increase in Knowledge of God if we are going to do what is desired of God. That helps to give us some insight in understanding the Lord's prophetic statements recorded in Daniel 12:4, 9-10. The Lord says that at the Time of the End He is going to open His Words and He is going to unseal the Book and the result is that it is going to cause many people to go to and fro so that they increase in knowledge. The Lord is not referring to just knowledge that we see in the world, such as going from steam engine train to supersonic jet aircraft and space shuttles within a time of just 100 years. The Lord is referring to the Biblical meaning of knowledge as it is revealed in Proverbs 9:10, that the knowledge of the Bible is the knowledge of the Holy One. The Lord also reveals that it is because of a lack of this knowledge that His people are destroyed. It is a lack of Knowledge of God and of how to do Good that is going to bring us to our being left out of the Rapture and to our destruction. The Lord reveals to us that the way to get the Knowledge of God is to hear His Words. For it is revealed by David in Psalm 119:130, that it is through the entrance of His Words we receive God in us, for God is Light. And David adds that it is also through the entrance of His Words we that we receive the understanding that is the knowledge of God. Jesus states all of this more bluntly in John 8:47, wherein He warns us that if we do not hear God's Words, then we are not of God. That is because it is through the entrance of His Words that God is able to install into us the Knowledge of God and the knowledge of God's laws of all things that enables our understanding so that we are fully equipped to do every Good Work. If we obtain this knowledge then we satisfy the desires and requirements of God. This is as He revealed in Micah 6:8 and Hosea 6:6.

- ☆ **Daniel 12:4** "But you, Daniel, **SHUT UP THE WORD, and SEAL the BOOK until the TIME of the END;** many shall run to and fro, AND **KNOWLEDGE SHALL BE INCREASED.**"
- ☆ **Daniel 12:9-10** ⁹And He said, "Go your way, Daniel, for **the Words are closed up and sealed till the Time of the End.** ¹⁰**Many shall be purified, made white, and refined,** but the wicked shall do wickedly; and **none of the wicked shall understand, but THE WISE SHALL UNDERSTAND.**
- ☆ **Proverbs 9:10** Understanding of the Holy One is knowledge.
- ☆ **Hosea 4:6** "MY PEOPLE ARE DESTROYED FOR LACK OF KNOWLEDGE. BECAUSE YOU HAVE REJECTED KNOWLEDGE, I also will reject you from being a priest before Me because you have forgotten the law of your God I also will forget your children."
- ☆ **Psalm 119:130** **The Entrance of Your Words Give Light;** It gives Understanding to the Simple.
- ☆ **1 John 1:5** This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that **God is Light** and in Him is no Darkness at all.
- ☆ **John 8:12** "I am the Light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in Darkness, but have the Light of Life."

- ☆ **John 8:47** ⁴⁷“He who is of God hears God’s Words; therefore you do not hear, because you are not of God.” (*How can Jesus state this more clearly?*).

Note: *God’s Word is Truth, for all 153 of His Words are found within His Word “Truth”, for the entirety of all His Words is Truth and all of Law is Truth. One cannot walk justly without doing the Truth. This is why He uses a singular “word” in Daniel 12:4, and a plural “Words” in Daniel 12:9. They are one in the same, but the expression in Daniel 12:4 is given to express the fullness of the purpose He gives us His Words, for God is Truth and the Spirit is Truth and all their Words are Truth, and God is Good, and all the Works that God does are Truth, so His “Work” is to do “Good Works” that glorify His Word.*

Consider that these people that He refers to in Matthew 7:21-23 have to be what we refer to in this day as “Spirit-filled Believers, Spirit-filled Evangelists, and Spirit-filled Prophets, Spirit-filled Intercessors, and Spirit-filled Healers”. For the Lord says that they have knowledge that they are to heal in His name and cast out demons in His name. These people spoke prophecies, healed the sick, and cast out the devil. That is not simple, and it is not the works of people whom we would say do not know the Lord. In fact those are the works of some of the best Christians of this day. A close friend reminded me that the apostle Luke reveals to us in Acts 19:11-20 that the seven sons of a Jewish priest, attempted in an exorcism to use the name of Jesus and the name of Paul, to cast out an evil spirit from a house, and the evil spirit attacked them in that house, and they fled wounded and naked. So the actions that the Lord is referring to in Matthew 7:21-23, are not slight things done by brash people without some knowledge of God. It is just like the Lord telling His disciples that after walking with Him for 3.5 years, that they still did not know Him – John 14:7. If these preachers, disciples, apostles, prophets, evangelists, intercessors, deacons, and theologians are found to not have knowledge at the Midnight Hour, then what will be the end of the poor sheep and children of the congregations who have been taught by them? Now you may see, why I have taken so long to get to this point. This is very serious matter. David is telling us and the Lord is telling us that we lack knowledge and that we are about to be cast out because we are only lukewarm when we thought that we are filled with the Spirit and not lacking in knowledge of God. Now perhaps you can understand why the Lord prophesied in Luke 21:35 that the Day of the Lord would come upon everyone on the face of the whole earth as a snare. Perhaps now the “Spirit-filled Christians” will be able to understand why they are included in this warning of the Lord. The Lord has found these preachers, disciples, apostles, prophets, evangelists, intercessors, deacons, and theologians of Matthew 7:21-23 as being lukewarm in their understanding and being without knowledge of Good. This is why Paul prophesied that the Christians of this day are going to have a form of godliness, but it will not be according to knowledge. The Lord will still be looking down and seeing that no one understands and not one does Good.

- ☆ **Matthew 7:21-23** ²¹“Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. ²²Many will say to Me in that day, ‘Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?’ ²³And then I will declare to them, ‘I never knew you; depart from Me, YOU WHO PRACTICE LAWLESSNESS!’.
- ☆ **Revelation 3:16-22** ¹⁶“So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spew you out of My mouth. ¹⁷Because you say, ‘I am rich, have become wealthy, and have need of nothing’ -- and do not know that you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked – ¹⁸I counsel you (*warn you*) to buy from Me gold refined in the fire, that you may be rich; and white garments, that you may be clothed, that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed; and anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see. ¹⁹As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. **Therefore be zealous and repent.** ²⁰Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice AND opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me. ²¹To him who overcomes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne. ²²He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.”
- ☆ **Luke 21:34-36** “But take to yourselves, lest your hearts be weighed down with dissipation (*wasted activities*), drunkenness (*the wine, or luxuries of this world*), and cares of this life (*building your house in this world*), and that Day come on you unexpectedly. **For it will come as a snare on all those who dwell on the face of the whole earth. WATCH therefore, and PRAY always** that you may be counted worthy to escape all these things that will come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man.”

Remember that the Lord reveals in Matthew 7:21-23 that there are going to many who come to Him at the Midnight Hour when the door is closed up and all those “Believers” who are left outside are gathered with those found unworthy of God. The Lord says that those people are unworthy and that they have practiced lawlessness. If you consider what we have just revealed, then you can begin to see that God is rejecting His Preachers and teachers because they have rejected to seek the knowledge of God, and that agrees exactly with what David reveals in Psalm 14:2-3. The Lord is saying that we do not know Him and there we are unable to do Good. Notice carefully that the Lord is saying in Matthew 7:21-23 that many wonders have been done by these people through the speaking of His name, and yet He is saying that they do not know Him, just like He told the Samaritan woman and the disciples. Thus, if you will, you can see that Jesus is clearly telling us that we do not know Him like we think that we do. We have missed the boat and we do not understand and we do not do GOOD. Thus, since the clock of our times is down to only ~3.5 years remaining until the judgment of the Midnight Hour, when it is the time when the Lord closes and bars the door to the Great Supper Banquet Hall, it means that we only have a short time to increase in the Knowledge of God so that we are fully equipped for every Good Work. As pointed out, that knowledge begins with the entrance of His Words.

- ☆ **Hosea 4:6** "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. **BECAUSE YOU HAVE REJECTED KNOWLEDGE, I ALSO WILL REJECT YOU FROM BEING A PRIEST BEFORE ME BECAUSE YOU HAVE FORGOTTEN THE LAW OF YOUR GOD I also will forget your children.**"
- ☆ **Mark 9:42-48** ⁴²"But whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in Me to stumble, it would be better for him if a millstone were hung around his neck, and he were thrown into the sea. ⁴³If your hand causes you to sin, cut it off. It is better for you to enter into life maimed, rather than having two hands, to go to hell, into the fire that shall never be quenched-- ⁴⁴where 'Their worm does not die and the fire is not quenched.' ⁴⁵And if your foot causes you to sin, cut it off. It is better for you to enter life lame, rather than having two feet, to be cast into hell, into the fire that shall never be quenched-- ⁴⁶where 'Their worm does not die and the fire is not quenched.' ⁴⁷And if your eye causes you to sin, pluck it out. It is better for you to enter the Kingdom of God with one eye, rather than having two eyes, to be cast into hell fire-- ⁴⁸where 'Their worm does not die and the fire is not quenched.'"

Now that we should have a clearer understanding that we have actually missed something, let us consider as to why the Lord said that David had such a heart that was so desired that it was likened to the Lord's own heart being knowledgeable enough to seek after doing the will of the Lord. This clearly means that David was doing Good. Consider that David had to have received the authority, with the blessing of the Holy Spirit, as well as the agreement of the Holy Angels, to proclaim in those two passages of Psalm 14:2-3 and 53:2-3, that are forever locked into the Scriptures of the Holy Bible, that the Father looks down from heaven, to see if anyone one understands and to see if anyone does Good, and then reveal that no, there is not one person who understands and that there is not one who does Good? David is indicating that He did know, and certainly the Lord's statement of Acts 13:22 would confirm this fact. The answer is found in that same passage of Psalm 119:97-101. Since the entire purpose of the Bible is to increase in the Knowledge of God so that we are fully equipped to do every Good Work, you can see that the way to do this is fully summed up within the verses of Psalm 119:97-105, and the keys are found within the verses of Psalm 119. David reveals to us that He loved God's Words more than honey and that He meditated upon them continuously, even when lying in bed he meditated upon the Words of God. David understood the true way to prosperity in this world that not only leads to wealth and joy, but it is the only way that guarantees to give you Eternal Life. David found the answer is within seeking out the Words of God that reveals the Works of God that enables you to increase in the Knowledge of God so that you are able to do the way of those Words and by so doing you enable the Father to do His Good Works for others. The result is that you enable the Father to be glorified in the eyes of man, and that unlocks God's favors to be poured out on you. It is also the very way of a heart that God loves (*Love means doing Good for others*), and it is to a person with that heart to whom He freely gives the gift of Eternal Life. David saw that it was in God's Words that he found the great treasures. For God's Words gives us Knowledge of God, and the Knowledge of God enables us to do His Good Works and that glorifies the Father. David knew that God desired such a heart more than He desired sacrifices and burnt offerings. For that is the heart of a man that is doing the Will of God, just as it is proclaimed in Hosea 6:6 and in Micah 6:8.

