THE MEANING OF THE WORD OX AS IT IS SPOKEN AND DONE IN HEAVEN

The Ox represents the teachers of His Word. For the Oxen is strong and pulls the loads of the people to plow up the ground. The Ox (*Preacher/Teacher*) pulls the plow across the field of His people by speaking of the Words of God, and the Ox helps plant the Words of God in the plowed ground. But, it is the Spirit of the Lord that plants His seed in the soil that is plowed by the Ox. The Ox just works, and it is the Lord who does the true work of making sure the seed gets into the plowed ground. The Ox goes back over the field allowing the Lord to add more nourishment to the seed that has been planted. This is the Lord's servant helping the congregation with instruction so that the people understand the way of the Word and how to seek the Lord to increase in knowledge of His Word and of His Works. The priests and teachers are to plant the seed, and then bring forth knowledge from the teaching of the Word and the ways of the Works of the Lord so that His people are fed and it will go well with them in their life. The teachers of His Words are to assist the people to seek the Lord so that they can come to understand and be fully equipped to do every Good Work of the Lord for His glory. The teacher is to give understanding and knowledge of His Word, and in what knowledge to seek from the Lord. The Lord then pours out His Spirit upon them and He makes His Words known to them. The point is that if the Priests will obey the Lord and teach His Words and the Way of His Words on the Lord's Holy Day – the Sabbath Day – then the Lord will take on the responsibility of doing the Good Work of making the minds of the people to understand His Words.

☆ **Proverbs 1:23** ²³**TURN AT MY REPROOF: SURELY I WILL POUR OUT MY SPIRIT ON YOU. I WILL MAKE MY WORDS KNOWN TO YOU.**

Can you imagine this, really? The Lord is saying He will give a Priest the easiest teaching job in the world. All the Preacher has to do is preach the Way of His Words, and He will cause the people to gain the understanding of His Words. All the Preacher has to do is to get the people turned so that they see that there are Words, and if they will come to Him to seek knowledge of this Words, then the Almighty God of Heaven, our Lord and Savior promises to make His Words known to them. If the preacher will do the Way of His Words to enable the Father to do a Good Work for the people to come to hear His Words, then the Lord cause the people to seek and to hunger for knowledge of His Word. An important point that we miss in the Bible is that we do not get saved from our doing good works, but our works are accepted as righteousness, as Abraham's, when we do the way of His Words such that we enable the Father to do a Good Work for others as we asked of Him. The things that Abraham did were done to enable the Father to bless his seed and the generations of that seed. He did this because that was the will of the Lord for Him, as was revealed by the Lord in Genesis 18:19. We are told this instruction by James in James 1:22-24, that we are to be doers of the Word so that we separate ourselves from others and showing the evidence of this by our seeking of His Words so that we are able to do them. That is the way we know what kind of person we are, whether we are of God or not of God. Thus, it is also the Way we are able to tell if a preacher is of God or not of God. If He does not hear His Words and does not preach them, then they are not of God. For it is the receiving of His Words that judges us, as the Lord made perfectly clear in John 12:48. Jesus says that if we reject that He was sent into the world to speak the Words of God, then we are not of God and do not have eternal Life, for we do not believe Him, again this is clearly proclaimed by the Lord in John 12:48. Thus, if preachers do not preach His Words when they are opened to man, then how can they be of God?

☆ **James 1:22-24** ²²But be doers of the Word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. ²³For if anyone is a hearer of the Word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror; ²⁴for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was.

☆ **John 8:47** ⁴⁷"He who is of God hears God's Words; therefore you do not hear, because you are not of God."

☆ **John 5:24-25** "Most assuredly, I say to you, **he who hears My Word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into everlasting life.** Most assuredly, I say to you, the hour is coming, and now is, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God; AND those who hear will live."

☆ **John 12:48** "**He who rejects Me, and does not receive My Words has that which judges him – the Word that I have spoken will judge him in the last day.**"

☆ **John 6:63** "The Words that I speak to you are Spirit, **AND THEY ARE LIFE.**"

Jesus said that He is the only Good Teacher. This does not mean that there are not other teachers. This means that He is the only person who can teach you the Way of God's Words that have His promises in them so that you can receive the knowledge to be able to do His Words so that you are able to enable the Good Works of the Father to be done for you as you ask it of Him. The Lord is our Teacher of Good, and only god is Good, and the Words of God are God for He does not give His Words in anything less than the full measure of His Spirit, and God is Spirit. The Lord Jesus, our High Priest, also was a High Priest in the Way of Righteousness for He spoke (*taught*) and did the Ways of the Words of God so as to enable the Father to do a Good Work for those to whom He was sent. In every miracle and every teaching instruction, the lord did all of them by doing them in the Way of His Words. That is the duty of His Oxen, to be like Him. His Oxen are sent as He was sent, to speak the Good News – the Words of

God, and to do the Way of the Words of God (*Deuteronomy 18:18-19; John 3:34*) so that the Father is enabled to cause His people to receive His teachings.

- ☆ **Psalm 119:130** The Entrance of Your Words Gives Light; It gives Understanding to the Simple.
- ☆ **Proverbs 9:10** Understanding of the Holy (*Can be Holy One or Ones, or all things Holy*) is knowledge. (*Understanding comes by the entrance of His Words per Psalm 119:130, and that comes by the pouring out of His Spirit – Pr. 1:23*)
- ☆ **1 John 1:5** This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that **God is Light** and in Him is no Darkness at all.
- ☆ **John 8:12** “I am the Light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in Darkness, but have the Light of Life.”
- ☆ **John 5:46-47** “For if you believed Moses, you would believe Me, for He wrote about Me. But if you do not believe His writings, how will you believe My Words?” (*If you think about it, we do not believe the Writings of Moses. If we did, would we be getting tattoos when God says that this is an abomination to Him? Or, would we standby and allow abortions when the Lord says that He is going to punish those who standby and allow His innocent ones to be killed? Or, would we allow anything to be taught to our children that goes against the Lord’s explanation that the Creation was accomplished in x days? Also, if we believed Moses then why would we not be teaching His Words to our children everyday? Why would we not have His Words on our doors? Why would we not demand that His Words be placed upon our business doors and upon our government office doors, etc.? Because of even just this we should see that we actually do not believe the Writings of Moses; and we should also understand that because of this the Lord says that we will not be able to understand and to discern His Words. Why? It is because we actually have our minds so full of preconceived ideas that we do not listen to the Lord with clear ears, and we do not read His Words with open eyes. Thus, you can understand that we do not know His Words because we actually do not hear His Way and we do not see His Way, and by this we come under the condemnation of God as is recorded in Deuteronomy 18:18-19, John 8:47, and Hebrews 10:25-31, because God cannot lie. There is no condemnation to those who love the Lord and believe on Him, but Jesus says in John 14:23-24 that if we do not keep His Words we do not love Him; so whether we desire to believe it or not, we have a problem coming from the Lord for our complacency in loving Him and in believing on Him).*

There is a great example of this in the Lord’s feeding of the 5,000, as is recorded in John 6. Probably all of us have heard the story of the Lord feeding the 5000, as well as the Lord then departing from that place in the midst of the Night by walking upon the Sea of Galilee, that is called the Sea of Tiberias, to go to the other side. Before the Lord had fed the 5000 and then walked across the Sea, He had ministered to many on the first side of the Sea. The Lord had performed many great miracles, and a great multitude had witnessed and participated in these miracles. When the Lord got to the other side, much of the crowd from the place where He had just taught had followed Him to the new place where He was going. That is a very interesting note, and in it there is revealed a great Truth of the Way of the ministry of Jesus within this event. The Lord greets these people and proclaims something very curious. In John 6:26 the Lord says, “Most assuredly, I say to you, you seek Me, not because you saw the signs (*miracles*), but because you ate of the loaves and were filled.” At first glance at this statement we likely say that these people did not come because the miracles of the healings, but because they liked the free food. We thus are saying that to they came because of the miracle of being fed the bread and fish, or the miracles of multiplying the bread and fish. But, if you will observe closely you will see that the Lord is very precise in His statement and He reveals exactly what He means. If He was talking about the miracle of creating the abundance of the bread the Lord’s statement would be wrong, because then it would be referring to a miracle – the miracle of creating all that bread. The Lord is saying that the people came and followed Him because they were most hungry for learning instruction and not for miracles. Please follow this carefully, and I believe that you will become overjoyed at the Lord’s teaching. Jesus did the Way of the Words “Bread” and “Meat” when He provided this bread and this meat to these people. This event happened at a time prior to the Passover. At the Passover the people would not be allowed to eat any bread that has leaven, and Jesus fed them from the 5 Barley loaves. The reason for the bread is that it is representing the Lord giving the instruction of the Way to do the Words of God to enable the Good Works of the Father to be one for them. This was celebrated prior to the Lord passing through and killing the first-born of Egypt that was the final act that enabled the Israelites to be freed from the Pharaoh. Jesus desired to cause these people to begin to understand the Way of the Word “Bread” and the Word “Meat” (*or commonly also called as “Food”*) so that during the time of the Passover this would come into remembrance and they would seek after His instruction. The Lord used this event teach the people that He was the bread sent down from heaven, of the bread is the symbol of the instruction of how to do the Way of the Promise of God that is in each of His Words. The Lord also used the event to show that His body that would be sacrificed on the Cross for their sins was the symbol for the Words of God, and thus the fish, where the “Food” or “Meat” that represented the Promises of God that are to be found in each of the Words of God. The Lord was revealing to these people that they are not following because of these miracles of healing that they had witnessed and heard about. They were not following Him for the miracle the multiplication of the Bread. The Lord is saying that they are following Him because He did the Way of the Words of God, and the Father did for Him what He asked of Him by His actions. Consider this in the following Scriptural account of this event.

- ☆ **John 6:1-71** ¹After these things Jesus went over the Sea of Galilee, which is *the Sea of Tiberias*. ²Then a great multitude followed Him, because they saw His signs, which He performed on those who were diseased. ³And Jesus went up on the mountain, and there He sat with His disciples. ⁴Now the Passover, a feast of the Jews, was near.

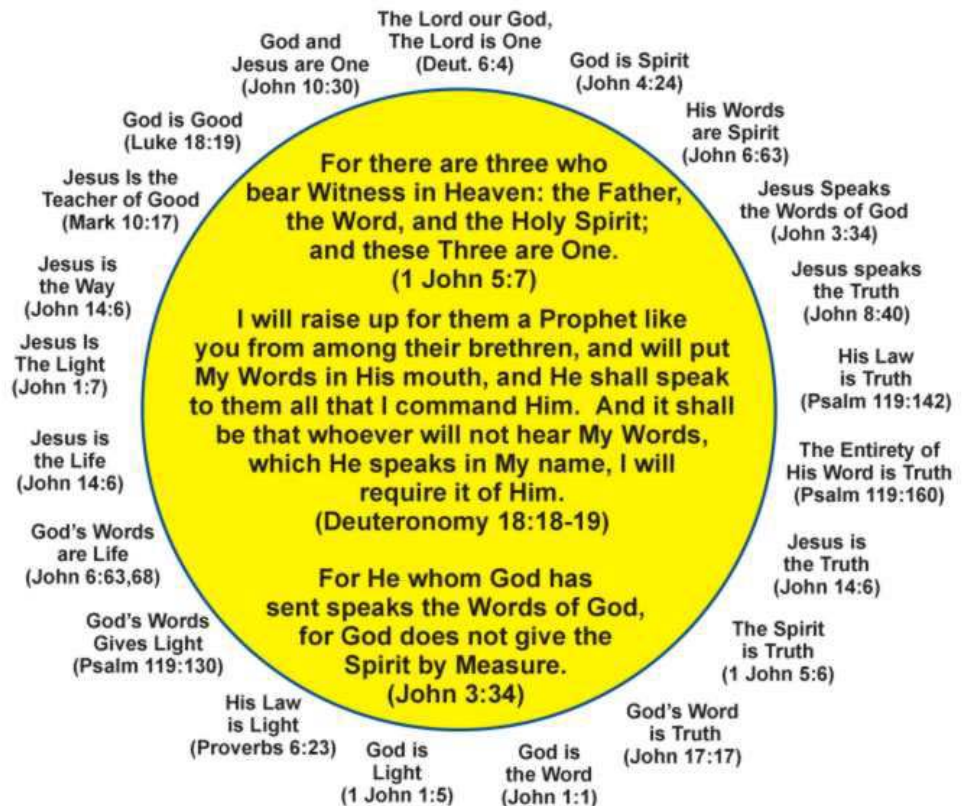
⁵Then Jesus lifted up *His* eyes, and seeing a great multitude coming toward Him, He said to Philip, "Where shall we buy bread, that these may eat?" ⁶But this He said to test him, for He Himself knew what He would do. ⁷Philip answered Him, "Two hundred denarii worth of bread is not sufficient for them, that every one of them may have a little." ⁸One of His disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, said to Him, ⁹"There is a lad here who has five barley loaves and two small fish (*The number 5 represents the Law of God, and the number 2 represents Jesus, and the number 7 (5+2=7) represents the Spirit. Thus Jesus is the instructor of the Law, it He pours out the Spirit to make His Words known to us*), but what are they among so many?" ¹⁰Then Jesus said, "Make the people sit down." (*Take notice of the Way that the Lord is doing. By wisdom the Lord decides what it is that He should do. Remember that Isaiah 50:4 it is revealed that the Lord Jesus sought the Father and the Father had prepared Him each day to speak a Word to those who are weary in the season. The Lord gives out His instructions every day and He also guides us so that we will be where He needs us to be in its season. Here in this event the Lord is doing the Way of the Words "Mountain", "Grass", "Bread", "Fish", "Meat", and "Rest". The Lord is on top of the mountain. It is as it is in heaven, for the people were coming towards the Lord. The Lord has said that whoever seeks shall find. The Bible says that the Lord looks down at the people on the earth and they are as Grass to Him. Like Grass the Lord brings us forth from the earth in our Season to do what He has purposed for us, if we will listen to Him, seek Him for knowledge, and seek what is His Will for us. Thus, by wisdom the Lord had them to sit down among the Grass. He then took the 5 loaves of bread and the two fishes and when He had thanked the Lord for them and the feeding of the 5000 men, He distributed it among His disciples to go forth and distribute to the people. He was giving these as the instruction of His Words as they are spoken and as they are done in Heaven, and the meat of heaven for it was the desire of Jesus that the Father use this event to open the minds of these people to receive the knowledge of the Promises of God that are in His Words. The Lord was thanking the Father not for the food that these people ate, but for filling their minds with the hunger for instruction of the Way of His Words and a desire for the meat of the Knowledge of His Promises that are in His Words. The Father saw His Good deed of doing the Way of His Words and He opened up a hunger for the instruction of His Words to do Good Deeds for others*) Now there was much grass in the place. So the men sat down, in number about five thousand. ¹¹And Jesus took the loaves, and when He had given thanks He distributed *them* to the disciples, and the disciples to those sitting down; and likewise of the fish, as much as they wanted. ¹²So when they were filled, He said to His disciples, "Gather up the fragments that remain, so that nothing is lost." ¹³Therefore they gathered *them* up, and filled twelve baskets with the fragments of the five barley loaves, which were left over by those who had eaten. ¹⁴Then those men, when they had seen the sign that Jesus did, said, "This is truly the Prophet who is to come into the world." (*Notice that he people call the miracle of the bread and the fish as a sign*). ¹⁵Therefore when Jesus perceived that they were about to come and take Him by force to make Him king, He departed again to the mountain by Himself alone. ¹⁶Now when evening came, His disciples went down to the sea, ¹⁷got into the boat, and went over the sea toward Capernaum. And it was already dark, and Jesus had not come to them. ¹⁸Then the sea arose because a great wind was blowing. ¹⁹So when they had rowed about three or four miles, they saw Jesus walking on the sea and drawing near the boat; and they were afraid. ²⁰But He said to them, "It is I; do not be afraid." (*Take notice of what the Lord is saying, and remember that these disciples had also partaken of the bread and the fish that the Lord had asked of the Father to incline their mind to hear instruction and to receive the Way of His Promises. He is saying that He was creating the great wind and the waves, for He said "It is I, do not be afraid". He was showing them that in the storm He will come to Him and that He brings the storm to test people. If we have faith and we place Him into our ship, our human vessel, the storm is over and our house, our vessel, is swept clean. And after He has tested us, He will appear and He will immediately take us to where He is desiring for us to go*). ²¹Then they willingly received Him into the boat, and immediately the boat was at the land where they were going. (*This is one of the greater scientific miracles in the New Testament. A wood ship traveled supersonic speeds and those in it did not have to have air masks or protection of any kind. When Jesus comes to the storm, He comes with great power and knowledge*). ²²On the following day, when the people who were standing on the other side of the sea saw that there was no other boat there, except that one which His disciples had entered, and that Jesus had not entered the boat with His disciples, but His disciples had gone away alone-- ²³however, other boats came from Tiberias, near the place where they ate bread after the Lord had given thanks-- ²⁴when the people therefore saw that Jesus was not there, nor His disciples, they also got into boats and came to Capernaum, seeking Jesus. ²⁵And when they found Him on the other side of the sea, they said to Him, "Rabbi, when did You come here?" ²⁶Jesus answered them and said, "Most assuredly, I say to you, you seek Me, not because you saw the signs, but because you ate of the loaves and were filled. (*Jesus is saying that the Father answered His request that He did the day before by doing the Way of His Promises that are in His Words. He filled them with a desire for instruction. They came asking Him of how He did His works, for remember that He came at Supersonic speed after they had already left seeking Him. They were indeed filled with the desire for instruction. Now that is the way for a preacher to do for His people so that they have a great desire to learn His Words and to learn of the Way of His instructions*) ²⁷Do not labor for the food which perishes, but for the food which endures to everlasting life (*The Words of God give Life and they are everlasting*), which the Son of Man will give you, because God the Father has set His seal on Him." (*Take note that the Lord is saying that the Father has set His Seal on Jesus and that means that only He can decide when and to whom to open His Words, and He said that all who will come to Him He will feed. But to Him who has received much, even more shall be given*). ²⁸Then they said to Him, "What shall we do, that we may work the works of God?" (*Consider this carefully, and you should see that this is another answer by the Father to the bread and the fish. Now they are asking for the knowledge of the Meat that is how to do a Word to enable the Father to do a Good Work for others. That is in answer to Jesus doing the Way of the Words and feeding them with the Fish*). ²⁹Jesus answered and said to them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He sent." ³⁰Therefore they said to Him, "What sign will You perform then, that we may see it and believe You? What work will You do?" ³¹Our fathers ate the manna in the desert; as it is written, *'He gave them bread from heaven to eat.'*" ³²Then Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, Moses did not give you the bread from heaven (*Moses did not provide the Bread, and He did*

not do a Good Work that enabled that bread. It was God's plan), but My Father gives you the true bread from heaven. ³³For the bread of God is He who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world." ³⁴Then they said to Him, "Lord, give us this bread always." ³⁵And Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst." ³⁶But I said to you that you have seen Me and yet do not believe. ³⁷All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will by no means cast out. ³⁸For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me. ³⁹This is the will of the Father who sent Me, that of all He has given Me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up at the last day. ⁴⁰And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have everlasting life; and I will raise him up at the last day." (*Everyone who SEES the Son are those who actually discern that the works that He was doing are being done in the Way of the Promises of God that are in His Words to enable the Father to do the Work*). ⁴¹The Jews then complained about Him, because He said, "I am the bread which came down from heaven." ⁴²And they said, "Is not this Jesus, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? How is it then that He says, 'I have come down from heaven'?" ⁴³Jesus therefore answered and said to them, "Do not murmur among yourselves. ⁴⁴No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up at the last day. ⁴⁵It is written in the prophets, 'And they shall all be taught by God.' Therefore everyone who has heard and learned from the Father comes to Me. ⁴⁶Not that anyone has seen the Father, except He who is from God; He has seen the Father. ⁴⁷Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me has everlasting life. ⁴⁸I am the bread of life. ⁴⁹Your fathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and are dead. ⁵⁰This is the bread which comes down from heaven, that one may eat of it and not die. ⁵¹I am the living bread which came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread that I shall give is My flesh, which I shall give for the life of the world." ⁵²**The Jews therefore quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this Man give us His Flesh to eat?"** ⁵³**Then Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless you eat the Flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you."** ⁵⁴**Whoever eats My Flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day.** ⁵⁵**For My Flesh is food indeed, and My blood is drink indeed.** ⁵⁶**He who eats My Flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him.** ⁵⁷**As the living Father sent Me, and I live because of the Father, so he who feeds on Me will live because of Me.** ⁵⁸This is the bread which came down from heaven—not as your fathers ate the manna, and are dead. He who eats this bread will live forever." ⁵⁹These things He said in the synagogue as He taught in Capernaum. ⁶⁰Therefore many of His disciples, when they heard *this*, said, "This is a hard saying; who can understand it?" ⁶¹When Jesus knew in Himself that His disciples complained about this, He said to them, "Does this offend you?" ⁶²**What then if you should see the Son of Man ascend where He was before?** ⁶³**It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing.** The Words (*of God*) that I speak to you are Spirit (*God is Spirit - John 4:23-24*), and *they* are life. ⁶⁴But there are some of you who do not believe." For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were who did not believe, and who would betray Him. ⁶⁵And He said, "Therefore I have said to you that no one can come to Me unless it has been granted to him by My Father." ⁶⁶**From that time many of His disciples went back and walked with Him no more.** ⁶⁷**Then Jesus said to the twelve, "Do you also want to go away?"** ⁶⁸**But Simon Peter answered Him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the Words of Eternal Life."** ⁶⁹**Also we have come to believe and know that You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."**

⁷⁰Jesus answered them, "Did I not choose you, the twelve, and one of you is a devil?" ⁷¹He spoke of Judas Iscariot, *the son of Simon*, for it was he who would betray Him, being one of the twelve.