- ☆ **Psalm 119:97-105** ⁹⁷Oh, how I love your law! (*The law of the fathers to know His Words Deut. 11:18-21. David says in Psalm 119:142 that His Law is Truth, and Jesus told us that His Words are Truth*) **It is my meditation all the day.** ⁹⁸You, through your commandments, make me wiser than my enemies, for they are ever with me. ⁹⁹I have more understanding (*Knowledge of God*) than all my teachers, for Your testimonies are my meditation. ¹⁰⁰I understand more than the ancients (*Knowledge of God's Good Works*), because I keep your precepts (*ways*). ¹⁰¹I have restrained my feet from every evil way, **that I may keep Your Word.** ¹⁰²I have not departed from Your judgments, for you Yourself have taught me (*We are judged by His Words*). ¹⁰³**HOW SWEET ARE YOUR WORDS TO MY TASTE, SWEETER THAN HONEY TO MY MOUTH!** ¹⁰⁴**THROUGH YOUR PRECEPTS I GET UNDERSTANDING.** (*Precepts are the Promises of God and the way that the Lord Jesus uses the way of His Words to enable the Good Works of the Promises of the Father that are in His Words to be done*). ¹⁰⁵Therefore I hate very false way. **Your Word is a light to my feet and light to my path.** (*Consider that Psalm 119 is by the wisdom of God located in the very middle of the Bible and it is also the longest chapter in all of the Bible*).
- ☆ **Psalm 119:145-148** I cry out with my whole heart; Hear me, O Lord! I will keep Your statutes. I cry out to You; Save me, and I will keep Your testimonies. I rise before the dawning of the morning. And cry for help; I hope in Your Word. My eyes are awake in the (*Night*) Watches that I may meditate on Your Word.

The Bible tells us more about David than any other person beside the Lord Jesus. As the verses above reveal, David devoted himself to learning the ways of God through the increasing in Knowledge of God through the meditation and study and prayer of His Words. David understood the values of prayer times. It is the opportunity to inquire of Knowledge of God and the way to do His good Works for the Good of others, and for the Glory of the Father. David found that in just the act of diligently seeking the knowledge of Good, that He found the favors of God. David found the key to great treasures. Job reveals in Job 23:12 that the Words of God are to be treasured more than the necessary food of this earth. You may remember that in Job 1:8 the Lord reveals that He found that there were none like Job on the earth, a blameless and upright man, one who feared the Lord, and one who turned from evil, meaning that Job did what is "Good" in front of the Lord. The Lord even gave us an example of the "Good Works for others" that Job did in offering a burnt offering for his children early every morning on an altar just in case they would have sinned. (*As is explained in the Writing, "The Word of God: Altar", Job was doing a Good Work by doing the way of the Words of God, as He was doing this for others*).

- ☆ **Psalm 119:162** I rejoice at Your Word as one who finds great treasure.

- ☆ **Job 23:12** I have not departed from the commandment of His lips (*Deuteronomy 18:18-19, 6:4-9, and 11:18-21*) of His lips; **I have treasured the Words of His mouth more than my necessary food.**
- ☆ **Proverbs 11:27** He who **DILIGENTLY SEEKS "Good" FINDS favor.**

Perhaps now you may begin to understand one of the greatest mysteries of the Bible, the way of life that brings prosperity and favor from God. I want to point out something to you that might open your eyes. The Bible records that when King Saul died, and David took over the Kingdom of Israel, first Judah, and then Israel, it was a nation that had been devastated by war, and that all the cities and towns of the nation was occupied by the enemy. David had an army of only 600 men, and he was facing an occupying army of Philistines that numbered in the millions of soldiers and laborers. Those people of the nation of Israel, who were not made into bonded slaves, were scattered. David reigned for forty years, seven years over Hebron and thirty-three years over all Israel. By the time of his death, David was able to leave a personal blessing, just for the Temple, that was the equivalent of ~\$19 Billion dollars in today's monies, and this was just his extra blessing that he gave to the Temple. This did not include the greater amount of billions of dollars in value that he had left in all the building materials that he had provided for the construction of the Temple. This was not inclusive of the vast wealth he left for his family. Consider the massive amount of wealth that the Lord had enabled David to accumulate during this time. How is this possible?

But, David was not alone in his vast increase in wealth. The leaders of Israel gave offerings that equated to more than ~\$4 billion in today's values. The Bible just begins to reveal the vastness of the wealth of Israel at the time of David's death. But, the greater gift that David left to the people of Israel can be found in his last instructions that is revealed in 1 Chronicles 28:8-9. David reveals that to the people that the key to success is to seek out the laws of their God so that they can remain to possess the Good Land. If you will consider this passage, you will see that David is revealing to us that these people knew the Ten Commandments and all the laws of Moses; but David is revealing a greater secret. David was reminding these people that the key to wisdom, strength, financial blessings, joy, and overall prosperity, was for them to **BE CAREFUL TO SEEK OUT ALL THE COMMANDMENTS OF THE LORD THEIR GOD**. In this statement David reminded them, and reveals to us, the secret to doing the very will of God and in so doing obtain prosperity. David was saying to not forget the law of God that we are to hear His Work that God has done. If we do this, then we are seeking Good and we are finding the key to the pouring out upon us of the favors of God. In verse 7, David reveals to us that all these laws of God were being obeyed within Israel in that day. David warned Solomon to remember to keep doing this and that God would pour out His favor upon Him and upon Israel. In chapters 28 and 29 David goes on to instruct Solomon to be faithful in building the Temple exactly like the plans that he had received from the Lord. For the Temple of Solomon was built in accordance to the way of the Words of God and its pattern was designed to teach the children of Israel the way of the Lord's Words so that they would increase in Knowledge (*of God*) and be fully equipped for every Good Work as God directed them.

- ☆ **1 Chronicles 28:1-8** ¹Now David assembled at Jerusalem all the leaders of Israel: the officers of the tribes and the captains of the divisions who served the king, the captains over thousands and captains over hundreds, and the stewards over all the substance and possessions of the king and of his sons, with the officials, the valiant men, and all the mighty men of valor. ²Then King David rose to his feet and said, "Hear me, my brethren and my people: *I had* it in my heart to build a house of rest for the ark of the covenant of the Lord, and for the footstool of our God, and had made preparations to build it. ³But God said to me, 'You shall not build a house for My name, because you *have been* a man of war and have shed blood.' ⁴However the Lord God of Israel chose me above all the house of my father to be king over Israel forever, for He has chosen Judah *to be* the ruler. And of the house of Judah, the house of my father, and among the sons of my father, He was pleased with me to make *me* king over all Israel. ⁵And of all my sons (for the Lord has given me many sons) He has chosen my son Solomon to sit on the throne of the kingdom of the Lord over Israel. ⁶Now He said to me, 'It is your son Solomon *who* shall build My house and My courts; for I have chosen him *to be* My son, and I will be his Father. **Moreover I will establish his kingdom forever, if he is steadfast to observe My commandments and My judgments, as it is this day.'** ⁸Now therefore, in the sight of all Israel, the assembly of the Lord, and in the hearing of our God, **BE CAREFUL TO SEEK OUT ALL THE COMMANDMENTS OF THE LORD YOUR GOD, that you may possess this GOOD land, and leave it as an inheritance for your children after you forever.** ⁹"As for you, my son Solomon, **KNOW THE GOD OF YOUR FATHER, and serve Him with a loyal heart and with a willing mind; for the Lord searches all hearts and understands all the intent of the thoughts. If you seek Him, He will be found by you; but if you forsake Him, He will cast you off forever.** ¹⁰Consider now, for the Lord has chosen you to build a house for the sanctuary; be strong, and do it."

David had brought Solomon up wisely, for he obeyed the law of God that is found in Deuteronomy 6:4-9 and Deuteronomy 11:18-21, and he taught his children the Words of God and the ways to increase in knowledge of God. David was prepared his children in the way to do Good. This is evidenced in the testimony of Solomon found in Proverbs 4:1-7. Solomon also records this testimony as a prophetic Word from God that is recorded in Proverbs 2:1-6. David knew the key to the doing of Good, and in these verses we see that it is all through the entrance of His Words that gives understanding and places God inside of us. Solomon, having this knowledge asked the Lord not by accident for wisdom to rule His people justly. Solomon understood according to knowledge that this is what God desired for him. It was from David's obedience to God's law to teach his children of His Words and of his Good Works that had enabled the Lord to make known this wisdom in Solomon, as it states in Proverbs 4:1-7. When God abides in you, as the Father and the Son, then His Words become your Words, for they become your heart's desire.

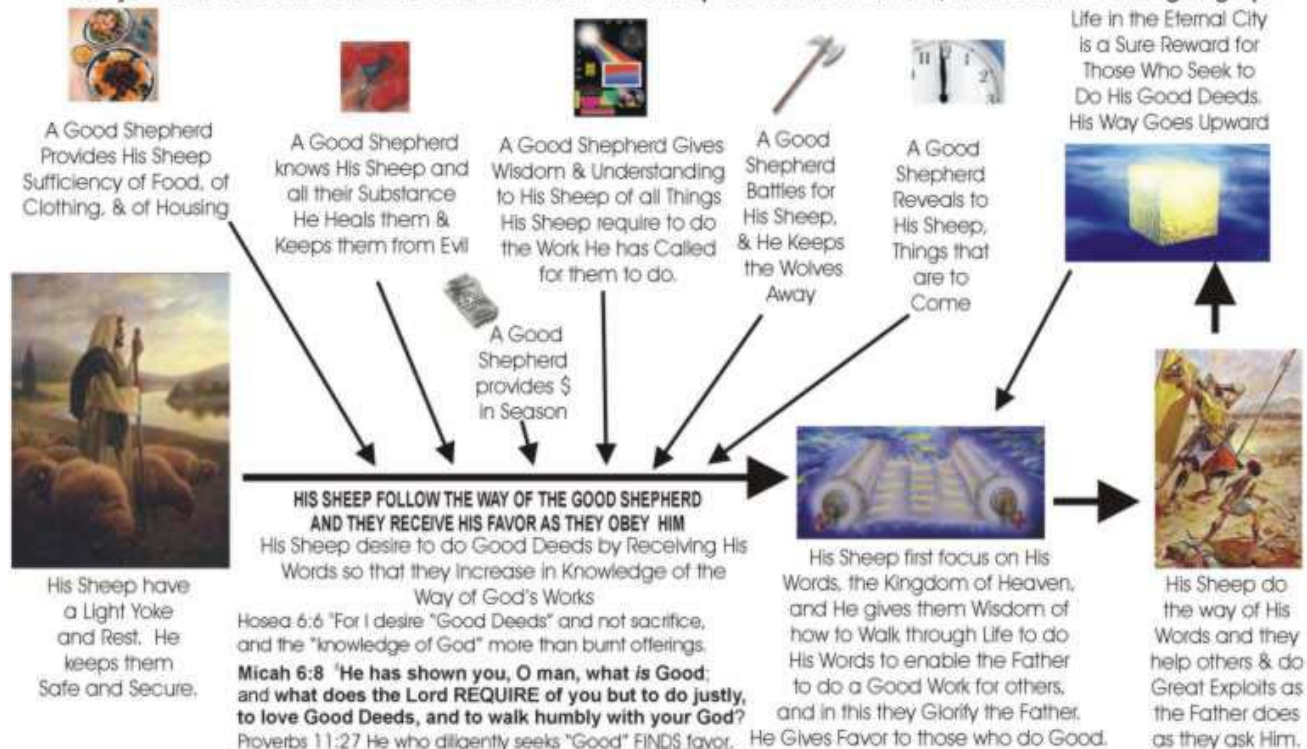
- ☆ **Proverbs 4:1-7** “Hear, my children, the instruction of a father, and give attention to know understanding; for I give you Good doctrine: Do not forsake my law (*Solomon recognizes it as a law for him, the law of the fathers – per Deuteronomy 11:18-21*). When I was my father's son, tender and the only one in the sight of my mother, He also taught me, and said to me; “Keep my commands, and live. Get Wisdom! Get Understanding! Do not forget, nor turn away from the Words of my mouth (*Like Jesus, David spoke the Words of God, for he had a heart after God's own heart, and he had God's Words written upon His heart – Acts 13:13:22*). Do not forsake her, and she will preserve you; love her, and she will keep you. Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom. And in all your getting, get understanding.”
- ☆ **Proverbs 2:1-6** ¹My son, if You receive My Words, and treasure My commands within you, ²so that you incline your ear to wisdom (*Discern God's Words*), and apply your heart to understanding (*Seek Understanding Of The Ways The Lord Used The Words As He Was Shown By The Father*); ³yes, if you cry out for discernment, and lift up your voice for understanding, (*By asking the Lord to make His Words known to you – Proverbs 1:23*) ⁴if you seek her as silver, and search for her as for hidden treasures; ⁵THEN you WILL understand the fear of the Lord, and **FIND the knowledge of God.** ⁶**For the Lord gives wisdom; from His mouth come knowledge and understanding.**
- ☆ **Proverbs 1:2-6** To know wisdom and instruction, (*is*) to perceive (*discern*) the Words of Understanding. To receive the instruction of wisdom, justice, judgment, and equity; to give prudence to the simple, to the young man knowledge and discretion. **A wise man WILL hear and increase learning, and a man of understanding will attain wise counsel, to understand a proverb and an interpretation (*enigma*), THE WORDS OF THE WISE and their puzzles.**

David had taught Solomon that lasting wealth is not poured out on us by what we do by our wisdom, but it is freely poured out upon us by seeking the wisdom of God. When we seek His Words and the understanding of all his works the Lord pours out all of those other things freely. The Words of God are the Kingdom of God that is within us. As we build upon that Kingdom God gives us the knowledge, the wisdom, the sufficiency to make all those others things come to us. It is the matter of our focus on increasing in the knowledge of the laws, works, and ways of God that equip us for every Good Work that God gives us all the other things through His favor, for it is joy to do so. In the chart, you will see David and Solomon's way that if we will diligently seek Good, we shall find God's favor.

☆ **Proverbs 11:27 He who DILIGENTLY SEEKS “Good” FINDS favor.**

THOSE WHO WALK IN THE WAY OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD FIND FAVOR AND LIFE

The Lord's Sheep HEAR His Voice and they set their heart's focus upon diligently Seeking the Entrance of His Words into their Mind so that they grow in Wisdom. Their focus is on Praying and Meditating upon His Words and the Ways that Jesus has done His Good Works so that they are able to grow in Wisdom and Understanding of how to do the Way of His Words so that they enable the Promise of the Father to do His Good Works for others, as they ask this of Him. As they progress in life being focused on increasing in knowledge of Him and His Good Works, the Father gives them favors to receive all necessities, such as knowledge of science for their career, of food sufficiency, of financial sufficiency, of clothing sufficiency, of housing adequacy, sufficiency of blessings and joy. As they increase in Knowledge and do His Words they receive the sure reward of Eternal Life. Their help comes from above, and their life ends going up.



One of the issues that we miss in the Bible is that David taught us in 1 Chronicles 29:1, that the Temple was to be built not for man but for God. David also told the leaders and people of Israel that they must be careful to seek out the laws of God. That is the same as saying that they must very diligent in their search for knowledge of God's laws that are placed into each of His Words as a Promise of God. Consider that when David transported the Ark he lacked in wisdom of God's ways of some of the things in the Temple. By the end of David's life, David was the one to pass on all things of the knowledge about the Temple design to Solomon, and the people of Israel became very blessed. If we will consider the point that Jesus taught us in John 6:28-29 that the work of God is that we believe in Him whom He sent. Therefore, since the Lord gave David the plans for building the Temple, it is clear that the purpose of the Temple was to teach us the way of His Words so that we would be fully equipped to do every Good Work. For example you in the specific design of the Temple there are many secrets to the way of God's Words, such as the twelve oxen under the Sea whose tails are tied together and that there are three oxen facing each direction, in a specific way. All of the things in the Temple are useful for teaching the people in the ways of God's Promises and in fully equipping the people to enable every Good Work. If we will carefully consider the Law of God in regard to the forgotten law of God that we are to teach His Words to our children, we will see that it is beneficial for us to design our house and all of things in it so that we are always reminded of the way of His Words. The Lord also told us to place His Words on the wrists of our children. Other places in the Bible the Lord reveals that they should be placed upon necklaces, and upon foot bracelets. The Lord is revealing to us that if we do this then we are doing like Job. For Job did the way of the Words of God for the benefit of His children. For God was obliged by His own promise that are forever within His Words to give favor to Job because he was diligent in seeking the way of God's Words as is proclaimed in Deuteronomy 6:4-9 and 11:18-21. Job was doing this as a Good Work for others – in this case His family. Thus, if you obey the Lord and place the bracelets upon the wrists of your children are you also not diligently seeking Good for you desire that the Spirit of God that is within His Words to guide the hand of your child in all things? Also, the Lord says that His Words must be placed upon our doorposts so that the favor of God by the way of doing His Words shall be upon all those who are in your house. Are you foolish enough to believe that God would place these commandments in the Bible for no reason when He was giving instructions to the fathers and teachers? All I can say is shame upon all of us for not hearing the Lord in this command, and especially if we have heard and not obeyed Him in this. The Lord said that we are to keep His sayings and to make everything we can to be designed to be reminding covers for our eyes so that we are always meditating upon the ways of God and how to do Good Works. The Lord desires us to be righteous and He wants us to increase in knowledge so that we can be highly favored. What we have to understand is that Jesus is the Good Shepherd who desires to do Good Works for us and to give us His favor. If we desire to diligently seek Good, then we have to hear what David stated, and obey God's commandments in regard to His Words – to the entirety of His instruction.

- ☆ **John 6:28-29** ²⁸Then they said to Him, "What shall we do, that we may work the works of God?" ²⁹**Jesus answered and said to them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He sent."**
- ☆ **Deuteronomy 18:18-19** ¹⁸"I will raise up for them a Prophet (*Jesus*) like you from among their brethren, and will put My Words in His mouth, and He shall speak to them all that I command Him. ¹⁹And it shall be that whoever will not hear My Words, which He speaks in My name, I WILL REQUIRE IT OF HIM."
- ☆ **Deuteronomy 6:4-9** (*The Bible Refers to this passage as both the Law of the Teachers, the Fathers, and Mothers*) ⁴"Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God is one Lord! ⁵You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and all your soul, and with all your might. ⁶**And these Words which I command you this day shall be upon your heart;** ⁷**and you shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you rise, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you are.** ⁸**And you shall bind them as a sign upon your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes.** ⁹**And you shall write them on the door posts of your house and on your gates."** (*Does your preacher teach the Words of God diligently to you, so that you may now teach them not only to your children but also to your parents who had not known them? Do you speak of His Words to your friends? Do you have the signs of His Words on the doors of your house, on your car, and on your right wrist?*)
- ☆ **Deuteronomy 11:18-21** (**THIS IS KNOWN AS THE LAW OF THE PARENTS and it teaches us that God has made it a law to teach His Works to our children. The reason is that all of God's Works are Good Works enabled by someone doing the way of the promises that are within His Words. If we teach these things to our children, then they will learn the way to enable His Good Works so that God will do for us what we ask of Him**) ¹⁸Therefore you shall lay up these Words of Mine in your heart and in your soul, and bind them in your heart and in your soul, and bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. ¹⁹You shall teach them to your children, speaking of

It is clearly a Law of God for all Parents, that we are to diligently teach the Words of God daily to all those in our house, and to speak of them in our business. For our soul's sake, we are to attach them to our right wrists, and place them on the doors of our houses, on the doors of our businesses, and on all our Government doors, so that they are always a reminder to us of His Promises. We have failed God by not honoring Him in this Way, as He commanded us to do. This reveals our naivety – our lack of knowledge!!! It also reveals why we must now increase in knowledge!

them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. ²⁰And you shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates (*The Gates are the places of Business and of Government, today that is the doors of our offices, the doors of both business and government*), ²¹that your days and the days of your children may be multiplied in the land of which the Lord swore to your fathers to give them, like the days of the heavens above the earth." (*Are the Words of God upon all the doors of your business, and on all the doors of our government? Those who receive His Words and believe upon Him, will receive eternal Life, so that they may have as the days of heaven above the earth – Ephesians 1:13-14*).

- ☆ **Psalm 78:1-8 (THIS IS A TESTIMONY THAT THE TEACHING OF GOD'S WORDS IS A LAW OF THE PARENTS)**
¹"Give ear, O my people, to my law; incline your ears to the Words of my mouth. ²I will open my mouth in a parable and I will utter puzzles of old (*Some Bibles translate, as dark sayings or riddles, but the proper translation should be as hidden "puzzles", or "parables". The puzzles are the writings and sayings in the Bible that use His Words to reveal to us understanding of the way to do the works of the Holy One of Israel, Jesus Christ of Nazareth, and the only Son of God*), ³which we have heard and known and our fathers have told us. (*As they obeyed the Law of Moses in Deuteronomy 11:18-21 and Deuteronomy 6:4-9 to teach their children His Words*). ⁴**We will not hide them from their children, telling to the generation to come the praises of the Lord, and His strength and His wonderful works that He has done. (He does His Works by His voice).** ⁵For He established a testimony in Jacob, and appointed a law in Israel, which He commanded to our fathers, that they should make them known to their children (*Deuteronomy 6:4-9 and Deuteronomy 11:18-21 commands us that we are to teach our children His Words and to make known His Works that are done by speaking and doing His Words*); ⁶that the generation to come might know them, the children who would be born, that they may arise and declare them to their children, ⁷that they may set their hope in God, and not forget the works of God, but keep His commandments; ⁸and may not be like their fathers, a stubborn and rebellious generation, a generation that did not set its heart aright, and whose Spirit was not faithful to God." (*The children are to be taught His Words that have His wisdom and understanding of His power so that they may grow up and not be rebellious to their Lord, and that they will learn how to enable Him to do His marvelous works for them as they ask*).
- ☆ **Proverbs 7:1-43** ¹My son, keep my Words (*the Words of God*), and treasure my commands within you. ²Keep my commands and live, and my law as the apple of your eye. ³**Bind them on your fingers (Rings with His Words);** write them on the tablet of your heart. ⁴Say to wisdom, "You are my sister," and call understanding *your* nearest kin.
- ☆ **Proverbs 6:21-23** ²⁰My son, keep your father's command, and do not forsake the law of your mother. ²¹Bind them continually upon your heart; **tie them around your neck (Necklaces with His Words).** ²²When you roam, they will lead you; when you sleep, they will keep you, and *when* you awake, they will speak with you. ²³For the commandment is a lamp, and the law a light; reproofs of instruction are the way of life.
- ☆ **Proverbs 10:23** A man of Understanding (*According to Psalm 119:130, it is he who has received the Words of God who has received Understanding, and Proverbs 9:10 tells us that Knowledge of God if Understanding*) has Wisdom (*Wisdom is the Understanding of how to use the Words of God to enable God to do His Good Works for others*).
- ☆ **Proverbs 19:8** He who gets Wisdom loves his own soul; **he who keeps Understanding WILL "find" Good.** (*It is a promise of God that He will open it to us if we diligently seek to receive Understanding, and that comes from the entrance of His Words in our hearts – Psalm 119:130*)
- ☆ **Matthew 7:24-27** "THEREFORE WHOEVER HEARS THESE WORDS OF MINE, AND DOES THEM, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock: and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall, for it was founded on the rock. **BUT EVERYONE WHO HEARS THESE WORDS OF MINE, AND DOES NOT DO THEM, will be like a foolish man** who built his house on the sand: and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it fell. And great was its fall."
- ☆ **John 6:63** "**The Words that I speak to you are Spirit, and they are Life.**"
- ☆ **John 3:36** ³⁶**He who believes in the Son has everlasting life and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."**
- ☆ **John 8:12** Most assuredly, I say to you, if anyone keeps My Word he shall never see Death.
- ☆ **John 8:31-32** ³¹Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My Word, you are My disciples indeed. ³²And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."