Now that you have sent that is the instruction – even the teaching - of the Lord, that His preachers are to speak and to do the Way of His Words, we can begin to understand a great truth of the Law that Jesus said that we are to obey, as is recorded in Matthew 22:36-40. If we do not love, and I mean really love with a zealous love, the Words of God, when they are made freely available to us, then we are not in full obedience to the Great Commandment, and we are

in no ways fit for the ministry, whether it be a Preacher, Prophet, Evangelist, Bible Teacher, Sunday School Teacher, or Prayer Intercessor, for at best we are only lukewarm to God. We need to consider all the continuity of the Scriptures, as we should see that God is His Words, and His Words are God. Thus, if we are to love our God with all of our heart, mind, and soul, then we should know that we must love His Words, for God is Spirit and His Words are Spirit, and God does not give us His Words in anything less than the full measure of His Spirit. The full measure of His Spirit means that God is in His Words.

- ☆ **Matthew 22:36-40** ³⁶"Teacher, which is the great commandment in the law?" ³⁷**Jesus said to him, "you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and all your mind. ³⁸This is the first and great commandment. ³⁹And the second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. ⁴⁰On these two commandments hang all of the Law and the Prophets."**
- ☆ **John 14:23-24** ²³**Jesus answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My Word; and the Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him. ²⁴HE WHO DOES NOT LOVE ME DOES NOT KEEP MY WORDS; and the Word which you hear is not Mine but the Father's who sent Me."**
- ☆ **PROVERBS 1:32-33** ³²**For the turning away of the simple will slay them, and the complacency of fools will destroy them. ³³BUT WHOEVER LISTENS TO ME WILL DWELL SAFELY, AND WILL BE SECURE (AT EASE) WITHOUT FEAR OF EVIL.**

In the Temple of Solomon the Wash Basin was mounted upon the backs of twelve Oxen, three facing outward in each of the four directions. Symbolically the priests washed their hands to make them pure before entering into the Temple to do the Lord's work. A very important detail of the design of the bulls is that the tails of all twelve bulls, oxen, were tied together in unison at under the center of the Great Water Basin. This is symbolic that the priests were to preach one message. The Lord says that they were to teach His Words, as is made clear in Deuteronomy 6:4-9, 11:18-21, and 18:18-19. In Isaiah 58:13-14 the Lord makes it clear that if the Priests (*Or also, the Preachers, Prophets, Evangelists and Bible Teachers, of this Day*) do not preach His Words on His Holy Sabbath Day, then it will not go well with His people. Therefore we can understand that the symbolism of the tails of the Oxen being tied together is clearly representative of the instruction of the Lord that they are to preach His Words on the Sabbath Day, that the people will have the knowledge of His Words so that they can obey the Lord and speak and teach of His Words in their house and in their work all of the other days of the week.

- ☆ **Isaiah 58:13-14** ¹³**"If you turn away your foot from the Sabbath, from doing your pleasure on My holy day, and call the Sabbath a delight, the holy Day of the Lord honorable, and shall honor Him, not doing your own ways, nor finding your own pleasure, NOR SPEAKING YOUR OWN WORDS, ¹⁴then you shall delight yourself in the Lord; and I will cause you to ride on the high hills of the earth, and feed you with the heritage of Jacob your father. The mouth of the Lord has spoken."**
- ☆ **Deuteronomy 6:4-9** ⁴**Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God is one Lord! ⁵You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and all your soul, and with all your might. ⁶And these Words which I command you this day shall be upon your heart; ⁷and you shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. ⁸And you shall bind them as a sign upon your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. ⁹And YOU SHALL WRITE THEM ON THE DOOR POSTS OF YOUR HOUSE AND ON YOUR GATES."**
- ☆ **Deuteronomy 11:18-21** ¹⁸**Therefore you shall lay up these Words of Mine in your heart and in your soul, and bind them in your heart and in your soul, and bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. ¹⁹You shall teach them to your children, speaking of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. ²⁰And you shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates. ²¹that your days and the days of your children may be multiplied in the land of which the Lord swore to your fathers to give them, like the days of the heavens above the earth."**
- ☆ **Psalms 78:1-8** ¹**"Give ear, O my people, to my law; incline your ears to the Words of my mouth. ²I will open my mouth in a parable and I will utter puzzles of old (*Some Bibles translate this as dark sayings or riddles, but the proper translation should be as hidden "puzzles", or even "parables". The puzzles are the writings and sayings in the Bible that use His Words to reveal to us understanding of the works of the Holy One of Israel, Jesus Christ of Nazareth, and the only Son of God*), ³which we have heard and known and our fathers have told us. (*As they obeyed the Law of Moses in Deuteronomy 11:18-21*). ⁴We will not hide them from their children, telling to the generation to come the praises of the Lord, and His strength and His wonderful works that He has done. (*He does His Works by His Words spoken by His voice and through His angels and in so many ways that it may be beyond our ability to comprehend*). ⁵For He established a testimony in Jacob, and appointed a law in Israel, which He commanded to our fathers, that they should make them known to their children (*Deuteronomy 6:4-9; 11:18-21*); ⁶that the generation to come might know them, the children who would be born, ⁷that they may arise and declare them to their children, that they may set their hope in God, and not forget the works of God, but keep His commandments; ⁸and they may not be like their fathers, a stubborn and rebellious generation, a generation that did not set its heart aright, and whose spirit was not faithful to God." (*This reveals that it is a confirmed Law of God that we are to teach His Words to our children*).**

As a final little forethought please consider that the Lord reveals to us through David that it is by the entrance of His Words that we receive Understanding – Psalm 119:130. Also, the Lord reveals to us in Proverbs 9:10 that Understanding is Knowledge of the Holy. That reveals that if we get His Words that we will have understanding, and that understanding is the Knowledge of Holy – the Holy God, the Holy Spirit and His Holy Words. Therefore,

we should be able to come to understand that if His Oxen are not preaching His Words on His Holy Day, as He instructed them to do, then they will be rejected as being Oxen before Him. But, what the people must understand is that God forgets the children who are under such Oxen. In other words, there is a responsibility here for the children, the congregation, they are required to place themselves under sound doctrine. Since the Lord says that because of the failure of the Oxen, we the congregation are forgotten by God, then clearly we need to seek the Lord by hearing Him, for we are without the knowledge of God, and since God is Truth, that means that we do not have the Knowledge of Truth because of the failure of the Oxen to teach His Words in obedience to the Lord. My point is not to belittle the Oxen, but to open the eyes of both the oxen and the flock. But, I am trying to say to the flock that until now we could not receive His Words from the Oxen because they had failed to receive His Words. The Lord makes this also clear in Luke 14:15-24, that because of the failure of the Oxen, the invited guests, to obey Him and to receive His Words, that they Lord says that everyone of the Oxen have failed to receive His invitation to come and increase in knowledge of Truth by eating at His prepare Table, thus the people must be seeking their own way to the Table that they might eat and increase in the knowledge of the Truth.

- ☆ **Hosea 4:6** “MY PEOPLE ARE DESTROYED FOR LACK OF KNOWLEDGE. **Because you have rejected knowledge, I also will reject you from being a priest before Me**, because you have forgotten **the law of your God ! also will forget your children.**”
- ☆ **Proverbs 2:6** For the Lord gives Wisdom: From His mouth come Knowledge and Understanding.
- ☆ **Proverbs 15:14** The heart of him who has Understanding seeks Knowledge, but the mouth of fools feeds on foolishness.
- ☆ **Proverbs 12:15** The way of a fool is right in his own eyes, but he who heeds counsel is wise.
- ☆ **Proverbs 12:1** Whoever loves instruction loves knowledge, but he who hates reproof is stupid.
- ☆ **Proverbs 10:23** A man of Understanding has Wisdom.
- ☆ **Proverbs 23:12** Apply your heart to Instruction, and you ears to **Words of Knowledge**.
- ☆ **Proverbs 24:5** A wise man is strong, yes, a man of knowledge increases strength.
- ☆ **Proverbs 18:15** The heart of the prudent (*This Hebrews word translated here as “prudent” also means one having “cunning Wisdom”, or “valuable Wisdom”*) acquires knowledge, and the ear of the Wise seeks Knowledge.

THE WAY OF THE WORD OX

The oxen represent the priests and teachers of the Words of God. In the Temple of Solomon the Basin of Water, that is called “the Sea”, was mounted upon the backs of twelve oxen that were molded as one. The oxen were designed so that three oxen faced out in each direction while the hind ends (*At their tails*) of the oxen were joined to each other, so that it represented that the teachings of the priests were to be of the same united root of knowledge. The Basin is the place where the priests washed their hands after burning the sacrifices to the Lord on the altar. The oxen represented the priests whose job it was to teach the Words of God to each of the twelve tribes of Israel unto all the ends of the earth. Sin is washed away and swept clean by the Word of God (*John 15:30*). In Proverbs 16:6 we are taught that it is by the knowledge of the fear of the Lord that men turn away from evil and follow the instruction of the Lord. In Psalm 119:130 we are taught that it is by the entrance of His Words that men receive the Spirit of Wisdom (*The Light of God*) that gives understanding even to the simple.

It would seem likely that the Oxen should be the ones to guide the people in teaching them to accomplish that which the Lord desires His people to obtain. We are told the secret of these requirements in basically four basic Scriptures. The first basic requirement is to obey the two Great Commandments – Matthew 22:36-40. The second basic principle is found in 1 Timothy 2:3-4, and in that passage the Lord is revealing that we are to seek to obtain the knowledge of the Truth that only He can open to us, and which Paul informs us in Hebrews 10:25-31 that it would not be received by us until the Day of the Lord approaches. The third basic principle that the Lord has made for His Oxen to guide us in, is the instruction that we are to increase in Knowledge of Him so that we are able to enable to do Good. The fourth basic principle is that we are to receive His Words, and to teach them daily to those in our house, in our business, and in our government. We will look at these in this Writing from the basis that these four principals are really the same principle. We are to hear His Words, receive them, and become a doer of His Words, fulfilling the Great Commission to take the Good News to all those in the world.

- ☆ **Matthew 22:36-40** ³⁶“Teacher, which is the great commandment in the law?” ³⁷**Jesus said to him, “you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and all your mind.** ³⁸**This is the first and great commandment.** ³⁹And the second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. ⁴⁰On these two commandments hang all of the Law and the Prophets.”
- ☆ **1 Timothy 2:3-4** For this is Good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, **who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the Truth.**
- ☆ **Hosea 6:6** ⁶For I desire “Good Deeds” and not sacrifice, and the “knowledge of God” more than burnt offerings.
- ☆ **Micah 6:8** ⁸He has shown you, O man, what is Good; and **WHAT DOES THE LORD REQUIRE OF YOU BUT TO DO JUSTLY, TO LOVE GOOD DEEDS, AND TO WALK HUMBLLY WITH YOUR GOD?**

In this Writing we are going to look at a few Ways of the Lord pertaining to Oxen. Jesus says that the first of His Ways are Righteousness and Justice – Genesis 18:19. That is simple. Everyone knows what Justice is, that is to keep all the ways of Truth. However, do we really understand what Righteousness is? It is actually similar to Justice, for the Lord says that he who speaks Truth, declares Righteousness. Now, with that in mind, consider His Ways within the context of what Moses recorded in Deuteronomy 18:18-19. In that passage Moses records that the Father gives us clarity about the requirement of His Way, for He says that He sends a prophet who will speak His Words and do the things He says in His Words. Clearly this has to be held against our account when the Words are opened so that we can hear and see them done. Until that time the Lord's covering from the Cross covered us when He said, "Father forgive them for they know not what they do." But, since 2003 His Words have been opened, and in Zephaniah 1:12 He says that in these days He will punish us for our complacency. Further, Paul adds in Hebrews 10:25-31 that as the Day of the Lord approaches, and the Knowledge of Truth is received, there no longer remains that plea of easy Mercy – or Mercy for ignorance - the Lord that He gave to us while on that terrible Cross. The Lord gives us Mercy, for sure, but now we are accountable to ask for Mercy in accordance of knowledge. Who are the teachers of Knowledge? The Bible refers that the responsible ones are the preachers and the fathers. In Deuteronomy 18:18-19, the Father clearly proclaims that if anyone refuses to hear His Words spoken by Jesus and will not keep the ways of the works of His Words that were revealed to us by Jesus, then He is going to hold us into account for our sin of complacency. The Lord Jesus tells us that we must be able to hear His Words and accept them, if we are to say that we believe Him and that we love Him (*John 14:23-24*).

I would like you to consider the true issue of the ox. The Ox is to have a yoke around it, and if it is a proper Ox who is working for His true Master, then it is the yoke of that Master that will be around its neck. The Oxen is to go forward doing the work that his Master desires that he do. The Oxen is not supposed to wear another master's yoke (*A yoke of the works of the spirit of the antichrist that are rebellion against the straight and narrow path that was instructed by the Lord within His Words as are recorded in the Bible*). He is also not supposed to plow in another master's field. Also, the Ox is not supposed to pull the plow for another master and allow him to plant weaker or even corrupted seed in his Master's field. The Lord's Oxen are supposed to teach what their Master has told them to speak with their tongues, and not their own Words and not their own Wisdom.

- ☆ **Matthew 7:24** ²⁴Therefore every one who hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, shall be likened unto a wise man, who built his house upon the rock:
- ☆ **Psalms 119:130** The Entrance of Your Words Give Light; It gives Understanding to the Simple.
- ☆ **Ephesians 1:13-14** ¹³In Him you also trusted, after you heard the Word of Truth, the Good News of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of Promise, ¹⁴who is the guarantee of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, to the praise of His Glory.
- ☆ **Jeremiah 9:3** "And their bow they have bent their tongues in lies. They are not valiant for the Truth on the earth. For they proceed from evil to evil, and they do not know Me," says the Lord.
- ☆ **James 4:4** Adulterers and adulteresses! (*Those who desire to stay in the world are making as a friend of the world. Do not desire to stay in the world because it brings you in enmity with God. It is good that our heart says that we want to do all the Good Works and save as many as we can, but the first commandment is that we are to love our God with all our heart and He has called us to bring Him Glory by being a leader guiding His people to the Rapture, and not guiding them to be complacent and to stay on. The Rapture is an event that brings Glory to the Father and that is our goal – bringing Glory to the Father. We are to work as hard as we can now to teach as many as we can, but we give the greatest Glory to the Father by being among the Raptured. The Scriptures says to work to show ourselves approved in the Faith. That means we should work to leave as much knowledge as can for the complacent unwise virgins; but the goal of the Lord is to receive us as His first chosen bride in whom He delights*). Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.

There is a fact about the Bible's instruction to us for this life that we seemed to have forgotten. The Oxen are to carry out the game plan given to them by the Lord, and not to substitute their own great plays, their own pearls of wisdom. The Bible teaches us that it is God's goal for us that each of us are striving are to obtain the Kingdom of God, and that on our path to obtain this goal, that we are to increase in knowledge so that we can become more like God. Now consider this a quick moment. Jesus said that to those to whom the Words come, that they are likened to little gods. What does a little god do? He acts like His Master, the God of heaven. What does the God of heaven do? He speaks and does His Words. What does the Son of God do? He speaks the Words of God and He does the Words of God so that the Father's Good Works can be done for others. Paul tells us in 2 Timothy 3:16-17 that the entire purpose of the Bible is to fully equip us to do every Good Work. Thus, what should be the work of an Ox? To teach the Lord's people to do every Good Work. How can He do that? By teaching the Words of God and revealing to people how the prophets and the wise men of the Lord have done this, as is recorded in the Good Works handbook that is the Bible. There is no other work of an Ox. He is not to worry about building great Temples and great ministries, for all those that are built that are not based upon the foundation of equipping His people with His Word and the knowledge of the Way of His Good Works, is a Temple that has no power, and when the storms come, great will be the fall of those churches. Many are likened to great white mansions built upon the sands of the Shore by the Sea. They look great and the life of those inside seems wonderful, and the weather is

beautiful and the sounds of the oceans waves are tantalizing to the ears, and the nights are wonderful to sit on its roof and watch the waves rolling and the stars sparkling. But, when the days of the troubles come, in one night the waves of troubles can wash that beautiful mansion into the ocean to never rise again. The beauty of the earthly works denied the power of the Words. Another ministry may not look like it has any wings, and there is not even a building for cover at night for its ox. But, that oxen has been faithfully waiting for His Master to come and to strengthen Him with instruction so that he may go forth and built a church that is built upon the power of His Word and not upon the glory of the treasures of this world. That is symbolic of an oxen that is faithful to his Master for his only desire is to longing await to hear the Word of the Lord and to always be willing to turn to follow His ways as He pulls on His cords.

- ☆ **Matthew 7:24-29** ²⁴Therefore every one who hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, shall be likened unto a wise man, who built his house upon the rock: ²⁵and the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon the Rock. ²⁶And every one that hears these Words of mine (He spoke the Words of God to them, and He spoke in Parables of instruction that He gave to them, and these parables used Words of God), and does them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, who built his house upon the sand: ²⁷and the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and smote upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall thereof. ²⁸And it came to pass, when Jesus had finished these sayings, the multitudes were astonished at his teaching: ²⁹for He taught them as one having authority, and not as their scribes.
- ☆ **John 14:23-24** ²³“Jesus answered and said to him, “If anyone loves Me, he will keep My Word; and the Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him. ²⁴HE WHO DOES NOT LOVE ME DOES NOT KEEP MY WORDS; and the Word which you hear is not Mine but the Father’s who sent Me.”

I hope that you can see that the key point to the God is that His Oxen are to wear only His yoke, and that they are to follow His lead and instruction only. Today it seems that many Oxen utilize their own substitute seed, and though it they produce that is seemingly beautiful plants, those plants are not of the seed that will select them into the Kingdom of Heaven. Thus the people who are the plant that grows from the substitute seed may look beautiful and may be seemingly strong and vibrant, is sadly, not an acceptable plant unto the Lord. There is a story of a Far East Emperor that a friend gave to me, and it is very symbolic of exactly what I am referring to. It is sad that today we seek the beautiful things of this world by our own wisdom, and we think we are beautiful before the Lord; but we fail to heed His instruction that the only way acceptable to Him is that we seek first the Kingdom of God and His Righteousness, and then He will make us beautiful and add all these things unto us. Consider this story carefully, and it may reveal an interesting truth to you....

***The Story of the Seed:** An Emperor in the Far East was growing old and knew it was time to choose his successor. Instead of choosing one of his assistants or his children, he decided to do something different. He called young people in the kingdom together one day.*

He said, "It is time for me to step down and choose the next Emperor. I have decided to choose one of you." The children were shocked, but the Emperor continued. "I am going to give each one of you a seed today - one very special seed. I want you to plant the seed, water it, and come back here one year from today with what you have grown from this one seed. I will then judge the plants that you bring, and the one I choose will be the next emperor."

One boy, named Ling, was there that day and he, like the others, received a seed. He went home and excitedly, told his mother the story. She helped him get a pot and planting soil, and he planted the seed and watered it, carefully. Everyday, he would water it and watch to see if it had grown.

After about three weeks, some of the other youths began to talk about their seeds and the plants that were beginning to grow. Ling kept checking his seed, but nothing ever grew. Three weeks, four weeks, five weeks went by, still nothing. By now, others were talking about their plants, but Ling didn't have a plant and he felt like a failure.

Six months went by--still nothing in Ling's pot. He just knew he had killed his seed. Everyone else had trees and tall plants, but he had nothing. Ling didn't say anything to his friends, however. He just kept waiting for his seed to grow.

A year finally went by and all the youths of the kingdom brought their plants to the Emperor for inspection. Ling told his mother that he wasn't going to take an empty pot. But his mother asked him to be honorable to the Emperor who had given him this opportunity. Therefore she said to him that he owed it to the Emperor to show that he had obeyed what he was told, but that for some reason the seed did not grow into a plant even though Ling had did his best. His mother told Ling that most of all be honest about what had happened.

Ling felt sick at his stomach, but he knew his mother was right. He took his empty pot to the palace. When Ling arrived, he was amazed at the variety of plants grown by the other youths. They were beautiful--in all shapes and sizes. Ling put his empty pot on the floor and many of the other children laughed at him. A few felt sorry for him and just said, "Hey, nice try."

When the Emperor arrived, he surveyed the room and greeted the young people. Ling just tried to hide in the back. "My, what great plants, trees, and flowers you have grown," said the emperor. "Today one of you will be appointed the next emperor!"

All of a sudden, the Emperor spotted Ling at the back of the room with his empty pot. He ordered his guards to bring him to the front.

Ling was terrified. He thought, "The Emperor knows I'm a failure! Maybe he will have me killed!"

When Ling got to the front, the Emperor asked his name. "My name is Ling, he replied. All the kids were laughing and making fun of him.

The Emperor asked everyone to quiet down. He looked at Ling, and then announced to the crowd, "Behold your new emperor! His name is Ling!"

Ling could not believe it, for he had not been able to even grow his seed. How could he be the new Emperor?

Then the Emperor said, "One year ago today, I gave everyone here a seed. I told you to take the seed, plant it, water it, and bring it back to me today. But I gave you all boiled seeds that would not grow. All of you, except Ling, have brought me trees and plants and flowers. When you found that the seed would not grow, you substituted another seed for the one I gave you. Ling was the only one with the courage and honesty to bring me a pot with my seed in it. Therefore, he is the one who will be the new Emperor!"

- ☆ **Matthew 7:21-23** ²¹"Not every one who says to Me, "Lord, Lord", shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that does the will of My Father who is in heaven. ²²Many will say to Me in that day, "Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and by Your name cast out demons, and by Your name do many mighty works?" ²³And then I will declare to them, "I never knew you: depart from Me, you that work iniquity." (*This is the cutting off of the complacent, rebellious, wealthy, blind, naked, and prideful pastors as per Luke 14:24*).
- ☆ **Luke 12:29-34** ²⁹"And do not seek what you should eat or what you should drink, nor have an anxious mind. ³⁰For all these things the nations of the world seek after, and your Father knows that you need these things. ³¹**But seek the Kingdom of God** (*The Kingdom of God is the Words of God that are inside you, for you have heard them and read them, but you do not know them. The Lord is saying to harvest that Words that have already been sown in you*), and all these things shall be added to you. ³²**Do not fear, little flock, for it is your Father's Good pleasure to give you the kingdom.** ³³Sell what you have and give alms; provide yourselves money bags which do not grow old, a treasure in the heavens that does not fail, where no thief approaches nor moth destroys. ³⁴**For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.**

The Bible says that many of us look good on the outside; but, He is revealing that even with our beautiful look, we have no basis in Him, for our root is of sin; for it is of a substitute seed and not a pure seed, and thus, He must cast us out and burn our beautiful flower. We are thus lukewarm and about to be cast out. The Lord cautions us that we must anoint our eyes with the eye salve of His Words that gives us Light – Psalm 119:130, and that gives understanding even to the Simple. The Lord says that it is His Words that sweep us clean and that a sacrifice of Praise of doing the way of His Words for pothers will cover a multitude of sins.