It is not difficult to learn the way to seek to do Good. The Works of God are the Good Works. All of the Works that the Father has done for enabling man to believe in Jesus is called as a Good Work. God is the God of the Good and the Evil. The Lord does not desire man to do evil, as He desires man to do Good and to increase in knowledge of Him. We see that in the creation there is clear differentiation given to the works of good and the works that are not of Good. For example the Lord does not call the firmament created on the second day as a Good Work. Further He does not call the darkness created upon the first day as a Good Work. Thus, all of the works that are done by God for the benefit of helping man to understand Him is referred to as a Good Work. Further, the Lord is saying that He has enabled for man to do the actions of the way of His words, and He will do that Work in which we ask of Him, as He so states in John 15:7. the Lord is waiting at our door, ready to reveal to us the way in which to do His Words so that He is able to be glorified in doing His Good Works for us.

- ☆ **John 15:7** "If you abide in Me, and My Words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you." (*To "abide" means to "walk in the way of"*).
- ☆ **Jeremiah 33:3** "Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and inaccessible things, which you do not know."

- ☆ **Proverbs 1:23** Turn at My reproof; Surely I will pour out My Spirit on you; I will make My Words known to you.
- ☆ **Matthew 7:7-8** ⁷“Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. ⁸For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.”
- ☆ **Luke 11:9-10** ⁹“And I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. ¹⁰For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.”
- ☆ **Revelation 3:19-20** ¹⁹“As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. Therefore, be zealous and repent. ²⁰**Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice AND opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.**

Unfortunately for us, the churches of today are not teaching us the way of this knowledge, and because of this we are not able to do the Good Deeds that he desires of us, and in fact requires of us within these last days when He has opened His Words. The Lord warns all preachers, teachers, evangelists, theologians, prophets, and healers that they should take heed to hear his warning. In these last days the Lord requires that on His Sabbath Day that His Words are taught in His churches and Temples. It is because they have been rebellious and have refused to obey His laws that we are not taught His Words on the Sabbath Day. In these days the Lord is offering to feed us all the abundance that we desire at His Great Supper (*Luke 14:15-24*). Those who refuse to eat will not get in His door when He shuts it at the Midnight Hour. It is important that you understand that if by the Midnight Hour you have not been diligent to seek Good, then it does not matter what you have done in wonderful things for the Lord, you have hindered His people by not giving them the opportunity to receive His Words and increase in knowledge of God. Just as He says in Matthew 7:21-23, He will tell them that He never knew them and that they rebelled against His law and that they practiced lawlessness.

- ☆ **Luke 11:52** “Woe to you lawyers! For YOU HAVE TAKEN AWAY THE KEY OF KNOWLEDGE (*The understanding His Words enable His Good*). You did not enter in yourselves, and those who were entering you have hindered.”
- ☆ **Isaiah 58:13-14** ¹³“If you turn away your foot from the Sabbath, from doing your pleasure on My holy day, and call the Sabbath a delight, the holy Day of the Lord honorable, and shall honor Him, not doing your own ways, nor finding your own pleasure, **NOR SPEAKING YOUR OWN WORDS,** ¹⁴then you shall delight yourself in the Lord; and I will cause you to ride on the high hills of the earth, and feed you with the heritage of Jacob your father. The mouth of the Lord has spoken.”

The Lord desires us to increase in knowledge of Him so that we are able to enable His miracle works of Good and to receive His blessings. As revealed before, David meditated constantly on the knowledge of the laws and precepts of God from the scriptures and from focusing thoughts and prayers, so that he could unlock the way to enable God to do His Good Works for others so that he could release the favor of God, not only upon himself but also upon the nation of Israel. The Lord teaches us that this is not simple, and that is why He says that it is to be done only by being diligent and zealous for learning about Him. Consider that the people of Israel reveal that they were very wise. They recognized that David was enabling God's favor to come upon them because he was diligent in seeking Good. Therefore the people of Israel become wise and they would not let David go to war. He and likely the other key priests, such as Asaph, were to stay back in Jerusalem so that they would have time to meditate on His Word. For he was too valuable for Israel and they understood that if they actually wanted to receive God's blessings and favor, then they needed to have David focus on seeking the knowledge of God's Words. The result of their gifts to the Temple and the greatness of the Kingdom in the days of Solomon reveal how wise that this was. God gave them favor because they honored God by having their religious leader whom God had anointed to seek after His wisdom and to gain in understanding. They were doing the ways of God by seeking Good through their actions of releasing David to do what was valuable to the nation a whole, and that was in having David focus on increasing in Knowledge of God to enable the way to understand ways to seek Good.

- ☆ **Isaiah 28:9-19** ⁹“Whom will He teach knowledge? And whom will He make to understand the message? Those just weaned from milk? Those just drawn from the breasts? ¹⁰For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept, line upon line, line upon line, here a little, there a little.” ¹¹**For with stammering lips and another tongue He will speak to this people.** ¹²To whom He said, “This is the rest with which you may cause the weary to rest,” and, “This is the refreshing”; yet they would not hear. ¹³**But the Word of the Lord was to them, “Precept upon precept, precept upon precept, line upon line, line upon line, here a little, there a little,” That they might go and fall backward, and be broken and snared and caught.”** ¹⁴Therefore hear the Word of the Lord, you scornful men, who rule this people who are in Jerusalem, ¹⁵because you have said, “We have made a covenant with Death, and with Sheol we are in agreement. When the overflowing scourge passes through, it will not come upon us, for we have made lies our refuge, and under falsehood we have hidden ourselves.” ¹⁶Therefore thus says the Lord God: “Behold, I lay a stone for a foundation, a tried stone, a precious cornerstone, a sure foundation. Whoever believes will not act hastily. ¹⁷Also I will make justice the measuring line, and righteousness the plummet; the hail will sweep away the refuge of lies, and the waters will overflow the hiding place. ¹⁸Your covenant with Death will be annulled, and your vision with Sheol will not rise up; ¹⁹As often as it passes, it shall take you, for morning by morning it shall pass, and by day and by night, it shall only be a terror just to understand the report.

The Bible further says that if we seek diligently to find the understanding of this Word “Good” then we shall receive a “sure reward”. That is like going forth to diligently seek a hidden treasure and getting rewarded by God just for

doing this. Thus, why would not everyone in the world want to expend every dollar that they have seeking after the knowledge of this Word "Good"?

- ✧ **Proverbs 11:23** The desire of the Righteous is only "Good".
- ✧ **Proverbs 10:24** The desire of the righteous will be granted. (*This is the same as is stated in John 15:7*).
- ✧ **Proverbs 12:17** He who speaks Truth declares Righteousness. (*The Words of God are Truth*).
- ✧ **Proverbs 11:18-19** ¹⁸The wicked man does deceptive work, but to him who sows Righteousness will be a sure reward .¹⁹As Righteousness gives Life (*His Words are Spirit and they are Life – John 6:63, and His Words are Everlasting – Mark 13:31. He who receives and keeps His Words will have Eternal Life – John 3:34-36; 6:68*), so he who pursues evil receives Death (*God's prison for the abominators and those who blaspheme against His Words is called Death, and it is located alongside the Pit within the Abyss that is also called the Outer Darkness*).

Please consider this thought carefully: The way of God is giving to those who diligently seek to increase in the Knowledge of God so that they are fully equipped in the knowledge of how to enable God to do His Good Works for others as we ask of Him. By understanding this, we may have a better understanding of why the Queen of Sheba would leave her kingdom and come to be in the presence of Solomon who was speaking the Words of God. For the Word "Good" is one of the most important Words of God in regard to knowing the way of living our lives. By being so diligent and zealous to increase in knowledge of God, the Queen of Sheba, earned the favor of God on herself, and upon her kingdom. She received the favor of God because she was definitely diligent to follow the desired way of God to leave her way of the world, and come to Jerusalem to seek of the Knowledge of God that was being revealed in the Words that Solomon was teaching. In so doing, this foreign lady who was the ruler of a nation was wise enough to recognize that anything that could enable the favor of God, had to be very important and was indeed more valuable than the gold and riches of this world. The Queen of the South obtained God's favor because she was so diligent and zealous to seek the way of Good. The Bible reveals that the Queen of the South came because she heard of the wisdom of the Words and Sayings that Solomon was teaching. The Bible tells us that wisdom is the knowledge of God. This is testified to by the Lord's statement that the Queen of the South will stand in judgment against us. Jesus was saying that her knowledge of the true treasure of the Kingdom of God was so much more honorable than the teachings of the priests of Israel that the Lord has appointed her to stand as a testimony against us.

It raises and intriguing question, could the obtainment of the favor of God be more valuable than the obtainment of the rewards of having an earthly kingdom of the earth? Interestingly Jesus says that this Queen of the South, who left the safety, power, glamour, and luxuries of her kingdom, to come forth to seek the knowledge of Good, will stand in testimony against us at our judgment. Further

- ✧ **John 10:32** ³²Jesus answered them, "**Many Good Works I have shown you from My Father.**"

The Lord REQUIRES us, "TO LOVE GOOD DEEDS"

- ✧ **Micah 6:8** ⁸He has shown you, O man, **what is Good**; and **WHAT DOES THE LORD REQUIRE OF YOU BUT to do justly, TO LOVE "GOOD DEEDS", and to walk humbly with your God?**

God DESIRES GOOD DEEDS Over "SACRIFICES"

- ✧ **Hosea 6:6** ⁶For I **DESIRE "GOOD DEEDS" AND NOT SACRIFICE**, and the "knowledge of God" more than burnt offerings.

If we "SEEK GOOD", we receive "GOD'S FAVOR"

- ✧ **Proverbs 11:27** He who **DILIGENTLY SEEKS "Good" FINDS favor.**

The Righteous DESIRES only "GOOD"

- ✧ **Proverbs 11:23** The desire of the Righteous is only "Good".

Those who Practice Righteousness are BORN of HIM

- ✧ **1 John 2:29** If you know that He is Righteous, you know that everyone who practices Righteousness is born of Him.

Those who SOW Righteousness GIVE LIFE

- ✧ **Proverbs 11:18-19** ¹⁸The wicked man does deceptive work, but to him who sows Righteousness will be a sure reward .¹⁹As Righteousness gives Life, so he who pursues evil receives Death.

to this, the Lord reveals in these statements that God has given her great favor, and the Lord is also revealing that she has also obtained Eternal Life.

Let us look at the basics of Good. In the textbox there is a series of scriptures that follow the way of "Good" within the Scriptures. The key to understanding the way of Good, is that Jesus says that only God is Good; and further, He says that there is no one who is Good but God. This means that if we are to increase in the knowledge of God, then we it is necessary to increase in the knowledge of Good.

- ☆ **Matthew 19:16-17** ¹⁶Now behold, one came and said to Him, "Good Teacher, what Good shall I do that I may have eternal life?" ¹⁷So He said to him, "Why do you call Me Good? **No one is Good but One, that is, God.**"
- ☆ **Mark 10:17-18** ¹⁷Now as He was going out on the road, one came running, knelt before Him, and asked Him, "Good Teacher, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life?" ¹⁸So He said to him, "Why do you call Me Good? **No one is Good but One, that is, God.**"
- ☆ **Psalms 119:68** You are Good, AND You do Good; teach me Your statutes.
- ☆ **Proverbs 19:8** He who gets Wisdom loves his own soul; **he who keeps Understanding WILL "find" Good.**
- ☆ **John 14:10** The Words which I speak to you I do not speak from Myself, but the Father who abides in Me, **He does the works.**
- ☆ **Acts 10:34-39** ³⁴Then Peter opened his mouth and said: "In Truth (*In the Words of God and in all Creation*) I perceive (*discern*) that God shows no partiality. ³⁵But in every nation, whoever fears Him and works Righteousness (*Has knowledge of God's Truth and does His Good Works*) is accepted by Him. ³⁶The Word which God sent to the children of Israel, preaching Peace (*Peace is the Eternal Kingdom of God, and those who receive His Word receives Eternal Life*) through Jesus Christ (*Jesus the risen Messiah came back to open to the children of Israel His Words and to give them Understanding*) – He is Lord of all – ³⁷that Word you know (*Jesus came to speak the Words of God and to do them*), which was proclaimed throughout all Judea, and began from Galilee after the baptism which John (*the Baptist*) preached: ³⁸how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with Power (*After the Baptism the Father placed on Him the Holy Spirit, and sent Him forth to speak the Words of God, after He went into the Wilderness to fast and grow in strength with power*), who went about DOING GOOD and healing (*He did the Words of God enabling the Father to heal the people*) all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him (*God is in His Words and His Words were in Jesus*). ³⁹And we are witnesses of all things which He did both in the land of the Jews and in Jerusalem, whom they killed by hanging on a tree.

Clearly "Good" is the Works of God, and we enable the Father to do His Good Works for others when we are doers of His Words. By doing the way of His Words we give the Father the opportunity to be glorified in front of man. That is the desire of the Father for us to do, and it is what should be our hearts desire. If we do His Good with the intention of getting a reward then we have not honored God, for we did not the work with a sincere heart. James the brother of Jesus reveals to us in James 4:2-3 that if we do a Good Work with the intention of doing it so that the Father will give us something of the world that we want, then we have asked amiss, and the Father is not going to do for us what we desire. James was speaking to people who were being taught the Words of God. For all the Disciples and the Apostles had the knowledge of Truth revealed to them. Notice that James did not say that these people were praying. He said that they were "asking" in amiss. Thus, James is scolding those whom had the knowledge of the Words of God and they were seeking to do His Words to enable the Father to do Good Works, but that they were doing so that they could receive from the Father favor in the form of receiving things of this world, such as money, houses, etc. The Lord says that anyone who is a friend of the world is not a friend of God. The Lord says that if we love the world and do not trust Him to give to us what is Good for us, then we are as like an adulterer, loving another God.

- ☆ **James 4:2-3** ²You lust and do not have. You murder and covet and cannot obtain. You fight and battle (*Struggle as if a war is going on inside of you*). Yet you do not have because you do not ask (*You do not ask by being a doer of His Words, and by doing His Words through the way of the Knowledge of God's promises and His Way of His Will for that Word and for your work*). ³**You ask and do not receive, because you ask amiss, that you may spend it on your pleasures.** (*That is as clear as it can be stated. We are not really looking for the greatest treasure to use it for God's glory; rather James is saying that we only seek it because we desire to enjoy fame or the luxuries of this world. Therefore it has not been given to us because the Lord knows the real intent of our hearts. James is saying that we do not seek it to do enable the Father to do His "Good" works so that He is glorified – we want the limelight; and for this reason His Words remained sealed from our eyes until now. If we had not been blind, He would have opened our eyes and healed us from all things*).
- ☆ **James 4:4** Adulterers and adulteresses! (*Those who do not hear God's Words and do not seek Him for knowledge are chasing the wisdom of man, and that is as adultery before God, for God makes wisdom to be as a female helpmate that stands always beside us. And pursuing the wisdom that is of the men's words is a bride who is committing adultery before God with a false Bridegroom – the false and foolish teachers*). Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? **Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself and enemy of God.**
- ☆ **1 John 2:15-17** ¹⁵**Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.** ¹⁶**For all that is in the world--the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life-- is not of the Father but is of the world.** ¹⁷**And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever.** (*The Will of God is that we do Good Deeds for others and increase in the Knowledge of God – Hosea 6:6, Micah 6:8, Matthew 12:7, 1 Timothy 2:1-4, and 2 Timothy 3:16-17*).

The key to doing God's "Good Works" that enables His favor is not to ask for anything. You have to trust the Lord that whatever He desires for you is what you will receive, and you have to believe in your heart that what the Lord provides for you is what is truly Good for you. For the Lord will also only do what are "Good Works" for you, for He established the Law of Good and all His Words are Truth and His way is to bless the righteous.

- ☆ **Proverbs 11:23** The desire of the Righteous is only "Good".
- ☆ **Proverbs 10:24** The desire of the righteous will be granted. (*This is the same as is stated in John 15:7*).

If you consider the way that the Lord teaches us to be diligent and seek after Good, then you can see the fallacy and danger of the false teaching of the prosperity message that is being widely taught within His churches in the world today. As Jesus said to the priests of Jerusalem, because these men have taken away the key to God's law regarding obtaining His favors, they shall be removed as priests before Him, as the Lord says that they will not enter into His law. This means that they are as the invited guests of the Great Supper who rejected His invitation to come and feed upon the food of heaven that gives wisdom of God and understanding of Good. In Luke 14:24 the Lord says that unless they turn and repent, they will in no way taste of His food.

- ☆ **Luke 11:52** "Woe to you lawyers! For YOU HAVE TAKEN AWAY THE KEY OF KNOWLEDGE (*The understanding His Words enable His Good*). You did not enter in yourselves, and those who were entering you have hindered."

The chart below reveals the way of the world, which is also the way of nearly all of today's seedtime and harvest messages. It shows that Christians are without knowledge of Good and they do not follow the Good Shepherd.

THOSE WHO WALK IN THE WAY OF THE WORLD FIND DECEIT AND LOSE LIFE

The Lord stands at the door and knocks but the unwise Sheep do not hear His Voice speaking His Words. The Lost Sheep do not see the Way of the Father to do His Good Works. They do not understand that the Father is always looking down to see if we do His Words so that He is enabled to do His Good Works for others so that He is Glorified, and that He is enabled to freely give us favor, blessing, and the sure reward of Life. The Lost Sheep do not set their hearts to focus firstly upon hearing Him and doing Good. Their heart is set upon the obtainment on goal of ownership of the things of this world: money, fun, man's knowledge, cars, wife, house, career position, and their own legacy in the world. The side thought is worshiping God, and doing things for others. They have no clue what is Truth and Good. They seek to obtain money to give offerings and sacrifices to God, instead of seeking after the knowledge of God that enables Him to do Good for others and to give them favor, blessing, & Life. They sow seed in those seeking knowledge in the way of the world instead of those seeking Understanding of Good.



We need to remember the Lord revealed in Daniel 12:9-10 that in these last days the Lord is going to pour out His Spirit upon the World and make the knowledge of His Words known to all those who will inquire of Him, as is also revealed in Proverbs 1:23. The Lord has promised that if you desire to be made wise and know Good then all you have to do is open your eyes and see God in His Works and hear His Words and be healed. WE have to believe in the Lord and increase in the knowledge of His Words so that we are able to do the way of His Words according to knowledge.

- ☆ **Proverbs 9:12** If you are wise, you are wise for yourself, and if you scoff (*At the Words of God and His Truth*), you alone will bear it.

- ☆ **Proverbs 14:6-7** ⁶A scoffer seeks wisdom and does not find it, but knowledge is easy to him who understands. ⁷Go from the presence of a foolish man, when you do not perceive in him the lips of knowledge.
- ☆ **John 10:25-38 (Full Text)** ²⁵Jesus answered them, "I told you, and you do not believe. The works that I do in My Father's name, they bear witness of Me. ²⁶But you do not believe, because you are not of My sheep, as I said to you. ²⁷My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. ²⁸And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. ²⁹My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand. ³⁰"I and My Father are one." ³¹Then the Jews took up stones again to stone Him. ³²Jesus answered them, "Many Good Works I have shown you from My Father. For which of those works do you stone Me?" ³³The Jews answered Him, saying, "For a Good work we do not stone You, but for blasphemy, and because You, being a Man, make Yourself God." ³⁴Jesus answered them, "Is it not written in your law, 'I said, "You are gods"?' ³⁵If He called them gods, to whom the Word of God came (and the Scripture cannot be broken), ³⁶do you say of Him whom the Father sanctified and sent into the world, 'You are blaspheming,' because I said, 'I am the Son of God'? ³⁷If I do not do the works of My Father, do not believe Me; ³⁸but if I do, though you do not believe Me, believe the works, that you may know and believe that the Father is in Me, and I in Him (The Father is in Him within His Words, for Jesus was a doer of the Words of God)." ³⁹Therefore they sought again to seize Him, but He escaped out of their hand.
- ☆ **John 14:8-18** ⁸Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient for us." ⁹Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'? ¹⁰Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? THE WORDS THAT I SPEAK TO YOU I DO NOT SPEAK ON MY OWN AUTHORITY; BUT THE FATHER WHO DWELLS IN ME DOES THE WORKS. ¹¹Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father in Me, or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves. ¹²Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father. ¹³And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. ¹⁴If you ask anything in My name, I will do it. ¹⁵If you love Me, keep My commandments. ¹⁶And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever-- ¹⁷even the Spirit of Truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you AND WILL BE IN you. ¹⁸I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you."

Let us consider that the Bible is also a book of Numbers. The Lord uses numbers to testify to what is revealed in the Scriptures. We are able to see that the numbers reveal that the Lord has indeed confirmed to us through the use of numbers that He is Good and that His Good Works are associated with those who set themselves apart to be Holy as He is Holy. This is shown in the following chart the reveals that God, Good, Holy and His Eternal Good Works of Mercy were intended to testify in support of what the Lord has revealed through David, the prophets and the disciples.