- ☆ **Deuteronomy 6:4-9** ⁴"Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God is one Lord! ⁵You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and all your soul, and with all your might. ⁶**And these Words which I command you this day shall be upon your heart;** ⁷and you shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. ⁸And you shall bind them as a sign upon your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. ⁹**And you shall write them on the door posts of your house and on your gates."**

- ☆ **Proverbs 7:1-4** ¹My son, keep my Words (*the Words of God*), and treasure my commands within you. ²Keep my commands and live, and my law as the apple of your eye. ³**Bind them on your fingers** (*Rings with His Words*); write them on the tablet of your heart. ⁴Say to wisdom, "You are my sister," and call understanding *your* nearest kin.
- ☆ **Proverbs 6:21-23** ²⁰My son, keep your father's command, and do not forsake the law of your mother. ²¹Bind them continually upon your heart; **tie them around your neck** (*Necklaces with His Words*). ²²When you roam, they will lead you; when you sleep, they will keep you, and *when* you awake, they will speak with you. ²³For the commandment is a lamp, and the law a light; reproofs of instruction are the way of life.
- ☆ **Deuteronomy 18:18-19** (*It is a LAW OF GOD to hear HIS WORDS*) ¹⁸"I will raise up for them a Prophet (*Jesus*) like you from among their brethren, and **will put My Words in His mouth, and He shall speak to them all that I command Him.** ¹⁹**And it shall be that whoever will not hear My Words, which He speaks in My name, I WILL REQUIRE IT OF HIM."**
- ☆ **John 3:34** "For He whom God has sent speaks the Words of God, for God does not give the Spirit by measure."

- ☆ **John 3:36** "He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him".
- ☆ **James 1:22-25** ²²**BUT BE DOERS OF THE WORD, AND NOT HEARERS ONLY, DECEIVING YOURSELVES.** ²³**FOR IF ANYONE IS A HEARER OF THE WORD AND NOT A DOER, HE IS LIKE A MAN OBSERVING HIS NATURAL FACE IN A MIRROR;** ²⁴for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was. ²⁵**But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues *in it*, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does.**
- ☆ **Proverbs 1:23** Turn at My reproof; Surely I will pour out My Spirit on you; I will make My Words known to you.
- ☆ **John 8:47** "He who is of God hears God's Words; therefore you do not hear, because you are not of God."
- ☆ **Revelation 3:14-22 (The Lukewarm, or "Deceived" Church)** ¹⁴"And to the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write, 'These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God: ¹⁵"I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot. I could wish you were cold or hot. ¹⁶So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spew you out of My mouth. ¹⁷Because you say, 'I am rich, have become wealthy, and have need of nothing' -- and do not know that you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked -- ¹⁸**I counsel you (*warn you*) to buy from Me gold refined in the fire, that you may be rich; and white garments, that you may be clothed, that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed; and anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see.** ¹⁹As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. Therefore be zealous and repent. ²⁰Behold, **I STAND AT THE DOOR AND KNOCK. If anyone hears My voice AND opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.** ²¹To him who overcomes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne. ²²He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches."

Jesus said that it is impossible for us to get even a basic understanding of His Words, if we do not believe that the entirety of the Books of Moses talk about Him, then the Lord is saying that His Words will be even more difficult for us to discern from out of the Scriptures. If His Oxen do not desire to be reproved by Him, then they will in now way desire to hear His Words, and when they are spoken and His instruction is spoken, even through their mouths, they will not be able to discern the Truth, for they will dilute the pure Word of God with their own interpretation instead of comparing it with the fullness of the entirety of the Scriptures. David gives us a clue to this, when he says that it is the "entirety" of His Words that is Truth, and that means pieces are not to be torn away as being truth unless they agree to the fullness of all the Scriptures. Anything else causes us to use an earthly interpretation and we will not discern His heavenly and Holy Words from small pieces. It is like taking the shell of the seed and hoping it grows the everlasting fruit as God intended for the whole of the seed. There is no authority given to man outside of His Words. The disciples heard His Words during His ministry, but they did not receive the power and authority of His Words until the time had come for them to be opened to them (*John 20:21-23*). Then, when Jesus opened His Words to them, He not only gave them the authority to use His Words, He gave them the authority over the forgiveness of sin. Despite what religious leaders may proclaim, the Lord reveals that no man has that authority until he receives the knowledge of the Words of God and the Spirit of God that is in them in the full measure of God (*John 3:26-36; 6:63; 8:47; 14:23-24; 15:3; 15:7; 16:13-15; 17:8; 20:21-23; and Luke 24:44-45*).

- ☆ **Psalm 119:160** The ENTIRETY of Your Word is TRUTH. (*Everything must be tested by the fullness of the Scriptures to see that it is of God and not of the spirit of the antichrist. Jesus is the Word and all the things He said and Did are the Word, and it is only by the fullness of all those things that we are to test anything against. When the understanding of all things is applied to it, then it should shine brightly like the Light of God. For an example, people may say that the rider of the White Horse on the 1st Seal Judgment is the antichrist, but that does not agree to the fullness of the Scriptures, and it does not agree with what the Lord spoke, and thus it means that such a statement is not of the Truth*).
- ☆ **John 5:46-47** ⁴⁶"For if you believed Moses, you would believe Me, for He wrote about Me. ⁴⁷But if you do not believe His writings, how will you believe My Words?"
- ☆ **Isaiah 55:6-13** ⁶Seek the Lord while He may be found, call upon Him while He is near. (*At the Midnight Hour - ~3 years from now, there will come a Famine of the Word on the earth – Amos 8:11-14, Zechariah 14:6-7. In that Day you will not be able to find the Lord, just as He foretells in the Parable of the Ten Virgins. What will you do then if you have not prepared your vessel and stored up the knowledge of Truth inside of you during this time when His Spirit is being poured out in abundance? Will you wail like the Egyptians who lost everything and were placed into slavery in the time of the Famine?*). ⁷Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts; let him return to the Lord, and He will have mercy on him; and to our God, for He will abundantly pardon. ⁸"For My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways My ways," says the Lord. ⁹"For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts. ¹⁰"For as the rain comes down, and the snow from heaven, and do not return there, but water the earth, and make it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower and bread to the eater, ¹¹**So shall My Word be that goes forth from My mouth; it shall not return to Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.** ¹²"For you shall go out with joy, and be led out with peace; the mountains and the hills shall break forth into singing before you, and all the trees of the field shall clap *their* hands. ¹³Instead of the thorn shall come up the cypress tree, and instead of the brier shall come up the myrtle tree; and it shall be to the Lord for a name, for an everlasting sign *that* shall not be cut off."
- ☆ **1 John 2:15-17** ¹⁵**Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.** ¹⁶**For all that is in the world--the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life--is not of the Father but is of the world.** ¹⁷**And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the**

will of God abides forever. (*The Will of God is that we do Good Deeds for others and increase in the Knowledge of God – Hosea 6:6, Micah 6:8, Matthew 12:7, 1 Timothy 2:1-4, and 2 Timothy 3:16-17*).

To hear the Words of the Lord, we must desire to hear. I have often told the story of the man who was desperate for a job and he went to put in his application for the job, but he was greatly disheartened to what he experienced as he arrived. But, as you consider this story, consider the way in which the man pondered and put his faith in the written instructions that he had been given. This is what His oxen and His fathers (*Fathers are the Ox to their household*) need to do to get back to the foundation of listening to the Lord as He tries to reveal to us the way in which He will select those as being worthy of Him. We are in the Time of the Seal Judgments, and we are in a time of judgment where the Lord is having His angels to record those who are worthy and those who are unworthy. The worthy will be the ones who at the Midnight Hour who sleep in the Lord's name, for they are given rest by increasing in the knowledge of His Words. Those who sleep in the world do not increase in knowledge of His Words, for they think His sleeping is a physical sleeping. Samuel says He was resting in Paradise, and Paul revealed to us that those in Paradise are hearing His Holy Words (2 Corinthians 12:1-4), so they are gaining rest by receiving of knowledge of His Spirit.

There was a man who was down on life, having lost his way. His finances no longer allowed him to support the lifestyle that he had enjoyed. He was lonesome and depressed, for nearly all of his friends were departing from him. Even most of his family turned their shoulders away from him, even those whom he had helped over the years. His wife left and divorced him. Even his children had become either ashamed of him, or no longer regarded him highly. He had grown older, so change was not as easy an obstacle to overcome. He was depressed and alone, spending most of his nights and early morning studying the Bible and seeking the Lord. The rest of the time he was contemplating and out seeking a new job, trying to find a way to meet his mountain of debts.

There came a day when he saw in the morning newspaper an advertisement for a job position in communications that he felt he just might be qualified for. The job was in a communications office, and it stated that they were several openings for skilled and alert people having experience in communications equipment. The man had been a scientist, and many years previous he had operated and repaired communications equipment while serving in the military. So the man's heart lifted, thinking that perhaps God had heard his cries, and had shown favor upon him. The man dressed quickly and he hurried to the 4th floor office of Watch-Tower Communications, the company listed in the advertisement. His hopes were lifted, and he was eager to put in his resume. In his heart he truly hoped to be interviewed and found worthy for the job position.

As he entered the 4th floor lobby of the company's main office, he was downhearted to find that there were so many people already filling the lobby. In fact it appeared that he was likely to be the last person to be able to enter the lobby. All the other applicants had received and had completed filling out their application. Their applications had already been taken to someone inside the big double doors at the center of that lobby. And they were in the lobby hopefully waiting to see if they might possibly be interviewed for the position. So the man filled out the application, turned it in to the receptionist, and then took a seat at the very far end of the row of seats in the lobby that was filled with so many people. He was nearly sure that the job positions would have likely already been filled. But, he was determined not to lose his hope until the employer had announced their decisions. He was also convinced that he could be capable of performing this job, so he decided to wait and see.

There was a slight tenseness, a nervous anticipation that filled the lobby; however, most of the other people quietly spoke together. The other people seemed quite confident, especially the early applicants that they would surely receive the positions that were being offered. Few of the people in the lobby even noticed the man at the end of the line of chairs along the wall. Those that did notice him, seemed to be quite sure that a man coming in so late, especially a man so old, surely had no chance of even being considered for one of the positions being offered. Besides, the man looked too old for a communications job position. So the lobby, being filled with so many people, seemed to hum with a noisy buzz of so many people speaking in low voices to each other. The man just closed his eyes and offered yet another prayer to his Lord, as he sat waiting, hoping, and listening intently for his name to be called.

After awhile the man began to hear a sound that seemed to be coming out of the office with the two large doors at the center of the lobby just beyond the reception center. The sound was only slightly audible above the noise of the people in the lobby. The sound was a repetitive tapping sound. The man quietly listened to

the sound, and then he began to focus on that rhythmic tapping. Quietly the man arose from his seat, and he hurried to the center of the lobby. Without knocking the man entered through the doors of the large office at the center of the lobby just beyond the reception center. A short while later the man re-appeared, coming from out of those large double doors. Standing a little taller, the man went back to his chair at the end of the room and took a seat.

This time the other people in the lobby noticed him, for he sat there with a large and very bright smile on his face. A few people nearest to him, seeing his smile, asked him what made him so happy. The older man replied, "Well I got a job with this company, and I am now just waiting on them to finish preparing my employment paperwork". The people stared at him incredulously, as they were quite confident that they would have received a position before this old man.

Seeing their disbelief, the man continued, "Perhaps you may have heard that tapping sound that was barely audible above your voices." They continued to stare at him with speculation upon their faces, so he continued to explain. "That tapping sound was coming from beyond those center doors beyond the receptionist. That sound was coming from a machine on the desk of the Chairman. He was tapping out a Morse code message to all of us. The message that he was sending out was, 'If you hear this message then come into the main office that is located inside the two large doors at the center of the lobby, for you have a job with us.'"

Needless to say the people in the lobby were shocked. It seems that except for the older man, everyone in that group was too confident in their "assumed understanding" of how the job interview was going to occur. Therefore the calling of the chairman had come, and his calling had been like a snare to all of them. They did not hear the call for they were not watching and had not tried to think of all that he had said in the employment advertisement. They had not paid close attention to the written instructions. Therefore, relaxed in their own wisdom, they perceived that they were only listening for a loud voice to call their name to come forward to be interviewed. They were quite sure that they had followed all of the instructions. Thus, no one but the old man had been alert, and he was the only one watching and listening for any way in which the Chairman would call them to come in to be interviewed. Everyone had been so confident that they would hear his call over the loud speaker or from the receptionist, that they were too busy with the cares of their life. They were not alert and they never heard the call of the chairman. Now they could not believe that they had ignored the sound of his calling. Thus, sadly, they missed out on getting the job. For truly there had been many job openings, but the instructions of the Chairman offering the job was that He would only give positions to those people who were alert, who had followed his written instructions, and who heard his call. All those who would have heard him would have received job positions. Now it was too late, for the time of the job position offers had come and gone, and they were left out. But, one man had been listening. He had not come into the office with the idea of how this would happen; but, because he was alone and seeking, he had heard the sound above the noise.

That little story is always makes me smile, and within this Bible Study I hope that you will come to understand why. However, it is also why my heart is so often depressed, bringing me often to frustration and tears. For the truth is that this little story is very likened to the real life situation between us and our Lord. It actually depicts a very sad and very real status of our present situation. We have not heard, and we have not seen, the true message of God. We did not actually understand what is the basis of the covenant of everlasting Life that the Father sent to us. We have failed to understand what a living God is and how it is that we can truly receive Him in a manner that we will know that we know that He is in us. We have failed to recognize His Words of wisdom (*The Words of the wise*) and likewise we therefore do not seek understanding of His wisdom (*Proverbs 1:2-8*). In Proverbs 4:3-7, king David told us that the principal thing that we are to get is wisdom, and that in all our getting of wisdom we are to get understanding.

☆ **Proverbs 4:3-7** ³"When I (*Solomon*) was my father's son, tender and the only one in the sight of my mother, ⁴He also taught me, and said to me; "Keep my commands, and live. ⁵Get Wisdom! Get Understanding! Do not forget, nor turn away from the Words of my mouth (*Like Jesus, David spoke the Words of God, and he was a doer of the Words of God; for he had a heart after God's own heart, and Jesus had God's Words written upon His heart – Acts 13:13:22*). ⁶Do not forsake her, and she will preserve you; love her, and she will keep you. ⁷WISDOM IS THE PRINCIPAL THING; THEREFORE GET WISDOM. AND IN ALL YOUR GETTING, GET UNDERSTANDING."

☆ **Proverbs 1:2-8** ²To know wisdom and instruction, (*is*) to perceive (*discern*) the Words of Understanding. ³To receive the instruction of wisdom, justice, judgment, and equity; ⁴to give prudence to the simple, to the young man knowledge and discretion. ⁵A wise man WILL hear and increase learning, and a man of understanding will attain wise counsel, ⁶to understand a proverb and an interpretation (*an enigma*), the Words of the wise and their puzzles ("riddles", or "parables" that utilize the Words of God). ⁷The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction. ⁸My son hear the instruction of your father, and do not forsake the law of your mother.

☆ **Proverbs 18:15** The heart of the prudent acquires knowledge, and the ear of the wise seeks knowledge.

In Psalm 37 the great King David gives us the answer to the riddle of Good. He reveals that it is the answer to all of the things needed by man, especially in these last days. We are in the Time of the 2nd Seal Judgment, and after the

Midnight Hour the Famine will come. This Psalm is very important for us of this day, for David says that in those times of the famine the Lord will keep safe and secure those who do Good. That means we must receive His Words and increase in the knowledge of Truth so that we are able to do Good Deeds and enable the Father to do Good Works for us as we ask them of Him. For only those with His Words will be kept safe and secure. Also it is very important to listen to David's statement that those of the world who are presently seeking to destroy the righteous, and that is the World system and all of the national leaders who have entered into an illegal union with them, shall have their own sword – the Sword of Truth – turned back against them, and by their own deceitful and illegal actions that they have done, they will be cast into prisons, where they have secretly been planning to imprison God's people. This is a very important prophetic word from David for the people of this day when His Words have been opened and the Lord's Sword of Truth and His bow have been released on the world to destroy the bows and the swords of the enemy of God's people, and they are also the enemy of the Lord.

☆ **Psalm 37:1-40** ¹Do not fret because of evildoers, nor be envious of the workers of iniquity. ²For they shall soon be cut down like the grass, and wither as the green herb. ³Trust in the Lord, and do Good; dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness. ⁴Delight yourself also in the Lord, and He shall give you the desires of your heart. ⁵Commit your way to the Lord, trust also in Him, and He shall bring it to pass. ⁶He shall bring forth your righteousness as the Light (*Righteousness is the doing of the Words of God to enable a Good Work to be done for others. Likewise in Psalm 119:130 we are told that it is by the entrance of His Words that the Lord comes into us, this the Light that lights our path so that it is as the fuel for our Lamp. The Light that we shine forth is the doing of His Words, for it is the Words of God that gives us the Light so that we can shine brightly, just as Moses face was lighted as a witness to the entrance of the Words of God inside of him until he was filled with knowledge – and this wisdom filled his face with Light*), and your justice as the noonday. (*According to Genesis 18:19 the way of the Lord is to do Justice and Righteousness, and God does all things by the way of His Words*). ⁷Rest in the Lord, and wait patiently for Him; do not fret because of him who prospers in his way, because of the man who brings wicked schemes to pass. (*The Lord will bring all wickedness to Judgment in His season and to do His purpose, and that purpose is defined as doing all things so that He is able to fully equip man to do every Good Work. Thus, we can know that in these last days the Lord will bring deceit into Judgment for the Lord is going to separate Peace from away from His Justice and His Righteousness*). ⁸Cease from anger, and forsake wrath; do not fret--it only causes harm. ⁹For evildoers shall be cut off; but those who wait on the Lord, they shall inherit the earth. (*The Lord has foretold that there will be a day when the Righteous shall inherit the earth, and the evildoers shall be cut off. But, as the Lord showed the Egyptians, because the Lord is Just and He does His Work by the Way of Righteousness, it means that in these last days the Lord will reveal His Glory so that His name is made great in the earth. As He brought forth plagues upon those who followed the unrighteous ways of the Pharaoh, the Lord will bring forth plagues upon the wicked, while He keeps His Righteous people safe and secure even while they are yet in the world, before He takes them out to the Promised Land that He has proclaimed in the event called the Rapture. Before the Lord took the Israelites out of the land of Egypt, He first increased their knowledge of His Way and His power, by keeping them safe and secure while they are yet in the world, and while He brings plagues upon the earth. The Lord says that this time the people whom He is raising up will hear Him and they will obey Him and they will turn and diligently seek to increase in the knowledge of God. You see this in what the Lord is about to do His great work in Israel as is made clear in Ezekiel chapters 36-38. Make no mistake, the Lord has prepared all things that shall be required to accomplish this purpose and He will not fail in His quest because the Lord is going to do this not for us, because we are weak and unfaithful to Him, and we are lazy and complacent when it comes to seeking out the knowledge of God. But the Lord is going to spoon-feed us because He is going to raise a great multitude of people up to have knowledge, so that they will go forth and make known the knowledge of the Glory of the Lord to all men throughout the world prior to the close of the time of the 6th Seal Judgment. We can know this for the Lord even says these things, as you can see in Ezekiel 36:22 that the Lord is going to do these great things not for our sake, but for the sake of His Holy Name, and His name is Truth, and Truth is all of the 153 Holy Words of God*). ¹⁰For yet a little while and the wicked shall be no more; indeed, you will look carefully for his place, but it shall be no more. ¹¹But the meek shall inherit the earth, and shall delight themselves in the abundance of Peace (*The name of God's Eternal Heaven is "Peace", and the Lord is saying that the Meek shall inherit this earth and in that Time when the earth is remade perfect by God, the meek shall live in great abundance upon this earth within the new Eternal Heaven that will be called Peace*). ¹²The wicked plots against the just, and gnashes at him with his teeth. ¹³The Lord laughs at him, for He sees that his day is coming. ¹⁴The wicked have drawn the sword (*They speak their own words that are as a sword, but it is not a sword of Truth and no such Truth shall prosper against the Lord's people in the Night of the Time of the Day of the Lord*) and have bent their bow (*They have planned evil against His people, and they want to bring the Righteous down to bankruptcy and cause them to enter into captivity, even to kill them and not to allow them to worship the Name of Jesus Christ. But for His Holy Name's sake the Lord will not allow them to prosper*), to cast down the poor and needy, to slay those who are of upright conduct. ¹⁵Their sword shall enter their own heart, and their bows shall be broken. (*The Lord has promised that in the Night Time of the Day of the Lord, no one shall hurt His oil and wine, and the wicked shall not prosper against this people, for He shall keep them safe and secure just as Noah and his family were kept safe and secure in the times when the Lord brought storms and then the flood upon the wicked and the lawless*). ¹⁶A little that a righteous man has is better than the riches of many wicked. (*The Lord says that He is going to punish every person who has rejected His knowledge, and that in the Time of the Night of the Day of the Lord, those who are not righteous will be caused to lose all that they have and they will enter into captivity. But the Lord promises that those who are righteous and have been diligent to seek out the knowledge of Truth shall be kept safe and secure. Then the world will see that the very little that the righteous have will be multiplied so that they are satisfied and lacking in nothing*). ¹⁷For the arms of the wicked shall be broken, but the Lord upholds the righteous. ¹⁸The Lord knows the days of the upright, and their inheritance shall be forever. (*The Lord has made known that the wicked shall be brought down; but the Lord has*