God is Good, God is Holy:

Matthew 19:17, and Mark 10:18 "So He said to him, "Why do you call Me Good? **No one is Good but One, that is, God.**"

Revelation 3:7 "These things says He who is Holy, He who is True, "He who has the key of David, He who opens and no one shuts, and shuts and no one opens."

Psalm 119:68 **You are Good, AND You do Good;** teach me Your statutes.

Acts 10:38 "how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with Power, who went about DOING GOOD and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

John 10:32 Jesus answered them, "Many Good Works I have shown you from My Father.

Micah 6:8 "He has shown you, O man, what is Good, and WHAT DOES THE LORD REQUIRE OF YOU BUT to do justly, TO LOVE "GOOD DEEDS", and to walk humbly with your God?"

In Luke 12 the Lord answers many questions in regard to enabling the miracles works of God. You may remember that the miracle works that were done in the time of the apostles happened about 1,335 days after the Lord finished His ministry on earth and had come back to open His Words to them. We have no entered into the tie of the 2nd Seal Judgment of the Day of the Lord. The Lord has now come as the Spirit of Truth and He is releasing the knowledge of Truth upon the earth. But, I think everyone wants to know as to when will the Father begin to do the Good Works as we ask them of Him. Even though the Lord opened His Words to the disciples, they could not begin to release the Good Works until after the day of Pentecost had fully come and they were gathered into the Upper Room, as it is told in Acts 2:1-4. Then they were filled with the power from on high and they were authorized by God to begin doing His Good Works as they asked of Him. They went out into the streets and to speak of His Good News to all those Jews and people gathered from all over the world, and the Lord enabled them to speak in whatever language that they desired. There immediately entering the streets of the City to preach was in itself doing the way of the Words of God in the manner as the way the Lord had sent them, and God honored their request of this physical action, and they were able to speak in the foreign languages so that the father was glorified. That was doing a Good Work for others and God gave them what they desired. They had to wait until a set time for that power to be given from on high. All they were given was a timeframe and instruction to be ready. We are likewise now in that same instruction. For the Lord says that we are to prepare ourselves for we do not know at what time the Father will come to instruct us that He is prepared to do the Good Works that He is calling us to go and do. The answer is given to us in the parable of Luke 12:38 the Lord tells us that the Master, the Father, could come in either the 2nd or the 3rd watch. That means that any time from now until Pentecost has fully come in 2010, the Father could release us with power to do Good. Until that time we are to watch and be ready. A faithful watchman prepares himself so that he is ready. This is why it is urgent that we increase rapidly in the knowledge of God. I believe that the Lord is soon going to release the power to do His Good Works, for He says that if our faith is as strong as a mustard seed then we will be able to do His Works. The issue is more on the way that we respond to Him. For, if the Father heard of a great celebration explosion of people seeking the knowledge of Him knowledge in His house, would He not come back early? Remember that the Lord looked down on Jerusalem and He said how many times have I wanted to take you in my arms but you were not willing. If we show the Lord by diligently seeking after the way of Good, did He not say that we would obtain favor? The Lord said that if we knocked the door would be opened. The Lord said that there is nothing impossible to Him. If we are diligent to seek Good and do His Words surely He will answer. Even though He said that this wicked and perverse generation would not receive any sign except the opening of His Words and the revelation of things to come, the Lord is still an awesome God with His eyes constantly upon His people. What we really need is for a serious support of our efforts to diligently seek the Knowledge of God to enable His Good Works. We need people to halt the preachers who are not speaking His Words on the Sabbath, by going into the aisles and calling out to God to pour out His Spirit of Truth on that church and make His Words known to them so that His churches may be filled with the knowledge of God. That is doing the way of His Words to diligently seek after Good.

☆ **Luke 12:1-59** ¹In the meantime, when an innumerable multitude of people had gathered together, so that they trampled one another, He began to say to His disciples first of all, "Beware of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy. ²For there is nothing covered that will not be revealed, nor hidden that will not be known. ³Therefore whatever you have spoken in the dark will be heard in the light, and what you have spoken in the ear in inner rooms will be proclaimed on the housetops. ⁴"And I say to you, My friends, do not be afraid of those who kill the body, and after that have no more that they can do. ⁵But I will show you whom you should fear: Fear Him who, after He has killed, has power to cast into hell; yes, I say to you, fear Him! ⁶"Are not five sparrows sold for two copper coins? And not one of them is forgotten before God. ⁷But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Do not fear therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows. ⁸"Also I say to you, whoever confesses Me before men, him the Son of Man also will confess before the angels of God. (*Take notice that God is His Words and is in His Words. The Angels are Angels of God, and therefore the Angels are keepers of the Words of God, as is exemplified by Gabriel, and is testified to by the Angel in Revelation 22:9, that the Angels are keepers of the Words of the Bible, and that we are to worship God, and that is the same as we worship His Words for God is in His Words. It is also why the Lord calls His Words Holy Words.*) ⁹But he who denies Me before men will be denied before the angels of God. (*It is the work of the Holy Angels who come with the Spirit of Truth in the 2nd Seal Judgment time and they are recording who receives His Words and who rejects His Words. At the Midnight Hour they will remove the Holy Spirit - the knowledge we have of His Words - from the Unworthy and they will add it to the Worthy. The Angels do this because it is there work to minister to, and to look after, the Words of God.*) ¹⁰"And anyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man, it will be forgiven him; but to him who blasphemes against the Holy Spirit, it will not be forgiven. ¹¹"Now when they bring you to the synagogues and magistrates and authorities, do not worry about how or what you should answer, or what you should say. ¹²For the Holy Spirit will teach you in that very hour what you ought to say." ¹³Then one from the crowd said to Him, "Teacher, tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me." ¹⁴But He said to him, "Man, who made Me a judge or an arbitrator over you?" (*It is the Words of God that judge us. Either we have them or we do not have them. God's Law is in His Words.*) ¹⁵And He said to them, "Take heed and beware of covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses." (*Man's Life depends upon the entrance of His Word that gives God and Eternal Life; and, man's gains are dependent upon the way he diligently seeks after the Knowledge of Good, meaning the seeking after the Knowledge of God, because God is Good. He who seeks diligently after the Knowledge of Good receives favor from God both on earth and in heaven.*) ¹⁶Then He spoke a parable to them, saying: "The ground of a certain rich man yielded plentifully. ¹⁷And he thought within himself, saying, 'What shall I do, since I have no room to store

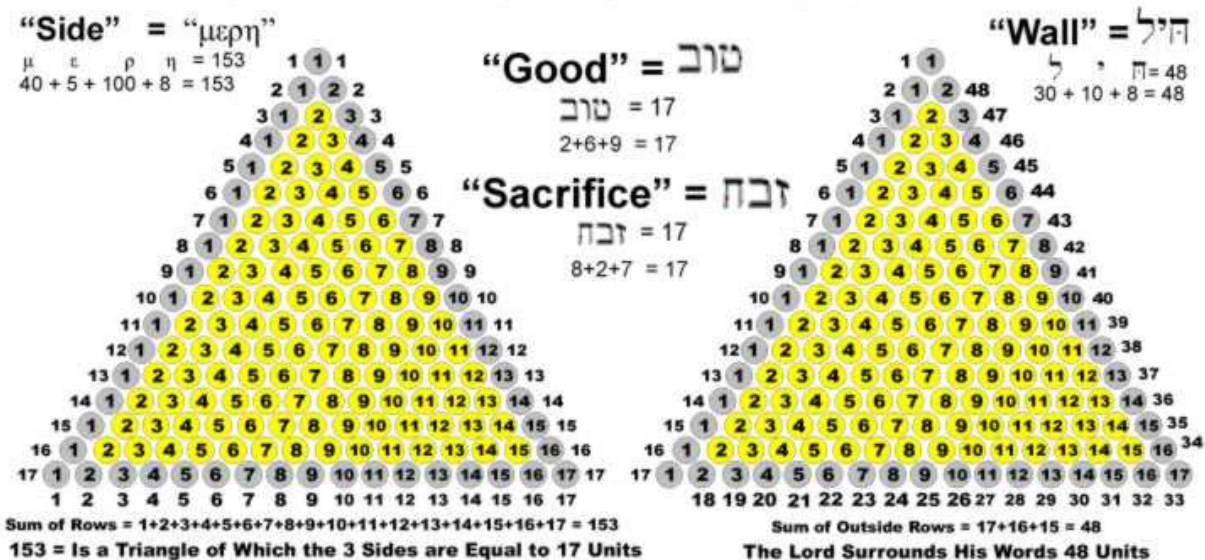
my crops?' ¹⁸ So he said, 'I will do this: I will pull down my barns and build greater, and there I will store all my crops and my goods. ¹⁹ And I will say to my soul, "Soul, you have many goods laid up for many years; take your ease; eat, drink, and be merry." ²⁰ But God said to him, "Fool! This night your soul will be required of you; then whose will those things be which you have provided?" ²¹ **So is he who lays up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God.**" (*Rich toward God means to be rich in the Understanding of His Words, for God is His Words*). ²² **Then He said to His disciples, "Therefore I say to you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat; nor about the body, what you will put on. ²³ Life is more than food, and the body is more than clothing.** (*The receiving of eternal Life is the increasing in knowledge until we are fully equipped so that we can enable Him to do His Good Works. The food is the Words of God and the Garment represents the increasing in Knowledge of God. But the true desire of God is that we progress in faith – that is Understanding - and wisdom until we can actually do the actions of the way of His Words so that we are able to Him to do His Good Works for others as we ask this of Him. In this way, and in this accomplishment of life, we glorify the Lord and the Father in like manner as to the way in which Jesus Glorified the Father. This is the true essence of an esteemed life that the angels will shout as being Glory, Glory, Glory unto the Lord, and in this way of life there will be give a sure and great reward, for God has proclaimed this as a promise. Those rewards will include the provision of everything that you require on earth, as well as treasures in heaven, for a faithful servant is worthy of his reward*). ²⁴ **Consider the ravens, for they neither sow nor reap, which have neither storehouse nor barn; and God feeds them. Of how much more value are you than the birds? ²⁵ And which of you by worrying can add one cubit to his stature? ²⁶ If you then are not able to do the least, why are you anxious for the rest? ²⁷ Consider the lilies, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin; and yet I say to you, even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. ²⁸ If then God so clothes the grass, which today is in the field and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, how much more will He clothe you, O you of little faith? ²⁹ And do not seek what you should eat or what you should drink, nor have an anxious mind. ³⁰ For all these things the nations of the world seek after, and your Father knows that you need these things. ³¹ But seek the kingdom of God (*His Words*), and all these things shall be added to you. (*This is the true Biblical secret to all prosperity, for if you begin to diligently seek after increasing in the Knowledge of His Words that fully equips us to enable Him to do His Good Works for us as we ask of Him, then He rewards our work of seeking Him diligently by giving to us blessings that we desire. The key is that if our heart is focused on the seeking of His knowledge and not seeking the things of the world, then He blesses us not only with things in heaven, but also with the things of this world that we need. Our focus should just be seeking knowledge of His Words and how what He desires to give us applies to His Words and His plan that they include, then He will provide all the earthly things to do His purposes. It is that we only have to focus on increasing in knowledge of Him and He will make known all things and He will provide all the things we need. This is the Bible's true revelation of the way of God's prosperity instructions*). ³² **Do not fear, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom. ³³ Sell what you have and give alms; provide yourselves money bags which do not grow old, a treasure in the heavens that does not fail, where no thief approaches nor moth destroys. ³⁴ For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. ³⁵ Let your waist be girded and your lamps burning; ³⁶ and you yourselves be like men who wait for their master** (*As men who wait for the Lord to come and open to us His Words, and then pour out the Spirit of Truth on us to make them known to. For Jesus said His flesh if food indeed – John 6:49-57, and John said that Jesus is first coming in the flesh – coming back in His Words – 2 John 7-11, before He returns in the physical flesh at the time of 7th Bowl Judgment. John says that if any one teaches you any other doctrine then it is a false teaching – such as those who falsely teach that the 1st Seal Judgment is the Antichrist emerging mounted on a white horse. This is because the prophet Ezekiel revealed that the bow is the Likeness of His Glory, and the Lord has foretold that He is coming in His Glory, and those the 1st Seal Judgment was the Lord coming as the Spirit of Grace to open His Words for us, and the entrance of His Words gives us the Crown of Eternal Life), when he will return from the wedding banquet (*This is the act of getting it ready for the wedding*), that when he comes and knocks they may open to him immediately. ³⁷ **Blessed are those servants whom the master, when he comes, will find watching. Assuredly, I say to you that he will gird himself and have them sit down, and will come and serve them.** (*If when He comes we are found to be wise and diligent to hear and observe His Words, then the people will be looking for Him to return in the flesh – for His Word is flesh and meat to our soul, as John reveals to us in 2 John 7, the Lord will surely gird Himself, have the people to sit down – meaning He desires that we sit down and focus on increasing in knowledge of Him, then He will come and serve them His food – the meat of His flesh are the Words of God. Jesus says that if we do turn that He will pour out His Spirit upon us and make His Words known to us. If you will notice, this description is likened to the last supper that He ate with His disciples. This is the Great Supper that He has invited us to per Luke 14:15-24 and Revelation 3:16-22. The problem is that we have not paid attention, and He has come already as the Spirit of Grace and we were not watching, so we caught in a snare. Now He is pouring out the spirit of Truth that is the 2nd Seal Judgment, and it is the last opportunity for us to prepare ourselves for the coming troubles of the Night*). ³⁸ And if he should come in the second watch, or come in the third watch, and find them so, blessed are those servants. (*This verse is revealing to us when the Good Works of the Lord will begin to be done for us. We cannot do the Works, only God can. He will come to do them in either the 2nd watch or the 3rd Watch of the Day of the Lord. The 2nd Watch is now – November 2006 until April 1, 2010. The 3rd Watch is April 1, 2010 until end of 2013, beginning of 2014, as his day is based upon the Jewish calendar and not the Gentile Gregorian calendar. But, the latest that the Lord will come to do His Good Works as we ask, is the beginning of the 3rd Watch*). ³⁹ But know this, that if the master of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have watched and not allowed his house to be broken into. ⁴⁰ Therefore you also be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect." ⁴¹ Then Peter said to Him, "Lord, do You speak this parable only to us, or to all people?" ⁴² And the Lord said, "Who then is that faithful and wise steward, whom his master will make ruler over his household, to give them their portion of food in due season? (*This is a wonderful question of the Lord. Are you wise and do you see that the Lord is looking for those people to whom He can find diligent to begin to give His instructions to equip you to enable Him to do His Good Works in the time when He has willed for that person? This tells us that it is for all of us and that this reveals to us that He is referring to the time when He will give us instruction to go do His Good Works for a person in season. You may say this****