established a season when He will raise up His Righteous and they will make known the Knowledge of His Glory until it covers the entire face of this earth. We are that people of the Lord whom the Lord is going to raise up to make known His Glory, for by the Word of Truth the Lord is going to cause the righteous to be set free from the wicked and set apart by His Truth).¹⁹ They shall not be ashamed in the evil time, and in the days of famine they shall be satisfied. (Everybody who is alive in this day should jump and down for this promise that David is announcing. At the Midnight Hour, that is about 3 years from now, there is coming the Time of the Night when no man can work. In those days of the Time of the Night of the time of the Day of the Lord, there is coming a famine throughout the world. During this famine there will be total economic collapse in those countries who are not of the Lord. This the time of the 3rd Seal Judgment. In those days no one will be able to buy food because they will not have enough money. In those days there will also be a famine of the Word of the Lord. For it is the time after the Midnight Hour. At the Midnight Hour the Lord will come with His Holy Angels and they will separate the wheat and the tares. From the tares He will remove His Word and in that time to the famine they will not have enough to keep them through. They will also not be protected from the plague of Death and Hades that will come upon the earth. In those days only those people who have the Word of God in them will have enough, for they will have the power of His Words with them. They will do the way of the Lord and ask the Father to do a Good Work for their neighbor and those in their household, and the Father will be pleased to do for them what they ask of Him. This is why the Lord promises that in the day of Famines those who do Good shall rejoice in the Good Works of the Lord who will fulfill all His promises for those whom He has Sealed up as being worthy of Him).²⁰ But the wicked shall perish; and the enemies of the Lord, like the splendor of the meadows, shall vanish. Into smoke they shall vanish away.²¹ The wicked borrows and does not repay, but the righteous shows mercy and gives. (The wicked have stolen from those trying to do the right thing, but the Lord is going to balance the books in these last days. But, the Lord will also have His people to do His works with Mercy and with Good works).²² For those blessed by Him shall inherit the earth, but those cursed by Him shall be cut off. (Those who receive His Word of Truth receive the Words of God, and they also receive the Promise of God that they shall be raised up to Eternal Life and that they will reign with Him and be priests with Him. But, the Lord is also going to raise His righteous up in the Time of the Night and He is going to seal them and keep them safe and secure in the Time of the Night, and in those days all of the other gods of this world will fail and the wicked shall fall into bankruptcy and enter into captivity to those who operate the world financial system and are those leaders whom they have trusted in).²³ The steps of a Good man are ordered by the Lord, and He delights in his way. (The only Way to do Good as it is done in heaven is to do the way of the Promises of the Lord that are within His Words. Those who walk in this way are delighted for as the Lord says in John 15:7, that all they ask of Him in this manner, He shall do for them. It is the Way of the Lord).²⁴ Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down; for the Lord upholds him with His hand. (They may try to knock down His people, but the Lord has promised that they will be kept safe and secure in the time of the Night. This also refers back to the Christians of the first church who had the Words of God and they persecuted them and poured out their blood in the coliseums of Rome, but those died praising God for the wonderfulness of His promises that He has placed within His Words).²⁵ I have been young, and now am old; yet I have not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his descendants begging bread. (People have not understood the meaning of this verse. The Righteous are those who have received His Words, have been diligent to seek and to receive understanding of His Words, so that they have been able to do the Way of the Promises of God that are in the Words of God, so that they have been able to enable the Father to do His good Works for others as we ask of Him. Faith is received with the Words of God, for faith comes by hearing the Word, and by this we can know that the Language of Faith is the Language of Heaven - the language of the Words of God).²⁶ He is ever merciful, and lends; and his descendants are blessed.²⁷ Depart from evil, and do Good; and dwell forevermore. (Those who do Good have received the Promise of Eternal Life that comes to them within His Words – John 6:63. Remember that we, the church of this last day, the Lord is saying that He is going to lift us up, He is going to cause us to hear Him, and for His name sake He is going to put in us His knowledge in us despite of ourselves, and He is going to do this for His name sake. We have until now rejected His Goodness, but the Lord is now going to make us to know His Good, and He is going to supernaturally pour out His Spirit of Truth on us until those who have a true desire to hear Him and we will come to know the Truth. By Truth God is going shake the nation and in a fast time the Lord is going to do a great and mighty work).²⁸ For the Lord loves justice (In Zephaniah 2:1-3, the Lord Jesus said that even if we are not righteous, that if we will still cry out to Him to bring forth Justice in the nation, then the Lord says that perhaps He will keep them from the troubles to come. Do you understand the magnitude of what the Lord has said in that verse? He is saying that Justice, that is a Justice that upholds all Truth, is so important in the eyes of the Lord, that the Lord may even keep nations from the judgment plagues in the times of the troubles of the Time of the Night of the Day of the Lord that is soon coming upon the earth. The Spirit of the Lord – the Spirit of Truth is going to move mightily upon the earth, for the Lord has promised it), and does not forsake His saints; they are preserved forever, but the descendants of the wicked shall be cut off.²⁹ The righteous shall inherit the land, and dwell in it forever. (Praise the Lord for in Ezekiel 36 the Lord says that in this day when the Lord has opened His Holy Words is opened, and this means that His Spirit is being poured out on all the people will hear Him calling out His Words and feeding you with knowledge so that you can do Good, that He is also going to pour out a revival in Israel. In Ezekiel 36 the Lord says that in this day He is now going to turn His people, and He is going to put His flesh – His Words - in their hearts, and they are going to hear Him and receive Him. They are going to be sorrowful for what they have missed, and in the coming days the Lord is going to put a hook in the nose of those who hate Israel and He is going to bring them into the land that they have determined to take over the Holy land of God, and they desire to trample upon His covenant that He made with His people, and they want to deny His promise that He shall cause this land to be delivered to His people before the Night comes of the Day of the Lord. But the Lord says in Ezekiel 36 that in these days He is soon going to bring them so that He can cleanse the lands that He has promised to the fathers of Israel to deliver to the children of Israel before the time of the Rapture has come. Too much has been made about the War in Israel, for no one should fear about Israel as it is in the hand of God and His eyes never leave the nation. Now it is the time that the Lord says that for His namesake He is going to

cause the people of Israel to hear His Words of God that He spoke, and the scales are going to come off of their eyes. Only then, as the Lord reveals in Ezekiel 36, when the wise ones of Israel have heard the Lord and have turned to Him, that He, the Lord of Hosts, shall cause those nations to come against Israel so that the Lord may use them as an example and to remove them from all of the Promised Lands, not matter what the World Financial System proclaims. For it has been the deceit of those men behind the World Financial System who have kept the promised lands of Israel from being turned over to His people as the Lord of Israel has claimed that land for His name sake. People please understand that the Lord reveals in Revelation 18:3-4 that the leaders of Israel, like those in America, have become corrupted and they have committed illegal unions with the leaders of the World Financial System, and the Bible also says that those leading merchants of Israel have also committed fornication with this illegal world system that operates a false and deceitful world currency system that is based upon their whim and that is operated to take advantage of the Lord's people and they have induced the leaders to not do Good for the Lord's people. For this reason the Lord has to bring the nation of Israel into correction, just as He has to bring America into correction. The Lord has Israel in His hand and before the Midnight Hour He will deliver the promised Land to His people of Israel who will hear Him and choose to repent and become rigidly righteous for Him. The Lord shall deliver Israel and He shall make the sands of the Promised land into a fertile garden before He raptures His Saints off of this earth. All that He has promised He will do).³⁰The mouth of the righteous speaks wisdom, and his tongue talks of justice. (All those who speak the Words of God speak Justice and declare Truth with the Bow of their tongue and His Words go out as flaming Spirits- flaming arrows shot from a bow - to enable His Works, and their Words are the Words of God and His Words only come in the full measure of the Spirit of God. The world hates righteousness because the world financial system is established upon laws of deceit and ways of corruption, and they cannot stand the Light of Truth because it will reveal their deceit and the wickedness that they have planned to destroy all those mention the name of Jesus Christ. But what they fail to see is that it is because of the Unbreakable Promises of God that are in His Holy name, for Jesus said He is the Truth, that shall cause the Lord to raise up and bring them to their fall for the sake of His Holy Name – the Name of Jesus Christ the God of Truth, the teacher of Truth. And nothing can stop the fulfillment of the Promise of God that is in His Holy name that the Father would raise His name up to make it known in the world so that the Knowledge of the Glory of the Lord is made known in all the earth).³¹The law of his God is in his heart; none of his steps shall slide. (The law of God is found in Deuteronomy 6:4-9 and Deuteronomy 11:18-21, and that is that we will teach the Words of God to all those in our house, to all those in our business, and to all those in our government, and that His Words will be in all things that are in front of our eyes, as if they are frontlets).³²The wicked watches the righteous, and seeks to slay him.³³The Lord will not leave him in his hand, nor condemn him when he is judged. (When the Lord Jesus comes upon us with the Spirit of Truth there is nothing that can be brought upon us because all things exist and consist by His Word, and all those who harm a saint of God shall be brought to their destruction by His Words, for His Words shall be like a flying scroll and they will go into that persons household who tries to harm His anointed, and this Words shall bring them to complete destruction as per the promise of the Lord as given in Zechariah 5. These are the days of the 2nd Seal Judgment and God has ordained it is the time that He will take Peace fro the earth and His Word will be a sword against all unrighteousness to bring it to exposure and to reveal it in the Light to show whether it is of the darkness or of the Light. When the world system tried to abolish the name of Jesus Christ, they crossed over the line and they have brought forth the Sword of Truth, and it shall not stop its work until all those who blaspheme the Holy Spirit that is the Words of God in the name of Jesus Christ, are brought low. The World Financial System is trying to remove the Bible from the land of America and to remove the name of Jesus Christ, but the Lord has stood up and He has released His Words with the Sprit of Truth, and now there is nothing that will stop the Lord from revealing all those who mock His name, and all those who will not stand up for Righteousness shall go into slavery and ruin, but the righteous shall be lifted up and God will support them to make His name known throughout the world. The Lord is now calling all people to wake up and come out of following the way of the World Financial System, or they will see their destruction that He is going to cause it to suffer. But all those who hear Him He will keep safe and secure, for that is the promise of the Way of the Lord).³⁴Wait on the Lord, and keep His way, and He shall exalt you to inherit the land; when the wicked are cut off, you shall see it. (As I have just revealed and as I have written in many Writings, the Time is now at hand when the Lord has stood up and He is about to cut off the wicked and exalt the righteous. For He is pouring out His Grace even upon those who are unworthy because it is for the fulfillment of His promise of His name's sake).³⁵I have seen the wicked in great power, and spreading himself like a native green tree. (A Native green tree is one who professes to have knowledge of the way of he Lord, yet his way has not grown into knowledge and He produces no fruit. He is like a beautiful white mansion built upon the sand. He has no foundation in God, but to the people who pass by they think by his outward appearance that he is a wise leader of great spiritual knowledge, yet when he comes to the judgment the Lord will say depart from Me you worker of lawlessness for you did not place your foundation in His Words, and therefore he has caused many to stumble in the way).³⁶Yet he passed by, and behold, he was no more; indeed I sought him, but he could not be found.³⁷Mark the blameless man, and observe the upright; for the future of that man is Peace. (Peace is the name of the Eternal Heaven. The upright man is one who is zealous to receive the knowledge of Truth and to come into the knowledge of the Promises of God that the Lord has placed within His Words from the Foundation of the Creation, and it is in His Words that the heavens are framed).³⁸But the transgressors shall be destroyed together; the future of the wicked shall be cut off.³⁹But the salvation of the righteous is from the Lord; He is their strength in the time of trouble. (The time of the Troubles of the Jacob are in the Time of the Night, but the Lord is going to deliver Israel, and in the Time of the Night they will gather back into the nation of Israel and they will rest safe and secure in the days of Troubles upon the earth for their God reigns in heaven and His Will be done for all those on earth who receive His Kingdom inside of them, and He will raise them up with the Righteous).⁴⁰And the Lord shall help them and deliver them; He shall deliver them from the wicked, and save them, because they trust in Him. (In Proverbs 1:20-33 the Lord says that in the time of the Night He will keep His people who have obtained knowledge, safe and secure).

David was like the High Priest of Israel, for He was the anointed one whom the Lord revealed His Words through to the nation of Israel. Thus, David is like a wise Ox. As an Oxen, David gives us another powerful teaching for us of this day who will understand Good, and who will obey God and go forth and do Good. Please again remember Psalm 14:2-3 and 53:2-3. David said that God is always looking down and that no one does Good, and not one understands that Good is God, and God does Good as we ask of Him by doing the Way of the Promises that are in His Words. Yet in Psalm 34:1-22 he reveals that there are going to be those who do understand and who will do Good. With this in our mind, meditate upon the Way of the Lord that David reveals in Psalm 34:1-22. Those who do Good are capable of all things. Praise God that He has given this Gift of God to us. Can you really imagine this Good News that He has opened to us, and the authority that He is about to empower upon us with the Sprit of Truth?

☆ **Psalm 14:2-3, & Psalm 53:2-3** ²The Lord looks down from Heaven upon the children of men, **to see if there are any who understand, WHO SEEK GOD.** ³They have all turned aside, they have together become corrupt; **there is none that does "GOOD", no, not one.**

☆ **Psalm 34:1-22** ¹I will bless the Lord at all times; His praise *shall* continually *be* in my mouth. ²My soul shall make its boast in the Lord; the humble shall hear *of it* and be glad. ³Oh, magnify the Lord with me, and let us exalt His name together. ⁴I sought the Lord, and He heard me, and delivered me from all my fears. ⁵They looked to Him and were radiant, and their faces were not ashamed. ⁶This poor man cried out, and the Lord heard *him*, and saved him out of all his troubles. ⁷The Angel of the Lord encamps all around those who fear Him, and delivers them. ⁸Oh, taste and see that the Lord *is* Good (*The Words of God are as food to us, the Flesh of the Lord is His Words for His Words are stored in the memory of the particles of His Flesh, and all His food gives us the knowledge of the Ways of His Promises so that we can feed others with His Good Works*); blessed is the man who trusts in Him! ⁹Oh, fear the Lord, you His saints! There is no want to those who fear Him. ¹⁰The young lions lack and suffer hunger; but those who seek the Lord shall not lack any Good. (*In John 15:7 the Lord promises us that if we walk in the Will of His Ways and we do the Way of His Promises in His Words, then whatever we ask of Him shall be done for us*). ¹¹Come, you children, listen to me; I will teach you the fear of the Lord. (*The knowledge of His powers gives us the knowledge of the fear of the Lord but it also gives us the understanding of why it is that He can do His great works as He says that He can do*). ¹²Who is the man who desires life, and loves many days, that he may see Good? (*This is a man who keeps His Words, walks Justly and is diligent to increase in the knowledge of the Promises of God that He placed within His Words – Deuteronomy 6:4-9, 11:18-21, Micah 6:8, and Amos 6:6*). ¹³Keep your tongue from evil, and your lips from speaking deceit. ¹⁴Depart from evil and do Good; seek Peace and pursue it. (*If we seek His Words then we shall receive the Promise of Eternal Life in His Eternal Heaven that will be called Peace. This is the Peace that Jesus said that He gives to us. He said not your peace do I give to you; but My Peace I give to you*). ¹⁵The eyes of the Lord are on the righteous, and His ears are open to their cry. (*In Psalm 14:2-3 the Lord says that He is always looking down to see if anyone understands, if anyone does Good. The Lord is pleased to do His Good Works for us if we ask Him by doing the Way of the Words with knowledge*). ¹⁶The face of the Lord *is* against those who do evil, to cut off the remembrance of them from the earth. ¹⁷The righteous cry out, and the Lord hears, and delivers them out of all their troubles. (*We can know this, that if we hear His Words and receive them, then we have His Promise of Proverbs 1:20-33 that He will keep us safe and secure in the Time of the Night when the great troubles come upon the earth*). ¹⁸The Lord *is* near to those who have a broken heart, and saves such as have a contrite spirit. (*His Words are Words of Healing for all things exist within His Promises that are within His Words*) ¹⁹Many are the afflictions of the righteous, but the Lord delivers him out of them all. ²⁰He guards all his bones; not one of them is broken. (*The bones are one of the two witnesses in our body of all things said and done. Our flesh is the other. The bones have memory, as they store all vibrations as like a stone. Bones are a forever testimony to all things that we have said and do, as well as all things spoken and done against us. This memory is never lost, for the bones are made of physical sub-atomic particles and they all have a polarizing state of memory. But, the Lord does not desire that we cremate bodies, for if they are righteous their bones are a testimony to them. This is why the Lord would not allow Satan to find and destroy the bones of Moses, for all the works Moses did in destroying Satan's false God's are forever remember is his bones and they testify against Satan. Therefore the bones forever testify of the history of that person while they lived. Moses' bones have in them the record of the Law, of the Creation, and of the account of Satan's fall. The bones of Moses shall testify against Satan and they record the testimony of the Coming of Jesus and the account of what is His Holy Name. The record of all our works and our wards are within our bones and our flesh, they stand in witness to the way of our soul. Also all of the particles in all creation are accounted for. Jesus calls the particles by their individual number, and thus He can call forth the bones to reveal all their secrets. It is interesting that even in sexual union there is a testimony of bone and flesh. Every act is remembered within the bones. You may recall that a dead person was placed into the tomb of Elisha, and his body was let down onto Elisha's bones, that he came to life and stood up, for the Lord would not let the bones of his prophet be defiled with a foreign raider. All of the Good Works that we have done are remembered in our bones and then stand in testimony as a witness to the works of our soul. This it was that Jacob, Joseph, and the great patriarchs of Israel wanted their bones brought back to the Promised Lands for it was also a testimony of their work to build the Kingdom ordained to them by God. The return of their bones to the Promised Land was in itself a doing of the Way of God's Promise within His Words to demonstrate their trust in the Words of His Promise, and that action of faith is accounted unto them as Righteousness. Jacob and Joseph request to be returned to the Promised Land reveals their trust in His Words to fulfill His Promise to establish His people in the Promised Land. Thus, now we can see why it was necessary for the Lord's bones not to be broken. For His bones shall stand in perfect testimony of His Good Works and as a firsthand witness of all that He did and what He said, as well as all things spoken of Him and done to Him. Now you may consider the terrible severity of the abortionists and those who willingly have abortions. The bones and the flesh of every aborted baby stands in testimony against all those involved with that child because everything said in the baby's presence is recorded in those bones and*

in that flesh. Further when the doctors rip the heads off the babies in the process as they kill them in the womb, and then pull them from the womb. Not only do the bones of the baby testify, but the mother's bones shall testify against her, and the doctor's bones shall testify against him as he tears the babies heads off in his abortion process. Every bone remembers. You may remember that King Josiah took the bones of the false priests' of Israel, their families, and the bones of the evil leaders of Judah, all who had supported idols in those places, and he burned them to ash on the altars. This left those priests with no pleasing testimony and it defiled their altars to have dead bone's touch the altars, for these men had done evil works when they were alive, and when you burn these bones it is multiplying these sins into the season of another ordained time season to those who worship as such an altar; thus the altar is defiled). ²¹Evil shall slay the wicked, and those who hate the righteous shall be condemned. (Consider this carefully. People hate it when you reveal to the Words of God and they have to accept the understanding that they have missed this from Scripture. That they did not have the Spirit that they thought that they had. Instead of rejoicing that they now have the knowledge of the way to the access to the power of God so that they can enable great miracles for the Lord, they often respond by anger and basically hatred derived from a realization that they have an error in their hearts. They also respond that this cannot be from God without giving evidence that it does not agree with a continuity of Scripture. That is very dangerous for them to respond like this, and that response is what is not of God, for the Lord said that the test is that it does concur with the continuity of Scripture. This verse is saying that it is very dangerous to harbor that hatred and jealousy for the Lord says they will be condemned). ²²The Lord redeems the soul of His servants, and none of those who trust in Him shall be condemned.

Because of the requirement of His Priests to be obedient of the Lord's instruction of Deuteronomy 6:4-9 and Deuteronomy 11:18-21, that they are to teach His Words to the fathers and the children of His people that the nation would obtain its blessing. This is why since long before the days of Daniel, that Israel has never lived in any manner of true peace and prosperity. It was only David that the nation strived and progressed to its greater reward. That reward of the work of David to learn the wisdom and the understanding of God and teach it to His sons, and the people, that the nation was given the promised blessing of the greatest prosperity ever under his reign, and under the reign of Solomon. It was not because of Solomon that the nation was blessed, for Solomon failed the Lord. Solomon spoke the wisdom of God's Words and that brought the continuation of the blessings of God. However, the true root of the blessing was from the work of David and his teaching. It was the promise given to David for the work of his obedience to learn of God's Words and to gain in understanding of His Works that enabled the nation to be so greatly blessed under the reign of Solomon.

This gives me an opportunity to bring to remembrance a great mistake of our churches of these days. The tithe and the offerings are an opportunity for a person to receive a blessing from God. However, when the churches do this by begging for it (*As likened to the prosperity teachers of these days*), and by "passing around" the offering plate in the church services, or having open requests in front of the congregation for building pledges, then the preachers and leaders of the church have taken away from the congregation the opportunity to receive the promised blessing. For the word that Jesus used (*Proverbs 3:9*), was for His people "to honor" Him with their tithes and offerings, as well as with their possessions. You do not honor God by placing tithes and offerings into passed around offering plates, or by taking "seed offerings" and throwing it into plates at the front of a church, or even putting it into the pockets of the teachers in front of the church. You have received your honor in front of man, and therefore God owes you no further blessing. Honor is given when the collection boxes are left in the back of the churches or in the halls, and the people voluntarily, and of their own heart desire, place what they know belongs to God into those collection boxes. This is how it was in the Jewish synagogues. Also you will note that Jesus was against the Temple Tax. When confronted by the Temple Tax collectors (*Matthew 17:24-27*), the Lord did not offer money from the free-will monies that the people had given to Him. He instead, so as not to bring offense and destroy the purpose of His coming, sent a disciple to go and catch a fish and that he would find in its mouth there would be a coin to be the Temple Tax. These taxes were for the building of the temple and the house of King Herod. . Notice that Jesus is saying that taxation implemented either by the nations, or by the churches, is not of Him. It was enacted to be as a punishment upon man, and He has never condoned it as being either Righteous or Just. Every tithe and offering, even offerings to your nation, were to be given voluntarily so as to honor Him and thus know that you will receive a greater blessing from God. Even the nation was to operate on a voluntarily gifted basis, because the people who love God would be blessed, and they would give so as to honor Him and thereby desire to make their nation strong for Him from the blessings that He gave them. The Lord will not remove the burden of national taxation until His people of His nations call out to Him to establish His way of Righteousness and Justice in their nation.