is already being done, but it is not yet being done the way and in the magnitude by which this will occur in the Time of the Day of the Lord when His Kingdom has come, as the Lord is referring to within this passage of Scripture).⁴³ Blessed is that servant whom his master will find so doing when he comes.⁴⁴ Truly, I say to you that he will make him ruler over all that he has.⁴⁵ But if that servant says in his heart, 'My master is delaying his coming,' and begins to beat the male and female servants, and to eat and drink and be drunk,⁴⁶ the master of that servant will come on a day when he is not looking for him, and at an hour when he is not aware, and will cut him in two and appoint him his portion with the unbelievers.⁴⁷ And that servant who knew his master's will, and did not prepare himself or do according to his will, shall be beaten with many stripes.⁴⁸ But he who did not know, yet committed things deserving of stripes, shall be beaten with few. For everyone to whom much is given, from him much will be required; and to whom much has been committed, of him they will ask the more.⁴⁹ I came to send fire on the earth (*Fire is the symbol of the increase in the Knowledge of God so that the power is received to enable the Good Works of God to be accomplished. Jesus came to open His Words and to pour out Understanding of the Scriptures so that we can obtain that fire that enables us to enable God's Good Works for others so that the Father is Glorified in front of all people that they may believe*), and how I wish it were already kindled!⁵⁰ But I have a baptism to be baptized with, and how distressed I am till it is accomplished!⁵¹ Do you suppose that I came to give peace on earth? (*Peace is God's eternal heaven that we receive through His Words, the Words of God in heaven. Jesus did not come to glorify earthly words, but to Glorify the Words of God of the Kingdom of Heaven, and through receiving His Words, people are able to freely obtain Eternal Life*) I tell you, not at all, but rather division.⁵² For from now on five in one house will be divided: three against two, and two against three.⁵³ Father will be divided against son and son against father, mother against daughter and daughter against mother, mother-in-law against her daughter-in-law and daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law."⁵⁴ Then He also said to the multitudes, "Whenever you see a cloud rising out of the west, immediately you say, 'A shower is coming'; and so it is.⁵⁵ And when you see the south wind blow, you say, 'There will be hot weather'; and there is.⁵⁶ Hypocrites! You can discern the face of the sky and of the earth, but how is it you do not discern this time? (*The Lord is saying that you can discern the time of His coming, and of the events to come. Our problem is that we do not understand His Words. Even Solomon tells us that there is a season for everything. Thins means that all things are placed into an exact cycle of time. If we understood God – meaning if we understood His Words – then we could discern all Truth, and all Truth includes the timing of everything that is going to happen within Truth, for Truth is the name God has given to the entirety of all Creation and the Ages. Everything that is within Truth hears the voice of God for all of creation was made by and consists, via the Spoken Word of God. If we seek the Knowledge of Truth, then He will reveal all Truth to us*).⁵⁷ Yes, and why, even of yourselves, do you not judge what is right?⁵⁸ When you go with your adversary to the magistrate, make every effort along the way to settle with him, lest he drag you to the judge, the judge deliver you to the officer, and the officer throw you into prison.⁵⁹ I tell you, you shall not depart from there till you have paid the very last mite."

THE "GOOD" "SACRIFICE" IN THE "SIDE" AND THE "WALL"

THE WORDS OF GOD ARE THE ONLY "GOOD" WORKS; AND THEY ARE THE COVENANT OF THE "SACRIFICE" OF PRAISE; AND THEY FRAME ALL THE 4 "SIDES", OR, THE 4 "WALLS" OF OUR HEAVENS

- ☆ The Lord looks down from Heaven upon the children of men, to see if there are any who understand, who seek God. They have all turned aside, they have together become corrupt; there is none that does GOOD, no, not one. Psalm 14:2-3, and Psalm 53:2-3
- ☆ He shall call to the heavens from above, and to the earth, that He may judge His people: Gather to Me My holy ones (saints), who have made a covenant with Me by SACRIFICE. Psalm 50:4,5
- ☆ Offer the SACRIFICE of praise (*His Words*) to God, and pay your vows to the Most High. Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall honor (glorify) Me. Psalm 50:14,15



As a final thought, consider John 15:7 and meditate on the ways of David, and you will find understanding and the way of every path to Good.

- ☆ **John 15:7** "If you abide in Me, and My Words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, **and it shall be done for you.**"
- ☆ **Proverbs 19:8** He who gets Wisdom loves his own soul; **he who keeps Understanding WILL "find" Good.** (*It is a promise of God that He will open it to us if we diligently seek to receive Understanding, and that comes from the entrance of His Words in our hearts – Psalm 119:130*)
- ☆ **Proverbs 2:1-6** ¹My son, if You receive My Words, and treasure My commands within you, ²so that you incline your ear to wisdom (*Discern God's Words*), and apply your heart to understanding (*Seek Understanding Of The Ways The Lord Used The Words As He Was Shown By The Father*); ³yes, if you cry out for discernment, and lift up your voice for understanding, ⁴if you seek her as silver, and search for her as for hidden treasures; ⁵THEN you WILL understand the fear of the Lord, and FIND the knowledge of God. ⁶For the Lord gives wisdom; from His mouth come knowledge and understanding. ⁷He stores us sound Wisdom for the Upright; He is a shield to those who walk uprightly. ⁸**He guards the paths of Justice, equity and every Good path.**
- ☆ **Proverbs 10:14** Wise people store up knowledge.
- ☆ **Proverbs 12:8** A man will be commended according to His knowledge.
- ☆ **Job 36:24** Remember to magnify His work, of which men have sung. (*We are to remember to magnify God by doing Good Deeds. We do that by being doers of His Words and enabling Him to do His Good Works*).
- ☆ **Psalm 50:22-23** ²²Now consider this, you who forget God, lest I tear you into pieces, and there be none to deliver you: ²³**Whoever gives a Thanks Offering glorifies Me (The Lord); and I will show the salvation of God to him who shows the Way** (*The Lord will do the work for those who do the Words of God so that others may see the Glory of God. The Lord is saying that if you will teach others His Good, then He will give you your salvation*).

David reveals in Psalm 119:99-100 that he was wiser in the Understanding of the Knowledge of God than all of His teachers; he also adds that he had more understanding than all of the ancients. But, consider how David was able to gain this knowledge. In Psalm 119:65-72 David tells us that he obtained this knowledge by receiving God's Words and then asking the Lord to give Him understanding of Good (*Good Judgment*) and increasing his knowledge in the ways of God. Thus David is giving his personal testimony that what He claims in Psalm 119:130 is true. David says that the promises in God's Words are more value to him than thousands of shekels of gold and silver. David says that even though the Lord afflicts him, that he would still rather have the promises that are in God's Words than all things, for the Lord knows what is best for him, and that His Words are perfect for him. If you will study the wording of David in the entire Psalm 119, it is easy to determine that it was written by David after he increased in the knowledge of God's Words and realized how valuable this knowledge was. The Psalm is all about the reasons and the ways of how to diligently seek after Understanding and the knowledge of how to enable God's Good Works. This is why it is the center chapter of the entire Bible that was been given to us by the Father to fully equip us to perform every Good Work.

- ☆ **Psalm 119:65-72** ⁶⁵You have dealt well with Your servant, O Lord, according to Your Word. ⁶⁶Teach me Good judgment and Knowledge, for I believe Your Commandments (*To diligently seek His Words for increasing in the knowledge of God to enable His Good Works for others, and find the favor of God*). ⁶⁷Before I was afflicted I went astray, but now I keep Your Word. ⁶⁸You are Good, and do Good; teach me Your Statutes. ⁶⁹The proud have forged a lie against me, but I will keep Your Precepts with *my* whole heart. ⁷⁰Their heart is as fat as grease, but I delight in Your Law (*To learn His Words and to do them*). ⁷¹*It is Good for me that I have been afflicted, that I may learn Your Statutes.* ⁷²The Law of Your mouth (*The Promises of God that are in His Words*) is better to me than thousands of *coins* of gold and silver.