☆ **Matthew 17:24-27** ²⁴When they had come to Capernaum, those who received the *temple* tax came to Peter and said, "Does your Teacher not pay the *temple* tax?" ²⁵He said, "Yes." And when he had come into the house, Jesus anticipated him, saying, "What do you think, Simon? From whom do the kings of the earth take customs or taxes, from their sons or from strangers?" ²⁶Peter said to Him, "From strangers." Jesus said to him, "Then the sons are free. ²⁷Nevertheless, lest we offend them, go to the sea, cast in a hook, and take the fish that comes up first. And when you have opened its mouth, you will find a piece of money; take that and give it to them for Me and you."

The Lord was showing us that His children who were about teaching the Words of God were not to be taxed. They would give their money freely as an offering. To collect it by forced tax was to steal the blessing away from the offering. The fish is the Word of God, and Jesus had a fish take the money from the Sea (*The symbol of Sheol, that*

is in the Sea of the Deep, and the prison where the souls of the rebellious and the proud are punished), and He took of this coin and gave it for the Temple Tax. What I am pointing out is that we obtain the blessing of God for our tithes and offerings when they are freely given in support to do the Good Works of God. If we are supporting works that are not teaching the knowledge of God in these days, then we are also not doing the will of God, and therefore we should also not expect to be blessed from placing our tithes and offerings wherein the gifts of God are not being multiplied into Good Works that glorify the Kingdom. When we are not in compliance with the Will of God, then do not expect the blessings of God. I have learnt that lesson very well myself, and if we will meditate upon this, we might consider the issue of tithes and offerings in a whole new light. If we truly desire to expect to receive the promised blessings that will endure through the times of the coming troubles, then we must do what Jesus tells us, and what He has shown us. When the times of the troubles come, what will happen with the present day prosperity teachers? What will happen with the bloated churches that teach their own knowledge and not the knowledge that comes from the Words of God? If our teachers and leaders will teach the Words of God to His people, they will fear to lose the access to the Words of God for they are wonderful, and then they will find that the people will understand that they truly receive their blessings when they honor those who have taught them the real knowledge of God. Then the churches will never have to ask for tithes and offerings for it will be the joy of man to honor God according to knowledge. The early church succeeded because the people came into knowledge of His Words, and they met each evening to discuss and speak of His Words. They also gained in knowledge of what each other needed; and thus they were able by knowledge to do the Way of His Words to enable the Lord to do a Good Work for their neighbor. The Bible records that when they did this they lacked in nothing. Consider that the disciples had followed Jesus in their ministry and they did not lack, but they also did not have the ability to do Good Works for each other and their families. After the Words of God they were able to enable the Lord to meet the needs of all their neighbors, and those neighbors enabled the Lord to give them what they needed.

☆ **Proverbs 3:9-10** ⁹Honor the Lord with your possessions, and with the firstfruits of all your increase; ¹⁰so your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will overflow with new wine.

☆ **Proverbs 11:27** He who DILIGENTLY SEEKS “Good” FINDS favor (Grace).

As it is clear in Deuteronomy 6:4-9, 11:18-21, and 18:18-19, Moses taught the Words of God to the people of Israel. The Father said in Deuteronomy 18:18-19, that He would raise up a prophet “like Moses”, and He would put His Words in His mouth. This reveals that Moses had the Words of God in his mouth, and He taught them. Even the Tabernacle of Moses was built with patterns involving the Words of God. When they built the Tabernacle with great jewels and gold, Moses had to tell the people of Israel to stop giving offerings into the Lord’s storehouse for they had too much. The teachers of God’s Word are to teach of the wisdom of the knowledge of the Words of God on Sunday, and they are to stop teaching their own wisdom. If they do not then the Words of Hosea 4:6 shall come true, for His people will be destroyed because of a lack of knowledge. For the oxen of His house will have forgotten for whom they work, and to whose voice they are to obey.

☆ **Isaiah 58:6-14** ⁶Is this not the fast that I have chosen: to loose the bonds of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, to let the oppressed go free, and that you break every yoke? ⁷Is it not to share your bread with the hungry, and that you bring to your house the poor who are cast out; when you see the naked, that you cover him, and not hide yourself from your own flesh? ⁸Then your light shall break forth like the morning, your healing shall spring forth speedily, and your righteousness shall go before you; the glory of the Lord shall be your rear guard. ⁹Then you shall call, and the LORD will answer; you shall cry, and He will say, 'Here I am". If you take away the yoke from your midst, the pointing of the finger, and speaking wickedness, ¹⁰if you extend your soul to the hungry and satisfy the afflicted soul, then your light shall dawn in the darkness, and your darkness shall be as the noonday. ¹¹The Lord will guide you continually, and satisfy your soul in drought, and strengthen your bones; you shall be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail. ¹²Those from among you shall build the old waste places; you shall raise up the foundations of many generations; and you shall be called the Repairer of the Breach, the Restorer of Streets to Dwell In. ¹³**If you turn away your foot from the Sabbath, from doing your pleasure on My holy day, and call the Sabbath a delight, the holy Day of the Lord honorable, and shall honor Him, not doing your own ways, nor finding your own pleasure, NOR SPEAKING YOUR OWN WORDS,** ¹⁴then you shall delight yourself in the Lord; and I will cause you to ride on the high hills of the earth, and feed you with the heritage of Jacob your father. **The mouth of the Lord has spoken."** *(The Lord is saying to preach His Words on Sunday and not your own words. In other Words we are to teach about the Words of God, for they are the Pearl of Great Price, and to stop teaching our own wisdom of pearls of lesser value. God has said that when the Pearl of Great Price is found, then His merchants, His teachers, are to get rid of all their other pearls and to teach only that Great Pearl of His Words that comes with the assurance of God’s promise of eternal Life to those who will hear and believe on Him. We are to stop preaching the promises of prosperity for giving a seed, and our ideas of how to achieve a more abundant life, and our other ideas of man’s wisdom, and to begin preaching the message that God has ordained for these times, the Words of God that come with His Spirit and Eternal Life in them. Many of His best preachers are teaching falsely, for they say that all is complete for the Rapture and to sit and wait. They deny His call to come to the Great Supper and eat His food that will out oil in their vessel for the Night).*

The Lord has said that it is the task of His priests to teach His Words on the Sabbath and not their own words (*Isaiah 58:13*). We have a country of His people who do not know how to bring about truth to be sovereign, and they do not know how to call out to God for justice, because we do not teach His Words, and His knowledge on His Sabbath days. Instead we teach our own words that translate into our own wisdom of what we believe that His

people need to know. If we do not know answers we mix the yokes that we put around our necks. For we take a little of that preachers knowledge, and a little of this teachers knowledge, until we may have a 100 yokes around our necks, but we are still not able to solve our burdens. We try to take the wisdom that these people give us and we try to do the works, for we are not taught the knowledge of how to enable our powerful and awesome God to do the works for us. Jesus said that His yoke is easy, and His burden is light. The Lord instructed us that there is one great pearl and not many. Jesus instructed us that there is one great treasure in the field and not many. Jesus instructed us that if we have Him abiding in us and we have His Words abiding in us, then we shall ask what we desire and it shall be done for us. Truly His yoke is easy and His burden is light, for He will do the works for us if we will just hear His Words and believe in Him.

☆ **Matthew 11:20-30** ²⁰Then He began to rebuke the cities in which most of His mighty works had been done, because they did not repent: ²¹"Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the mighty works which were done in you had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes. ²²But I say to you, it will be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon in the Day of Judgment than for you. ²³And you, Capernaum, who are exalted to heaven, will be brought down to Hades; for if the mighty works which were done in you had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day. ²⁴But I say to you that it shall be more tolerable for the land of Sodom in the day of judgment than for you." ²⁵At that time Jesus answered and said, "I thank You, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden these things from the wise and prudent and have revealed them to babes. ²⁶Even so, Father, for so it seemed good in Your sight. ²⁷All things have been delivered to Me by My Father, and no one knows the Son except the Father. Nor does anyone know the Father except the Son, and the one to whom the Son wills to reveal Him. ²⁸**Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. ²⁹Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. ³⁰For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."** (*Preachers teach their own wisdom and not God's Words, thus they have failed to hear Him*).

The Lord has also recorded for us in Isaiah 28:9-19, the way in which He imparts knowledge to His Oxen and how the Oxen are to impart it to His people. The Lord says that He does not waste His knowledge, and He does not pour His knowledge out before swine – to those who do not respect and honor His Father's Words. The Lord gives us access to His Knowledge line upon line, precept upon precept, here a little there a little. You may remember the warning that the Lord gave to the Laodiceans of the lukewarm church of these last days. The Lord said that they are to turn, to repent, and then they are to become zealous to increase in knowledge. It was not a joke when the Lord warned us that the Queen of the South is going to standing up in judgment against us. She heard that Solomon was speaking the Words of Knowledge of God and she left her kingdom to come and to learn the eternal knowledge that gives enduring riches and wealth. If we of this day do not get up out of our chairs and go to wherever it is necessary to increase in the knowledge of God, then we are not worthy of Him. When the Queen of the South heard the Words of God were being spoken, she gave up everything to go to another country and seek out these Words so that she could increase in the knowledge of God. Her testimony, her zealousness, is the gauntlet that has been laid down in front of us as an example by the Lord. He desires that heart, or He would not have given her the authority to stand in witness against us. The Lord has placed her into the position of our measuring stick for the measure of our zealousness. Once it has been made known to us that His Words are opened and that the Knowledge of His Promises is being taught, we are without an excuse. It is a pilgrimage that we must make for our families and our neighbors. Jesus warned us that our words we have and that we have used are going to judge us. In the Parable of the Ten Virgins it is revealed to us that it is the absence of the multiplication of the knowledge of His Words in our heart that will cause His Holy Angels to put out our Light. It is now our Day and our Hour. It is our judgment time. Our attitude of zealousness is going to reveal the true way of our heart, and reveal the Way of our true character in front of the face of God. What will you do to increase in the knowledge of God? Will you endure not having the knowledge of Truth being taught to you and your family? Will you hear God and come into agreement with the Way that He desires to teach you knowledge? Or, will you be rebellious to His Ways, and be likened to Eve and Adam who fell from Grace and had to repent? The trouble for us is that we have the Promise of God that in these days, the Lord says in Luke 14:24 that those who do not receive of His invitation shall never even taste of His food? For as it was for Sodom and Gomorrah and as it was for the Pharaoh and the Egyptians, the Lord's patience to pour out the Grace of giving you His knowledge, shall not remain available to you forever. He has said in Amos 8:14 that He is going to close the door. In the Parable of the Ten Virgins the 5 unwise virgins were complacent and they were not ready at the Midnight Hour and sadly, that meant that they were also left behind at the Rapture.

☆ **Isaiah 28:9-19** ⁹"Whom will He teach knowledge? (*He opened His Words to the Disciples after His death upon the Cross – Luke 24:44-45; and He has opened His Words to us – Hebrews 10:25-26*) And whom will He make to understand the message? (*The Good News of His Words. In Psalm 119:130 it states that it is by the entrance of His Words that we gain Understanding, and Understanding is knowledge of the Holy One – Proverbs 9:10. The Message is the Words of God, the Good News that Jesus was sent to speak and to do*). Those just weaned from milk? Those just drawn from the breasts? ¹⁰For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept, line upon line, line upon line, here a little, there a little." (*The Lord does not teach His Words in a short moment. The Lord intended for people to seek Him, so that step by step He will increase them in knowledge. This is why He says that we have to have a zeal for Him. We have to have a great desire to increase in knowledge of Him. It is to those people that He will pour out His knowledge, and He will not give it to the complacent ones, such as the 5 unwise virgins. If you will not seek Him and*

also to study so that you can learn from Him how to discern knowledge, then you are not worthy of Him, for you have not taken up your cross and followed Him. Notice that the Lord is revealing to us that His way of learning is by repetition of precepts and through repetition of lines. People struggle with the idea that in my Writings that there is a steady repetition of precepts; but that is how the Lord has laid it upon my heart to write. If you will consider this verse in Isaiah, you will see that this is the way the Lord proclaims is the key to increasing in knowledge of His Words. He teaches us that we have to repeat these lines until we get into our minds that we have to reconsider His Words until we have gleaned all the Truth from His precepts and from His verses. The meaning of line upon line is that the Lord has given it to us throughout the entire Bible and through the written Words of every prophet and Apostle, yet we have refused to see His revelation). ¹¹**For with stammering lips and another tongue He will speak to this people.** (The Lord is saying that He will speak in a way of repetition when HE speaks His Words to His people so that we may understand His Words and His Ways. The Lord is also revealing in this verse a prophetic announcement that He will bring forth His Words in another tongue other than Hebrew and Greek. For this has come true in that the Lord has revealed His Words in America and in the English language). ¹²To whom He said, "This is the rest with which you may cause the weary to rest (The Lord speaks His Words to the weary to give them rest – Isaiah 50:4)," and, "This is the refreshing"; yet they would not hear (People have not sought out God enough to see nor to hear His Words that He has spoken plainly within the Bible. Even we have failed to hear Him speak plainly through His prophets. Because we are complacent to seek out knowledge we have missed the importance of the very power of God that the Lord has offered to us openly. Because we have refused to ask, He has not shown us His great and mighty things. You can truly say that we have indeed refused to hear. I even receive this response today from people as I have given to them what the Lord has opened. They refuse to hear the Lord. It is not me that they refuse to hear; it is the Lord they refuse to hear. For I have given to them the very same Scriptures that He has given to all of us). ¹³**But the Word of the Lord was to them** (The Words of God – the Word of Truth - was nevertheless given to them in this way), "Precept upon precept, precept upon precept, line upon line, line upon line, here a little, there a little," That they might go and fall backward, and be broken and snared and caught." (We have failed to hear His Words, and that is why the Time of the End has begun with the opening of His Words and it has come upon everyone on the face of the whole earth as a snare, for no one heard God, and no one understood – Luke 21:35 and Psalm 14:2-3). ¹⁴**Therefore hear the Word of the Lord, you scornful men, who rule this people who are in Jerusalem,** (This statement is being made to all those who believe in Jesus, for it is not limiting itself to Jews; and further, He is showing us that all those of the economic system dictate much of what goes on in Israel, and America certainly is a leader of that list) ¹⁵**because you have said, "We have made a covenant with Death, and with Sheol we are in agreement** (Sheol is the prison of God that is in the Sea of the Deep, and it is a prison for the rebellious and the proud of earth). **When the overflowing scourge passes through, it will not come upon us, for we have made lies our refuge, and under falsehood we have hidden ourselves."** (This is the same type of complacent wording used by the lukewarm church of these last days, the Church of Laodicea. The Lord prophesies that the people of this day will believe that they are rich and that they lack nothing in knowledge of God. They will not believe that they know little of the Bible, and that they have very little power of the Spirit with them. They do not believe that the Lord would allow the prophesied troubles of the last days to come upon them. But of these, the Lord says that they are blind, naked, and wretched; and the Lord says that if they do not turn, repent, and become zealous for Him, then they will share in the troubles and plagues of these Last Days that are coming upon all those on the face of the who are not sealed by God). ¹⁶**Therefore thus says the Lord God: "Behold, I lay a stone for a foundation, a tried stone, a precious cornerstone, a sure foundation** (The Father sent Jesus to speak His Words, and He did so; thus laying the sure foundation of His Words that has now been opened to our knowledge, so that we have the sure foundation that is able to change this nation by the power of His Spirit of Truth). **Whoever believes will not act hastily** (This has a meaning that if they believe, then they will "not be greatly disturbed", for God will protect and keep them safe and secure). ¹⁷Also I will make justice the measuring line, and righteousness the plummet; the hail will sweep away the refuge of lies, and the waters will overflow the hiding place. ¹⁸Your covenant with Death will be annulled (*shall be covered*), and your vision (*agreement*) with Sheol will not rise up (*not stand*); ¹⁹As often as it passes, it shall take you, for morning by morning it shall pass, and by day and by night, it shall only be a terror just to understand the report. (The people who are sealed up by the Lord, and who are kept safe and secure, will be a witness to the troubles of the 3rd through the 5th Seal Judgments that will pass over them. It will be a terror just to see all that the troubles that the Lord is bringing forth upon the world every day. It will be that each day brings more troubles on the world, for in those days the Holy Spirit has been removed from the wicked, and the worst of their ways will be let loose upon the world, for the restrainer will have been removed).

In Revelation 3:16-22 the Lord tells us that we have to become zealous for Him. This is because the Lord says that they are blind and wretched, being without Understanding because our eyes are blinded, and we are blind because the Oxen did not teach us His Words. There are Oxen out there today who are chasing me to destroy me because they do not see His Words and do not want to believe that they are blind. That is exactly the description of Saul before the Lord hit Him with Light, and made the blind Saul to become the seeing Paul. The Lord makes the understanding of our blindness to be easier understood in the way of His conversion of Saul, the Biblical zealot, as it is recorded in Acts chapter 9. Saul was perhaps the most devout Jewish man in Israel at upholding the Truth of the Bible. You may recall that Saul (*Before he became Paul*) had these same scales upon his eyes. He was among the most zealous of the Jews whom it is said have had scales on their eyes. The Bible does not say that actual scales fell off of Paul's eyes; it says something that was "like" scales fell from His eyes.

☆ **Acts 9:17** ¹⁸**Immediately there fell from his eyes something like scales, and he received his sight at once; and he arose and was baptized.**

☆ **John 5:46-47** ⁴⁶“For if you believed Moses, you would believe Me, for He wrote about Me. ⁴⁷But if you do not believe His writings, how will you believe My Words?”

It may indeed have been something physical that fell from Saul's eyes, but for sure what it represented was Saul's ability to see the Scriptures. For Paul was immediately able to see, and it represented the fact that at the speaking of Ananias, who was sent from the Lord Jesus to Saul, that Saul was to be enabled to be filled with the Holy Spirit, that Saul was given his sight so that He could see. Further, Ananias related to Saul that Jesus Christ had sent him. Further the Lord had given to Saul the gift of a vision that had revealed to him that a man named Ananias would come and would lay his hand on Saul so that he could see. Jesus could have opened Saul's eyes when He visited Saul on the way. However the Lord did all of this conversion of Saul by following the way of His Words. The Lord sent Ananias after Saul had been blind for three days and had not eaten any food or drank any water. Thus, the Lord was letting Saul see the way of the opening of our sight to His Words. As like Jesus was in the grave three days, and then was resurrected to the Father, but returned that evening to give the Disciples His Holy Spirit, and then He stayed with them some days to open the Words of God and Understanding of the Scriptures to His Disciples. So was Saul given his sight on the third day, and so was Ananias sent from the Lord to anoint Saul with the Holy Spirit – by opening His Words. And then Ananias and other Disciples opened the Words of God to Saul, as Saul spent some days with them.

☆ **Acts 9:1-22** ¹Then Saul, still breathing threats and murder against the Disciples of the Lord, went to the high priest ²and asked letters from him to the synagogues of Damascus, so that if he found any who were of the Way, whether men or women, he might bring them bound to Jerusalem. ³**As he journeyed he came near Damascus, and suddenly a light shone around him from heaven.** ⁴**Then he fell to the ground, and heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me?"** ⁵**And he said, "Who are You, Lord?"** **Then the Lord said, "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting. It is hard for you to kick against the goads."** ⁶So he, trembling and astonished, said, "Lord, what do You want me to do?" Then the Lord *said* to him, "Arise and go into the city, and you will be told what you must do." ⁷And the men who journeyed with him stood speechless, hearing a voice but seeing no one. ⁸Then Saul arose from the ground, and when his eyes were opened he saw no one. But they led him by the hand and brought *him* into Damascus. ⁹And he was three days without sight, and neither ate nor drank. ¹⁰Now there was a certain Disciple at Damascus named Ananias; and to him the Lord said in a vision, "Ananias." And he said, "Here I am, Lord." ¹¹So the Lord *said* to him, "Arise and go to the street called Straight, and inquire at the house of Judas for *one* called Saul of Tarsus, for behold, he is praying. ¹²And in a vision he has seen a man named Ananias coming in and putting *his* hand on him, so that he might receive his sight." ¹³Then Ananias answered, "Lord, I have heard from many about this man, how much harm he has done to Your saints in Jerusalem." ¹⁴And here he has authority from the chief priests to bind all who call on Your name." ¹⁵**But the Lord said to him, "Go, for he is a chosen vessel of Mine to bear My name before Gentiles, kings, and the children of Israel.** ¹⁶For I will show him how many things he must suffer for My name's sake." ¹⁷**And Ananias went his way and entered the house; and laying his hands on him he said, "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you came, has sent me that you may receive your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit."** ¹⁸**Immediately there fell from his eyes *something* like scales, and he received his sight at once; and he arose and was baptized.** ¹⁹So when he had received food, he was strengthened. Then Saul spent some days with the Disciples at Damascus. ²⁰Immediately he preached the Christ in the synagogues, that He is the Son of God. ²¹Then all who heard were amazed, and said, "Is this not he who destroyed those who called on this name in Jerusalem, and has come here for that purpose, so that he might bring them bound to the chief priests?" ²²**But Saul increased all the more in strength, and confounded the Jews who dwelt in Damascus, proving that this Jesus is the Christ.**

Thus, the Lord gave an open door of a "Heavenly Calling" to Saul so that He would enter and receive the understanding of the knowledge of the Words of God. Saul did not have to open the Door, for the open Door to instruction was given to him already opened by the Lord. In some churches the Lord is saying that He has placed a Door in front of them, but unless they see that the Word of Truth is the eye salve that opens understanding and allows them to see the door handle, they cannot open that door. In Acts 9:15 the Lord reveals this special calling that was given to Saul. A few are called in such a way like Saul was. (*I must add here that I can understand this calling, for it is like Saul's calling that I have been given by the Lord to take and open His Words to His people. I am not justified for it, but it is the Lord who is the reader of all hearts, and not man. I know that this calling was on me since Creation, though I had to receive it, along with its loneliness and persecutions, when the Lord did call me*). What Saul had to do was to follow instruction. It was that Saul's mind was turned and now He could see the Words of God, the Holy Spirit, that was there in front of him all the time, but Saul had never seen Him. It was like he had turned the Bible sideways and was looking at it from a different angle. It was like Saul was seeing the Bible through different eyes, eyes that were no longer blind to His 153 Words and the Promises that they contain. When the Lord came in the way of the Word of God as a great Light and intercepted Saul, Saul was on his way to Damascus to arrest followers of the Lord. Paul was left blinded for three days, and on the third day gained his sight. When the Lord came to Saul, He came as a bright Light. This is important to understand. Jesus came as the Spirit of Truth in the Way of His Word "Light". Jesus confirms this by His proclamation to Saul that is recorded in Acts 9:5. The Lord tells Saul that He is Jesus, and then states a proclamation, "It is hard for you to kick against the goads." This is very important because the statement goes back to Solomon. Of all Jews, Solomon had been the most learned in the Words of God and the ways of the Lord until Jesus. But, as Solomon grew he began to lean on his own wisdom

and tried to do things himself, instead of doing them in the way of the Words of God. After a life of failing at this, Solomon records in the last chapter of Ecclesiastes that he had learned that it was much easier during his youth, when he was yet a preacher of the Words of God to the people. Solomon says that to go against the way of the Lord to preach the Words of God will result in a vane approach and it is like going against the goads. Solomon says that the Words of the Wise are like goads (*The Words of God are like goads*). The wise are those who have received the Words of God. In Psalm 119:130 we learn that it is the entrance of His Words that gives us Light and gives Understanding. In Proverbs 9:10 we are told that Understanding is having the knowledge of the Holy (*This can be the Lord, His Words, or the Writings of the Holy Prophets*). The dictionary defines goads as: *goad (noun) 1. A long stick with a pointed end used for prodding animals. 2. An agent or means of prodding or urging; a stimulus.* Generally a goad was made from a sharpened bone. You may remember that Shamgar took the Ox Goad (*The sharp jawbone of an Ox*), and killed 600 Philistines with it – as is stated in Judges 3:31. A “goad” is associated to a weapon and as a guiding stick in the Bible. Thus, we see the wisdom of what Solomon is saying in Ecclesiastes 12:11 when he revealed that the Words of the Wise are like goads.

- ☆ **Ecclesiastes 12:11** **The Words of the wise are like goads** (*The Words of God are like Guiding Rods*), and the Words of scholars (*The Parables of the Prophets*) are like well-driven nails (*In Zechariah 10:4 our Lord says that He is the nail, and we know that our Lord is the Word*), given by the One Shepherd. (*Jesus says that He is the only “Good” Shepherd – that means that He is the One Shepherd*).
- ☆ **Acts 9:3-5** ³As he journeyed he came near Damascus, and suddenly a light shone around him from heaven. ⁴Then he fell to the ground, and heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me?" ⁵And he said, "Who are You, Lord?" Then the Lord said, "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting. **It is hard for you to kick against the goads.**"

To better understand the way of the Oxen in these present days, let us consider the parable of the Great Supper in Luke 14:15-22. I understand this parable very well, for the Lord has sent me to reveal and to speak His Words to His people. I have invited people to seek Him to have Him to make His Words known to them. For two years there has not even been one church that has invited me to come and speak about the Words of God to their people. The only ones who have truly come seeking knowledge are those who do not have a regular church that they go to, and they are interested in truly hearing the message of God. Often they are the meek, the poor, and the oppressed. What will these leaders of these churches say to the Lord about not desiring to enjoy this great supper with Him? Was their yoke better than the yoke the Lord has offered?

- ☆ **Luke 14:15-24** ¹⁵Now when one of those who sat at the table with Him heard these things, he said to Him, "Blessed is he who shall eat bread (*Partake of Instruction from the Lord*) in the kingdom of God!" (*The Kingdom of God is His Words that are within us*). ¹⁶Then He said to him, "A certain man gave a great supper and invited many, ¹⁷and sent his servant at supper time to say to those who were invited, 'Come, for all things are now ready.' (*Take notice that this is the invited guests, the preachers, teachers, spirit-filled believers, evangelists, prophets, Scholars, Rabbis, priests and all those who say that they are rich in the Lord. They are told it is now ready, for the Lord said that the End would come when His Spirit went forth speaking forth His Words with the bow of His tongue and giving Life to all who will receive His Words. This invitation started in early 2003 and it has now come to a close in March 2007. This invitation was sent to those who knew the Lord, for they are the invited guests in His City. That is the city of the Lord, the city that is His church. Jesus, the Servant of the Father, has sent His servant to tell you that He is desiring that you let Him in so that He can give you an invitation to come to the Great Supper and dine on the food of His Father. That food is the Words of God that the Father has released to be opened by Jesus to everyone. He has come to say that all is ready for you to come and partake of His Great Supper. For His Words is the meat of heaven, and Jesus has come to give you the bread of instruction. And all who will receive of His meat and His bread will receive the Waters of everlasting Life. But everyone is too busy and they believe that they are rich in knowledge and lacking nothing, so they are ignoring the call to come to His Great Supper.*) ¹⁸**But they all with one accord began to make excuses** (*This first invitation has now come to a close in March 2007, and these people have missed the opportunity to eat of His food. Unless they repent in sackcloth and repent zealously, there is not a hope for them. For four years I have been shouting out His invitation. For the last two years I have sent out Writing after Writing, to thousands of ministers, intercessors, Spirit-filled believers, and College Presidents, and not one of His churches has invited me in to speak, and I gave away the Writings freely and I offered to speak without cost, but no one would receive the Good News of His invitation. Now time is dwindling, and everyday is that much less time for you to increase in knowledge for the amount of it that you will need to fill the oil in your vessel, so that you will have enough Light for the coming time of the Night of the Day of the Lord. After the time of the Evening, and after the Great Supper is over, the Midnight Hour shall come, and the Lord is going to remove the oil*)

**His Invitations to the Great Supper
At the Time when all is Prepared:
The Evening of the Day of the Lord**

1. **Invited Guests who are in His Houses that are within His City.**
(These are His Oxen, His Religious Leaders and Teachers who were to be watching, expecting His Calling)
2. **The Poor, Maimed, Lame, and Blind who are in the Streets and Lanes within His City.**
(These are His Congregations of believers who have been made poor in Spirit, made maimed, made lame, and made blind by the poor teachings in the houses of His Invited Guests)
3. **The Lost who are in the highways and hedges outside of His City.**
(These are those who are not of His City – all the Lost who are in the World)

from those who only have a little oil in their vessel, and He is going to add it to those who have much oil in their vessel, for they were fruitful in obedience to His commandment to increase in knowledge so that you will be fully equipped for every Good Work). **The first said to him, 'I have bought a piece of ground, and I must go and see it. I ask you to have me excused.'** (To a preacher nearly every one of them is interested in what it takes to raise money. It is not about the Lord and His Will; it is about walking at peace with Satan's world's system (Even though the Lord says that this is the Time He has ordained to take Peace from the earth) and to make money. Most of this is done by lying to people about great blessings if they will take that extra job and if they will borrow in faith believing, and even make every abominable request to beg money from people so that they can have multi-million dollar homes, ranches, estates, luxury cars, family compounds, buses, TV equipment, jets, and all manners of luxury, even men to check the toilets before they use them. Absolute anarchy against the work of a preacher and an evangelist that is of God and sent by God. These men and women know who they are, and now that they have rejected His hand when He offered His knowledge, the Bible reveals that the Lord has now loosed His flying Scroll of Truth to seek after them and all those with them until He has literally erased these prophets of Baal from the earth. Take notice in this verse that this first group is too busy obtaining things of this world and increasing their assets. They ignore the fact that Bible warns them that a great famine is coming within 5 years, and that an economic collapse is coming within 7 years. They ignore the fact that the Bible warns them in Zephaniah 1 that the Lord is going to allow the world system to place the affliction of Joseph on them because they would not hear Him, and that they are going to lose their homes and all they own, and that they will become as bonded slaves. They say that they do not want to think about bad things and that the Lord loves us and that He will not let us come to destruction. They ignore that He has invited them to a Great Supper that will feed them with the food that will keep them safe and secure in the coming Time of the Night. They tell their people to sit back and wait on the Lord. They ignore the Lord's call that they are not to sit back, that they are to get up and come out of following the way of that City of people who just shut up and goes along, and does not seek God in prayer aggressively in their churches. No they are too busy, and they are too complacent to believe God).¹⁹ And another said, 'I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I am going to test them. I ask you to have me excused.' (The oxen are the preachers of the Lord. If a man has bought five yoke, it means that he has bought into five different preachers teachings of man's wisdom, and thus he does not have time to listen to the Lord about the teaching of the Pearl of Great Price, that is the Words of God that are given by the Father, and that are to be the food to be served and enjoyed at the great Supper of the Lord. One can understand this in that you can have a guy who is listening to the teachings of five different preachers and when He receives the invitation to come to the Great Supper to partake of the food of the Great Treasure hidden in the field, they are too occupied with the wisdom of man than to listen to the wisdom of the Words of God that are sent down from heaven, and that are the Words of the language of heaven, that is the language of the angels and of those who are in Paradise awaiting the Rapture).²⁰ Still another said, 'I have married a wife, and therefore I cannot come.' (They took the place of the bridegroom. They are a bridegroom not as wise as Jesus, for they created a bridegroom of false teaching and they have a church who believes in their wisdom, and they do not desire to receive the wisdom of the one whom the Father sent to speak His Words – Deuteronomy 18:18).²¹ So that servant came and reported these things to his master. (Consider this: The Servant – Jesus, or the Spirit of Truth - is reporting to the Father that His Preachers, Teachers and Religious Leaders were too busy to consider His invitation). **THEN THE MASTER OF THE HOUSE, BEING ANGRY,** (Please pay attention to this the Lord is saying that He is angry at His church and take careful notice that the Lord has determined to destroy all the leaders of His church, for in Luke 14:24 He says that not one of these invited are going to be able to taste of His food – His Words. Without His Words these people are condemned to the Outer Darkness and Death. Their only hope is to become like the leaders of Nineveh and greatly repent. For the Lord closed off the preachers, prophets, and spirit-filled believers in March 2007 and now they are condemned to His Death unless they seek Him zealously. That means that they have got to stop all business, all church services, and all personal activities and get on their knees before God and truly repent that He may change His mind), **said to his servant, 'Go out quickly into the streets and lanes of the city** (The city that is being referred to here is the congregation, for they are the ones who have been harmed by the teachings of the Preachers who were not teaching His Words, and they are in worm's clothing wounded in Sheol for they have nothing of God in them because of their teachings. This is still the church where the Master lives, and He is sending His servant out to go and get all those who were hurt by the false teachings and false believes =of these preachers who would not listen to Him and did not prepare them. For they are as dead and torn apart by the beasts in Sheol before Him unless they are opened to His words that heals them), **and bring in here the poor and the maimed and the lame and the blind.'** (He is saying to send His invitations out to His people – the congregations of the churches, but the invitations are going to go direct to them, and not through the Preachers who were too busy to hear His call).²² **And the servant said, 'Master, it is done as you commanded, and still there is room.'**²³ **Then the master said to the servant, 'Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel them to come in, that my house may be filled.'** (This invitation is those who are not members of His Church, and it includes the people of Israel. He is saying that after He invited all the people of His church to come, that not all of them came, for there is still too much empty chairs. So the Father is saying go out into the world and get those who have not heard my Word and they will receive His invitation and many of them will turn and come to eat the food of His Great Supper).²⁴ **FOR I SAY TO YOU THAT NONE OF THOSE MEN WHO WERE INVITED SHALL TASTE MY SUPPER.'"** (We should pay close attention to this statement by the Lord, because He is saying to those who are putting off His invitation, and to those who have rejected His invitation, that NONE OF THEM will taste of His Great Supper. Please take notice that the time of the Great Supper being served is still not over. Meaning this is still in the Time of the Evening. Yet the Lord is saying that He is going to cut off those who rejected to receive His invitation to eat of His food. This means that the preachers, teachers, and Bible scholars who are too busy are going to be cast out because they were too lukewarm. They thought that were rich in the Spirit and lacking nothing. They did not know that they were blind and deaf. They did not know that they are too greedy for the things of the world, and they are going to be cast out from God. Before the Time of the Evening is finished, even before the Midnight hour, the Lord has judged them as blasphemers against His Words that are Spirit and they are Life. For to reject His Words is to trample on the Spirit of

Grace, the Holy Spirit, who dwells within His Words. In the time of the Night when they will need all of the wisdom and understanding that is available, they are going to be without the food from heaven, and also they will not be found among the Raptured for they will not be found worthy at the Midnight Hour as there will not be enough oil of His knowledge in their vessel. Thus, they will suffer greatly in the Time of the Night. For in the Time of the Night, no man will be able to work, and thus, the only works will be those done by the Father. At the Midnight hour the Lord will come with His Holy Angels – the set apart Angels who are the ones who watch over His Words – and they will remove the knowledge of His Words from the unworthy and add that to the worthy. Then they will seal the worthy for the years of the Night that follow. In that Time of the Night, no man who is without the seal of the knowledge of His Words will be able to enable any of the Good Works of the Father to be done for them. They can cry out to the Lord, but as He says in Proverbs 1:20-33, that He will laugh at them and He will not hear their cries, for they have rejected His knowledge that was offered in the food of the Great Supper of the Evening Time of the Day of the Lord. This is why the Lord says in verse 25 that not one of those who were invited and who rejected to dine with Him and receive understanding of His Words will taste of the food of His Great Supper. Do we get it yet? When the Words of God are opened to you, and you see the invitation, you must go to and fro, wherever necessary and receive of the food of knowledge that comes from the throne of heaven. If you do not turn, repent and become zealous for His Word, then the men of Nineveh will stand up in judgment against you. Because when they heard the Word of God, and when they were told of what was coming, they immediately repented within a few days, they fasted, they prayed, and they sought the knowledge of the God of Israel. He heard their cries and He saved them from what was to come. Do not be like those who have been called for two years and they have failed to hear. For they were too busy seeking the small pearls that they ignored the Pearl of Great Price that was found in front of them. They were too busy buying the treasures and luxuries of this world, and they have walked right by that Great Treasure that was found in the field where they walk everyday. What do your ears hear? What do your eyes see? Right now, what does your heart feel? Do you feel the Spirit of Truth rising up inside of you causing you to thirst for knowledge?

- ☆ **Psalm 119:97-105** ⁹⁷Oh, how I love your law! (*The law of the fathers to know His Words Deut. 11:18-21 and in Deut. 6:4-9*) It is my meditation all the day. ⁹⁸You, through your commandments, make me wiser than my enemies; for they are ever with me. ⁹⁹I have more understanding than all my teachers, for Your testimonies are my meditation. ¹⁰⁰I have more understanding than the ancients, because I keep your precepts (*His Ways that are done within His Will*). ¹⁰¹I have restrained my feet from every evil way, that I may keep Your Word. ¹⁰²I have not departed from Your judgments, for you Yourself have taught me. ¹⁰³**How sweet are Your Words to my taste, sweeter than honey to my mouth!** (*David said that God's Words were as sweet food to His mouth*). ¹⁰⁴Through Your precepts I get understanding. Therefore I hate every false way. ¹⁰⁵Your Word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.
- ☆ **Job 23:12** I have not departed from the commandment of His lips (*Deuteronomy 6:4-9, 11:18-21*); I have treasured the Words of His mouth more than my necessary food. (*Most Bibles translate this verse as saying "my necessary food". For the word "food" is not actually written in the Hebrew text. The phrase actually just reads "my necessary". However it is obvious that this phrase applies to the person's necessary food intake. Because of this, this verse actually could be translated as "my necessary sustenance". But, in any case, the fullness of the meaning is that the bread and meat of the Lord, which is the Instruction of God and the Words of God, are greater than anything of the earth that is required for our earthly Life, for the Words of God are not only fulfilling in our needs on earth, but also they are what fulfills us even in eternity. This verse of Job indicates His knowledge of the Words of God, and gives some confirmation that indeed He was the son of Issachar (Genesis 46:13). For he is standing between two burdens as a carrier – a donkey - of the Word of God, as is highlighted by the blessing of Jacob in Genesis 49:14. Further the Lord testifies that Job was the greatest of the men of the East. These are men of God, for the word "East" is another name given to the heaven of God, for Jesus will return from the "Way of the East*).
- ☆ **Psalm 78:25** Men ate Angels' food; He sent them meat to the full. (*When the people were on their way to the Promised Land, did the Lord not provide them food? We are now in the Day of the Lord's Promise, and are we not getting ready to enter Paradise? Should He not give us also a Great Supper?*).
- ☆ **Acts 14:17** Nevertheless He did not leave Himself without witness, in that He did Good, gave us rain from heaven and fruitful seasons, **filling our hearts with FOOD and gladness.**" (*The food He gave us is the meat of His Word, and the bread of His instruction, and the drink is the water of the promise of eternal Life that comes embedded as an unbreakable promise to anyone who receives His Words – Ephesians 1:13-14*).

In this parable, the Lord used an example of a man who bought five yoke of oxen and he was going out to test them and therefore He was too busy to come to the great supper that the Lord had called. Five is of course the number of law, and the yoke is that knowledge worn by the teachers of His Word – the oxen. This man is saying that he has just "purchased" knowledge, obviously from some other man's wisdom, for he has rejected to come and hear the Lord's wisdom, and he is going out to test them in the marketplace. This is likened to a prosperity teacher coming up with 5 new ways to explain Bible verses, and he is going out to test whether his new wisdom will get more people to come into his church and give him money. He is going out to test his new message and he is not willing to take time to go to the great supper with the Lord to hear the Lord speak of His knowledge. It is likened to preachers who are receive information from contacts who are of the way of the world, and they are too busy writing 5 new books to get their worthy message out to the world; and thus they have no time to come to the great supper and hear the Lord speak of wisdom from His Words. This great supper is the days that we are now in. We are in the Evening Time of the Day of the Lord, and it is suppertime. This is the great suppertime when the Lord has invited all of us priests and teachers to come in and dine with Him, so that they may increase in knowledge, and then go out to feed His people the true meat of heaven. The Lord tells this last days church in Revelation 3:16-20 that they belief that they are rich in knowledge and that they are filled with the Spirit, yet they do not realize that He

sees them as being blind and naked being without a garment of knowledge. The Lord invites them to hear His voice calling them to the great supper. For His Spirit is knocking on their heart's door, asking to come in, so that He may feed them the meat of His Words and the bread of His Instruction. They will also receive the blessing of the eternal Living Waters for His Words come with the promise of the Holy Spirit to raise us up to everlasting life.

- ☆ **Revelation 3:16-22** ¹⁶“So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spew you out of My mouth. ¹⁷**Because you say, ‘I am rich, have become wealthy, and have need of nothing’ -- and do not know that you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked – (Preachers are too busy to hear the Lord)** ¹⁸I counsel you (*warn you*) to buy from Me gold refined in the fire, that you may be rich; and white garments, that you may be clothed, that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed; and anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see. ¹⁹As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. Therefore be zealous and repent. ²⁰**Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone “HEARS” My voice (He speaks the Words of God that are all Truth) AND opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.** ²¹To him who overcomes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne. ²²He who has an ear, let him HEAR what the Spirit says to the churches.”

If we were to grade ourselves for our performance as teachers of Jesus and to believe in Him, then it would that means that we teach His Words, the results of the majority of the Oxen of the present day are empty. Jesus was very blunt in the Parable of the Great Supper in saying that the actual numbers of His Oxen who will be properly watching for Him, and who have not preoccupied themselves with their own wisdom of how to teach God to His people, is an absolute zero. He says that not one His Oxen will hear His call, and that every one of them are unprepared for receiving His invitation. That is really a shocking news item, because if you listen to most of those of the nation of America who deem themselves to be as the leaders of the nation's Oxen, they are preaching that we are ready to be raptured, yet Jesus says that we are not even prepared for the Rapture if it came today. Thus, it is very right and fair to proclaim that we, especially the people of the last 100+ years have truly drifted further away from understanding the truth of the Bible annually. We probably have less than 50% of the knowledge of the Lord that we think that we have. It is perfectly and clearly stated by the Lord, in now fulfilled prophesy, told in Luke 14:15-24 and Luke 21:34-36, that there is not one religious leader in the world of this day who is preaching the Bible correctly and within the Will of God, and that not one of His Oxen were prepared when He sent forth His Spirit of Truth. In this Writing we are going to reveal from Scripture why that is a correct statement, and in itself it is a fulfillment of the Lord's prophecy. Thus, being said, it also means that every preacher, evangelist, bishop, prophet, rabbi, priest, Bible teacher, satellite/TV network operator, radio network operator, every intercessor, every Biblical book publisher, every religious products maker, and every religious musician, should perk the ears up and understand that they should be quaking in their shoes (*I left out apostles, for the Bible reveals that there are no apostles at this time. Those who call themselves apostles are not apostles according to the Bible. Thus it would be wrong for me to call them as apostles*). The Bible says that these are the watchmen, or Doorkeepers, the Oxen, are the invited guests. They were the ones who chose their positions, and in that position they took on the responsibility to be the ones manning the watchtowers, the gates, and the doors, to hear the Lord's voice telling them that all is prepared. There were the ones who were to dig into the Scriptures and to know the Way and the Instructions of their King so that they would know when their King would announce that all things are prepared and readied, and that they should come forth. In this Writing we are going to explore the Parable of the Great Supper because it is extremely important for us of this day. To learn the Way of the Lord, we need to first come to understand that we do not know the Way in these days when His Words have been opened. Let us consider a Way of the Lord that was ordered upon us continuously throughout the Bible, and that we have miserably failed to keep up, and that is that we were to be obedient watchmen.