The following is the prayer that David offered when he had gathered the people of Israel and from their heart they had given to the Lord for use in preparing His Temple. People who owned precious stones had given these precious stones freely to the offering for the Temple with a heart to do Good. One only has to look at the precious stones that were poured into Israel as free gifts from other nations during the early parts of Solomon's reign to know that the Lord had blessed their freely doing the ways of His Words in asking the Lord to do Good for the purposes of His house. The people were diligent to seek Good even in their offerings for the building of the Lord's house and they did it with a free heart meaning they did not expect God to return such blessing to them. The rest is history....and it is the way of God when we seek Good with a pure heart.

- ☆ **1 Chronicles 29:10-16** ¹⁰Therefore David blessed the Lord before all the assembly; and David said: "Blessed are You, Lord God of Israel, our Father, forever and ever. ¹¹Yours, O Lord, is the greatness, the power and the glory, the victory and the majesty: for all *that is* in heaven and in earth is *Yours*; Yours is the kingdom, O Lord, And You are exalted as head over all. ¹²Both riches and honor *come from You*, and You reign over all. In Your hand is power and might; In Your hand *it is* to make great and to give strength to all. ¹³Now therefore, our God, we thank You and praise Your glorious name. ¹⁴But who *am I*, and who *are* my people, that we should be able to offer so willingly as this? **For all things come from You, and of Your own we have given You.** (*David is saying that they had obeyed the Lord and they had diligently sought Good, and as a result they were blessed from the Lord. From this they are returning to Him an offering from what He had given. They had not obtained this by seeking riches first. They sought the Knowledge of God and to do the way of His Words in all they did, and because of this He had blessed them exceedingly. Thus, all of what they had received was from the favor of God. Remember that when David became King the enemy was in occupation of all the land and cities of Israel. At that time David proclaimed the Words of God and said, "We must*

teach the sons of Judah the Bow – the sign of the Glory of the Lord, for only God could have delivered Israel from an occupying enemy). ¹⁵For we are sojourners and transients before You, as were all our fathers; our days on earth are as a shadow, and without hope. ¹⁶**O Lord our God, all this abundance that we have prepared to build You a house for Your holy name is from Your hand, and is all Your own."**

We have just seen evidence of the knowledge of David in regard to the wonderful favor of God that is in the Word "Good" and his awareness of God's desire for all of us to diligently seek to do Good and increase in the Knowledge of God. In the Writing "He Makes Wise the Simple", as well as in the Writing "The Word of God: Door", I have explained the wonderful heart and knowledge of a lady named Hannah, who did the way of the Words of God by going and silently praying before the Door Posts of the House of the Lord so that she could enable the Father to do a Good Work and to give her a son, whom she promised to give to the Lord for the benefit of His people. Because of her faith (*Hannah's knowledge of His Words*), the Lord answered her request and to her Samuel was born. Her wisdom of doing the way of the Lord continued even while Samuel was in the house of the Lord under the tutelage of Eli the Priest. Samuel went forth to give Israel a great blessing that led to saving the nation and setting the foundation for Israel's great time of obedience to God, and its greatest times of prosperity and power. We all know how David put the nation back together, and then grew the nation in wisdom and knowledge. We have Biblical scriptures that reveal the great growth in wealth of the nation during the short reign of David, and how this set the stage for the staggering wealth obtained by Solomon because of David's diligence in seeking the knowledge of God's Good Works for others. The nation's prosperity and strength under Solomon is the answer of God to David doing the way of the Words for the enabling of the Good Works of the Father for others, the others being Solomon and the entire nation of Israel and its neighbors. The root for the nation's miraculous prosperity and blessings under David and Solomon began with the wisdom of the barren Hannah, and as the scriptures record in 1 Samuel 12:20-25, her Good Works was then further set into a foundation by her son Samuel. God did the Good Work initiated by Hannah and grew Samuel in the wisdom that would save Israel and return the nation to following after God. For David as a youth sought diligently after the knowledge of the Words of God, and as you can see in 1 Samuel 12:20-25, it was Samuel's commitment that was the basis of the teaching in Israel of the way of Good. David had to get the key from someone to chase after knowledge. Samuel taught the nation, and did not know the boy David, but it is clear from the coming of Samuel to the house of Obed, that the entire family of Obed knew of Samuel and that they honored his teachings. Thus, we have the chain of results of the doing Good for others by faith that started with Hannah, passed on and through Samuel, became rooted in David to the Glory of the Lord, and that provides even greater blessings for the entire peoples of the world today.

☆ **1 Samuel 12:20-25** ²⁰Then Samuel said to the people, "Do not fear. You have done all this wickedness; yet do not turn aside from following the Lord, but serve the Lord with all your heart. ²¹And do not turn aside; for *then you would go after empty things which cannot profit or deliver, for they are nothing.* ²²For the Lord will not forsake His people, for His great name's sake, because it has pleased the Lord to make you His people. ²³Moreover, as for me, far be it from me that I should sin against the Lord in ceasing to pray for you; but **I will teach you the Good and the right way.** ²⁴Only fear the Lord, and serve Him in truth with all your heart; for consider what great things He has done for you. ²⁵But if you still do wickedly, you shall be swept away, both you and your king."

There is so much to teach about Good within the Bible. This Writing is only a sampling of the depth of the knowledge of doing the Good Works of the Father. What is important for us to completely understand is that it is the requirement of God that we live our life with the goal of focusing on walking justly, and increasing in the knowledge of God, and that means to increase in the fullness of the knowledge of His Words. We are to do this so that we become fully equipped to do every Good Work that is the Will of God for us to do. Jesus said that upon Peter He would build His church. Since the purpose of the church is to teach the knowledge of God so that we increase in enough of the knowledge of God so that we are fully equipped to do His Words, so that we enable Him to do His Good Works. Perhaps Peter gives to us the most complete summation of this purpose of the Lord's church in 1 Peter chapter 4. Carefully consider this teaching of Peter and you will see that we, His church, are to live in the way so that we are equipped and we are able to do all Good things. Peter also reveals that the Father places fiery trials in front of us so that we are prepared for that time when He calls us forth to do every Good Work that He has established us to accomplish for the benefit of His children. The heavenly meaning of "fire" is "an increase in knowledge of God". Thus, a fiery trial is given us to prepare us for that time when the Lord needs us to be fully equipped for being able to enable the Good Works that we have been called by the Will of God to perform.

☆ **1 Peter 4:1-19** ¹Therefore, since Christ suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves also with the same mind, for he who has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin, ²that he no longer should live the rest of his time in the flesh for the lusts of men, but for the will of God (*We are to rest in the eating of the "Flesh" of Jesus that is the symbol of the Words of God that He died to receive the authority to return and open for us and through them to open for us the Understanding of the Knowledge of God, and God is His Words and He is the power of the Promises of God that are within His Words. Jesus is the key that unlocks understanding of God and God is His Words, His Holy Spirit is His Words, and Faith is His Words*). ³For we have spent enough of our past lifetime in doing the will of the Gentiles--when we walked in lewdness, lusts, drunkenness, revelries, drinking parties, and abominable idolatries. ⁴In regard to these, they think it strange that you do not run with *them* in the same flood of dissipation, speaking evil of *you*. ⁵They will give an account to Him who is ready to judge the living and the dead. ⁶For this reason the gospel was preached also to those who are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, **but live according to God in the Spirit (His Spirit is Truth, and God**

Words are Spirit, and His Words are Truth, so we are to live in the knowledge and the way of doing His Words). ⁷But the end of all things is at hand; therefore be serious and watchful in your prayers. ⁸And above all things have fervent love for one another (*In heaven the meaning of "Love" is doing the Words of God to enable Him to do His miraculous Good Works for others as we ask of Him*), for "love will cover a multitude of sins." ⁹Be hospitable to one another without grumbling. ¹⁰**As each one has received a Gift, minister it to one another, as Good stewards of the manifold Grace of God.** (*We are to do Good knowing that whosoever seeks to do "Good" finds God's favor and has the promise of Eternal Life through the power of God's Grace that is His promise written forever within His Word "Grace" that will raise us up to Eternal Life*). ¹¹If anyone speaks, as the oracles of God (This is actually "the Utterances" or "the sayings" of God. If anyone ministers, as with the ability which God supplies (*God gives us His promises within His Words, and when do them, the Father does the Good Works as we are asking by our doing the Way of His Words within His Will*), that in all things (*All Good Works*) God may be Glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belong the Glory and the Dominion forever and ever. Amen. ¹²Beloved do not think it strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened to you; ¹³but rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ's sufferings, that when His Glory (*His Good Works*) is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy. ¹⁴If you are reproached for the name of Christ, blessed are you, for the Spirit of Glory and of God rests upon you (*His Power is with you so that He can be witnessed to be strong when He raises you up*). On their part He is blasphemed (*Those who do not receive His Words are not of God, and that is blaspheming God, for His Words are Spirit and God is Spirit*), but on your part He is glorified. ¹⁵But let none of you suffer as a murderer, a thief, an evildoer, or as a busybody in other people's matters. ¹⁶Yet if anyone suffers as a Christian, let him not be ashamed, but let him glorify God in this matter. ¹⁷For the time has come for judgment to begin at the house of God; and if with us first, what will be the end of those who do not obey the Good News of God? (*The Father says that if they will not hear His Words that He sent Jesus to speak that He will require it of them – Deuteronomy 18:18-19*). ¹⁸Now "If the righteous one is scarcely saved (*The Righteous are those who received His Words and do them*), where will the ungodly and the sinner appear?" ¹⁹**Therefore let those who suffer according to the Will of God commit their souls to Him in doing Good, as to a faithful Creator.**

THE PROMISE IN HIS WORD: GOOD

The Lord has told us that only God is Good, and the Lord has told us that it is the desire of God that all of seek to do Good. David revealed that God is looking down from heaven to see if any of us are going to understand do Good. The Lord has promised that if we will just diligently seek to do His Words so that He is enabled to do His Good Works for the benefit of others, then He will give us favor. The Lord has said that if we even diligently seek to do Good with a sincere heart then He will give us favor. Jesus said that when He abides in us, and when His Words abide in us, then whatever we ask will be done for us (*John 15:7*). Speaking does not generally satisfy the act of asking God to do His Good Works. Rather it is done by our physically doing the way of the promises that are in God's Words. Such as Abraham making a pact with King Abimelech by giving him seven lambs so that the Father would cause the truth of the covenant to be upheld for all generations by His promise that is within His Words. Jesus said that if we turn to Him then He will pour out His Spirit of Truth upon us and that He will make all Truth known to us. By that by the statement would include the way of doing His Words to enable the Father to do His Good Works for us. The apostle James warns us that if we do the way of the Words to gain for ourselves things of the world and to fulfill our own lusts, then the Father will not answer our request. Further, the Lord says that if we do the way of His Good, then He will give us favor, and that we are not to ask for favor, but to trust in Him to know what we truly need, and that He will give all those who do Good and put their trust in Him without worry.