- ☆ **Revelation 3:1-4** ¹“And to the angel of the church in Sardis (*The church who receives His Words in these days, but is acting complacent, and has not become zealous for Him*) write, “These things says He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars: “I know your works, that you have a name that you are alive, but you are dead. ²**Be watchful and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die, for I have not found your works perfect before God.** ³**Remember therefore how you have received and heard; hold fast and repent. Therefore if you will not watch, I will come upon you as a thief, and you will not know what hour I will come upon you.** ⁴You have a few names even in Sardis who have not defiled their garments; and they shall walk with Me in white, for they are worthy.”
- ☆ **Luke 21:34-36** “But take to yourselves, lest your hearts be weighed down with dissipation (*wasted activities*), drunkenness (*the wine, or luxuries of this world*), and cares of this life (*building your house in this world*), and that Day come on you unexpectedly. **For it will come as a snare on all those who dwell on the face of the whole earth. WATCH therefore, and PRAY always that you may be counted worthy to escape all these things that will come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man.**
- ☆ **Mark 13:32-37** ³²“But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father. (*Take care to notice that this is a parable. For the Lord Jesus says that He and the Father are One. Thus, He is saying that the Father, who is Spirit, and who resides in His Words and who is His Words, knows the Day and the Hour. Thus, if we watch and seek understanding of the Father, the Words of God, then we shall know that Day and our Hour*). ³³Take heed, watch and pray; for you do not know when the time is. ³⁴*It is like a man going to a far country, who left his house and gave authority to his servants, and to each his work, and commanded the doorkeeper to watch. (Jesus said that He is the Door, and the Lord also said that we are to keep the Words of His Father that He speaks, those very Words that are written on His Doorposts. Thus, the Doorkeeper is the ministers and teachers, and they are*

responsible to watch and to keep the Words of God, just as Jesus kept the Words of God. But they have not entered gone to the Door and they have not understood His Words on the doorposts, and thus they have failed to Watch, and this is why the Lord says that this Day and Hour shall come upon everyone on the whole earth as a snare for His watchmen have failed to watch and to keep the Door). ³⁵ **Watch therefore, for you do not know when the master of the house is coming--in the evening, at midnight, at the crowing of the rooster, or in the morning—** (*The Day of His coming is the Day of the Lord, and the hour of His coming is the moment that the opening of His Words are made known, for that is the sign of invitation to the watchmen, who are then supposed to inform their congregations and to go out and gather all those of the world that they could gather. But the watchmen were sleeping when the invitation came to them, when that Day and hour came to them. Their names have now been removed from the Book of Life and they must now turn, repent and zealously seek Him that they may cause Him to change His mind of them for their not being faithful and not obeying the law of the watchmen*). ³⁶ **lest, coming suddenly, he find you sleeping.** ³⁷ **And what I say to you, I say to all: Watch!**" (*The Lord says that are all to watch, but what were we to be watching for? The Lord tells us in Isaiah 21 that we were to be watching for the Table that He was preparing for us*).

Ministers reading this will likely burn with anger. They may say that it is very prideful for someone to say this because they will say in their minds that they have been excellent watchmen. To this idea, I will only ask of them: If you have faithfully performed the task of a watchman, then why in the world have you not told your people that it is time to prepare themselves for the coming of the Night? Also, why did the lord say in Luke 14:21 that He is angry with the invited guests? We missed the teaching of the Lord that would have enabled us to understand that instead of waiting for the Rapture, we should have been looking for the invitation from the Lord to call us to a prepared table to dine and to eat of His food? To understand this, let us consider the Words of the Lord given to the great prophet Isaiah as are recorded in Isaiah 21:3-12. This is a prophecy and it is a parable, but may seem to you to be quite difficult to translate; however, if you carefully consider it, you will find that it is relating to us of this day because it is relating to the time when Babylon (*The great harlot of Revelation 18*) is about to fall, as is revealed in Isaiah 21:9-10. The Lord has warned His people to set up Watchmen, and that those Watchmen are to be looking for the Table that he Lord has prepared, and that when the Table is ready the Lord will call them into His Watch Tower to dine with Him – to eat and to drink with Him. But, as we see in Luke 14:15-24, the sad result is that the Watchmen, (*Each and all of His preachers, evangelists, bishops, prophets, rabbis, priests, Bible teachers, satellite/TV network operators, radio network operators, all intercessors, all Biblical book publishers, all religious products makers, and all religious musicians, have failed in their position as Watchmen for the Lord. In this process they have openly rejected His Knowledge, and therefore, as a result of their refusal to increase in knowledge, they have been rejected as priests before Him – Hosea 4:6*). Consider this passage from Isaiah 21:3-12 and you will discover that the Lord had warned the Watchmen that they are to be watching not for Him to come in the clouds to call them up in the Rapture; but rather, they were to be watching for Him to come as the Spirit of Truth – His return to us in Spirit, as the Spiritual flesh and blood of His Words – and that we were to dine with Him so that we can fulfill all Scriptures and make the knowledge of His Glory to be made known throughout the face of the whole Earth. This is why the Day of the Lord has come as a snare upon everyone on the face of the whole earth. We were not looking for the Lion of the Tribe of Judah who roars with His voice calling out the Words of His Father; because the leaders of this nation, and other nations, have entered into an illegal union with the Great Harlot and have conspired to bring about the bankruptcy of His people so that they can rapidly bring forward the cashless society of Satan so that they may control all financial flows. The Lord will deliver His people but only if they rapidly respond. All of the believers of His churches have come to the time, as He did the men of Nineveh. Because the Lord's invited guests of the Gentiles and Jews have refused His hand when He offered to them to come and eat of His Table so that they may increase in knowledge, the Father has allowed for the destruction of their city to come. Satan has planned it, and the work of his destruction is imminent. If the people do not respond to God's warning that they are to call out to Him to have the Spirit of Truth to reveal all Truth, then He will allow them to enter into their destruction and ruin. This Writing will reveal why we must come to the knowledge of the Way of the Lord rapidly and to do so zealously, or you will find yourself bankrupt and you will soon become a bonded servant of the whim of those who are operating Satan's world system.

☆ **Isaiah 21:3-12** ³Therefore my loins are filled with pain; pangs have taken hold of me, like the pangs of a woman in labor. I was distressed when I heard it; I was dismayed when I saw it. ⁴My heart wavered, fearfulness frightened me; the night for which I longed He turned into fear for me. ⁵**Prepare the table, set a watchman in the tower, eat and drink.** (*This is one of the saddest verses in the Bible, for Isaiah is saying that the watchmen were to be eating and drinking in the watchtower at the Table that the Lord has prepared for the watchmen, the invited guests. But, Isaiah is saying that his heart wavered in fear and regret because none of the watchmen came. He said that they are Princes of the Most High God, but they did not arise and they would not come, and therefore they have not received Of the High Anointing of the Watchmen in the High Tower of the Lord. For they did not expect that the Lord was preparing a Table for them, and as it says in Luke 14:21 that not one watchmen, His invited Guests, even bothered to come and eat at His Table when He called and it was prepared. Thus, when the Lord called out and said that the Table is prepared and tell the Watchmen to come and sit at the Table He has prepared, so that they are they did not receive the knowledge from the Lord of the news of the things that are to come in the Night and of the Morning of this Day of the Lord*). Arise you princes, anoint the shield! (*Isaiah is saying to the religious leaders and the leaders of the nations for them to watch over their cities, and to make sure that they know the future and that they should receive the things that are of God, and avoid the things of the world that will lead to their destruction*). ⁶For thus has the Lord said to me: "Go, set a watchman,

let him declare what he sees." ⁷ And he saw a chariot *with* a pair of horsemen, a chariot of donkeys, *and* a chariot of camels, and he listened earnestly with great care. (*Two ways of the world – donkeys are to be carriers of the Words of God; but camels are the carriers of the words of the things of the world*). ⁸ Then he cried, "A lion, my Lord! I stand continually on the watchtower in the daytime; I have sat at my post every night. (Isaiah is saying that the Lord will come and He will change the things that are coming, and at the time of the end He will judge and the He will take those who have received the way of the Words, and He will leave those who have pursued the way of the world). ⁹ And look, here comes a chariot of men *with* a pair of horsemen!" (*Take notice that as the Lord has come as the Lion of the Tribe of Judah roaring out His Words with His voice, then it shall be the beginning of the fall of Babylon, for the Lion will cause the leaders of the world to destroy their own system as the Lion comes in Truth, and Babylon is a city of false gods, false wealth and false wisdom. Babylon is fully destroyed by the end of the Morning of the Day of the Lord*). Then he answered and said, "Babylon is fallen, is fallen! And all the carved images of her gods He has broken to the ground." ¹⁰ Oh, my threshing and the grain of my floor! (*The work of those who have fallen her and who slaved with their hands to obtain the worldly things of her luxuries and the lure of her sinful lusts, have finally come to not*). That which I have heard from the Lord of hosts, the God of Israel, I have declared to you. (*Isaiah is saying that he is warning us that Babylon is going to come to naught – to nothing, and all of her idols – money, houses, mansions, ranches, cars, sports, pleasures of leisure, sexual desires, and high appointments in a system that worships the way of the world – are going to fall and all those who followed her will come to bankruptcy and captivity*). ¹¹ The burden against Dumah (*Dumah means Silence – This is a burden against those who have kept silent and who have not spoken the Good News of the Words of God that Jesus came into the World to give His blood of the Cross so that He could obtain the authority to come back and unseal for man these Words of God. The watchmen were ordered to teach and to speak His Words, but instead they spoke and taught their own words*). He calls to me out of Seir (*Seir means a place of goats, a place covered by trees. Since the Bible refers to men as trees walking, we can understand that these are people who are of Satan who are walking about, but they falsely believe that they are sheep under His covering*), "Watchman, what of the night? Watchman, what of the night?" (*The Lord repeats this twice to His watchman. If His ministers are His Watchmen, then does not this say that they should know what is the Night and also the Morning, and that they should be inquiring from Him as to what is the roll of His servants, His ministers, in those times?*). ¹² The watchman said, "The morning comes, and also the night. If you will inquire, inquire; Return! Come back!" (*The Lord is making a plea to us to be a watchman of understanding. It seems that in these days every pastor is telling us that there is nothing more to be completed and that we are ready and prepared for the Lord to call us up in the Rapture. In reality we are so unprepared for the Rapture that I think that there is such a few prepared for the Rapture that the number could be counted with less than the number of fingers of one hand. That is terribly tragic. People you are not going to be raptured unless you hear Him and enter into His table and share His Great Supper with Him. Think about it this way: Before the He took them out of 400 years of captivity in Egypt; He had them to eat a Passover meal. Before He went to the Cross to bring the knowledge of the Words of His Kingdom, He first shared His meal with His disciples. Each of these events was prepared and served by the Lord's instruction so as to bring these people into greater knowledge of the Way of their Lord. Before we can be raptured we are going to have to wake-up and come and sit at His Table and dine with Him so that we have partaken of the food that will bring us into His knowledge. The first stage of the Seal Judgments is the call to eat. Just as the Lord did in the days of Joseph, He provided abundance for the people to prepare for the famine that is coming. The Lord told us in Zechariah 14:6-7 that there will be an abundance of Light in the Evening of His Day, but that there will be no Light in the Night and the Morning. This is why the Watchmen were called to watch and be prepared to come and eat at His table. For His Words is flesh (meat), and His blood is instruction. Without His Words we will not see Eternal Life*).

- ☆ **Revelation 1:3** "Blessed is he who reads and those who hear the Words of this prophecy (*The Words within this prophecy*), and keep those things which are written in it; for the time is near." (*Now it is being fulfilled in us*).
- ☆ **Revelation 22:7** "Behold, I am coming quickly! Blessed is he who keeps the Words of the prophecy of this Book." (*The Words within the prophecy that is in the Book – He is telling us to watch for, to read, to hear, to search out, and then keep, the Words of God that He speaks, for Jesus speaks the Words of God, and those we need to seek out the Words of God that are in this prophecy and that are in His Bible*).
- ☆ **Luke 6:46-49** ⁴⁶ "But why do you call Me 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do the things which I say? (*He speaks the Words of God and we are to be doers of His Words. If we do not, then the Lord says that He is not our Lord and we are in sin for disobedience against His instruction*). ⁴⁷ **Whoever comes to Me, and hears My Words and does them, I will show you whom he is like:** ⁴⁸ **He is like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid the foundation on the Rock. And when the flood arose, the stream beat vehemently against that house, and could not shake it, for it was founded on the Rock.** ⁴⁹ **But he who heard and did nothing is like a man who built a house on the earth without a foundation, against which the stream beat vehemently; and immediately it fell. And the ruin of that house was great."** (*When the bankruptcy comes and they take your house, will you fall immediately and seek after following the Way of the World Financial System and agree to accept the laws of the system that Satan has put in place for these days? The Lord says in Amos 5:5 that if you do this you are choosing to go into the Way of Gilgal and He promises you that you will go into slavery. The Lord established this nation and it's Constitution, and if you choose to accept another foundation to have things of this world, and thereby choose to not put your trust in Him, then He will have no part in you*).

We seem to look past certain teachings and instructions of the disciples, such as in the Writings of Mark, Luke, John and Paul. They endeavored to give us Writings that tried to open our eyes to exactly what the purpose of the Lord coming to earth was for, and exactly what was the Way in which He taught us to walk. But, we have failed to open our eyes to the Words Jesus spoke. We have also not paid attention to the things Jesus did and the Way in which He did them. Did He not say that I am the Way, and that in the manner of the Way in which I was sent, that

in like manner I now send you? This is being completely disobedient to the instruction of the Father that was given to us in Deuteronomy 18:18-19. He warned us that He was sending Jesus into the world to speak His and do those things that He told Jesus to do, and if we did not believe in what He said and the Way He did the things He was told, then He is going to require it of us. But we have not heard the Words of God that Jesus came and spoke, and we did not seek out the Way in which He did the things that He was told by the Father. Because we have listened to the words of His invited guests who were not good watchmen and did not speak to us His Words, nor did they tell us of His Way; thus, we have been made poor in the Spirit, maimed in our power to do His Good works, we have been made lame in our walk, and we have been made blind of the Words of God. Because His invited guests have been convincing with their oratory skills, we were therefore not aware that we are only lukewarm. The Lord is saying that we are wretched and blind and about to be spewed out into the Outer Darkness with all sinners. We are injured and we are without the Words of God that heal us.

- ☆ **Luke 1:1-4** ¹Inasmuch as many have taken in hand to set in order a narrative of those things which have been fulfilled among us, ²just as those who from the beginning were eyewitnesses and ministers of the word delivered them to us, ³it seemed good to me also, having had perfect understanding of all things from the very first, to write to you an orderly account, most excellent Theophilus (*This name "Theophilus" means "friend of God"*), ⁴that you may know the certainty of those things in which you were instructed.
- ☆ **Mark 1:1-3** ¹The beginning of the Good News of Jesus Christ, the Son of God. ²As it is written in the Prophets: "Behold, I send My messenger before Your face, who will prepare Your way before You." ³"The voice of one crying in the wilderness: 'Prepare the way of the Lord; make His paths straight.'"
- ☆ **Deuteronomy 18:18-19 (THIS IS THE TESTIMONY OF THE FATHER ABOUT JESUS. IT IS ALSO A "LAW" OF THE FATHER THAT ALL MEN ARE TO HEAR AND TO OBEY)** ^{18a} will raise up for them a Prophet (*Jesus*) like you (*Moses, the Law Giver*) from among their brethren, and **will put My Words in His mouth, and He shall speak to them all that I command Him.** ¹⁹ **And it shall be that whoever will not hear My Words, which He speaks in My name, I WILL REQUIRE IT OF HIM.** (*Do we not understand that if we do not Hear His Words and seek the Lord, then we are in danger?*).

There is an interesting event regarding the Ox that is recorded in Judges 3:31. It is a rather simplified explanation of a deliverance of Israel by a man named Shamgar, who was the son of Anath. The Bible records only one sentence, having three parts, about Shamgar. The first part tells us that Shamgar was the son of Anath. The second part tells us that he used an ox goad to kill 600 Philistines. The third part of the sentence tells us that His action delivered Israel again to rest.

This verse tells us that the father of Shamgar was Anath. Although I have not been able to find a good understanding of why Anath named his son Shamgar, the meaning of the name "Anath" can be understood. The meaning of Anath is "to answer", or "to teach". The fact that he used an ox goad to kill 600 hundred Philistines to deliver Israel is of course a very interesting statement. Since the symbolic meaning of the oxen is "to teach His Word", it bears an interesting intrigue that Shamgar would use the ox goad to deliver Israel from its enemy. Was Shamgar prodding the leaders of the nation of Israel that they should teach His Words; and/or was Shamgar using the ox goad to deliver Israel from its enemy to show Israel and its enemies that by the knowledge of the Words of God the Lord will deliver His people?

The ox goad is a long wood pole having one sharp end that is used by a man to prod and thereby guide oxen. The ox goad is a strong pole that was made out of wood, and usually had a single iron bladed end to it. Samples of ox goads that have been found say that they were up to ten feet in length. One can see that the ox goad could be a formidable weapon; but being of such size, would cause it to be very difficult to use such a weapon in a fight against 600 men. It would seemingly be a heavy and cumbersome weapon. It is logical that it would not often have been utilized in hand-to-hand battle. If it were a good battle weapon then seemingly the Bible and history books would be full of historical accounts of men utilizing ox goads in battle. There is only one mention of an ox goad in the entire Bible, and that is this passage in Judges 3:31. So, it begs to question why did Shamgar utilize a cumbersome ox goad as the weapon of choice to slay 600 Philistine men of war?

- ☆ **Judges 3:31** ³¹ After him was Shamgar the son of Anath, who killed six hundred men of the Philistines with an ox goad; and he also delivered Israel.

In Daniel 12:10 the Lord says that the wise shall understand. In Revelation 13:18 the Lord says that let he who has understanding calculate the number of the beast. The Lord is saying that we can learn some wisdom from the calculation of numbers as a testimony of His Works. Thus, as I revealed in the Writing "A Testimony of Numbers", we can learn insight to Shamgar's actions by the testimony of the numbers that are involved. Clearly the fact that the verse records that Shamgar killed exactly 600 Philistines provides us with some insight that the numbers related to this verse are of importance to gain understanding of the work that the Lord did through Shamgar. So let us consider the numeric values – the gematria – of things involved with this event to gain further understanding of God's work through Shamgar.

The Hebrew word for ox goad is shown in the chart. The gematria letter number value for this Hebrew word is the number 114. The number 114 is the same gematria as the Hebrew word for "Knowledge". In Proverbs 9:10 we are told that Understanding is having Knowledge of the Holy One. It is also the same gematria of the Hebrew word for "Gracious". King David tells us that one who has the Words of God will follow after the way of the Lord, being gracious, full of compassion and righteous. He will remain that way even when he is seeing his desires put upon his enemies (*Psalm 112:8*). There may be no greater example of understanding the true meaning of David in Psalm 112, than the example of Shamgar that is found in Judges 3:31.

- ☆ **Judges 3:31** ³¹ After him was Shamgar the son of Anath, who killed six hundred men of the Philistines with an ox goad; and he also delivered Israel.
- ☆ **Psalm 112:1-10** ¹ Praise the Lord! Blessed is the man *who* fears the Lord, *Who* delights greatly in His commandments. ² His descendants will be mighty on earth; the generation of the upright will be blessed. ³ Wealth and riches *will be* in his house, and his righteousness endures forever. ⁴ Unto the upright there arises light in the darkness; *He is* gracious, and full of compassion, and righteous. ⁵ A good man deals graciously and lends; He will guide his affairs with discretion. ⁶ Surely he will never be shaken; the righteous will be in everlasting remembrance. ⁷ He will not be afraid of evil tidings; his heart is steadfast, trusting in the Lord. ⁸ His heart is established; HE WILL NOT BE AFRAID, until he sees his desire upon his enemies (As by the promise of God as stated clearly in John 15:7. He who has the promise of God's Words and Understanding will not be afraid, and the Lord says that no cowards will be found in heaven, and neither will there be found in heaven those whose heart firstly pursues after the idols of the riches of this world – Revelation 21:8). ⁹ He has dispersed abroad, he has given to the poor; his righteousness endures forever; his horn will be exalted with honor. ¹⁰ The wicked will see it and be grieved; he (*The wicked*) will gnash his teeth and melt away; the desire of the wicked shall perish (*The Father is glorified to do the desires of those who do His Words – John 15:7 and Psalm 50:14*).

Among words having the gematria value of 114, there is a witness of words and numbers in regard to the way of doing the Lord's Words. Shamgar took up the ox goad by wisdom. Shamgar had understanding of the Words of God and the Ways of the Works of the Lord. Shamgar took up a lowly ox goad, and he used it as a weapon with knowledge to bring destruction upon the enemies of God. The Lord honored Shamgar for giving praise and glory to the Words of God and the Father did the desire of his heart for him (*John 15:7*). To get back to the point of the great exploit accomplished by Shamgar, we can observe the testimony of the numbers. Shamgar took the Ox Goad to slay the Philistines because it was a representation of a tool by the Lord to show the Priests of Israel that they were failing to uphold the commands of the Lord to teach His Words to His people. The Ox Goad was made of dried wood. When the Lord was on His way to be crucified, He told the weeping daughters of Jerusalem not to weep for Him, but that they should weep for themselves. The Lord then said that if they (*the Priests*) do these things in the time of the greenwood, what would they do in the time of the dry wood? The green wood is the Wood that has the waters in it. The greenwood is symbolic of the presence of the Holy Spirit. Thus, the Lord was referring to the time when the Holy Spirit, the Restrainer, is removed from the access of men who have been found unworthy. We can understand that these Priests of Israel were surely found to be unworthy of the Lord. Yet, as is evidenced by the Apostles, the Words of God were still being taught, and they were still open for the Jews. They were available to be received until the time that Paul sealed them from the Jewish people in Acts 28:28 (*His Words were closed to the Jews in ~60 AD when the Priests of the synagogues rejected them in Rome when Paul invited them to come and receive the Words*).

The dry wood of the Ox Goad symbolized the fact that the Priests of Israel had failed to keep the covenant to keep and to teach the Words of God. By the use of the Ox Goad Shamgar related the lack of knowledge and the correction that was needed in Israel. Shamgar restored knowledge of the Words of God and the Understanding of God in Israel; and by it he restored Israel once again to be as like God's nation. In Hosea 4:6 we are taught that it is by a lack of knowledge that His people are destroyed.

- ☆ **Hosea 4:6** "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. **Because you have rejected knowledge, I also will reject you from being a Priest before Me,** because you have forgotten the law of your God I also will forget your children." (*This means that their children would not be destroyed if they had been taught knowledge*).

Shamgar's use of the Ox Goad to slay the Philistines was a way of shaming the Priests of Israel to do their proper job of teaching the Words of God to His people. The Lord says that it is because the Priests have rejected to teach His Words that they are being rejected as Priests before Him. We should be able to understand this from the way of the priests in the days of Jesus. The Lord came speaking the Words of God and His people rejected Him (*John 3:26-36*). This included the Priests who were primarily responsible for sending Him to His crucifixion. In Acts 28 we

see that the Priests in the synagogues of Rome also rejected to receive the Words of God when Paul opened them to them. That is why Paul says in the verse of Acts 28:28, that the Words of God have been sealed up and closed and sent to the Gentiles. But it would not be lawful for the Words of God to be opened to the Gentiles until the Time of the End, (*Per Daniel 12:4, 9-10, 2 Corinthians 12:1-4, and Hebrews 10:25-31*). In the days of Shamgar it is clear that Israel had again swayed from being obedient to following the ways of the covenants of God.

The Bible is clear that it is by a lack of knowledge that His people are destroyed. If the Priests do not teach His Words when they are opened to them, then God holds them into account for their complacency and lack of wisdom and understanding. For this cause the Lord raised up Shamgar. By the use of an Ox goad Shamgar went forth and slew 600 Philistines. The Priests were to burn the sacrifices so that the aroma of the burning of the sin was offered up to the Lord so that He would provide them with a settling of the waters, a calming of troubles. It seems that Shamgar desired to goad the Priests into doing their job, so he used an ox goad to slay 600 of the enemies of the Lord as a pleasing offering unto the Lord.

This passage in Isaiah 11:2 is referring to the way that Jesus would be sent. We know from John 3:34 that Jesus was sent to speak the Words of God and that He came with the Spirit of Truth (*The Father*) in Him. The Father was in Jesus, and His Words are Spirit and they are Life. Jesus came with the Father in Him in His Words that abided in Him. As the chart reveals the very Spirit of God, that gives us Understanding and Wisdom has a gematria sum of 600. Also it is that from the throne of God His wise instructions go forth as immediate Lightening, and lightening has a numeric value of 600.

It now becomes clear that by wisdom Shamgar chose to slay 600 of the Philistines. Shamgar by wisdom chose to take the Ox Goad to make an offering of praise unto the Lord and to slay the Philistines with the Ox Goad. The Father delivered the 600 Philistines into the hand of Shamgar, as it was the desire of Shamgar to do the Words of God and to do the will of the Father. It glorified the Father to deliver the Philistines to the hand of Shamgar for the deliverance of His nation Israel. In Judges 3:31 it tells that Shamgar delivered Israel. This means that Shamgar's actions was a testimony that brought the Israelites back into rest by the gaining of the knowledge of His Words and Understanding of the ways of the Lord. A nation cannot have rest unless it is obeying the will of the Lord, and it is a requirement by covenant with God that His Priests teach His Words to His people.

The number 600 is also the gematria numeric value of the Hebrew words for "His Righteousness"; "Rejoicing"; "Splendor"; "A Settling of the Water"; and for the Greek Words of "the Godhead"; and the "Choice Wine". As can be seen, all these words and phrases are applicable in Bible Scriptures to the washing away of sin, and the making clean of the people. This is accomplished by gaining in the knowledge of the Holy One (*Proverbs 9:10*). Because of Shamgar's exploits that praised the Lord's wisdom, the nation of Israel was brought into rest and prosperity, even in the face of their enemies. The numbers give testimony to the Way of the Lord that was accomplished by the hand of Shamgar and the work of the Father. Truly His numbers give testimony to His Ways.

☆ **Matthew 10:5-24** These twelve Jesus sent out and commanded them, saying: "Do not go into the way of the Gentiles, and do not enter a city of the Samaritans. But rather go to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. And as you go, preach, saying, 'The Kingdom of heaven is at hand.' Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give. Provide neither gold nor silver nor copper in your money belts, nor bag for your journey, nor two tunics, nor sandals, nor staffs; for a worker is worthy of his food. Now whatever city of town you enter, inquire who in it is worthy, and stay there till you go out. And when you go into a household, greet it. If the household is worthy, let your peace come upon it. But if it is not worthy, let your peace return to you (*Do not leave Peace, as it is a Word of Spirit, it is life and it is powerful*) And whoever will not receive you nor hear your words, (for you are His Anointed by having His Words, and His Words are Spirit) when you depart

from that house or city, shake off the dust from your feet. Assuredly, I say to you, it will be more tolerable for the land of Sodom and Gomorrah in the Day of Judgment than for that city! Behold I send you out as sheep in the midst of wolves. Therefore be wise as serpents and harmless as doves (*Let the Spirit do the work, and do not argue with the blind. Let the Spirit shame the blind*). But beware of men, for they will deliver you up to councils and scourge you in their synagogues. And you will be brought before governors and kings for My sake, as a testimony to them and to the

Gentiles. But when they deliver you up, do not worry about how or what you should speak. For it will be given to you in that hour what you should speak. For it is not you who speak, but the Spirit of your Father who speaks in you. Now brother will deliver up brother to death, and a father his child; and children will rise up against parents and cause them to be put to death. And you will be hated by all for My name's sake. But he who endures to the end will be saved. But when they persecute you in a city, flee to another. For assuredly, I say to you, you will not have gone through the cities of Israel before the Son of Man comes. A disciple is not above His teacher, nor a servant above his master.

- ☆ **Ezekiel 33:28-33** ²⁸For I will make the land most desolate, her arrogant strength shall cease, and the mountains of Israel shall be so desolate that no one will pass through. ²⁹Then they shall know that I *am* the Lord, when I have made the land most desolate because of all their abominations which they have committed. ³⁰As for you, son of man, the children of your people are talking about you beside the walls and in the doors of the houses; and they speak to one another, everyone saying to his brother, 'Please come and hear what the Word is that comes from the Lord.' (*I have called out the Good News of His Words*). ³¹**So they come to you as people do, they sit before you as My people, and they hear your Words, but they do not do them; for with their mouth they show much love, but their hearts pursue their own gain.** ³²Indeed you *are* to them as a very lovely song of one who has a pleasant voice and can play well on an instrument; **for they hear your Words, but they do not do them.** (*I testify that people want the key to the miracles, but they do not obey to first heed God's command to hear and to teach the Good News of His Words - of His power and of His purposes to all those in their house and in their business*). ³³And when this (*destruction*) comes to pass--**surely it will come**--then they will know that a prophet "has been" among them."

It was not an accident that Elijah found Elisha following the oxen pulling the plow (*1 Kings 19:20*). Elisha left that oxen and ran to follow after Elijah. In this Elisha was doing what the Lord is calling for His people to do at this present time. We are to come out from following after the teachers and leaders who are leading us in the ways of worshipping after the luxuries of the city of Babylon, and we are to follow after the true oxen who will help us to increase in the knowledge of the Lord. Even in the death of Uzzah there is wisdom to be learned. When God's people follow after the things of God, there is no authority for man to reach out and pull up His ox when they stumble. For when their yoke is attached to God's Words, it is the Lord who will bring His people under correction and give them strength when they stumble. Man is not authorized to touch those who are anointed with His Word, or they will pay the price of death, as Uzzah learned. Even the Lord says that alone He will avenge His true prophets, for a true prophet of the Lord is one who carries His Words. If their yoke is not attached to teach the Words of God, then you can correct an ox that is stumbling in the way. Uzzah was doing what He would normally have done; but he never knew the power of God's prized possessions, that God is in them and that they are thereby Holy and set apart. For this reason the Lord says that in these last days, at the Midnight hour, those whom have received his Words, that He shall seal them as in the days of Noah inside the ark, for when He comes He will find them worthy, for they will have filled their vessels with the knowledge of His Words, and they keep their oil and they shall not be hurt in the Night. They shall be kept safe and secure in the days of the troubles that are coming (*Proverbs 1:20-33*). The Lord has promised that if we teach the children of His Ways then their life will be well for them, and they will not grow up to be rebellious against Him.

- ☆ **Proverbs 1:20-33** ²⁰Wisdom (*The Words of God that are our Helper, and that Jesus is calling out to us*) calls aloud outside (*of the city of the world*); she raises Her voice in the open squares. ²¹She cries out in the chief concourses, at the openings of the gates in the city She speaks Her Words (*The Words of God, that are also called the "Truth"*). ²²How long you simple (*naive*) ones, will you love simplicity (*naivety*)? For scorners delight in scorning, and fools hate knowledge. ²³Turn at My reproof: Surely I will pour out My Spirit on you. I will make My Words known to you (*This has always been available to us, yet we failed to seek His Words and the understanding of the way of His "Good" Works*). ²⁴Because I have called and you refused. I have stretched out My hand and no one regarded (*This is a warning that we should not reject His Knowledge of Truth when it is opened to us*). ²⁵Because you disdained all My counsel, and would have none of My reproof, ²⁶I also will laugh at your calamity; I will mock when your terror comes. ²⁷When your terror comes like a storm, and your destruction comes like a whirlwind. When distress and anguish come upon you. ²⁸Then they will call upon Me, BUT I WILL NOT ANSWER; they will seek Me diligently, but they will not find Me. ²⁹Because they hated knowledge, and did not choose the fear of the Lord, ³⁰they would have none of My counsel, and would have none of My reproof. ³¹THEREFORE they shall eat the fruit of their own way, and be filled to the full with their own fancies. ³²**For the turning away of the simple will slay them, and the complacency of fools will destroy them.** (*Those who reject His Knowledge in these days when the Lord has opened the Words of His promises to them, as per Hosea 4:6, will be destroyed, and God will allow them to suffer the troubles of the 3rd, 4th and 5th Seal Judgments in the Time of the Night, while He keeps all those who received His Words safe and secure; as He will not allow His oil and wine to be troubled*). ³³**BUT WHOEVER LISTENS TO ME WILL DWELL SAFELY, AND WILL BE SECURE (AT EASE) WITHOUT FEAR OF EVIL** (*Please understand that this is great news revealed to you from God*).

The Ox (*Bull*) has been part of the Temple sacrifices for the covering of the sins of the people. I have included the Biblical passages from Leviticus that reveal the sacrifice of the Oxen for the covering of sin. In Leviticus 6:25 Moses is told that the sin offering is the Most Holy of the sacrifices. In Leviticus chapter 4 The Oxen is the sacrifice that is used for the sins of all the people. You will note in Leviticus chapter 4 that there is a different animal to be sacrificed for sins when it involves unintentional sins of individual rulers, individual priests, or the individual common people. But, the basic sacrifice for sin offerings is that of the Oxen. The sin offering is a very precise and careful sacrificial practice that was implemented by the Lord, and He called to it as the Most Holy Sacrifice. Now, this is important for us to understand that the sin offering is made for disobedience to the commandments of God;

or, said another way, the sin offering is made for the disobedience against the Words of God, both His spoken Word and the doing of the Way of His Words. In John 15:3 we are told that it is His Words that sweep us clean, and we have seen that the Oxen is the representative of the Lord's obedient servants who are to go out and walk in the right field and walk on the correct path so that the seed is not planted, but that it is properly harvested. The Lord gave His people the Ways of the sacrifices so that they would be doing the Ways of His promises that are in His Words. If not, then there is no purpose to the sacrifices. Consider this as you read these following verses.

☆ **Leviticus 4:1-35** ¹Now the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, ²"Speak to the children of Israel, saying: 'If a person sins unintentionally against any of the commandments of the Lord *in anything* which ought not to be done, and does any of them, ³if the anointed priest sins, bringing guilt on the people, then let him offer to the Lord for his sin which he has sinned a young bull without blemish as a sin offering. ⁴He shall bring the bull to the door of the tabernacle of meeting before the Lord, lay his hand on the bull's head, and kill the bull before the Lord. ⁵Then the anointed priest shall take some of the bull's blood and bring it to the tabernacle of meeting. ⁶The priest shall dip his finger in the blood and sprinkle some of the blood seven times before the Lord, in front of the veil of the sanctuary. ⁷And the priest shall put some of the blood on the horns of the altar of sweet incense before the Lord, which is in the tabernacle of meeting; and he shall pour the remaining blood of the bull at the base of the altar of the burnt offering, which is at the door of the tabernacle of meeting. ⁸He shall take from it all the fat of the bull as the sin offering. The fat that covers the entrails and all the fat which *is* on the entrails, ⁹the two kidneys and the fat that *is* on them by the flanks, and the fatty lobe *attached* to the liver above the kidneys, he shall remove, ¹⁰as it was taken from the bull of the sacrifice of the peace offering; and the priest shall burn them on the altar of the burnt offering. ¹¹But the bull's hide and all its flesh, with its head and legs, its entrails and offal-- ¹²the whole bull he shall carry outside the camp to a clean place, where the ashes are poured out, and burn it on wood with fire; where the ashes are poured out it shall be burned. ¹³Now if the whole congregation of Israel sins unintentionally, and the thing is hidden from the eyes of the assembly, and they have done *something against* any of the commandments of the Lord *in anything* which should not be done, and are guilty; ¹⁴when the sin which they have committed becomes known, then the assembly shall offer a young bull for the sin, and bring it before the tabernacle of meeting. ¹⁵And the elders of the congregation shall lay their hands on the head of the bull before the Lord. Then the bull shall be killed before the Lord. ¹⁶The anointed priest shall bring some of the bull's blood to the tabernacle of meeting. ¹⁷Then the priest shall dip his finger in the blood and sprinkle *it* seven times before the Lord, in front of the veil. ¹⁸And he shall put *some* of the blood on the horns of the altar which *is* before the Lord, which *is* in the tabernacle of meeting; and he shall pour the remaining blood at the base of the altar of burnt offering, which is at the door of the tabernacle of meeting. ¹⁹He shall take all the fat from it and burn *it* on the altar. ²⁰And he shall do with the bull as he did with the bull as a sin offering; thus he shall do with it. So the priest shall make atonement for them, and it shall be forgiven them. ²¹Then he shall carry the bull outside the camp, and burn it as he burned the first bull. *It is a sin offering for the assembly.* ²²When a ruler has sinned, and done *something* unintentionally *against* any of the commandments of the Lord his God *in anything* which should not be done, and is guilty, ²³or if his sin which he has committed comes to his knowledge, he shall bring as his offering a kid of the goats, a male without blemish. ²⁴And he shall lay his hand on the head of the goat, and kill it at the place where they kill the burnt offering before the Lord. *It is a sin offering.* ²⁵The priest shall take some of the blood of the sin offering with his finger, put *it* on the horns of the altar of burnt offering, and pour its blood at the base of the altar of burnt offering. ²⁶And he shall burn all its fat on the altar, like the fat of the sacrifice of the peace offering. So the priest shall make atonement for him concerning his sin, and it shall be forgiven him. ²⁷If anyone of the common people sins unintentionally by doing *something against* any of the commandments of the Lord *in anything* which ought not to be done, and is guilty, ²⁸or if his sin which he has committed comes to his knowledge, then he shall bring as his offering a kid of the goats, a female without blemish, for his sin which he has committed. ²⁹And he shall lay his hand on the head of the sin offering, and kill the sin offering at the place of the burnt offering. ³⁰Then the priest shall take *some* of its blood with his finger, put *it* on the horns of the altar of burnt offering, and pour all *the remaining* blood at the base of the altar. ³¹He shall remove all its fat, as fat is removed from the sacrifice of the peace offering; and the priest shall burn it on the altar for a sweet aroma to the Lord. So the priest shall make atonement for him, and it shall be forgiven him. ³²If he brings a lamb as his sin offering, he shall bring a female without blemish. ³³Then he shall lay his hand on the head of the sin offering, and kill it as a sin offering at the place where they kill the burnt offering. ³⁴The priest shall take *some* of the blood of the sin offering with his finger, put *it* on the horns of the altar of burnt offering, and pour all *the remaining* blood at the base of the altar. ³⁵He shall remove all its fat, as the fat of the lamb is removed from the sacrifice of the peace offering. Then the priest shall burn it on the altar, according to the offerings made by fire to the Lord. So the priest shall make atonement for his sin that he has committed, and it shall be forgiven him.

☆ **Leviticus 6:24-30** ²⁴Also the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, ²⁵"Speak to Aaron and to his sons, saying, 'This *is* the law of the sin offering: In the place where the burnt offering is killed, the sin offering shall be killed before the Lord. **IT IS MOST HOLY.** ²⁶The priest who offers it for sin shall eat it. In a holy place it shall be eaten, in the court of the tabernacle of meeting. ²⁷Everyone who touches its flesh must be holy. And when its blood is sprinkled on any garment, you shall wash that on which it was sprinkled, in a holy place. ²⁸But the earthen vessel in which it is boiled shall be broken. And if it is boiled in a bronze pot, it shall be both scoured and rinsed in water. ²⁹All the males among the priests may eat it. *It is most holy.* ³⁰But no sin offering from which *any* of the blood is brought into the tabernacle of meeting, to make atonement in the holy *place*, shall be eaten. It shall be burned in the fire.

We should be able to see that the Oxen are the representation of the one who is a doer of His Words. James, the brother of Jesus, told us that we are to be doers of the Word and not hearers only. That means that the Oxen should be doers of His Words as Jesus was. If they do, then many will be healed, for Jesus said that His Words are healing Words (*Matthew 13:15*). Moses made the Tabernacle in the way of the instruction of the Lord.

Solomon made the Temple likened to the instructions given by the Lord to his father King David. In both the Tabernacle and the Temple the Lord reveals to us His Ways, and the both were built so as to prepare His people for increasing in knowledge of His Promises within His Words so that they could be prepared to do every Good Work. The Temple and the Tabernacle were like Bibles to those who understood the Words of God. The Oxen could teach His Words by the understanding of the way of the physical things that the Lord placed in front of their eyes. Consider that the Lord made it a law to the His people that all things that were to be in front of their eyes was to reveal His Words (*Deuteronomy 6:4-9 and Deuteronomy 11:18-21*). During these last days, as the Spirit of God moves through Israel and He will cause His Words to be made known to them. The people of Israel will turn to Him and He will make His Words known to them. They will turn to His Words and receive the Spirit of Truth as it reveals in Ezekiel 36. Then the Lord will sweep all uncleanness from Israel, and before the Midnight Hour He will cause Israel to inherit the entirety of the Promised Land that He proclaimed to their fathers, for the Lord shall do this for His name's sake. In those days, they will rebuild the Temple. I believe that the bible reveals that in those days, once again the sacrifices will be made not for the rejection of Jesus, but rather they will be made so as to teach the children of Israel the Way of the Words of God, and they will do this to bless many. Then the Oxen shall be again respected in Israel, for they will not sacrifice bulls without authority of the Lord and they will only do so to give Him glory.

Christians might say that this sacrificing of animals because of the lack of covering by Jesus' blood is some type of false doctrine, but they need to consider Paul's warning very carefully, for we have entered that Day of the Lord and things have changed for us. But, we must remember that after the Knowledge of Truth was received, Paul reveals to us in Hebrews 10:25-31, that willful sins are no longer covered by the sacrifice of Jesus. Now we must again to the Way of His Words. In Israel, these sacrifices will likely be done in the Temple partly as teaching, and also partly as for doing the Way of Righteousness likened to Job; and they will offer sacrifices to cover the people of Israel just in case they may have sin and become outside of the Way of His Words and committed willful sins. We Gentiles do not need to do those sacrifices, for the Lord has told us that there is a substitute sacrifice that covers a multitude of sins. That is to become a doer of the Words of God to enable Him to do a Good Work for your neighbors. The Lord says that whoever does such Good shall find favor from the Lord. That is the substitute replacement for the sacrifice of blood. No man can do Good for only God is Good, and thus it is not our Work, but God's Work. You can do nothing, but you can enable God to do a Good Work for another, and that gives Glory to the Lord and to God; further. it means that you accept and keep the New Covenant of His Good News – His Good Works enabling by your observing by action, His Way of His Holy Words. It is also important to remember that God's Words are Holy and a big part of the sacrifice of the sin offering is that the Lord did not allow unholy people to offer the sacrifice. Thus, the Lord will also not allow unholy people to do the Way of His Words. There are preachers and fathers who believe that they are holy and very righteous, but they should be very careful. The Lord makes it clear that after the Midnight Hour, or even when the time of your hour of decision has come, that none of those who have rejected His Words will be able to use His Ways of doing His Words to enable a Good Work to be done for others, for in those days only the worthy shall be heard in heaven or seen by the Father. Only those who have been sealed as being part of the Kingdom of God shall be able to enable His Good Works, all of the others remain as a "man of the earth", and not a "son of God's Kingdom", and in those days no man will be able to work.

☆ **Hebrews 10:25-31** ²⁵...and so much more **AS YOU SEE THE DAY (Day of the Lord) APPROACHING.** ²⁶**For IF we sin willfully AFTER We HAVE RECEIVED the KNOWLEDGE OF THE TRUTH, THERE NO LONGER REMAINS A SACRIFICE FOR SINS,** ²⁷but a certain fearful expectation of judgment, and fiery indignation, which will devour the adversaries. ²⁸Anyone who has rejected Moses' law dies without mercy on the testimony of two or three witnesses. ²⁹**Of how much worse punishment do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of Grace?** ³⁰For we know Him who said "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says the Lord. And again, "The Lord will judge His people." ³¹It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the Living God.

In Psalm 22:11-13, there is a teaching of what would happen when Jesus would be in the midst of suffering upon the Cross. In this passage that the Lord reveals that the wild strong bulls of Bashan have encircled Him. They were gaping at Him with their mouths and roaring like lions. These are the leading priests (*The big male oxen*), men who were filled with the spirit of their father the Devil, and who were mocking Jesus in His death upon the Cross. Jesus calls upon the Father to be near to Him, for not one of His priests were there to help Him. What a said fate of priests in the days of Jesus, when He was sent by the Father to speak and to do His Words, and none of the priests of Israel would receive His message of Truth? Will they repent and hear His Words, and begin to teach His knowledge; or, will they be rebellious as were the priests of Jesus' first coming, and shall they thereby willfully agree to take up their appointed place among the tortured in the prison of Sheol? Where are the Lord's true oxen? The Lord desires that all be saved and that all come to the knowledge of His Truth, including His Oxen.

THE PROMISE IN THE WORD OX

If the teachers of the Words of God, and this includes the parents, as they are priests unto their children, are faithful to speak of the Words to their children, then the Lord will bless the children in their ways and He will keep them, and if they wander from Him, He will bring them back to His Way in their life.
